### Revamp of secondary sanitary water pumping stations continues

anitary Engineering Assistant Undersecretary at Ministry of Works, Municipalities Affairs and Urban Planning, Asma Jassim Murad, stated that work is still ongoing on the project of revamping secondary sanitary water pumping stations in an effort to raise the efficiency of sanitary networks and to reduce damages.

Ms Murad explained that the project aims to maintain the stations and to improve them to raise their efficiency and to ensure their longevity in addition
