Gaza children, women 'dying' of malnutrition

As malnutrition surges in war-torn Gaza, tens of thousands of children and women require urgent treatment, according to the UN, while aid enters the blockaded Palestinian territory at a trickle.

Gaza's civil defence agency told AFP it has noted a rising number of infant deaths caused by "severe hunger and malnutrition", reporting at least three such deaths in the past week.

"These heartbreaking cases were not caused by direct bombing but by starvation, the lack of baby formula and the absence of basic healthcare," civil defence spokesman Mahmud Bassal told AFP.

Ziad Musleh, a 45-year-old father displaced from Gaza's north to the central city of Nuseirat, told AFP: "We are dying, our children are dying and we can't do anything to stop it."

HM King Hamad highlights strengthened Bahrain-US ties following key agreements

His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, conveyed their condolences to the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman bin Abdulaziz Al Saud. In their messages, they extended deep sym-

pathies to the Saudi royal family and the people of Saudi Arabia, praying for eternal peace for the deceased and strength for his family.

Prince's legacy

HRH Prince Al Waleed bin Khalid bin Talal Al Saud, known as the 'Sleeping Prince', passed

away at the age of 36 after spending nearly 20 years in a coma. The prince suffered a severe brain injury in a car accident in London in 2005 while attending a military college.

He was later moved to King Abdulaziz Medical City in Riyadh, where he remained on life support and was tube-fed for the rest of his life.

His father, HRH Prince Khalid bin Talal, consistently refused medical advice to withdraw care, citing faith and the will of God. In 2019, minor reflexes such as finger movements and head turns

sparked hope, though no recovery followed.

Final rites

Funeral prayers were held yesterday after Asr prayer at Imam Turki bin Abdullah Mosque in Riyadh. Condolences are being received at the family palace for three days.

HRH Prince Al Waleed's condition became a national symbol of patience, spiritual endurance, and a father's unwavering devotion, capturing the compassion of millions across the Arab world.

A new parliamentary friendship committee has been formed between Bahrain's Shura Council and Russia's Federation Council, in a move aimed at deepening bilateral cooperation and strengthening legislative ties

The announcement was made by His Excellency Ali bin Saleh Al Saleh, Chairman of the Shura Council, who confirmed the committee's formation as a di-

rect outcome of his recent visit to Moscow from July 14th to 18th, during which he held official talks with Valentina Matviyenko, Chairperson of Russia's Federation Council.

Bilateral coordination

H.E. Al Saleh said the new committee would serve as a platform for enhancing parliamentary diplomacy, broadening Bahrain-Russia coordination in regional and international forums, and reinforcing the historical ties between the two nations.

The initiative, he added, reflects the shared vision of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and Russian President Vladimir Putin to strengthen friendship and institutional

partnership across all sectors.

Committee leadership

The newly formed committee will be chaired by Jihad Abdullah Al Fadhel, Second Deputy Chairperson of the Shura Council. Members include Khalid Hussein Al Musallam, head of the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee; Dr Mohammed Ali Hassan Ali, chair of the Public Utilities and Environment Committee; and Ejlal Isa Bubshait, Deputy Chair of the Women and Children Committee. The move marks a continued push by the Shura Council to expand its role in international parliamentary diplomacy and exchange best practices with peer legislatures around the world.

UoB Launches AI Psychology

The University of Bahrain is expanding its postgraduate offerings with two new programmes aimed at bridging future skills gaps in both technology and mental health support.

A Master of Science in Applied Artificial Intelligence and a Doctor of Philosophy in Counselling Psychology were announced by the university, both set to begin in the 2025 - 2026 academic year.

President of the University, Dr. Fuad Mohammed Al Ansari, said the AI master's degree is designed for students from non-IT backgrounds who want to apply smart systems and data analytics to their fields. The course combines theoretical foundations with practical

applications, reflecting a demand for cross-disciplinary upskilling.

Meeting mental health needs

The PhD in Counselling Psychology aims to train professionals in supervisory and therapeutic support roles, including family counselling, career guidance, digital platforms, and trauma cases. Students will study advanced models of supervision and apply them to complex psychological contexts.

Future-ready portfolio

UoB currently offers 49 postgraduate programmes, including 33 master's and 13 doctoral tracks. Registration for the new academic year is open until August 14 through the university's online portal.

Digital Leap for NGOs

A comprehensive digital platform for managing civil society organisations is set to launch soon from the Ministry of Social Development. The new e-system is designed to modernise procedures for registered NGOs across Bahrain.

Institutional empowerment

According to Inas Mohammed Al-Majed, Assistant Undersecretary for Community Development, the platform will simplify documentation, accelerate processing times, and support stronger self-governance and oversight through electronic tracking and approvals. She described the launch as “a major step in our journey to create a smart, transparent sector driven by public-private collaboration.”

Public-private cooperation The platform has been developed in partnership with the National Bank of Bahrain and Atyaf eSolutions. Their contributions, Al-Majed noted, exemplify Bahrain’s effective model of government and private sector cooperation to foster social development.

The ministry first entered into an agreement with public and private stakeholders to develop the e-NGO system. In the next phase, additional e-services will be introduced to support NGOs, streamline workflows, and ensure high governance standards across the sector.

Tax Sweep Nets Dozens

Eight evasion cases under legal action

- 724 inspections in six months
- 71 fined for VAT violations

Bahrain’s National Bureau for Revenue (NBR) carried out 724 inspection visits across local markets during the first half of 2025, uncovering dozens of VAT and excise violations as part of a nationwide campaign to tighten tax compliance.

The intensified monitoring resulted in the reporting of 71 VAT-related offences. According to the NBR, the most common issue was the failure to issue proper VAT invoices, along with businesses not showing prices inclusive of VAT, failing to display VAT certificates in a visible location, and issuing tax invoices on non-taxable goods.



Administrative fines were imposed in each case.

Excise breaches and suspicious activity

The bureau also detected eight instances involving excise

goods acquired without payment of applicable duties. These cases were subject to administrative penalties under existing excise laws.

More significantly, eight suspected cases of VAT and Excise

tax evasion were identified during the same period. Legal proceedings have been initiated, with potential punishments including prison terms of up to five years and fines amounting to three times the VAT owed, or up to one year in prison and double the evaded excise amount.

Public urged to report violations

The NBR has urged businesses to strictly comply with VAT and Excise regulations to avoid penalties. It also called on the public to report any suspicious activity by contacting the NBR’s 24-hour call centre at 80008001 or through the Tawasul national complaints system.

Additional guidelines and updates are available on the NBR website, www.nbr.gov.bh. The bureau reaffirmed its commitment to transparent enforcement and continued inspection as part of its strategy to safeguard market integrity and consumer protection.

First time in history

Bahrain secures WIPO chair

Maryam AlDoseri elected

Paris Union oversees patents

Bahrain has secured a historic diplomatic breakthrough by winning the chairmanship of the Paris Union Assembly, one of the oldest treaty bodies within the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO).

Historic first

This marks the first time the Kingdom has assumed the presidency of a WIPO assembly. Maryam Abdulaziz AlDoseri, Bahrain’s Commercial Attaché at the Permanent Mission in Geneva, was elected as Chair of the Paris Union Assembly, which oversees the implementation of the 1883 Paris Con-

vention for the Protection of Industrial Property.

Global recognition

The Paris Convention forms the backbone of international standards related to patents, trademarks, and industrial designs. Bahrain’s election signals growing recognition of its active engagement in multilateral intellectual property policymaking and its leadership in promoting fair, transparent, and innovative global trade rules.

Strategic positioning

Officials say the appointment strengthens Bahrain’s global presence in intellectual property governance and aligns with its national priorities to support innovation, protect IP rights, and advance industrial cooperation through international platforms.

The chairmanship is expected to enhance Bahrain’s visibility in shaping global IP standards and deepen its influence in future treaty negotiations.

Youth Ministry, WHO enhance cooperation

Global Gem Gateway

Bahrain has taken a decisive step toward global leadership in gemmology education, with the Bahrain Institute for Pearls and Gemstones (DANAT) becoming the first institution in the Middle East to offer the prestigious Gem-A Diploma and Foundation programmes, accredited by the UK's Gemmological Association of Great Britain.

Registration has officially opened for the two academic tracks, which are scheduled to begin in September. The programmes are sponsored by the Labour Fund (Tamkeen) as part of Bahrain's wider national push to develop talent in high-value, specialised sectors.

Delivered by certified instructors with deep industry experience, the course offers over 300 hours of integrated theoretical and practical training across a 16-week period.

Vision 2030 aligned

With a limited number of certified Bahraini professionals currently active in the field, DANAT's move addresses a clear skills gap and strengthens the Kingdom's claim as a global centre for gemmology. The initiative aligns with Bahrain's Vision 2030 goals of diversifying the economy and investing in human capital development.

Jamsheer stressed the strategic intent behind the launch. “By cultivating a new generation of highly qualified gemmological professionals, DANAT reinforces its dedication to advancing Bahrain's status as a global hub for gemstones and jewellery expertise,” she said.

The programme is also part of DANAT's broader mission to blend scientific knowledge with Bahrain's long-standing pearling heritage, positioning the Kingdom not only as a guardian of tradition but as a rising force in the global gemstone arena.

All for progress

Services Committee drives bulk of Muharraq Municipal Council proposals

One committee alone put forward nearly two-thirds of all measures debated by Muharraq's municipal council during its latest term.

The Services and Public Utilities Committee was behind 140 out of 213 suggestions made during the third session of the sixth council.

The rest came from the Technical Committee, which submitted 41, and the Financial and Legal Committee, which added 32.

Decisions

The Services Committee met 17 times over the session. It took four decisions, prepared eight memos, and sent out four letters.

Among its main requests was approval for the final designs of a ring road stretching from Busaiteen through Al Dair and Samaheej to Diyar Al Muharraq in two stages.

It also called for widening Raya Road from the Busaiteen side to ease traffic. That work is already in progress.

Flyover

The committee also backed plans for a flyover linking Shaikh Isa bin Salman Bridge with Road 105 in Busaiteen, including an extra slip road.

Other ideas included placing portable prayer cabins in areas without mosques, working with the Ministry of Justice, Islamic Affairs and Waqf.

The committee also asked for shaded shelters outside schools,

new tarmac for streets and footpaths, better sewerage connections, and more space for parking in housing areas.

Pedestrian bridge

It also looked into the idea of a pedestrian bridge to connect Old Hidd with East Hidd across Dry Dock Road.

The Financial and Legal Committee held 19 meetings during the same session. It made 32 suggestions and 24 decisions.

Among them were plans to charge food delivery firms a fee, set money aside for repairing unsafe houses, and restart the Investment Committee within the council's executive side.

Public bidding

The committee supported opening Muharraq Grand Park to public bidding, called for land to be reserved for new housing, and suggested using a fifth of insurance money for investment.

Other items included a proposed change to Article 6, paragraph D of the Property Rent Law.

The aim was to better consid-

er both landlords and tenants.

The group also pushed for funding to tackle dangerous buildings, suggested relocating and improving the temporary central market, and called for a fund to support older neighbourhoods.

Recommendations

The Technical Committee, which met 11 times, put forward 41 recommendations, two decisions, two memos, and three letters.

It said councillors should be shown any council-owned land in their area before it goes to auction, and called for building limits in Diyar Al Muharraq to be revised.

It also laid down terms for around-the-clock shop openings, and turned down a guide allowing carports outside property lines, giving reasons for its stance.

Road junction

One of its suggestions was to name every road junction across Muharraq Governorate.

Its role also covered rules on

selling corner plots and using land owned by state bodies inside the council's boundary.

It looked into street names, park names and neighbourhood names, reviewed local health rules with those in charge, and handled permits for building, demolishing, repairing or changing structures.

Saar sewer project begins to connect 230 homes

A sewer project worth BHD 1.76 million has begun in Saar's Block 527, with the Ministry of Works confirming that construction is now in motion to connect 230 properties to the main network.

The work covers the northern section of the block and falls under the Government Programme for 2023 to 2026.

It includes the laying of over three kilometres of main sewer lines and nearly four kilometres of secondary pipes.

Teams will also build 135 main

manholes, 344 smaller inspection chambers, and a pumping station.

The road surface across the site will be restored once the work is finished.

Aim

Engineer Fatima Jaafar Ahmed, who leads the Sanitary Planning and Projects Directorate, said the aim is to expand access to the service while keeping pace with the housing and building spread seen across the governorates.

Residents and visitors have been asked to take care near the worksite and follow any safety signs.

The Tender Board awarded the contract to Eastern Asphalt & Mixed Concrete Company.

Japan sees bright future for ultra-thin, **flexible solar panels**

Tokyo, Japan

Japan is heavily investing in a new kind of ultra-thin, flexible solar panel that it hopes will help it meet renewable energy goals while challenging China’s dominance of the sector.

Pliable perovskite panels are perfect for mountainous Japan, with its shortage of flat plots for traditional solar farms. And a key component of the panels is iodine, something Japan produces more of than any country but Chile.

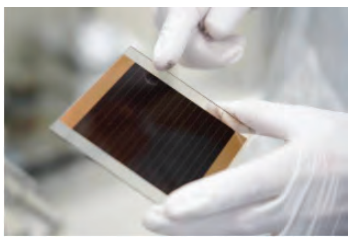
The push faces some obstacles: perovskite panels contain toxic lead, and, for now, produce less power and have shorter lifespans than their silicon counterparts.

Still, with a goal of net-zero by 2050 and a desire to break China’s solar supremacy, perovskite cells are “our best card to achieve both decarbonisation and industrial competitiveness,” minister of industry Yoji Muto said in November.

“We need to succeed in their implementation in society at all

costs,” he said.

The government is offering generous incentives to get industry on board, including a 157-billion-yen (\$1 billion) subsidy to plastic maker Sekisui Chemical for a factory to produce enough perovskite solar panels to generate 100 megawatts by 2027, enough to power 30,000 households.

By 2040, Japan wants to install enough perovskite panels to generate 20 gigawatts of electricity, equivalent to adding about 20 nuclear reactors.

That should help Japan’s target to have renewable energy cover up to 50 percent of electricity demand by 2040.

Breaking the silicon ceiling

The nation is looking to solar power, including perovskite and silicon-based solar cells, to cover up to 29 percent of all electricity demand by that time, a sharp rise from 9.8 percent in 2023.

“To increase the amount of renewable energy and achieve carbon neutrality, I think we will have to mobilise all the technol-

ogies available,” said Hiroshi Segawa, a specialist in next-generation solar technology at the University of Tokyo.

“Perovskite solar panels can be built domestically, from the raw materials to production to installation. In that sense, they could significantly contribute to things like energy security and economic security,” he told AFP.

Tokyo wants to avoid a repeat of the past boom and bust of the Japanese solar business.

In the early 2000s, Japanese-made silicon solar panels accounted for almost half the global market.

Now, China controls more than 80 percent of the global solar supply chain, from the production of key raw material to assembling modules.

Silicon solar panels are made of thin wafers that are processed into cells that generate electricity.

They must be protected by reinforced glass sheets and metal frames, making the final prod-

ucts heavy and cumbersome.

Perovskite solar cells, however, are created by printing or painting ingredients such as iodine and lead onto surfaces like film or sheet glass.

The final product can be just a millimetre thick and a tenth the weight of a conventional silicon solar cell.

Perovskite panels’ malleability means they can be installed on uneven and curved surfaces, a key feature in Japan, where 70 percent of the country is mountainous.

Generating where power is used

The panels are already being incorporated into several projects, including a 46-storey Tokyo building to be completed by 2028.

The southwestern city of Fukuoka has also said it wants to cover a domed baseball stadium with perovskite panels.

And major electronics brand Panasonic is working on integrating perovskite into window-

panes.

“What if all of these windows had solar cells integrated in them?” said Yukihiro Kaneko, general manager of Panasonic’s perovskite PV development department, gesturing to the glass-covered high-rise buildings surrounding the firm’s Tokyo office.

That would allow power to be generated where it is used, and reduce the burden on the national grid, Kaneko added.

For all the enthusiasm, perovskite panels remain far from mass production.

They are less efficient than their silicon counterparts, and have a lifespan of just a decade, compared to 30 years for conventional units.

The toxic lead they contain also means they need careful disposal after use.

However, the technology is advancing fast. Some prototypes can perform nearly as powerfully as silicon panels and their durability is expected to reach 20 years soon.

Cammie, a young camel whose front leg was chopped off by a landlord in Pakistan's southern province of Sindh, left her caregivers emotional as she walked for the first time on a prosthetic leg.

"I started weeping when I saw her walking with the prosthetic leg. It was a dream come true," Sheema Khan, the manager of an animal shelter in Karachi told AFP on Saturday.

Veterinarian Babar Hussain said it was the first time a large animal in Pakistan had received a prosthetic leg.

Cammie's leg was allegedly severed by a landlord in June 2024 as punishment for entering

his field in search of fodder.

A video of the wounded camel that circulated on social media prompted swift government action. According to the deputy commissioner of Sanghar, she was transported the very next

day to Karachi, over 250 kilometers (155 miles) away, and has been living in a shelter there ever since.

"She was terrified when she first arrived from Sanghar. We witnessed her heart-wrench-

ing cries. She was afraid of men," Khan told AFP.

One of the biggest challenges the caregivers faced was gaining her trust.

"I cannot put her condition into words," Khan added.

To aid her recovery, the caregivers introduced another young camel named Callie. Her

presence brought comfort to the injured Cammie, who tried standing on her three legs for the first time after seeing her new companion.

"Cammie had been confined to her enclosure for almost four to five months before Callie arrived," Khan added.

After treating the wound and

completing initial rehabilitation, the shelter -- Comprehensive Disaster Response Services (CDRS) Benji Project -- arranged a prosthetic leg from a US-based firm so she could walk on all fours again.

"We don't force her to walk. After attaching the prosthetic leg, we wait about 15 to 20 minutes. Then she stands up on her own and walks slowly," veterinarian Hussain told AFP.

He said that it would take another 15 to 20 days for her to fully adjust to the new limb.

The caregivers said Cammie will remain at the shelter permanently.

Ahmedabad Air Disaster: "Media Points Finger at Pilot"

On June 12, a catastrophic event shook the nation when Air India Flight 171, a Boeing 787-8 Dreamliner, crashed moments after takeoff from Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport in Ahmedabad. The tragedy claimed the lives of 241 of the 242 passengers aboard and 19 individuals on the ground at a medical college hospital where the aircraft plummeted.

From the outset, suspicion has swirled around the pilots as the cause of the disaster. Initial reports suggested that co-pilot Clive Kunther was responsible for the crash. However, in recent days, media narratives have shifted, pinning the blame on Captain Sumit Sabharwal. Speculation, fuelled by sensationalised reporting, claims that Captain Sabharwal, grieving the recent death of his mother, deliberately caused the crash as an act of suicide.

These allegations, reportedly based on leaks from agencies such as the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB), which are assisting India's Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), were first carried by The Wall Street Journal. The story, marked by dramatic language, was picked up by The Daily Telegraph and subsequently amplified by Indian media outlets.

Indian authorities, however, opted to retain control of the aircraft's black box rather than transfer it to the United States. The Indian Ministry of Civil Aviation has also categorically dismissed these media claims,

emphasising that the investigation remains ongoing.

This stance appears to reflect wider concerns among those closely monitoring the investigation, including within Boeing and Air India.

Who, then, is Captain Sumit Sabharwal? At 54, this unmarried pilot resided with his elderly parents in Powai, Mumbai. His mother passed away recently, leaving behind his 97-year-old father, a former official with the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA). Captain Sabharwal, whose elder sister resides in Delhi with her two children, both pilots, was reportedly preparing to retire to care for his ailing father full-time.

Colleagues and friends describe him as a calm, respected individual who, even amidst personal grief, maintained a routine of taking walks with his elderly father. With extensive experience piloting aircraft such as the Airbus A310, Boeing 777 and the 787 Dreamliner, logging between 8,200 and 15,638 hours on the latter, Captain Sabharwal was a seasoned aviator.

Yet, media narratives allege that this composed and dedicated professional resorted to suicide, driven by grief over his mother's death and the burden of caring for his aging father. How implausible does this story seem?

This rush to judgment, introduced in reports by The Wall Street Journal and The Daily Telegraph, was echoed widely by Indian media over the past two days. Adding fuel to the fire, some commentators, including a pilot named Mohan Rangana-

than, have publicly speculated about possible mental health factors, though no formal documentation or diagnosis has been cited in public records.

Strikingly, few have questioned why such concerns were never formally documented. Instead, these claims risk shifting the narrative away from systemic or technical issues and toward a pilot who can no longer defend himself.

It is worth noting that since 2019, the Boeing 787 Dreamliner has faced documented technical and software issues.

To attribute the crash of an aircraft, potentially experiencing unresolved maintenance issues, to a pilot's personal tragedy is not only convenient but also deeply troubling. The ease with which some media have embraced this theory, while giving little attention to the aircraft's mechanical record, is alarming.

According to official reports, Air India Flight 171 crashed on June 12 at 1:39 PM Indian Standard Time, or 8:09 UTC, just 30 seconds after takeoff. At the moment of impact, the aircraft's maximum speed was recorded at 180 knots. Reports further indicate that the engine start switches were reactivated at 8:08:42 UTC, suggesting that within the brief 30-second window post-takeoff, the aircraft's engines were turned off and then restarted.

The apparent cause? The fuel tank switches were found in the "off" position. The flight's voice recorder captured a critical exchange: one pilot, upon discovering the issue, asked, "Who turned this off?" to which the other responded, "Not me." This conversation, preserved in the retrieved black box, has fuelled a narrative, first raised by The Wall Street Journal and echoed by The Daily Telegraph and Indian media, that Captain

Sumit Sabharwal deliberately switched off the fuel supply, causing the crash. The question remains, whom does this narrative serve?

Let us now examine the flaws in this theory.

Imagine driving a car at 80 kilometres per hour and suddenly shifting it into neutral without braking. The car would continue moving forward for some distance due to inertia, the natural tendency of an object in motion to remain in motion. The same principle applies to an aircraft.

In the case of Air India Flight 171, the crash occurred at 1:39 PM IST, moments after the pilots' recorded exchange about the fuel switches.

The switches were found off and promptly turned back on, indicating that the pilots noticed the issue when the engines lost the thrust needed to climb. Following standard procedure, they attempted to reboot the fuel switches at 8:08:42 UTC to restart the engines.

Tragically, within the next 18 seconds, the aircraft plummeted to the ground. If the engines were restarted at 8:08:42 UTC, they must have been turned off, or become inoperative, prior to that moment. For an aircraft travelling at 180 knots, an immediate crash upon engine cutoff is implausible. Inertia should have allowed it to glide further before descending.

The absence of such a glide suggests the fuel switches were turned off while the aircraft was still on the runway, causing the engines to fail shortly after takeoff. Like a kite with a snapped string, the plane briefly soared before crashing and bursting into flames. The pilots' exchange likely occurred during this chaotic sequence.

Would a pilot intent on suicide attempt to restart the engines to save the aircraft? The

notion seems absurd.

Another critical point: the fuel switch in a Boeing 787-8 Dreamliner (registration VT-ANB), powered by two General Electric GENx-1B engines, is not a simple electrical toggle like a light bulb. It is controlled by a sophisticated software system known as the Full Authority Digital Engine Control (FADEC). When a pilot flips the fuel switch, it sends a request, not a direct command, to the software, which evaluates the request based on operational conditions.

In some cases, the system may even prompt the pilot for confirmation before cutting the fuel supply to the engines. These processes unfold in milliseconds.

In essence, even if Captain Sabharwal had intended to sabotage the flight, it would have been extremely difficult to bypass the FADEC system to cut the fuel supply and bring down the aircraft. Moreover, the timeline of events suggests there was simply no time for such an act.

Since 2019, the Boeing 787 Dreamliner has been repeatedly affected by software glitches, with Boeing issuing periodic service patches to address them, patches that have often been criticised as inadequate.

Meanwhile, Air India faces allegations of negligence in maintaining this aircraft. Whether the reported technical issues, some of which Captain Sabharwal is said to have noted in the logbook, were addressed promptly, or whether the aircraft was overdue for servicing, remains under investigation.

Yet, despite these unresolved questions, some media outlets have presented Captain Sabharwal as the primary cause, based on reports that remain unverified.

My plea is simple: until the official investigation report is released, we must refrain from tarnishing the memory of a captain who lost his life in this tragedy.

The allegations against Boeing and the persistent issues with the Dreamliner's systems could easily warrant another major article. However, for now, the focus must remain on seeking the truth, not perpetuating convenient narratives.

◆ **Iran has replaced the air** defence systems damaged during its 12-day war with Israel last month, a senior army general said on Sunday according to state media. “The Zionist enemy sought to destroy Iran’s defense capabilities, and some of our defense systems were damaged in that war,” army operations chief Mahmoud Mousavi was quoted as saying by the official IRNA news agency. “The damaged defence systems have now been replaced,” he added. Iran’s air defence network includes systems like the domestically built Bavar-373 and Khordad-15, designed to counter missiles and aircraft. Iran also installed Russia’s S-300 air defense systems in 2016.

◆ **Britain, France** and Germany are planning to hold fresh talks with Iran on its nuclear programme in the coming days, a German diplomatic source told AFP yesterday. could be reactivated if Tehran does not resume negotiations. Iran’s Tasnim news agency also reported that Tehran had agreed to hold talks with the three European countries, citing an unnamed source. Consultations are ongoing regarding a date and location for the talks, the report said.

Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi held a call Friday with his British, French and German counterparts and European Union foreign policy chief Kaja Kallas.

◆ **Hong Kong was** battered by strong winds and heavy rain on Sunday as Typhoon Wipha skirted along China’s southern coast, with fallen trees and collapsed scaffolding spotted across the city. Wipha was located around 140 kilometres (87 miles) to Hong Kong’s southwest as of 5 pm (0900 GMT), according to the city’s weather observatory. Hong Kong’s highest tropical cyclone warning, T10, was in effect for around seven hours but was downgraded to the third-highest T8 warning at 4:10 pm as Wipha departed the city. “Gale to storm force southeasterly winds are still affecting parts of the territory occasionally,” the observatory said. “The intense rainbands of Wipha are persistently affecting the vicinity of Pearl River Estuary.” Neighbouring casino hub Macau issued its own top-level typhoon warning shortly after noon, with authorities suspending all public transportation services.

Putin meets Khamenei’s top adviser Larijani for nuclear talks

Russian President Vladimir Putin held a surprise meeting with Ali Larijani, top adviser to Iran’s supreme leader on nuclear issues, to discuss Tehran’s nuclear programme in the Kremlin yesterday.

Moscow has a cordial relationship with Iran’s clerical leadership and provides crucial backing for Tehran but did not swing forcefully behind its partner even after the United States joined Israel’s massive bombing campaign on Iran in June.

Larijani “conveyed assessments of the escalating situation in the Middle East and around the Iranian nuclear programme”, Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said of the unannounced meeting.

Putin had expressed Russia’s “well-known positions on how to stabilize the situation in the

region and on the political settlement of the Iranian nuclear programme”, he added.

Separately, a German diplomatic source told AFP on Sunday that Britain, France and Germany are planning to hold fresh talks with Iran on its nuclear programme in the coming days.

Iran’s Tasnim news agency also reported that Tehran had agreed to hold talks with the three European countries, citing an unnamed source.

Last week, Russia had slammed a story by US news outlet Axios citing anonymous sources that said Putin had “encouraged” Iran to accept a deal with the United States that would prevent the Islamic republic from enriching uranium.

Iran has consistently denied seeking a nuclear weapon, while defending its “legitimate rights” to the peaceful use of atomic energy.

Israeli fire kills 73 aid seekers

Deaths of civilians seeking aid have become a regular occurrence

Gaza’s civil defence agency said Israeli forces opened fire on crowds of Palestinians trying to collect humanitarian aid in the war-torn Palestinian territory yesterday, killing 73 people and wounding dozens more.

At least 67 were killed as truckloads of aid arrived in the north, while six others were reported shot near an aid point close to Rafah in the south, where dozens of people lost their lives just 24 hours earlier.

The UN World Food Programme said its 25-truck convoy carrying food aid “encountered massive crowds of hungry civilians which came under gunfire” near Gaza City, soon after it crossed from Israel and cleared checkpoints.

Israel’s military disputed the death toll and said soldiers had

fired warning shots “to remove an immediate threat posed to them” as thousands gathered near Gaza City.

Deaths of civilians seeking aid have become a regular occurrence in Gaza, with the authorities blaming Israeli fire as crowds facing chronic shortages of food and other essentials flock in huge numbers to aid centres.

The UN said earlier this month that nearly 800 aid-seekers had been killed since late May, including on the routes of aid convoys.

“Sniper” fire In Gaza City, Qasem Abu Khat-er, 36, told AFP he had rushed to try to get a bag of flour but instead found a desperate crowd of thousands and “deadly overcrowding

and pushing”.

“The tanks were firing shells randomly at us and Israeli sniper soldiers were shooting as if they were hunting animals in a forest,” he added.

“Dozens of people were martyred right before my eyes and no one could save anyone.”

Civil defence agency spokesman Mahmud Bassal told AFP the death toll was 67 and expected to rise while the WFP condemned violence against civilians seeking aid as “completely unacceptable”.

“Israeli forces’ gunfire” was responsible for the deaths in the south, he added.

Media restrictions in Gaza and difficulties accessing many ar-

reas mean AFP is unable to independently verify tolls and details provided by the agency and other parties.

The army has maintained that it works to avoid harm to civilians, saying this month that it issued new instructions to its troops on the ground “following lessons learned” from a spate of similar incidents.

Papal call

The war was sparked by Hamas’s attack on Israel on October 7, 2023, leading to the deaths of 1,219 people, most of them civilians, according to an AFP tally based on official figures.

Israel’s retaliatory campaign has killed 58,895 Palestinians, mostly civilians, according to the health ministry in Hamas-run Gaza.

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu on Thursday expressed his regret to Pope Leo XIV after what he described as a “stray” munition killed three people sheltering at the Holy Family Church in Gaza City.

At the end of the Angelus prayer on Sunday, the pope slammed the “barbarity” of the Gaza war and called for peace, days after the Israeli strike on the territory’s only Catholic church.

The strike was part of the “ongoing military attacks against the civilian population and places of worship in Gaza”, he added.

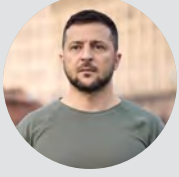

US CEO in viral Coldplay video quits



"Uh-oh, what? Either they're having an affair or they're just very shy," joked Coldplay frontman Chris Martin.

The CEO of an American tech company resigned Saturday after a video of him embracing an alleged colleague at a Coldplay concert went viral and fueled relentless memes.

"Our leaders are expected to set the standard in both conduct and accountability, and recently, that standard was not met," New York-based Astronomer said in a statement shared on LinkedIn.

"Andy Byron has tendered his resignation," the firm said, after previously launching an investigation.

During a Coldplay concert in Foxborough, Massachusetts on Wednesday, the jumbotron

zoomed in on a man and a woman embracing in the stands.

But the canoodling pair appeared shocked and horrified when they spotted themselves on the big screen, with the man ducking out of frame and the woman hiding her face.

"Uh-oh, what? Either they're having an affair or they're just very shy," joked Coldplay frontman Chris Martin.

Within hours, internet sleuths tracked down the man as Astronomer CEO Andy Byron and said the woman was the company's chief people officer, Kristin Cabot, alleging that the two were having a not-so-discreet affair.

The video has garnered millions of views on TikTok and other social media, giving rise

to memes discussing everything from the folly of having an affair at a Coldplay concert, to the hypocrisy of an HR representative seemingly caught in a workplace relationship.

"The craziest thing is about the Astronomer CEO cheating scandal is it was the HR lady," said one X user. "The person who would warn you against fraternizing with coworkers."

Furry mascots of the Philadelphia Phillies Major League Baseball team jumped on the trend and recreated the scene for the jumbotron at a game after the video went viral.

However an apology statement attributed to Byron which spread rapidly online was fake and appeared to have originated from a parody account.

South Korea rain death toll hits 17, with 11 missing

Heavy rain in South Korea has killed at least 17 people in recent days, government records showed yesterday, while 11 remain unaccounted for in the intense downpours.

South Korea typically experiences monsoon rains in July

and is usually well-prepared. But this week, the country's southern regions were hit with some of the heaviest hourly rainfall on record, according to official data.

There was also a dangerous deluge in the north early Sunday, with close to 170 millimetres (6.7 inches) of rain hitting

Gapyeong county in Gyeonggi province, east of the capital Seoul, leaving at least two dead and five missing.

The number of casualties rose throughout the day as bodies of those previously reported missing -- many swept away in landslides -- were recovered.

Agency relationship

Many points were raised and many questions were asked by many concerned entities regarding the agency relationship between the agent and the principal, generally the concept of agency in general and the duties of the appointed agent in particular.

To begin with, in an attempt to explain the legal concept and the limits conferred on the agent, we say that an agency relationship is the fiduciary bond which results from the manifestation of a consent by one person (who is the principal) to another person (who is the agent) wherein the principal to appoint an agent who shall act on his behalf and subject to his control and consent to the acts taken by the agent.

In other words, to create an agency relationship there must be a principal and an agent who mutually consent that the agent will act on behalf of the principal and be subject to his control. By this mutual agreement they are giving their consent to create a fiduciary relationship.

Based on the above, it is clear that consent, control and a fiduciary relationship are necessary for agency relationship. To establish consent, the principal must ask the agent to do something and likewise the agent must agree to do what he has been asked to do.

Control of the principal is required and based on this the principal is liable for the acts of his agent because principals exercise control over their agents. This point of control is very crucial to determine the legal status of the agency and the liability of the principal who will be of no liability unless there is agency relationship conferring a certain degree of control from him regarding the acts of his agent. In other words, an agent and principal must not only consent to an agency relationship, but the principal must also have control over the agent.

As explained above an agency relationship between the two parties is a form of a fiduciary relationship which constitutes certain type of special relationship with high standards. The beneficiary places special confidence in the fiduciary who, in turn, is obligated to act in good faith and perform his duty in every aspect in good faith.

This high standard of duty and good faith requires that the agent works for the interest of the principal and the interest of the agency relationship and, in this respect, to put his own personal needs second in line. This is basically because the purpose of the fiduciary relationship is for one person to benefit another. Agents have, and are required to have, a fiduciary duty to their principals. They have already accepted to undertake this special duty by giving their consent to form the agency relationship with the principal.

All three elements i.e., the consent, the control and the fiduciary duty are necessary to form or create an agency relationship. However, we need to mention that in some relationships, for example, there might be a fiduciary duty but no control. A trustee of a trust must act for the benefit of the beneficiaries, but the beneficiaries have no right to control the trustee. Therefore, a trustee even though he is doing fiduciary duty but he is not an agent for the beneficiaries.

Turkey's Erdogan insists on Cyprus two-state solution

Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan yesterday reaffirmed his country's support for a two-state solution in Cyprus, urging the international community to accept the Mediterranean island's existing division.

Cyprus has been divided since 1974, when a Turkish invasion followed a coup in Nicosia backed by Greece's

then-military junta. The Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, declared in 1983, is recognised only by Ankara.

"We fully support the vision based on a two-state solution," Erdogan said during a visit to northern Cyprus marking 51 years since Turkish troops invaded the island.

"It is time for the international community to make peace with the realities on the ground," Erdogan said.

It looks like a dragonfly and flies like a dream — meet the Pivotal Helix (formerly the BlackFly), the personal flying vessel that puts the sky on your terms. What began as a sci-fi fantasy is now real: an ultralight, car-

bon-fibre eVTOL that first flew in 2018 and today arrives as the Helix — Pivotal's fourth-generation, production-ready aircraft and successor to the original BlackFly. Weighing just 115 kg empty and supporting a max take-off weight of around 249 kg, the Helix qualifies under the U.S. FAA Part 103 ultralight category — meaning no pilot's licence, no runway, and minimal regulatory burden. Its eight whisper-quiet electric motors enable vertical takeoff and landing, and the unique tilt-aircraft design — where the entire airframe angles forward — ensures smooth, controlled flight. Performance is focused on

short, low-altitude personal flights: a top speed of 101 km/h, with up to 32 km of range (leaving 20% battery in reserve). Each flight lasts about 20 minutes, and recharging the 8 kWh battery takes roughly 75 minutes on a 240V connection, or around 4.5 hours on a standard 120V outlet. At just 72 dB, it's quieter than most cars and significantly less disruptive than traditional aircraft or drones. Safety is core to the Helix's design. It includes triple-redundant fly-by-wire controls, auto-hover, auto-land, and a ballistic parachute. A front-facing and downward-facing camera system helps with landings, while an ADS-B transponder enhances

visibility to other aircraft. Envelope protection systems and simple joystick controls make flying feel more intuitive than driving a car. Built with carbon-fibre composites, the Helix is light enough to be trailered and re-assembled in under 30 minutes. It can land on grass, snow, asphalt, and even water in emergencies. Priced at \$190,000 (about 1.6 crore), the Helix isn't inexpensive — but it's real, in production, and already reaching customers across the U.S. Higher-spec versions, reaching \$260,000, include upgraded avionics, custom lighting, and trailer kits.

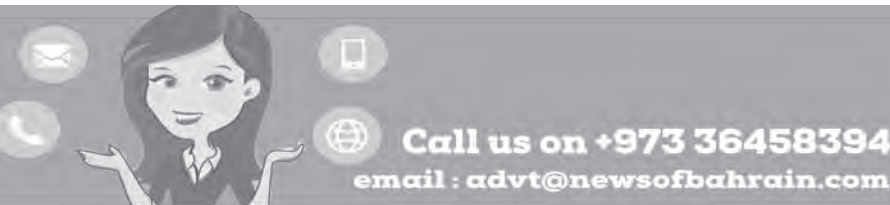

Pacquiao held to draw by Barrios in world title return

Filipino legend dominates early but settles for draw in dramatic comeback fight

- Pacquiao, 46, returns after four-year retirement
- Barrios retains WBC welterweight title
- Judges scored 115-113, 114-114, 114-114
- Both fighters open to rematch

Manny Pacquiao’s bid to make a fairytale return to boxing at the age of 46 ended in disappointment on Saturday, as the Filipino icon was held to a draw by defending WBC welterweight champion Mario Barrios in Las Vegas.

Barrios, 30, retained his belt despite being dominated for several rounds by Pacquiao, making a comeback to the ring after a four-year retirement. Barrios was awarded the fight 115-113 by one judge, with the other two cards scoring it 114-114. The result drew a subdued reaction from the MGM Grand Garden Arena crowd, who had roared on Pacquiao during a cagey, hard-fought contest. At times, it seemed as if Pacquiao was poised to write another improbable chapter in his 30-year professional career as he used all of his guile and experience to frustrate Barrios. But Barrios rallied furiously

over the final three rounds -- he was deemed the winner of those rounds on all three cards -- to do just enough to force a result that sees him retain his title. “I thought I won the fight,” Pacquiao said afterwards. “I mean, it was a close fight. My opponent was very tough. But it was a wonderful fight. “I was trying to find a way to finish the fight but my opponent was so tough. He threw punches in combination and with defense, so it was hard.” Barrios, meanwhile, felt he had done enough to deserve the draw. “I thought I pulled it out,” Barrios said. “But I still tip my hat to Manny. It was an honor to

share the ring with him, somebody with so much experience who has accomplished so much in this sport. We left everything in the ring, nothing but love and respect.” Barrios admitted he had been awed by Pacquiao’s remarkable

reserves of energy and stamina. “That’s crazy -- his stamina, he can still crack and he’s still strong as hell. His timing, his rhythm, everything. He was still a very awkward fighter to figure out,” he said.

Rematch offer

Barrios said he had been made aware that he needed to up his workrate to force the result over the closing rounds. “I knew I had to step it up to try to and solidify a win,” Barrios said. “I was really pressing him, trying to make him feel old. But he has some good legs -- a lot of the tank and a lot of fight left in him.

Marquez masters Brno, again

Marc Marquez wins Czech MotoGP for his eighth victory in 12 races, extending his championship lead

- Fifth consecutive victory for Marquez
- Bezzecchi 2nd, Acosta takes first podium

Marc Marquez won the Czech MotoGP yesterday for his eighth victory in 12 races this season and fifth in a row, extending his commanding lead in the world championship.

The factory Ducati rider beat Marco Bezzecchi on an Aprilia by almost two seconds, while Pedro Acosta on a KTM came in third in his first race podium finish of the season.

Marquez had a fifth straight perfect weekend, winning both the sprint on Saturday and yesterday's race.

The 32-year-old Spaniard now leads the world championship with 381 points, 120 ahead of his younger brother Alex who crashed, and 168 ahead of Ducati teammate Francesco Bagnaia.

"It has been a super first part of the season and especially these last races," Marquez said.

"I feel better and better and I'm riding super good," he added.

Bagnaia started from pole in bright sunshine but only retained the lead until the second lap when Bezzecchi eased past him, with Marquez following suit soon afterwards.

Acosta did the same to settle down in third after getting a boost from a second-place finish in Saturday's sprint.

Marquez glided past Bezzecchi in lap eight as the runaway trio kept building up their lead, and as so often this season kept widening the gap comfortably.

The three stayed put until the finish line, although fourth-placed Bagnaia gave Acosta a hard time pressing from behind.

"The first lap was unbelievable," said Bezzecchi.

"I had so much fun in the first half of the race but unfortunately when Marc passed me I immediately saw that he had something more."

"I tried to attack but he was strong. Anyway, I made a fantas-

tic performance, I'm very, very happy," added the Italian.

'Long journey'

Acosta relished his Brno podium finishes after spending much of the year battling a forearm injury.

"The last time that I was in the podium was in Thailand last year. It was a really long journey to come back here," said the 21-year-old Spaniard.

Reigning world champion Jorge Martin collected his first points after finishing seventh in the first race he has completed this year.

Martin sat out the first three races following two pre-season crashes and then crashed again during his comeback race at Qatar, missing another seven events.

Marquez took 40 min

04.628sec to complete the 21 laps on the resurfaced 5.4-kilometre Brno circuit returning to the MotoGP calendar after a five-year break due to financial woes.

Bezzecchi crossed the line 1.753 seconds adrift, while Acosta trailed Marquez by 3.366sec.

Almost 220,000 fans gathered in the stands for the weekend as Marquez sped to his fourth MotoGP win at Brno after 2013, 2017 and 2019.

'Time to relax'

Alex Marquez retired after crashing on lap two to leave Brno without a point following a disappointing 17th spot in the sprint race.

He took out Joan Mir who also walked away from the gravel safety area, just like Enea Bastianini a lap later.

Japan's Takaaki Nakagami was ruled out of the race after suffering a knee injury in a crash in Saturday's sprint.

The MotoGP circus will now take a summer break and resume with the Austrian GP on August 15-17.

"Now it's the summer break but still 10 races to go. Time to relax, but in Austria I (will) keep the same mentality with the same intensity," said Marquez.

He is eyeing his seventh MotoGP world title -- and first since 2019 -- that would put him level with Valentino Rossi and one behind the legendary Giacomo Agostini.

Messi double as Miami bounce back against Red Bulls

Lionel Messi rediscovered his scoring touch with two goals as Inter Miami bounced back from defeat to complete a 5-1 drubbing of the New York Red Bulls in Major League Soccer on Saturday.

Messi's red-hot season was rocked on Wednesday as Miami stumbled to a 3-0 defeat against FC Cincinnati.

But the Argentinian superstar was back to his inspired best as Miami turned on the style at the Sports Illustrated Stadium in Harrison, New Jersey to record an emphatic victory.

The Red Bulls had threatened to deliver another upset after Alexander Hack bundled home a 14th-minute opener to fire the hosts into an early lead.

But Messi swiftly orchestrated Inter Miami's recovery from that setback, providing a

sublime pass to set up former Barcelona team-mate Jordi Alba's equaliser in the 24th minute.

Messi then combined with Alba for Miami's second goal, producing another brilliant pass to pick out the Spaniard, who crossed for Telasco Segovia to prod home on 27 minutes.

Segovia then swept in his second of the night deep into first-half stoppage time to leave Miami firmly in control.

Messi then took over in the second half as Miami cut loose. A majestic through ball by another former Barcelona team-mate, Sergio Busquets, sent the Argentine World Cup-winner racing through on goal in the 60th minute.

Messi took his time and coolly feinted to wrongfoot Red Bulls goalkeeper Carlos Coronel before tucking away the finish for 4-1.

Hermann powers South Africa to T20 win over Zimbabwe

A maiden international half-century by Rubin Hermann took South Africa to a seven-wicket win over Zimbabwe in their Twenty20 international tri-series match at Harare Sports Club yesterday.

The left-handed Hermann hit 63 off 36 balls as South Africa chased down a target of 145 with 16 balls to spare.

Defeat ended Zimbabwe's hopes of playing in the final and ensured that South Africa and unbeaten New Zealand will meet in the showpiece match on Saturday.

bowler Tinotenda Maposa with only 22 runs on the board.

But Hermann, 28, who made his debut in the opening match of the tournament, struck the ball confidently and dominated a third wicket stand of 106 with captain Rassie van der Dussen, who finished unbeaten on 52.

Van der Dussen said there had been an improvement in all aspects of South Africa's performance.

"I was really chuffed with the bowling - 144 was never enough. We lost two early wickets so there was a little bit of early pressure but Rubin came in and played beautifully," he said.

It was a slow start, but once Bahrain hit their stride, there was no stopping them. Qatar, Kuwait Stay in the Hunt in Pool B

Over in Pool B, Qatar picked up their second straight win by beating a spirited Oman in four sets (25-19, 25-16, 23-25, 25-16). Oman's Ismail Al Hidi impressed despite the loss, notching 24 points, 23 from attack.

The day's most dramatic contest came between Kuwait and Saudi Arabia, which was a back-and-forth five-set battle that ended with Kuwait clinching the decider 15-13. Once again, it was Rashed Anbar leading the way for Kuwait with 24 points, continuing his standout tournament after topping Day 1's scoring despite defeat.

Today's schedule

The third day of group stage play features another full schedule of four matches at Isa Sports City. Lebanon will face Jordan at 1 PM, followed by Saudi Arabia vs Oman at 3 PM. Qatar and Kuwait, both on form, will face each other at 5 PM. But all eyes will be on the nightcap where Bahrain will face UAE at 7 PM in a match that could decide the top seed in Pool A.

With momentum building and the home crowd behind them, Bahrain's gold medal chase continues with purpose, as they aim for a third title this year following their AVC Nations Cup win.

France's Boisson wins maiden WTA title in Hamburg

French number one Lois Boisson battled to her first WTA title on clay in Hamburg yesterday with a straight sets win over Hungary's Anna Bondar.

A surprise Roland Garros semi-finalist last month, Boisson won 7-5, 6-3 to give France a first success on the WTA circuit since Caroline Garcia at the season-ending Tour Finals in November 2022.

Wellens wins stage as Pogacar keeps Tour de France lead

Tim Wellens of Team UAE won a baking and hilly stage 15 of the Tour de France at Carcassonne yesterday after a 45km solo rampage towards the walled citadel.

Overall leader Tadej Pogacar held on to the overall lead with a 4min 13sec advantage on Jonas Vingegaard, who had to fight to catch up when caught behind an early mass fall.

Wellens had been part of an early break that was whittled down to five before the Belgian champion's sudden acceleration caught the others napping.

This was a fifth win for Team UAE with Pogacar previously having won four on a thoroughly dominant Tour for the team.

Wellens was so far ahead at the finish line he had time to high five dozens of Belgian fans on the run in on the eve of the

Belgian national holiday.

Wellens has also won stages on the Giro d'Italia and the Vuelta a Espana.

The remaining 167 riders embarked towards Carcassonne yesterday on yet another nervy stage.

After a mass fall early on with Florian Lipowitz and

Vingegaard involved, the Pogacar group raced on, leaving two-time winner Vingegaard and a clique of 30 riders to exhaust themselves catching up.

Pogacar entered the Pyrenees on Thursday tucked in at second to surprise yellow jersey Ben Healy but emerged with two more stage wins and a four min-

utes advantage atop the overall standings in his bid for a fourth Tour de France title.

Monday is a the final rest day before the 2025 edition soars into the Alps on Tuesday's stage 16 with the 15.8km ascent of Mont Ventoux at 7.9 percent gradient to its 1901m high summit.

England to host next three World Test Championship finals

England will stage the next three World Test Championship finals after the successful hosting of the first three showpiece matches, the International Cricket Council (ICC) announced yesterday.

The most recent final took place last month, when South Africa were crowned champions for the first time after defeating holders Australia at Lord's.

Nearly 110,000 people went through the gates of the London ground over the course of a Test lasting four days.

India were reportedly keen to host the next final in two years' time but England have been awarded the finals of the 2027, 2029 and 2031 editions.

At its annual conference in Singapore, the ICC noted England's "successful track record in hosting recent finals", even

though Ben Stokes's side are yet to reach the one-off showpiece.

"We are absolutely delighted that England and Wales has been chosen to host the next three ICC World Test Championship finals," said England and Wales Cricket Board chief executive Richard Gould.

"It's a testament to the passion that fans in this country have for this treasured format of the game and the willingness of supporters from around the world to travel here for these games."

Nine teams contest the WTC and each nation plays six other sides -- three home and three away -- over the course of a two-year cycle.

Teams are ranked by percentage of points won because they play a different number of matches within those six series.
