**Facebook plans to change name**

London

Social media giant Facebook is planning to re-brand itself with a new name next week, according to a report.

Facebook Chief Executive Officer Mark Zuckerberg plans to talk about the name change at the company's annual Connect conference on Oct. 28, but it could be unveiled sooner, the Verge reported.

In response, Facebook said it does not comment on "rumour or speculation."

The news comes at a time when the company is facing increasing US government scrutiny over its business practices.

Lawmakers have excoriated the company, illustrating the rising anger in Congress with Facebook.

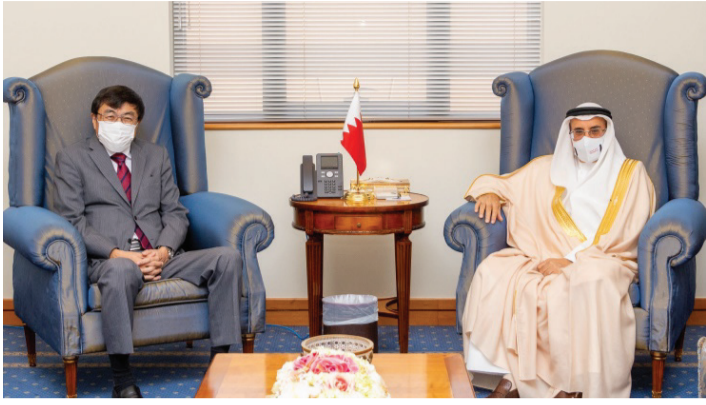

## Training programme on information technology

The training programme aims to build the capabilities of information technology officials in public sector institutions to enable them to develop and implement information technology strategies according to the needs of their institutions and in line with the government strategy and the national programme for digital transformation.

The programme includes training participants to follow methodologies and use tools to design and develop strategies to increase their aptitudes to keep pace with change and achieve qualitative addition to government information technology projects.

It consists of about 100 training hours and a programme to prepare trainers in the same field.

The committee also approved the digital transformation plan for the services of the ministries and authorities of Bahrain in light of its follow-up to its decision regarding government agencies speeding up in preparing their plans for e-transformation.

The committee reviewed the status of e-transformation

of government services and the services that have been completed, including 578 out of 1,581 government services while 66 different government e-services were completed in 202 and financial transactions grew by 80% to reach about 2.7 million financial transactions totaling about BD353 million until last September.

They were the result of providing alternative channels for payment and of launching electronic invoices.

HH Shaikh Mohammed directed the iGA to complete the study of the remaining government services within the e-transformation programme.

The authority should also propose the implementation of future plans for them according to their importance and priority within a specific timetable in coordination with the Services Development Committee.

## 19,838 Bahrainis are employed under national programme 2.0

A total of 19,838 Bahraini citizens have so far been employed in the private sector under the second edition of the National Employment Programme until 14 October.

Labour and Social Development Minister Jamil bin Muhammad Ali Humaidan extended his deep thanks and praise to all companies that contributed to the integration of citizens into the labour market in the Kingdom.

He stressed the importance of providing Bahrainis, particularly the youth, with job opportunities as part of the government's initiatives to make them the first choice for employment.

The ministry is determined to continue national efforts to increase the pace of employment in light of the Kingdom's gradual economic recovery from the pandemic.

The programme aims to enhance the efficiency and sustainability of the services provided, as well as invest in the national competencies and develop them professionally, through improving training and adapting its output to the real needs of the labour market so as to make Bahrainis the employees of choice in the private sector.

The National Employment Programme 2.0 also provides incentives aimed at increasing the pace of employment, through increasing the incentives provided to employers and job-seekers.

These include supporting the salaries of the citizens in the private sector, and increasing the support provided by the Unemployment Fund for the unemployed.

Humaidan stressed the ministry's keenness to develop the systems at private training centres.

## Two jailed for smuggling drone into Bahrain

● Six months in prison

● Third suspect fined BD500

Two men were sentenced to six months in prison, while a third man was fined BD500 for smuggling a drone into the Kingdom of Bahrain, the Public Prosecution announced.

The three are said to have smuggled the drone into Bahrain, which is classified as illegal to possess, and their wrongdoing was reported to police by customs officials.

Consequently, the defendants were captured and questioned.

"They confessed to smuggling the drone and they failed to provide any document confirming that they had a licence to possess it," the Public Prosecution added.

They were charged with possessing illegal goods and they were tried before the Lower Criminal Court.

# Royal decree on oil and gas tasks and competencies of relevant authorities

His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa yesterday issued Decree 108 of 2021, amending Article (1) of Decree 105 of 2021 on defining the competent authorities in accordance with Law 10 of 2006 regarding some tasks and competencies of the relevant authorities in oil and gas and the amendment of some provisions of Decree-Law

42 of 1999 on the establishment of Bahrain Petroleum Company.

According to the decree, the second paragraph of Royal Decree 105 shall be replaced by the following:

"As an exception to the provisions of the first paragraph of this article, the Oil and Gas Holding Company shall be the competent authority responsible for appointing the boards of directors of companies that

carry out business related to the oil industries and wholly owned by the state, and to select government representatives in the boards of directors and general assemblies of companies in which the state contributes a share in their capital.

The Oil and Gas Holding Company shall also be the competent authority stipulated in Article (2) of Law 10 of 2006 regarding some tasks and com-

petencies of the relevant authorities in oil and gas and the amendment of some provisions of Decree-Law 42 of 1999 on the establishment of Bahrain Petroleum Company."

The Prime Minister and ministers, each in their capacity, shall implement the provisions of this decree, which comes into force immediately and will be published in the Official Gazette.

His wrongdoing was exposed after one of the two women managed to establish contact with her embassy, whose officials alerted police officers. The apartment was raided by police.

## Kingdom to explore business opportunities with Brazil

## Bapco Chairman meets ART delegation

Dr. Nassif welcomed the ART delegation and reviewed with them the status of the Full-Cycle Catalyst Management (FCM) services for the new Bapco residue hydrocracking unit known as IRHCU, which is one of the key components in the Bapco Modernisation Programme (BMP), through which Bapco aims to boost the processing capacity of Bahrain's oil refinery from 267,000 to 380,000 barrels per day. ◆ **Russian President Vladimir Putin yesterday approved a government proposal** for a week-long workplace shutdown at the start of November to combat an alarming rise in COVID-19 cases and deaths. Speaking at a televised meeting with government officials, Putin said this period, from Oct. 30 to Nov. 7, could begin earlier or be extended for certain regions. Authorities across the country have made moves to curb the spread of the virus, reflecting a growing sense of urgency as they confront widespread public reluctance to get injected with the Russian-made Sputnik V vaccine.

◆ **Russia scrambled two Sukhoi Su-30 fighter jets to escort a pair of US B-1B strategic bombers over the Black Sea**, Russia's defence ministry said yesterday, an incident that coincided with a visit to the region by the U.S. secretary of defense. The supersonic US Cold War-era planes were originally designed to carry nuclear bombs and missiles but now carry conventional payloads. "Russian fighter crews identified the aerial targets as two U.S. Air Force supersonic strategic B-1B bombers, accompanied by two KC-135 refuelling planes, and escorted them over the waters of the Black Sea," the defence ministry said in a statement accompanied by video footage of the U.S. aircraft in flight.

◆ **North Korea test-fired a new, smaller ballistic missile from a submarine**, state media confirmed yesterday, a move that analysts said could be aimed at more quickly fielding an operational missile submarine. The statement from state media came a day after South Korea's military reported that it believed North Korea had fired a submarine-launched ballistic missile (SLBM) off its east coast, the latest in a string of North Korean missile tests. The White House urged North Korea to refrain from further "provocations", with spokeswoman Jen Psaki saying on Tuesday the United States remained open to engaging diplomatically with North Korea over its weapons programmes.

Japanese volcano spews plumes of ash

Reuters | Tokyo

A volcano erupted in Japan yesterday, blasting ash several miles into the sky and prompting officials to warn against the threat of lava flows and falling rocks, but there were no reports of injuries or casualties.

Mount Aso, a tourist destination on the main southern island of Kyushu, sent plumes of ash 3.5 km (2.2 miles) high when it erupted at about 11:43 a.m. (0243 GMT), the Japan Meteorological Agency said.

It raised the alert level for the volcano to 3 on a scale of 5, telling people not to approach, and warned of a risk of large falling rocks and pyroclastic flows within a radius of about 1 km (0.6 mile) around the mountain's Nakadake crater.

Local police said there were no reports of people injured or missing as of Wednesday evening, and that 16 people who had gone hiking on the moun-

tain earlier on the day came back safely.

Television networks broadcast images of a dark cloud of ash looming over the volcano that swiftly obscured large swathes of the mountain.

Ash falls from the 1,592-metre (5,222-foot) mountain in

the prefecture of Kumamoto are expected to shower nearby towns until late afternoon, the weather agency added.

Mount Aso had a small eruption in 2019, while Japan's worst volcanic disaster in nearly 90 years killed 63 people on Mount Ontake in September 2014.

Bomb hits army bus in Damascus, shells target rebel-held northwest

A bomb attack on an army bus in Damascus yesterday killed at least 14 people, state media reported, the deadliest bombing in the Syrian capital in years, while army shelling in rebel-held Idlib killed 11 civilians, rescue workers said.

The attack on the rebel-held town of Ariha, which took place shortly after the Damascus bombing, had caused the biggest civilian death toll in the Idlib area since March, 2020, the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights said.

A decade of conflict in Syria has killed hundreds of thousands of people and fractured

the country.

There was no immediate claim of responsibility for the Damascus bombing, which hit a

bus carrying army personnel in the middle of the city at around 6:45 a.m. (0345 GMT), state television reported.

India floods block roads, sweep away bridge

Floods unleashed by days of unseasonal heavy rain have wrecked crops, blocked roads and washed away bridges in northern India, killing at least 46 people, officials said yesterday, as they mounted rescue efforts for those stranded.

Aerial images gave glimpses of engorged rivers and partially submerged villages in affected areas in the Himalayan state of Uttarakhand, which is especially prone to flooding, although other areas have also suffered in this week's downpours.

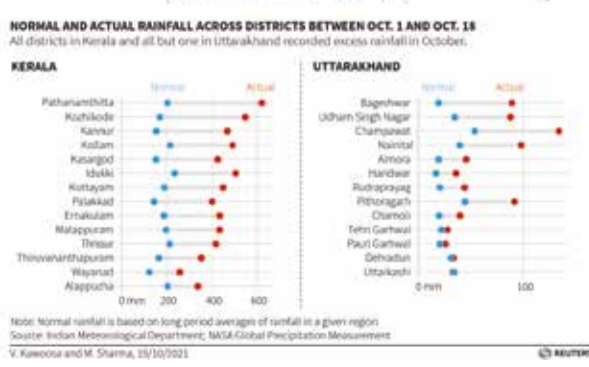
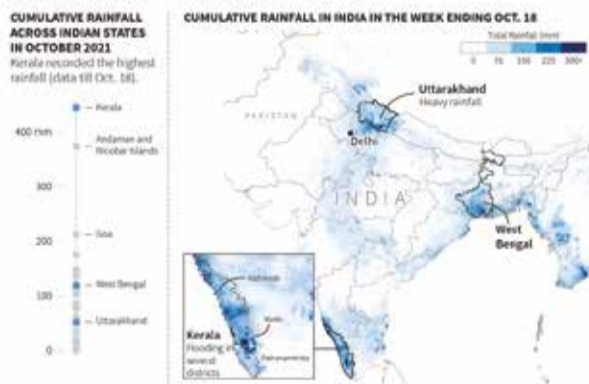
"There is huge loss due to the floods ... the crops have been destroyed," Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami told Reuters partner ANI after surveying the damage late on Tuesday.

"The locals are facing a lot of problems, the roads are waterlogged, bridges have been washed away."

Russia fought its own disastrous war in Afghanistan in the 1980s and has close military and political ties with former Soviet Central Asian states that border Afghanistan.

### FRIENDLY TONE

In his speech, Lavrov struck a noticeably conciliatory tone towards the Taliban government, which is still seeking international diplomatic legitimacy that would bolster its calls to unfreeze assets held in the West and let aid flow.

“We note the efforts undertaken by them to stabilise the military and political situation, to set up state institutions,” Lavrov said. Moscow was satisfied with cooperation from the Afghan authorities to ensure the safety of Russians in Afghanistan and the smooth working of its embassy, he said.

Lavrov did not put figures on how much aid Afghanistan might need or how much Russia was willing to provide.

Lavrov said on the eve of the talks that Moscow was withholding recognition from the Taliban while waiting for them

to fulfil promises they made when they took power, including on

the political and ethnic inclusivity of the new government.

The Taliban have promised to safeguard the rights of women and minorities, but their interim cabinet includes only men, nearly all from the Pashtun ethnic group which makes up less than half the population, from which they draw most of their support.

## Taliban praise suicide bombers, offer families cash and land

The Taliban praised suicide bombers who died during the war against the former government and its Western allies and offered their families sums of cash and promises of land, the movement’s interior ministry said in a statement.

Sirajuddin Haqqani, the acting interior ministry who has a \$10 million US bounty on his head as a “specially designated global terrorist”, met the families at a ceremony at the Intercontinental Hotel in Kabul, which was itself targeted by suicide bombers in 2018.

Official photographs of the meeting on Tuesday obscured his face.

“In his speech, the minister praised the Jihad and sacrifices of the martyrs and Mujahidin and called them heroes of Islam and the country,” the ministry said in a statement on Twitter.

Families of the suicide bombers were given clothing, 10,000 afghani (\$111) and

promised plots of land, spokesman Qari Sayeed Khosti said.

Haqqani took over from his father Jalaluddin Haqqani as head of the Haqqani network, a militant group affiliated with the Taliban that was blamed by Western intelligence services for some of the bloodiest suicide attacks of the war.

He is wanted for questioning by the FBI in connection with an attack on another hotel in Kabul in 2008 in which six people including an American citizen were killed.

## Arriving in fighter jet, Moon urges defence industry growth

South Korea should redouble its efforts to become a global defence industry leader, President Moon Jae-in told a military expo in the outskirts of Seoul yesterday, after landing at the site in an air force fighter jet.

Clad in a flight suit, Moon arrived at the biennial Seoul International Aerospace & Defense Exhibition (ADEX) in the back seat of an FA-50 jet fighter, South Korea’s first indigenous supersonic aircraft and a major defence export.

The military display came a day after North Korea test fired a ballistic missile from a submarine. Last week North Korea opened a defence exhibition of its own, where leader Kim Jong Un said his country’s military developments were for self-defence and accused South Korea of destabilising the peninsula with an arms build up.

In his speech yesterday, Moon defended the South’s increasingly sophisticated military as necessary for peace.

“The goal of building strong defence power is always to foster peace,” he said.

Amid glittering displays of drones, sniper rifles, helicopters, missiles, and other weapons, crowds of company representatives, diplomats, and South Korean troops mixed with military delegations in an array of foreign uniforms.

At least 440 companies from 28 countries are participating in what organisers said was the largest ADEX ever. About 300 government, military and defence acquisition officials from 45 countries were expected to attend the event, which lasts through Saturday.

Moon said it was time for South Korea’s arms industry to become a global leader.

## A royal rest: Queen Elizabeth told by doctors to take a break

Britain’s Queen Elizabeth, the world’s longest-reigning monarch, decided yesterday to rest for the next few days on advice from doctors and cancelled a planned visit to Northern Ireland, Buckingham Palace said.

The palace did not say why the queen had been told to rest, though it said the 95-year-old monarch was in “good spirits” and looking forward to visiting Northern Ireland in the future.

The queen spent Tuesday night hosting a drinks reception at Windsor Castle for billionaire business leaders such as Bill Gates after Prime Minister Boris Johnson convened a green investment conference ahead of the COP26 climate summit.

“The queen has reluctant-

ly accepted medical advice to rest for the next few days,” the palace said.

“Her Majesty is in good spirits and is disappointed that she will no longer be able to visit Northern Ireland, where she had been due to undertake a series of engagements today and tomorrow.”

The queen has reigned for almost seven decades. She was 25 when she became Queen Elizabeth II on Feb. 6, 1952 on the death of her father.

Elizabeth, who acceded to the throne as Britain was shedding its imperial power, has symbolised stability for generations of British people, building the popularity of the monarchy despite seismic political, social and cultural change which threatened to make it an anachronism.

This is the first year of the SRMC and it is being held alongside the long-established Bahrain Rotax MAX Challenge (BRMC), which is scheduled to kick off later this 2021/2022 season at BIKC.

The season's third round will take place on Friday followed by the championship finale on Saturday. Both meetings will follow the same schedule of sessions.

Kicking things off will be Qualifying Practice for all classes, starting with the Micro and Mini MAX together at 3pm. The junior competitors will then get out on track at 3.13pm, followed by the

The match, which was played at the Shaikh Ali bin Mohammed Al Khalifa Stadium in Arad, was the Zonal Final of West Asia in this year's edition of the prestigious club competition.

The Kingdom's representatives are now set to play for

the tournament title against FC Nasaf Qarshi of Uzbekistan, who also qualified for the final yesterday with a 3-2 win in extra time against Lee Man FC of Hong Kong.

That game was the Inter-Zone Final, and it was played in the Uzbek city of Karshi.

The AFC Cup 2021 Final is scheduled for November 5. Based on the competition's rules, it will be played in Bah-

rain. Both Al Mardi's and Flavio's goals were scored in the first half last night.

Al Mardi gave the Bahrainis the lead in the 19th minute when his free-kick from around 30 yards found its way into the net. The ball went untouched despite the aerial challenge of a couple of players, catching Kuwait goalkeeper Hameed Youssef off guard as it bounced

Both teams had other chances to find the net in the second half, as well as in the four additional minutes of stoppage time, but could not add to the score line.

In the AFC Cup Final, Muharraq will be gunning for their second title in the history of the competition, which is organised and run by the Asian Football Confederation for the top clubs in the continent who have not qualified for the AFC Champions League.
