hile the municipal workers are still labouring to remove the puddles left behind by the showers last week, clouds of dust have started wafting over the Kingdom, amplifying their woes

However, there were no reports of any casualties or injuries.

Essam Khalaf, the Minister of Works, Municipalities Affairs and Urban Planning, said directives are given to municipalities to sweep and clean the streets until the dust storm settles and the weather returns to normality.

Municipal workers were in operation at all affected streets and squares of the Kingdom to clear the trees uprooted, and advertisement hoardings brought down in the gust of heavy wind that also massed tonnes of sand winds to hit the Kingdom. and dust on motorways and other places.
