



UNESCO opens nominations for 2025 UNESCO King Hamad Bin Isa Al Khalifa Prize for ICT in Education

The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) has announced the opening of nominations for the 2025 UNESCO King Hamad Bin Isa Al Khalifa Prize for the Use of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) in Education.

Dr. Mohammed bin Mubarak Juma, Minister of Education, noted that the theme of the 2025 edition is "Preparing learners and teachers for the ethical and responsible use of artificial intelligence." UNESCO has set March 28, 2025, as the deadline for nominations, which must be submitted through the National Commissions of UNESCO member states or non-governmental organisations in official partnership with UNESCO.

Two winners will be selected based on recommendations from an independent international jury.

Trump says not 'very important' for Zelensky to be in Ukraine talks

Arab leaders meet in Saudi to hash out Gaza plan

Riyadh, Saudi Arabia

Arab leaders met in Riyadh yesterday to craft a plan for Gaza's post-war reconstruction to counter Donald Trump's proposal for the United States to take over the territory without its Palestinian inhabitants.

Egyptian President Abdel Fattah al-Sisi's office said he had left the Saudi capital after the meeting with the leaders of Bahrain, Jordan, Kuwait, Qatar, Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates.

A Saudi source had earlier told AFP that the Palestinian Authority, Hamas's West Bank-based rival, was also expected to take part in the talks.

The official Saudi Press Agency said the decisions taken at the "unofficial fraternal meeting" would be put on the agenda of an emergency Arab League summit to be held in Egypt on March 4.

State aid for housewives!

Financial aid for married housewives over 40 with no steady income

Plan removes eligibility limits based on husband's wealth or family support

Committees back the move, but concerns remain over funding and benefit overlap

State support for financially vulnerable housewives over 40 years of age.

A proposal aimed at expanding the social support programme calls for financial aid to married women

over 40 who lack a steady income.

Tabled in parliament by MP Jalal Kadhem, the move seeks to offer financial assistance to housewives without fixed earnings.

The Services Committee, after discussions with Kadhem, introduced amendments to tighten definitions and clarify eligibility criteria.

Kadhem said many housewives, including those with university degrees, had dedicated their lives to raising families and managing households. "These women contribute just as

much to society as those in paid work. They build homes, raise the next generation, and keep families together. It's only fair they're recognised," he said.

An amendment would remove an existing clause that prevents those with financially capable relatives from receiving social assistance. This means a woman's right to support would no longer be tied to her husband's income.

The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee has advised that the change would require extra funding but said it could help struggling households. The Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee has confirmed the draft is legally sound.

The Supreme Council for Women has raised concerns over overlapping benefits. However, Kadhem argued that the wording had been adjusted to ensure it does not affect other categories, such as widows, divorcees, and abandoned women. "This change is for married women without an income of their own.

It won't affect those who already qualify under different rules," he said.

The committee also added wording to confirm that a husband's wealth

would not block a housewife from claiming support. Kadhem said this addressed a long-standing policy gap. "A woman's financial security should not depend entirely on her husband's bank balance. Many housewives do unpaid work that keeps society running, yet they don't get a dinar for it," he said.

"Housewives raise families, support communities, and do work that goes unpaid. Meanwhile, employees and labourers get a wage for their role in the economy. It's time we acknowledged the work they do," he said.

Israel to release 602 prisoners in Gaza swap Saturday: Palestinian NGO

Israel will free 602 inmates from jails today as part of a hostage-prisoner swap with Hamas under an ongoing Gaza ceasefire deal, according to the Palestinian Prisoners' Club advocacy group.

Among those released, 445 are individuals from Gaza, 60 are serving long sentences, 50 are serving life sentences, and 47 were re-arrested after a 2011 prisoner exchange.

MPs seek to snuff out shisha cafes near homes

Parliament is set to debate a proposal on Tuesday that would ban or relocate shisha cafes operating near residential areas, schools, and mosques.

The plan seeks to reinstate a 2006 ministerial decision regulating the location of cafes and restaurants that serve tobacco products.

The proposal is backed by MPs Bader Al Tamimi, Hamad Al Doy, Mohammed Mousa, Abdulhakim Al Sheno, and Abdulla Al

MP Bader Al Tamimi said: "It is no secret that the presence of shisha cafes in residential areas has become a daily grievance for many families. The noise, the traffic, and the clouds of smoke drifting into homes—it's a nuisance that shouldn't be allowed to continue unchecked."

Bahrain already has regulations restricting tobacco use, including the 2009 anti-smoking law and zoning rules introduced in 2023 that outline where smoking establishments can operate.

Health Minister Dr. Jaleela Al Sayyed told Parliament that authorities would review the issue if the proposal secures approval. Meanwhile, the Ministry of Municipalities Affairs stated that its role is limited to location assessments, while licensing falls under the Ministry of Industry and Commerce.

The Anti-Smoking Society has voiced support for the plan, warning that some cafes have become late-night gathering spots for loitering and, in some cases, illicit activity. It pointed to countries like New Zealand, which is moving towards a tobacco-free future, and Turkmenistan, where tobacco sales have been severely restricted.

Intra-Islamic dialogue calls for unity, shared destiny

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The Intra-Islamic Dialogue Conference, hosted by Bahrain, concluded with a strong call for unity under the declaration titled "Nida' Ahl Al Qibla" (Call of the Qibla People). The declaration advocates for a unified religious discourse under the theme "One Nation, One Shared Destiny."

It emphasises that true Islamic fraternity is not merely about redefining identities or promoting rapprochement but rather about fostering a deeper understanding of harmony in light of the challenges facing the Muslim Ummah. It acknowledges doctrinal differences, stating that the goal is not to eliminate them but to uphold Islamic brotherhood

while respecting diversity within religious traditions.

Highlighting the threats and hostilities facing Muslims today, the declaration stresses that overcoming these challenges requires collective action. It calls for increased cooperation among religious, academic, intellectual, and media institutions to counteract the spread of hatred and division within the Muslim world.

The guiding principles of the declaration, it notes, are deeply rooted in the Holy Qur'an and the teachings of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH). While recognising differences in interpretation and opinion, it urges scholars and thought leaders to work together to shape public discourse in a way that strengthens unity.

BETTER YOU KNOW

Shisha cafes trace their origins to the Ottoman Empire in the early 16th century, where smoking shisha (also known as hookah or waterpipe) became a popular pastime among the elite.

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The Minister of Industry and Commerce, Abdullah bin Adel Fakhro, led the kingdom's delegation at the Invest Kerala Global Summit in Kochi, India, highlighting Bahrain's commitment to strengthening economic ties with India. The summit, organised by the Kerala Industrial Development Corporation, brought together global representatives from various industries to explore investment opportunities. On the sidelines of the summit, Minister Fakhro held meetings with Kerala's Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan, India's Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal, Kerala's Minister of Industry and Law P. Rajeev, and Lulu Group International Chairman Yusuf Ali.

Nawaf bin Mohammed Al Maawda, Minister of Justice, Islamic Affairs, and Endowments, received Martina Polasek, Secretary General of the International Centre for Settlement of Investment Disputes (ICSID) and Vice President of the World Bank, during her visit to Bahrain. The meeting was also attended by Marika Paulson, Secretary General of the Bahrain Council for the Development of International Commercial Dispute Resolution Mechanisms.



Bahrain seeks full membership in Mediterranean Parliament

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Bahrain has officially applied for full membership in the Mediterranean Parliament, moving beyond its current observer status.

A delegation led by Second Deputy Chair of the Shura Council, Dr. Jihad Al Fadhel, submitted the application during the 19th General Assembly in Rome, held from 19 to 21 February.

As part of the request, Dr.

Al Fadhel delivered a letter from Speaker of the Council of Representatives, Ahmed bin Salman Al Musallam, who also chairs the parliamentary group's executive committee, to the President of the Mediterranean Parliament.

Dr. Al Fadhel emphasised that full membership would enhance Bahrain's participation and influence in regional policymaking. She also highlighted that several Gulf states had already joined as full members.

Paid paternity leave for new dads?

Mps call it a necessity, authorities differ

companies offer this to new fathers?

When Parliament meets again, MPs are set to debate this.

The Civil Service Bureau (CSB) has already raised concerns that this would increase costs, as men account for 43 per cent of the public sector workforce.

The proposal by MP Jalal Kadhem argues that fathers should be there for their wives and newborns without having to dip into their annual leave.

The Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee supports the move, saying it would allow for a better balance between work

and home life.

"The family is the bedrock of society," Kadhem said, quoting Bahrain's Constitution. "Fathers should be given time to take care of paperwork and hospital requirements at this crucial time."

The CSB warns that the cost of paid leave would put a strain on public services, particularly in schools, hospitals, and utilities. It also argues that men already have options for time off, including their standard leave, which can be taken in half-day or hourly slots.

Public sector maternity leave is already fully paid, starting

from the day of birth or up to 15 days before. New mothers also get two daily breastfeeding hours for two years and can take unpaid leave for childcare up to a set limit.

The committee disagrees with the CSB's stance, saying the change would help ease the strain on families. "A father's presence at such an important time gives reassurance to his wife and ensures he is there for any emergencies," its report said.

The CSB maintained that government costs must be kept in check, warning that extra leave would add to expenses and could affect service delivery. "The government is working to lift productivity and keep spending on track," it said.

Kadhem rejected the pushback. "The birth of a child is a turning point for any family," he said. "A father should not have to choose between work and being there for his wife and child."

Small debt, big price: Man jailed and deported over 20-dinar dispute

A dispute over 20 dinars landed a man in jail for three years after he pushed his roommate down the stairs, leaving him with a 10% permanent disability.

The accused, an Asian national, will be deported after serving his sentence. A forensic report from the Material Evidence Department confirmed that the victim suffered a fractured right foot, requiring surgery to insert medical plates and screws.

Police said the incident occurred when the accused confronted the victim, who was reportedly playing "batata" with his roommate on the terrace of their building.

A verbal altercation broke out when the accused demanded the money back. The situation escalated when the victim threatened to report him to the police.

Shortly after, as the victim was descending a wooden staircase, the accused allegedly pushed him forcefully with his chest, causing him to lose balance and tumble down from the first floor.

In addition to persistent swelling and pain, the victim now suffers from a slight limp, with his permanent disability estimated at 10%.



Turning family homes into rentals? Landlords may pay the price

Landlords who lease family homes for other purposes could face fines under a proposed law set for discussion in Parliament on Tuesday.

If a landlord knowingly allows such misuse, they would face a fine. If unaware, the responsibility falls on the tenant.

Municipal inspectors will enforce the law, with fines set by the local authority—subject to approval by the minister in charge of municipal affairs—and capped at the property's annual rent. The minister will also establish rules for leasing homes for non-family use.

Officials say some areas have been overrun by renters, altering the character of neighbourhoods despite existing regulations.

The Public Utilities and Environment Committee has backed

the proposal after reviewing a revised version that amends the Real Estate Leasing Law. The legislation was put forward by MPs Mohammed Al Olaiwi, Dr Hisham Al Ashiri, Abdulwahid Qarata, Jaleela Alawi, and Hassan BuKhammas.

The Ministry of Justice has

raised concerns about enforcement, noting that multiple authorities would need to coordinate efforts to track violations. The Ministry of Municipalities Affairs, which oversees rental registrations, has stated that it has no role in policing breaches.

The Capital Municipal

Council supports the proposal, while the Muharraq Municipal Council has also backed it, citing the growing issue of housing workers in family districts—especially in older neighbourhoods where companies have been caught using homes to accommodate drivers. The council is calling for fines to be paired with eviction orders.

However, the Northern Municipal Council opposes the plan. The Southern Municipal Council is in favour, arguing that penalties would help curb violations.

The Real Estate Regulatory Authority has noted that the proposal aligns with broader rental laws, including property classifications and lease oversight. The Survey and Land Registration Bureau has not raised objections, aside from minor wording adjustments.

MPs push to extend traffic fine discount to 30 days

Make it 30 instead of the current seven days.

MPs are demanding that traffic fines be cut by half if an offender pays within 30 days.

For now, the discount is offered only to those who pay their fines within a week.

This will come into force if a proposal to this effect gets the green light.

Backers say the extra time will ease pressure on courts, as the current one-week window is too short, especially given rising living costs. The argument is that giving a month to pay at the lower rate would lead to more settlements and fewer cases.

However, the government argues that cutting fines for everyone risks sending the wrong message and could lead to more rule-breaking on the roads.

The Bahrain Bar Society has backed the proposal, calling it fairer. The Parliamentary Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence, and Security, which reviewed the draft, has recommended approval in principle.

Works Ministry completes Ma'ameer Avenue Upgrade



A four-kilometre stretch of roads in Ma'ameer has been resurfaced to enhance traffic flow and safety. The Ministry of Works confirmed that the project included new parking spaces, footpaths, and a rainwater drainage system. Additionally, underground services were reinforced, new streetlights installed, and road signs and markings set up.

Only 255 contractors eligible for government projects

Works Minister Ibrahim bin Hassan Al Hawaj has confirmed that only 255 contractors meet the strict technical and financial standards required to work on government projects in Bahrain.

In a statement to Parliament, Al Hawaj responded to a question from MP Ali Saqer regarding companies operating in the construction and contracting sector.

The minister emphasised that prequalification is mandatory for bidding. "Firms that fail to

meet the requirements are simply not included," he said.

Contractors are categorised into roads, sanitation, and government buildings, with some

firms listed under multiple categories. The list is automatically updated after approval by the Tender Board and is available to the public, Al Hawaj added.

The minister also confirmed that feasibility studies are conducted before undertaking any major project. The project management framework follows five key steps: planning, design, contracting, construction, and completion.

Addressing concerns about firms being excluded, Al Hawaj stated: "If a company isn't listed, it means it didn't meet the required standards."

He further noted that the ministry works closely with the Tender Board to regularly review contractor requirements, ensuring that standards align with the scale and complexity of government projects.

MPs call for dedicated Children's TV channel

A proposal to launch a dedicated children's TV channel and enforce stricter regulations on digital platforms is set for a vote in Parliament on Tuesday.

The plan calls for increased parental engagement, stronger oversight of digital content, and programming that aligns with local values and traditions.

MPs Maryam Al Dhaen, Hanan Fardan, Basma Mubarak, Dr Ali Al Nuaimi, and Ahmed Al Salloom submitted the proposal, aiming to create a safer media environment for children.

"We want a secure media space that supports children's development in every way, with the right authorities taking the lead, particularly the Ministry of Information," said Al Dhaen.

Both the Ministry of Information and the Ministry of Social Development back the initiative.

The Information Ministry stated that it already sets media policies and regulations to uphold high standards. It also

runs programmes such as an annual TV and radio competition to enhance children's public speaking skills and collaborates with the Education Ministry on school trips to heritage sites to promote cultural awareness.

Meanwhile, the Ministry of Social Development said it works with government and non-government organisations to encourage children's participation in media, improve internet safety awareness, and develop critical thinking through dedicated media platforms.

The National Childhood Commission supports the proposal, as does the Bahraini Society for Child Development, which emphasised the need for a secure media space where children can learn and thrive.

The Children & Mothers Welfare Society has also urged broadcasters to include more reading-focused content, highlighting that radio and TV currently show little interest in books. It further called for specialised programming for children with disabilities and greater support for young talent across various fields.

Plan to let civil societies invest surplus funds moves forward

Plans are advancing to allow civil societies to invest surplus funds within Bahrain while avoiding high-risk financial ventures.

The Shura Council drafted the government-backed proposal, which is set for a vote in Parliament on Tuesday.

If approved, the amendment would lift a blanket ban on financial activities, enabling associations to grow their resources under strict regulations. The government has endorsed the plan, confirming that it aligns



with existing laws and the constitution.

The proposal seeks to amend Article 18 of the 1989 law gov-

erning associations, social and cultural clubs, youth and sports groups, and private institutions.

The Services Committee, which reviewed the bill, highlighted that regulated investments would provide civil societies with sustainable funding while keeping them clear of volatile markets.

Originally proposed by the Shura Council, the bill was sent to the government for legal review. The Cabinet referred it to the Legislation and Legal Opinion Commission, which finalised its wording.

MPs push to freeze new furnished apartment licences

Lawmakers are calling for an immediate halt to new furnished apartment licences, citing their unchecked spread in residential areas, violations of public decency, and concerns that they are crowding out other tourism-related businesses.

The proposal, set for debate in Parliament on Tuesday, warns that lax enforcement has led to a surge in furnished apartments, creating issues for local communities and undermining Islamic values and traditions.

The Services Committee has endorsed the plan. Second Deputy Speaker Ahmed Qarata, one of its key supporters, stressed the need for stricter regulations. "We need clear limits and penalties. Our goal is to put a stop to violations happening right

MPs Hisham Al Awadhi, Jameel Mulla Hassan, Mohammed Al Olaiwi, and Mohammed

Al Rafaei are also backing the proposal. Supporters argue that Bahrain's tourism sector should not be built around furnished apartments alone and that other forms of investment must be encouraged.

A major concern is that furnished apartments are being set up too close to mosques, prayer halls, and homes, despite tourism laws requiring a minimum distance. Qarata said existing laws already prohibit such rentals near mosques and residential areas unless specific distance requirements are met but accused authorities of failing to enforce them. "People living in these areas are fed up," he said. "We have laws, but they are not being enforced properly."

The proposal also calls for a more balanced approach to tourism investment. MPs have

requested a full government study to assess licensing regulations and whether additional controls should be introduced.

However, the Tourism Ministry and the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority have pushed back, arguing that a blanket ban is unnecessary. A 2019 rule already prohibits furnished apartments in housing areas, allowing them only in commercial buildings or those approved by tourism authorities. The ministry warned MPs in writing that blocking new licences entirely could deter investment and limit accommodation options as Bahrain expands its tourism sector.

Despite this, the committee has reaffirmed its support for the proposal, insisting that the current system is not being enforced effectively.

Bahrain, ICSID sign MoU to enhance international dispute resolution

The Bahrain Council for the Development of International Commercial Dispute Resolution Mechanisms and the International Centre for Settlement of Investment Disputes (ICSID), part of the World Bank Group, signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) to develop cooperation in international dispute

resolution.

The MoU was signed by Marika Paulson, Secretary General of the Bahrain Council for the Development of International Commercial Dispute Resolution Mechanisms, and Martina Polasek, Secretary General of ICSID and Vice President of the World Bank. The agreement aims to establish a framework for collaboration and knowledge exchange between both entities.

Court rejects woman's bid to declare husband incapacitated and seize assets

A woman's attempt to gain control of her husband's assets by having him declared legally incapacitated has been dismissed by the High Sharia Court. The ruling also coincided with the husband divorcing her in court.



The woman, in her sixties, had been the man's second wife for 24 years but had no children. She claimed he was suffering from dementia and incapable of managing his financial affairs. However, her lawsuit was rejected following intervention from the man's children from his first marriage, who argued she was

attempting to seize his wealth and home.

The court summoned the husband, who appeared before the judge and confirmed he was in good health. To ensure a thorough review, the case was referred to medical committees, and a psychiatric hospital opened a file for

him. The resulting report confirmed his physical health but made no mention of mental incapacity.

After evaluating the findings and personally assessing the husband, the court ruled that he remained fully capable of handling his affairs and dismissed the case.

MPs to vote on shareholder rights in board appointments

Parliament will vote on Tuesday on a proposal to grant shareholders holding at least 10% of a company's capital the automatic right to appoint board members in proportion to their stake, regardless of company rules.

The amendment to the Commercial Companies Law seeks to remove a clause in Article 175 of Decree-Law No. 21 of 2001, which currently allows firms to override this right through their founding agreements.

Supporters argue that the change would give minority

shareholders a stronger voice in company decisions. The Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and

Industry has backed the proposal, saying it would create a fairer balance among shareholders and prevent larger stakeholders from monopolising board seats. However, it suggested further review on how the rule would apply to companies with existing shareholder agreements. The Bahrain Businessmen's Association has also endorsed the move, calling it beneficial for the business sector.

The proposal has been submitted by MPs Ahmed Sabah Al Salloom, Khalid Buanaq, Maryam Al Dhaen, Basma Mubarak, and Ali Saqer Al Doseri.

Under the amendment, shareholders with at least 10% of a

company's capital would have the right to appoint board members in proportion to their stake, with fractional shares rounded to the nearest whole. Shareholders who do not exercise this right or lack enough shares to appoint a member could instead use their stake for voting. If the right is not exercised, it would be forfeited for that board election cycle.

The amendment consists of three articles: the first revises Article 175 to reflect the change, the second repeals any conflicting laws, and the third stipulates that the amendment would take effect the day after its publication in the Official Gazette.

Lawmakers to debate state-backed firms offering public shares

Parliament is set to debate a proposal for state-backed commercial companies that would allow Bahrainis to invest and earn a share of the profits. The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee has

already endorsed the plan.

Put forward by MP Dr Ali Majid Al Nuaimi, the proposal calls for the government to establish and manage businesses with public investment, giving citizens the opportunity to buy shares. Supporters argue it could boost the economy, increase household income, and create new job opportunities.

"This isn't just about business—it's about ensuring everyday Bahrainis benefit from government-backed projects," said Dr Al Nuaimi. "By encouraging shared investment, we can foster a stronger savings culture and provide families with greater financial security."

If approved, the initiative would see the government overseeing the creation and operation of these companies while offering Bahrainis a trusted investment avenue.

Parliamentarians push for tax breaks, incentives to turn Bahrain into a high-tech hub

MPs are calling for tax exemptions, investment incentives, and streamlined regulations to attract global firms and position Bahrain as a leading high-tech hub.

The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee has backed the plan, arguing that it would diversify the economy, reduce reliance on oil, and create new job opportunities.

Proposed by MPs Ahmed Al Salloom, Khalid Buanaq, Mohammed Al Ma'arifi, and Dr



Ali Al Nuaimi, the initiative calls for Bahrain Mumtalakat Holding Company to forge partnerships with private firms—both local and international—to develop home-grown expertise in advanced technologies.

The report highlights that high-tech industries are essential for economic sustainability, citing China, South Korea, and Singapore as examples of nations that have invested heavily in artificial intelligence, automation, and advanced manufacturing.

Tax exemptions can be a game-changer for economies. For example, Ireland used corporate tax incentives to attract major tech firms like Google, Apple, and Facebook, transforming the country into the "Silicon Valley of Europe." This strategy helped boost Ireland's GDP and employment, showing how tax breaks can turn a small nation into a global business hub.

Key measures in the proposal include tax and customs exemptions to attract global companies, government procurement policies favouring local tech firms, and the establishment of research and training centres to equip Bahrainis with industry skills. The committee also recommends easing investment regulations and cutting bureaucracy to make Bahrain a more attractive destination for tech-driven businesses.

Trump hits out at US agency AP as 'radical left' media



US President Donald Trump on Thursday called the Associated Press a "radical left organization" in his latest salvo in the fight over the US media mainstay's use of the Gulf of Mexico for the renamed body of water. Trump in his first month in office dubbed the area the "Gulf of America" and has restricted Associated Press (AP) journalists' access to the White House until the news agency obeys his order. The White House has blocked AP journalists from Air Force One and the Oval Office, arguing that the agency was ignoring a lawful name change.

Swedish authorities said yesterday they were investigating suspected damage to an underwater cable in the Baltic Sea, following a string of incidents experts believe are acts of sabotage orchestrated by Russia. Finnish operator Cima said it had recorded "some disturbance" on its C-Lion 1 communications cable linking Finland and Germany. "However, the disturbance does not affect the functionality of telecommunications connections running in the cable and the data traffic continues flowing normally," it said in a statement, adding that the cause was "still under investigation".

Mexico says won't accept US 'invasion' in fight against cartels



Mexico's president warned the United States on Thursday her country would never tolerate an "invasion" of its national sovereignty and vowed fresh legal action against US gunmakers after Washington designated cartels as terrorist organizations. The remarks were the latest in a series hitting back at the administration of President Donald Trump, which has ramped up pressure on its southern neighbor to curb illegal flows of drugs and migrants.

People can spread bird flu to their cats, US study suggests

A study published Thursday by the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) suggests that people can transmit bird flu to their domestic cats, with fatal consequences.

Two household case studies from Michigan in May 2024 were published in the agency's Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report, as fears grow that the virus could mutate and cause a human pandemic.

Since then, it has also emerged that cats can be infected by pet food contaminated with the virus -- and it can spread between "big cat" species in shelters.

Both case studies involved pet owners who worked at or near dairy cattle farms affected by bird flu, and both resulted in deaths of infected felines.

In the first case, a five-year-old indoor female cat rapidly developed a loss of appetite, poor grooming habits, disorientation, lethargy, and neurological deterioration.

Her condition worsened quickly, requiring emergency care at the Michigan State

University (MSU) Veterinary Medical Center.

Despite intervention, her symptoms progressed, and she was euthanized within four days. Postmortem testing confirmed she had contracted bird flu.

Two other cats lived in the same household. One exhibited mild symptoms, which the owners attributed to allergies, and they ceased communication with public health officials.

Among the household members, the farm worker declined testing, while an adult and two adolescents tested negative for bird flu.

Days later, a second case involving a six-month-old male Maine Coon was brought to the university. The cat exhibited symptoms including anorexia, lethargy, facial swelling, and limited movement, and died within 24 hours.

This cat lived with another feline that remained unaffected. The Maine Coon's owner regularly transported unpasteurized milk from various Michigan farms, including those confirmed to have infected dairy cattle.

US-Ukraine resources deal still on table despite Trump-Zelensky spat, Kyiv says

Talks ongoing for US access to Ukraine's mineral deposits

Kyiv and Washington re-engaged in talks over a deal to hand the United States preferential access to Ukraine's mineral deposits, a source in Kyiv said yesterday -- despite a dramatic spat between leaders Volodymyr Zelensky and Donald Trump.

The US president's top advisers have doubled down on their attacks on the Ukrainian leader in recent days, after Trump branded him a "dictator" and said Ukraine had "started" the war with Russia.

The war of words has stunned Kyiv and European capitals, a sign of just how rapidly Trump is overhauling Washington's long-standing support for Ukraine as he opens talks with Moscow on a settlement to the conflict.

The United States had been Ukraine's most important financial, military and political backer since Russia invaded in February 2022, in what the West's top powers had condemned as an unprovoked and illegal war of aggression.

Despite the tensions between Zelensky and Trump, talks on a possible agreement to give

the US preferential access to Ukraine's critical resources and minerals were "ongoing" yesterday, a senior Ukrainian official with knowledge of the matter said.

Kyiv had rejected a first attempt by Trump's team to strike a deal for Ukraine's natural resources, saying the proposal did not include security guarantees for Kyiv -- a move that infuriated Trump.

"There is a constant exchange of drafts, we sent another one yesterday," the Kyiv source said, adding that Ukraine was now waiting for a US response.

Military spokesman Avichay Adraee said on Telegram that Israel had identified the remains of the Bibas boys Ariel and Kfir, accusing "Palestinian terrorists" of killing them in November 2023.

Hamas has long maintained an Israeli air strike killed the boys and their mother early in the war.

Israel's Hostages and Missing Families Forum said it was "horrified" that Shiri Bibas was not among those returned.

Hamas yesterday asked Israel to return the body of the Gazan woman handed over a day earlier.

Black coffins

Via the Red Cross, Hamas also handed over a fourth body, that of Oded Lifshitz, a veteran journalist and long-time defender of Palestinian rights who was aged 83 at the time of his capture.

The bodies' repatriation is part of the six-week initial phase of the ceasefire between Israel and Hamas, which took effect on January 19. The deal has so far led to the release of 19 living Israeli hostages in exchange for more

Chainsaw-wielding Musk savors Trump's return to White House

Elon Musk, who has bragged of putting US federal agencies "into the woodchipper" as he slashes government spending, paraded a chainsaw on stage before American conservatives celebrating President Donald Trump's return to power Thursday.

Argentina's President Javier Milei -- who has used a chainsaw as a symbol of his own push to restore fiscal discipline -- handed Musk the power tool before a cheering crowd at the Conservative Political Action Conference.

The world's richest person, who was clad in sunglasses, a baseball cap and a large necklace, paraded it up and down the stage before laying it to one side and declaring he was "living the meme."

"We're trying to get good things done. But also, like, you know, have a good time doing it, and... a sense of humor," Musk said of his cost-cutting efforts, which so far have seen him gut the agency responsible for delivering US aid to the poorest countries in the world and fire thousands of federal workers.

Later he again picked up the chainsaw -- which had the words "Long live freedom, damn it" written along its blade -- to carry it off stage at a center on the outskirts of the capital Washington.

Musk was not the only one in a celebratory mood at CPAC, as conservatives revelled in Trump's return one month ago.

Pope marks week in hospital amid questions over future

Pope Francis hospitalized for pneumonia in both lungs

Pope Francis marked a week in hospital with pneumonia yesterday, as speculation grew over the 88-year-old's ability to continue leading the Catholic Church.

Francis, admitted to Rome's Gemelli hospital with breathing difficulties, has slightly improved over the past couple of days despite pneumonia in both lungs, according to the Vatican.

"The night went well. This morning Pope Francis got up and had breakfast," it said in a regular morning briefing yesterday, adding that the next update would come earlier than usual, at around 5:30 pm (1630 GMT).

But that has not dampened questions over the future of a leader with a punishing domestic and international schedule who has been increasingly plagued by health issues in recent years.

Francis has disappeared from public view since his admittance to a special papal suite on the 10th floor of the Gemelli.

The Vatican said he is cheerful and has been alternating rest with reading, but has yet to publish the standard photo-

graphs of him in hospital that have marked his previous stays, fuelling rumours.

"I know that some out there

say my time has come, they are always bringing me bad luck!" Francis is reported by Italian media to have quipped to Italy's Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni when she visited him on Thursday.

The Argentine is no stranger to the plotting and scheming his health woes inevitably prompt among those keen to get their man in as next pope.

After undergoing colon surgery in 2021, he joked to a group of Jesuits that "I'm still alive. Even though some wanted me dead."

"They were preparing the conclave", he said, in reference to the meeting of cardinals to elect a new pope after a death or resignation.

Netanyahu visits West Bank refugee camp, orders intensified offensive

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu visited the Tulkarem refugee camp in the northern West Bank yesterday, ordering the army to intensify a month-old offensive there after three bombs exploded on Israeli buses, his office said.

"Netanyahu visited a short while ago Tulkarem refugee camp" and ordered more "operational activity" in the area, his office said, after the rare visit to a camp in the occupied Palestinian territory.

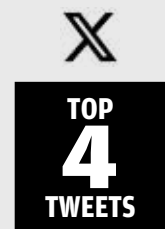
Days after a ceasefire took effect in Gaza, Israel launched a large-scale military operation in the north of the West Bank that it dubbed "Iron Wall."

Spanning multiple refugee camps near the cities of Jenin, Tulkarem and Tubas, the operation has killed at least 40 Palestinians and displaced at least 40,000, according to the UN.

Israel and Hamas announced a deal earlier this week for the return of eight hostages' remains in two groups this week and next, as well as the release of the six living Israeli captives on Saturday.

Israeli campaign group the Hostages and Missing Families Forum has published the names of the six Israelis as Eliya Cohen, Tal Shoham, Omer Shem Tov, Omer Wenkert, Hisham al-Sayed and Avera Mengistu.

Israeli Foreign Minister Gideon Saar has said talks will begin this week on the truce's second phase, aiming to lay out a more permanent end to the war.

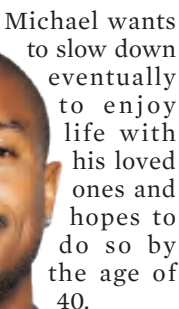

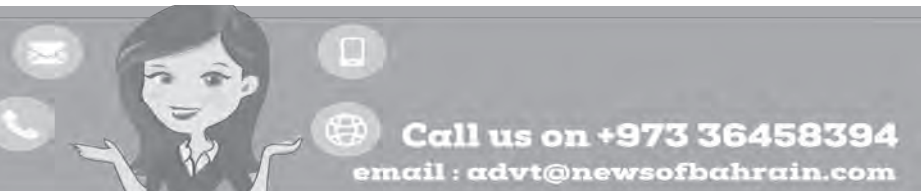

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Liverpool to face PSG in Champions League

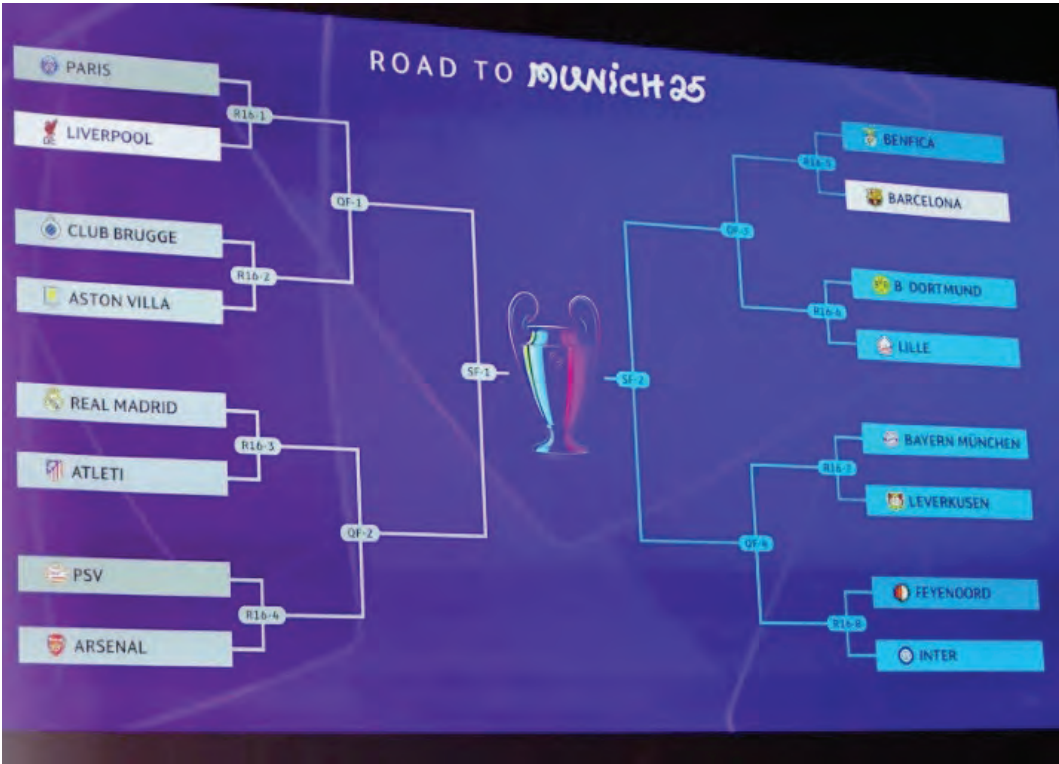
Liverpool will take on Paris Saint-Germain in the last 16 of this season's Champions League while yesterday's draw also threw up a showdown between reigning champions Real Madrid and their city rivals Atletico.

Arne Slot's Liverpool finished first in the 36-team league phase of the competition to qualify directly for this stage, while PSG finished 15th and had to come through a two-legged play-off tie in which they crushed fellow French side Brest 10-0 on aggregate.

The first leg will take place at the Parc des Princes in Paris on March 4 or 5, with the return at Anfield a week later.

The clubs last met in the Champions League in the group stage in 2018/19, when PSG won 2-1 at home after Liverpool triumphed 3-2 in England.

The only previous knockout tie between the sides came in the semi-finals of the now defunct Cup Winners' Cup in 1997, when PSG won 3-2 on aggregate before losing the final to Barcelona.

tween the teams who succeeded each other as European Cup winners in the early 1980s.

Villa will face Club Brugge seeking revenge for their 1-0 defeat against the same opponents in Belgium in the league phase in November.

Real, fresh from eliminating Manchester City in the play-offs, will be at home in the first leg against Atletico.

The rivals from the Spanish capital met in the competition in four straight seasons in the last decade, with Real coming out on top every time.

Man Utd to face Real Sociedad in Europa League last 16

Manchester United were drawn yesterday to play Real Sociedad of Spain in the last 16 of this season's Europa League, while Rangers will take on Jose Mourinho's Fenerbahce, and Tottenham Hotspur face AZ Alkmaar.

Ruben Amorim's United are struggling in the Premier League this season but finished third in the league phase of the Europa League. They will travel to San Sebastian for the first leg on March 6 before the return a week later against a Real Sociedad side who reached this stage after beating Midtjylland of Denmark in the play-off round.

The clubs have met several times in European competition in recent years, with United winning a Europa League

knockout phase play-off tie in 2021 before both sides each won away from home in the group stage in 2022/23. They also faced off in the Champions League group stage in 2013.

Whoever wins will advance to a last-eight tie against either Lyon or FCSB. The Romanians lost 2-0 at home to United in their last game in the group phase last month.

Fenerbahce will welcome beaten 2022 finalists Rangers to Istanbul for the first leg of their tie in a competition coach Mourinho won with United in 2017. He also won its predecessor, the UEFA Cup, as Porto boss in 2003.

If Fenerbahce win, Mourinho could come up in the quarter-finals against one of his old clubs in Roma, with whom he won the Europa Conference League in 2022.

Australia's Cummins targets IPL for return from injury

Australia captain Pat Cummins said yesterday he is targeting the Indian Premier League to make his return from a niggling injury that sidelined him from the Champions Trophy.

The 31-year-old quick has been struggling with a long-standing left ankle issue that flared during the Test series win over India in December-January.

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Haaland doubtful for Liverpool clash

"Tomorrow we will know," said Guardiola at his pre-match

press conference on Friday.

The January signing of Omar Marmoush at least means Guardiola does have a back-up option should Haaland fail to recover in time to face the league leaders,

"It's better to have Erling on the pitch than not," he added. "Of course with Erling we are stronger."

The battle for supremacy between Guardiola's City and Jurgen Klopp's Liverpool marked an era in the Premier League. But Arne Slot has seamlessly

succeeded Klopp to have the Reds on course for the title in his first season in charge.

"For me it's an exceptional team. I have said many times, they have been the biggest rival in my tenure here," said Guardiola.

"Arsenal right now in the last years have been involved as well, but I could not expect differently that Liverpool (would) be in the position that they are."

Liverpool hold an eight-point lead over Arsenal, who have a game in hand and are favourites to cut the gap to five when they host West Ham on Saturday.

After four consecutive title triumphs, City's defence of their crown is realistically over as they are 17 points adrift of Liverpool in fourth.

Injuries have played a major role in City's decline.

John Stones is set for another couple of months on the sidelines after limping off with a thigh tear early on against Madrid, while Rodri and Manuel Akanji may also not play again this season.

Guardiola pointed to a brutal schedule as the cause and pointed out that Arsenal, Real Madrid and Tottenham are among other clubs battling a number of serious muscle injuries this season.
