US plan sees Ukraine ceding territory same size as Luxembourg

● Putin says Russian army will seize more territory if Ukraine rejects US plan



The US peace plan for Ukraine could see Russia gain an area almost the same size as Luxembourg without a fight, according to an AFP analysis of data provided by the Institute for the Study of War (ISW).

The US initiative, seen by AFP, calls for the withdrawal of the Ukrainian army from territories it still controls, leading to a net gain of approximately 2,300 square kilometres (888 square miles) for Moscow -- almost the same area as Luxembourg (2,590 sq km), without firing a single shot.

Kyiv would relinquish nearly 5,000 sq km currently under its control in the Donetsk Oblast -- which would be used to create a buffer zone -- and a 45 sq km pocket in the Lugansk Oblast.

These concessions include the major cities of Kramatorsk and neighbouring Sloviansk.



Lawmakers slam visa brakes

Government warns a full ban could hinder legal hiring

● Government argues existing laws already control visa misuse

● Interior Ministry data shows current visa rules have cut visit-to-work conversions by over 87%

Entry visas should not be turned into work residence permits, lawmakers have warned, even as the government objects.

They say allowing this would harm job opportunities for Bahraini citizens. MPs made the point as they tabled a draft law to amend the 1965 Aliens (Immigration and Residence) Law, scheduled for discussion next Tuesday.

Government objection rests on the argument that current laws already ensure this, and therefore there is no need for a

new one. Parliament responded positively to the call, but the Shura Council has raised objections and sent the bill back for a second review.

The Foreign Affairs, Defence and National Security Committee has now urged MPs to hold to their earlier vote.

Supporters argue the change would help slow the rise in unemployment among Bahrainis and keep citizens first in the hiring queue.

However, the government has written to the chamber urging a rethink, saying the existing law already covers the issues the bill seeks to address. It believes a full ban on converting visas would clash with Article 18 of

a 250-dinar fee. The ministry says these steps have cut visit-to-work conversions by more than 87%, and warns that a full ban would make it harder for families to hire domestic workers legally. The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) says conversion is already tied to clear conditions, with joint monitoring alongside the Interior Ministry.

BETTER YOU KNOW

As of 2024, Bahrain no longer allows the conversion of visitor visas into work or dependent visas unless the visitor has the same sponsor -- and the conversion fee has risen from BD 60 to BD 250.

CBB Governor: capital market development is a key driver of economic growth

Khalid Humaidan, Governor of the Central Bank of Bahrain (CBB), said Bahrain's capital markets hold significant growth potential, with current market capitalisation showing strong promise against regional and global benchmarks.

Speaking at a fireside chat titled "From Vision to Reality: Reshaping the Future of Bahrain's Capital Markets" during The Market 2.0 conference, he said boosting listings, liquidity, and investor participation remains a core CBB priority, supported by a nationwide development plan for public equity markets.

He also highlighted the CBB's push to advance payment infrastructure and expand the use of Supervisory Technology (SupTech) for real-time oversight and reduced systemic risk, ensuring innovation aligns with risk management, compliance, consumer protection, and governance standards.

Deadly crash

Fighter jet crashes at Dubai Airshow, killing pilot

An Indian fighter jet crashed during a flying display at the Dubai Airshow yesterday, killing the pilot, a government statement said.

The warplane executed a low roll before crashing in flames about a mile (1.6 kilometres) from the show site, an eyewitness told AFP.

"A Tejas fighter aircraft from India participating in today's flying display at the Dubai Airshow has crashed, resulting in



the tragic death of the pilot," Dubai's state-run media office posted on X.

Videos circulating on social media showed the aircraft going down at speed and bursting into a ball of flames on impact as onlookers watched in shock. A plume of smoke billowed

from the crash site as emergency vehicles sped towards it.

The incident happened on the last day of the Middle East's biggest airshow, which features a flying display each afternoon.

Hundreds of people were watching from a grandstand, while the apron was packed

with planes, helicopters and other hardware on static display. Thousands of people have attended the show this week, including aviation industry leaders and military officials.

The Indian Air Force announced an inquiry into the accident. "IAF deeply regrets the loss of life and stands firmly with the bereaved family in this time of grief," a statement said. It is believed to be the first crash in the history of the airshow, which dates back to 1986.

Palestinian ministry says two killed in West Bank clashes

The Palestinian health ministry said yesterday that Israeli forces fatally shot two teenagers overnight in the town of Kufr Aqab in the occupied West Bank.

"The young man Amr Khaled Ahmed Al-Marbou (18) and the boy Sami Ibrahim Sami Mashayekh (16) were martyred by occupation forces gunfire in the town of Kufr Aqab near Ramallah," the ministry said in a statement.

Public Security to become **Police**

Draft law proposes new ranks, promotion rules

● Terms such as 'military courts' and 'cadets' would be replaced with police-specific titles

● A new Interior Ministry Council and two standing committees would take over policy and staff matters.

Public Security Forces will be renamed 'Police' under a major overhaul of the force.

MPs will discuss the bill on Tuesday. If approved, the Public Security Forces Law will become the Bahrain Police Law. Rules on ranks, promotions, postings

and staff support would also be revamped.

References to military courts would change to 'police courts'. The term 'military cadet' would be replaced with 'officer candidate'.

Article 44 of the current law would be removed. This article sets minimum and maximum time in rank before officers can be promoted.

At present, officers must serve three to five years from lieutenant to first lieutenant. They need four to five years to move from first lieutenant to captain, four to five from captain to major, and four to six years from major to lieutenant-colonel.

The draft law repeals these timelines and other promotion rules.

Under the new system, promotion decisions for officers

would follow conditions set by the Interior Minister. Non-commissioned officers, personnel and guards would be promoted by the Chief of Police under ministerial rules.

The draft reshapes the rank ladder. It adds and renames grades for NCOs and guards, including a new 'first warrant officer' rank and an additional guard rank called 'first guard'.

Inside the Interior Ministry, the single general committee would be replaced. A new Ministry of Interior Council and two standing committees — one for officers and one for personnel — would handle policy and staff issues.

On welfare, the Police Rewards Fund and Police Aid Fund would replace existing funds. The Interior Ministry, in its feedback, said it was open to adding civilian ministry employees to the aid fund. It added that allowances are reviewed periodically and depend on budget availability.

The Foreign Affairs, Defence and National Security Committee has recommended approval in principle, saying the changes match the ministry's evolving structure and introduce new categories within the police force.



Ain Huwais to spring back to life

MPs push to restore Buri's historic spring and reopen it as a community oasis

● **Lawmakers say Ain Huwais, believed to be up to 4,000 years old, has suffered decades of neglect that threaten its historic value.**

● **The proposal calls for restoring the spring's natural features and transforming the area into a green public space for families and visitors.**

● **An archaeological study and scientific dating are being urged to ensure the site is preserved as a key link to Bahrain's Dilmun and early Islamic past.**

Ain Huwais, an ancient spring that once powered daily life in Buri, may finally escape decades of neglect as MPs push for its revival.

They want the dried-out site restored to its natural form and reopened as a green oasis for families and visitors.

by MPs Muneer Seroor, Jaleela Alawi, Abdulwahid Qarata, Mohammed Mousa and Hamad Al Doy.

"We have more than 12 archaeological springs in Bahrain that have dried out or been left to fade away, and each one carries a piece of our history," Dr

Seroor said.

He noted that many of these springs link back to the Dilmun civilisation, the early Islamic period and the old farming communities that once shaped life across the islands.

"Reviving Ain Huwais is about protecting our water heritage

and giving families a green space that feels like it belongs to them," he said.

Local sources suggest Ain Huwais may be three to four thousand

years old, possibly tracing its roots to the Dilmun era.

Yet the spring's surroundings have deteriorated. Natural features have disappeared. What was once a focal point for social life in Buri now sits abandoned.

MPs say this amounts to the loss of a heritage site that deserves urgent protection and renewal.

Ain Huwais once supplied households with water, supported farmland and offered a simple retreat for families — a natural gathering spot for the community.

Dr Seroor has called for an archaeological study and scientific dating to be carried out before any physical work begins, to ensure the spring is treated primarily as a heritage site.

Port Cargo rises slightly as vehicle arrivals reach 3,872

Khalifa bin Salman Port handled 37,473 standard containers in October, a 0.997 per cent rise on the same month last year, while general cargo dropped to 25,384 tonnes, down 30.72 per cent, new figures from Ports and Maritime Navigation Affairs at the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications show.

The monthly record also lists

3,872 vehicles received at the port and 64 ships calling in.

During the month, the port unit issued 29 commercial licences, granted 227 ship departure certificates, and carried out 10 inspection visits.

Cargo moving through private berths rose year on year. Liquid cargo reached 1,634,495.19 metric tonnes in October this year, compared with 813,241.78 metric tonnes in October 2024. Solid cargo

totalled 2,903,658.004 metric

tonnes, up from 2,118,320 metric tonnes a year earlier.

Ports and Maritime Navigation Affairs is in charge of licensing maritime business activity, including private berths used for industry or passenger transport, and it supervises shipping agents and related services. It also runs routine checks on private berths to make sure they meet technical and operating rules and apply safety, security and environmental standards.

Summer bill relief planned for **single mothers**

Proposal gives divorced women and widows a four-month break from power and water charges

● **Plan would waive electricity and water bills from June to September for single-mother households**

● **Committee backs the idea**

● **EWA warns the move could raise costs and spark demands for similar waivers**

Single mothers could get a break from electricity and water bills during the summer, under a proposal MPs will discuss on Tuesday. The plan is aimed at divorced women and widows who are raising children on their own.

The idea, submitted by MPs Lulwa Ali Al Rumaihi and Muneer Seroor, calls for wiping out utility bills from June to September — the months when power and water use shoot up because of the heat.

Al Rumaihi said the Constitution requires the state to support citizens in cases such as widowhood and protect them from poverty. She explained that single mothers often struggle

with household expenses, and the high cost of cooling homes in summer makes things even harder. A summer waiver, she said, would ease the pressure and help keep home life stable for children.

Parliament's Public Utilities and Environment Committee has supported the proposal and sent it forward with a recom-

mendation to approve it.

However, the Electricity and Water Authority (EWA), in comments sent to the committee, raised concerns about cost and policy issues. It noted that Bahraini households with only one account already receive heavy subsidies — the first band of consumption is subsidised by around 90 per cent — making

local tariffs among the lowest in the Gulf. EWA also pointed to existing support given through the Ministry of Social Development, which provides a BD10 discount on electricity and water bills for low-income families, rising to BD20 for larger households, homes with more than one family, or families that include a person with special needs.

EWA warned that offering a full summer waiver to one specific group could lead to similar demands from others, reducing its income and affecting future service improvements.

The committee still backed the plan unanimously, leaving it to MPs to take the final call on Tuesday.



Ministry says 'no space', but MPs press for Sanabis school gym

The Education Ministry has rejected a call to build an indoor sports hall and stage at Sanabis Boys Primary School, saying the campus is too small to accommodate a full facility. It suggested using existing play areas as a temporary alternative.

Despite the ministry's stance, MPs will vote on the proposal on Tuesday. The plan was submitted by MPs Mamdouh Al Saleh, Jalal Kadhem, Mohsen Al Asbool, Jaleela Alawi and Mahmoud Fardan.

MPs argue that pupils need a proper indoor space with

age-appropriate equipment, learning, behaviour and school engagement. It would also give staff a suitable venue for awards days, theatre events, par-

ent meetings and exhibitions, and allow the school to host inter-class competitions.

In its written response to the Services Committee, the ministry thanked MPs for highlighting school needs and noted that its 2020-2030 plans aim to expand facilities as resources allow. However, it said Sanabis Boys Primary School lacks the space required for a standard gym and that it is exploring other ways to improve sports areas. It added that a gym could be considered in future plans if funding and space become available.

The Services Committee has recommended approval, with all members supporting the proposal in the public interest.

MPs push to scrap BD900 cap on pre-2004 housing alternatives

A move to scrap the BD900 salary cap on alternative housing options for pre-2004 applicants is heading to Parliament after a key committee ruled the limit unfair.

The proposal — submitted by MPs Hamad Al Doy, Abdulwahid Qarata, Bader Al Tamimi, Jameel Mulla Hassan and Mohammed Al Ma'arafi — calls for the income ceiling to be removed from the substitute schemes offered to people whose applications date back to 2004 and earlier. Supporters argue the cap prevents long-waiting families from choosing the most suitable option once their income rises above the threshold.

The Public Utilities and Environment Committee has recommended approval, saying the change would place older applicants on equal footing and give them wider choice among the alternatives already available.

In its written response, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Planning said it has begun rolling out a set of options for applicants from 2004 and earlier under directives from the Crown Prince and Prime Minister. Three routes are currently offered. For households earning under BD900, the first is a subsidised housing plot funded through Tas'heel at

BD40,000, with the housing allowance continuing for two years. The second is a flat with a BD3,000 grant and a two-year waiver of shared-area fees. For applicants earning BD900 and above, the third option is Tas'heel financing of BD70,000 supported by a non-refundable BD10,000 grant. Applicants who decline these alternatives may remain on the original waiting list until housing becomes available.

Mr Al Doy said the salary ceiling contradicts the purpose of the alternative plan. "The Crown Prince's instructions were clear — find solutions for old applications without setting a salary cap," he said. He added that the Land and Loan option should be open to all pre-2004 applicants, while preserving the BD70,000 financing with the BD10,000 grant for those who prefer it.

The MP also argued that the BD900 limit applies only to new applications, not to the allocation stage now affecting families who have waited more than two decades. Many applicants, he noted, are over 45 and nearing retirement, making long repayment terms harder to sustain once income drops. He added that some now exceed BD900 purely due to gradual pay rises over 20 years, while living costs, inflation and property prices have surged far beyond what earlier housing-finance levels were designed to meet.

MPs urge new start-up track for Bahraini accountants

Tamkeen is being urged to help more Bahrainis become self-employed accountants, as Parliament prepares to debate a proposal on Tuesday. The plan calls for a new entrepreneurship programme for people who want to work in accounting, bookkeeping or auditing.

The proposal was submitted by MPs Jaleela Alawi, Dr Hisham Al Ashiri, Mohsen Al Asbool, Khalid Buanaq and Mohammed Janahi, and the Services Committee has recommended that Parliament approve it.

MPs say these professions need better quality control and more properly licensed Bah-

raini workers. They warn that some people are doing accounting and audit work without registration, and believe a Tamkeen start-up programme would help fresh Bahraini graduates enter the field and reduce unemployment.

The MPs also point out that Bahrain's laws already limit bookkeeping and

auditing to Bahraini nationals. With many accounting graduates struggling to find jobs, they say an entrepreneurship track would help them start their own firms. Rising demand for tax-related services, they add, makes it even more important to improve skills and standards.


In its response, Tamkeen said it supports the idea but noted that it already helps the sector by fully funding professional qualifications such as ACCA and other recognised certificates. It also highlighted its existing entrepreneurship programmes and training for business owners. Tamkeen said it is ready to continue working with Parliament on projects that benefit the public.

The Youth Pioneer Society also backed the proposal. It said one reason for high unemployment among graduates is the mismatch between university training and real labour-market needs. The society called for stronger training standards, better teaching, more private-sector investment in training institutes, a refreshed role for the Bahrain Training Institute,

and more practical placements for students.

After reviewing all opinions, the Services Committee unanimously recommended approval, saying the proposal clearly supports public interest by raising professional standards and creating opportunities for young Bahraini accounting graduates.

30-plus nations oppose COP30 draft over fossil fuel omission: Colombia

eastern Democratic Republic of Congo, the country's United Nations mission said yesterday. A number of armed groups and militia are operating in the conflict-racked region, including Rwanda-backed anti-government M23 forces, which seized swathes of territory in North and South

Miss Mexico wins Miss Universe contest after host insult drama

Miss Mexico was crowned Miss Universe in Thailand yesterday, strutting to victory after the beauty pageant's host had publicly chastised her, among several dramatic missteps in the run-up to the final stage.

Contestants from Ivory Coast, the Philippines, Thailand and Venezuela also made it to the final round, selected from more than 120 women vying for the title of Miss Universe in a contest considered one of the "big four" of global beauty pageants.

But before Miss Mexico Fatima Bosch was ultimately crowned, chaos reigned -- from allegations of an insult to her intellect, to judges quitting and participants taking flops on and off the stage.

Bosch staged a dramatic walkout earlier this month -- in an evening gown and high heels -- from a meeting where she was lambasted by Thai organiser Nawat Itsaragrisil.

In a livestream of the event,

Nawat seemed to single out Miss Mexico during a dispute over her apparent failure to post promotional content on her social media.

After Nawat called for security to intervene, Bosch staged a walkout flanked by Miss Iraq.

Other beauty queens appeared to rise in solidarity with Bosch, before freezing as Nawat warned those still wanting to participate should "sit down".

"What your director did is not respectful: he called me dumb," Bosch told reporters at the time. "The world needs to see this because we are empowered women and this is a platform for our voice."

After the incident, Mexican President Claudia Sheinbaum called Bosch an "example of how we women should speak out" in the face of aggression. Nawat later apologised.

Other drama in the run-up to the final round included two judges quitting this week, with one alleging the contest was rigged by a "secret and illegitimate vote" held without the official jury.

Bangladesh earthquake kills five, injures dozens

Tremor causes panic, with shaking felt as far away as Kolkata, India

- 5.5-magnitude quake hits near Dhaka
- Around 100 people reported injured
- Government monitoring situation and assessing damage

A powerful earthquake struck Bangladesh yesterday outside the crowded capital Dhaka, killing at least five people and injuring around a hundred, the government said.

The 5.5-magnitude quake struck at 10:38 am (0438 GMT) near the city of Narsingdi, about 33 kilometres (16 miles) from Dhaka, according to the US Geological Survey (USGS).

The Friday morning earthquake sparked fear and chaos with many in the Muslim-majority nation of 170 million people at home on their day off.

Reporters in Dhaka saw people weeping in the streets while others appeared shocked.

Interim leader Muhammad Yunus expressed his "deep shock and sorrow over the news of casualties in various districts".

At least five people, including a child, had been killed and around 100 people injured, including university students and factory workers, he said in a statement.

Nine people were taken to

hospitals in Dhaka with serious injuries, according to the government's health department.

An eyewitness told AFP that masonry from an eight-storey building in a Dhaka district had fallen onto a busy road below.

"Many people had gathered at the butcher" when the rubble fell, said Sakib Hossain, 50, who rushed out after hearing a loud bang.

"I saw vans carrying injured people," he added.

The USGS warned of potential "significant casualties" and

damage.

Yunus said the government was taking "all necessary measures" and that emergency services were "responding swiftly to the reports of damages" from across the country, including in Dhaka.

The shaking lasted for 26 seconds, according to the Bangladesh Meteorological Department, which recorded the magnitude as 5.7.

"The situation is being closely monitored, and all relevant departments have been directed

to immediately go to the field to assess any possible damages," Yunus said.

Strong tremors were felt as far as the Indian city of Kolkata, more than 325 kilometres away from the epicentre.

AFP reporters there saw people fleeing offices and homes after the sudden jolt.

"I felt tremors and my bed moved... I rushed out of my room," said Sumit Dutta, 66.

There were no immediate reports of casualties or significant damage in India.

Pupils, teachers kidnapped from Catholic school in central Nigeria

- Second school kidnapping in a week
- School defied closure order

Armed gang members kidnapped pupils and teachers from a Catholic school in central Nigeria, officials said yesterday, in the second such incident in less than a week.

The school kidnappings and an attack on a church earlier this week came weeks after US President Donald Trump threatened military action over what he described as the targeted killings of Nigeria's Christians by radical Islamists, a narrative rejected by the Nigerian government.

The Catholic Church in the area said in a statement that "armed attackers invaded" the school between 1:00 am and 3:00 am, abducting "pupils, students, teachers and a security" guard who was shot.

The Niger state government said it had "received with deep

sadness the disturbing news of the kidnapping of pupils from St. Mary's School in Agwara local government area".

"The exact number of abducted pupils is yet to be confirmed as security agencies continue to assess the situation," Abubakar Usman, the state government secretary, said in a statement.

After gunmen on Monday stormed a secondary school in Kebbi state in northwestern Nigeria, abducting 25 schoolgirls, yesterday's attack further raises alarm over security in Africa's

most populous country.

For years, heavily armed criminal gangs locally known as "bandits" have been intensifying attacks in rural areas of northwest and central Nigeria with little state presence, killing thousands and conducting kidnappings for ransom.

The gangs have camps in a vast forest straddling several states including Zamfara, Katsina, Kaduna, Sokoto, Kebbi and Niger from where they launch attacks.

Zelensky rejects US peace plan

Ukrainian leader resists US plan favouring Moscow despite risk of isolation

- Zelensky vows not to "betray" Ukraine
- Plan requires Ukraine to cede territory
- Ukrainian leader will propose alternatives to Trump

Ukraine's Volodymyr Zelensky yesterday warned he will not "betray" his country as he pushed back on a US plan to end the war on terms favourable to Moscow, acknowledging he risked losing Washington as an ally.

Ukraine faces one of the most challenging moments in its history, Zelensky said in an address to the nation published on social media, adding that he would propose "alternatives" to US President Donald Trump's 28-point plan.

Kyiv and its European allies were startled by the proposal -- which would effectively force Ukraine to capitulate by giving up land, cutting its army, pledging never to join NATO and holding snap elections.

Russia, meanwhile, would not only gain territory but be reintegrated into the global economy and rejoin the G8, under a draft of the plan, seen by AFP.

In Moscow, the Kremlin was bullish, threatening Zelensky to negotiate or lose even more territory.

Zelensky said: "I will present arguments, I will persuade, I will

propose alternatives." Recalling how he marshalled Kyiv's response to the Russian invasion in February 2022, he said: "We did not betray Ukraine then, we will not do so now."

He spoke to US Vice President JD Vance yesterday, a source in the Ukrainian president's office said, without elaborating on the discussion.

And the Ukrainian leader plans to speak directly to Trump in the "coming days", his office said Thursday.

He also held an emergency call with German, French and British leaders as Europe, cut out of the process, also scrambled to respond.

'Most difficult moment'

The US plan envisages recog-

nising Moscow-annexed Crimea and occupied eastern Ukraine as "de-facto" Russian, also requiring Kyiv to pull out from parts of the Donetsk region that it still controls.

The front line would be frozen in the southern Kherson and Zaporizhzhia regions.

Kyiv would also cap the size of its army to 600,000, rule out ever joining NATO and have no NATO troops deployed to its territory.

In return, it would get unspecified "reliable security guarantees" and a fund for reconstruction using parts of Russia's frozen assets.

Zelensky has made no illusions about how much of a corner Ukraine has been backed into with the proposals.

"Right now is one of the most

difficult moments in our history," Zelensky said in the address to the nation, wearing all black.

"The pressure on Ukraine is one of the hardest. Ukraine may face a very difficult choice: either the loss of dignity or the risk of losing a key partner," he said, warning of a complete break with Washington.

Trump's administration has rejected accusations that it worked on the proposal with Moscow, which, in turn, said it had not officially received the draft.

The White House insisted that it was a "good plan" for both Russia and Ukraine.

Zelensky has also sought to rally the support of his key European allies.

Following a call, UK Prime Minister Keir Starmer, French

President Emmanuel Macron and German Chancellor Friedrich Merz stressed their "unwavering and full support for Ukraine on the path to a lasting and just peace".

The United States bypassed Europe with the plan, with many in the EU unsettled by the prospect of the war ending on Moscow's terms.

Germany's Merz stressed that Ukraine's army "must remain capable of defending itself".

Berlin said the current front line "remains the starting point for any understanding" -- in contrast to the US plan that would immediately hand vast territories to Moscow.

The Kremlin appeared to see victory in the vicinity -- either through diplomacy or on the battlefield.

Indian warplane crashes at Dubai Airshow, killing pilot

An Indian fighter jet crashed during a flying display at the Dubai Airshow yesterday, killing the pilot in front of hundreds of shocked onlookers.

The Indian-made Tejas warplane was executing a manoeuvre when it plunged to the ground and erupted in a fireball. The pilot was unable to eject.

The crash happened in full view of a packed grandstand watching the aerobatics display

on the last day of the Middle East's biggest air show.

Dubai's government-run media office confirmed the "tragic death of the pilot" and the Indian Air Force (IAF) announced an inquiry.

"IAF deeply regrets the loss of life and stands firmly with the bereaved family in this time of grief," it said in a statement.

The plane went down about a mile (1.6 kilometres) from the show site, which was full of planes, helicopters and other hardware on static display.

Nobel laureate Machado will be 'fugitive' if she leaves Venezuela to accept peace prize

Venezuela's attorney general said Thursday that Nobel laureate and opposition leader Maria Corina Machado will be considered a "fugitive" if she travels to Norway to accept the peace prize.

Machado, who says she is in hiding in Venezuela, has expressed an intention to travel to Oslo for the December 10 ceremony.

"By being outside Venezuela and having numerous criminal investigations, she is considered a fugitive," Attorney General Tarek William Saab said, adding she is accused of "acts of conspiracy, incitement of hatred, terrorism."

Saab said Machado is also under investigation for her support of the United States's deployment of military forces in the Caribbean.

US President Donald Trump has mobilized the world's largest aircraft carrier, warships and fighter jets with the stated aim of anti-drug operations, but Venezuelan president Nicolas Maduro says they intend to overthrow his leftist govern-

Nobel laureate Machado has welcomed the military presence -- which has seen strikes on alleged drug boats claim at

least 83 lives in the Caribbean and Pacific -- and has backed Washington's claim that Maduro heads a drug cartel.

Caracas calls the boat strike deaths "extrajudicial executions."

In a video posted to social media Tuesday, Machado said Venezuela is "on the threshold of a new era."

Trump has said Maduro's days are numbered, and that he has authorized the CIA's clandestine operations in Venezuela.



Norris tops red-flagged second practice in Vegas

Championship leader Lando Norris went fastest in Thursday's second practice for the Las Vegas Grand Prix in a session disrupted by two red flags, one for a loose manhole cover.

The Briton, who boasts a 24-point lead over McLaren teammate Oscar Piastri in the driver standings, completed his hot lap just before crimson fury struck the Las Vegas Strip.

Norris was quickest around the 6.201-km street circuit with a lap of 1min 33.602secs -- 0.029sec ahead of Mercedes' Kimi Antonelli.

Moments later, the session was red-flagged to check a manhole cover.

Cars returned to the track with six minutes remaining, time enough for Charles Leclerc of Ferrari to end his session early with a gearbox issue, before a final red flag definitively curtailed the action.

"We didn't manage to get too much from FP2 given the disruption, but we did get a slightly better feeling than in FP1," said Norris, who was sixth in opening practice.

"We made some good progress and we've got a reasonable feeling altogether. Some positives to build on and some

areas to try and improve going into tomorrow."

Monaco's Leclerc was third in a session where many of the drivers did not have a soft tyre run, including Piastri, who was 14th and 0.891 adrift of title rival Norris.

Australian Piastri, who was 34 points clear in the standings after winning the Dutch Grand Prix in August, has not managed

a podium finish in the past five races.

While Norris cannot secure the world championship crown this weekend, he could doom the repeat bid of four-time defending champion Max Verstappen, the Dutchman entering 49 points adrift.

Verstappen was ninth in his Red Bull in the second session, 0.503 off the pace.

Leclerc set the fastest time in first practice in 1:34.802 with Thailand's Alexander Albon second for Williams and Japan's Yuki Tsunoda of Red Bull third.

A lack of grip marked the opening session on the Las Vegas strip as many cars skidded or failed to brake in some corners, Norris touching a wall but getting away with it.

Guardiola says 'season starts now' as Man City hunt Arsenal

Pep Guardiola said yesterday that the "real season starts now" as Manchester City seek to hunt down Arsenal at the top of the Premier League.

City closed the gap to the Gunners to four points before the recent international break, thumping champions Liverpool 3-0 after Arsenal dropped points in a 2-2 draw at Sunderland.

Guardiola was asked ahead of his side's match at Newcastle on Saturday about the importance of a potential swing in momentum from those results.

The City boss admitted it was important not to allow "impeccable" Arsenal to build up too big a lead, though he cautioned the season was still relatively young.

"The feeling that I had in the past when we fought incredibly against Liverpool, I had the feeling that we'll not drop many points and if they can take a lot of distance it will be difficult to catch up," he said.

"It was similar with Liverpool last season," when they won the league with four games to spare, he said.

Guardiola will be without midfielders Mateo Kovacic and Rodri for the visit to St James' Park.

The Kingdom wrapped up the 6th Islamic Solidarity Games in Riyadh on a high yesterday, closing the tournament with a historic gold in men's handball and three medals in wrestling, bringing the Kingdom's total to 16 gold, 11 silver, and 7 bronze — 34 medals. The final day showed the depth and versatility of Bahrain's athletes, who delivered strong performances across both team and individual events.

The defining moment came on the handball court, where Bahrain faced hosts Saudi Arabia in a nail-biting final. The match started in favor of the home team, but Bahrain fought back through the sharp finishing of Hasan Alsamahiji, who scored six goals from seven attempts. Mohamed Mohamed and Mohamed Ahmed added critical strikes at key moments, while captain Husain Alsayyad contributed five goals to steady the team. With the score tied at 25-25 late in the second half, Jasim Khamis and Salman Alshowaikh delivered decisive goals that secured a 33-31 win, giving Bahrain one of its most memorable team medals of the



Games.

The momentum from handball carried into wrestling, where Bahrain added two silvers and a bronze to its medal haul. Khidir Saipudinov advanced to the men's freestyle 86kg final before narrowly losing to Azerbaijan's Arsenii Dzhioev, taking silver. Shamil Sharipov reached the final in the 125kg division after edging Giorgi Meshvildishvili 7-6 in the semifinal, ultimately claiming silver as well. Magomedrasul Asluev secured bronze in the 74kg category with a 4-3 victory over Turkey's Fazli Eryilmaz, giving Bahrain a strong finish in wrestling and adding to its growing medal count.

Bahrain's campaign had already seen success across ath-

letics, with ten golds coming from stars including Edidiong Odiong, Salwa Eid Naser, Nelly Korir, Winfred Yavi, and Rooba Alomari. Weightlifting contributed five more golds thanks to Ingrid Grueso and Gor Minasyan, while additional medals in judo, fencing, volleyball, table tennis, and e-sports showed the Kingdom's depth and versatility across sports.

By the end of the Games, Bahrain ranked sixth overall, behind Türkiye, Uzbekistan, Iran, Saudi Arabia, and Egypt. Across handball, athletics, and wrestling, Bahraini athletes produced standout performances, closing the Games with an impressive medal haul and a strong finish to their campaign in Riyadh.

Slot says Liverpool will never use Jota grief as 'excuse' for poor form
