

#### **US urges coalitions** against Iran

The US wants to build more coalitions in the Middle East to counter the "very real" threat of Iran's malign meddling in the region, Secretary of State Mike Pompeo told the World Economic Forum in Davos yesterday.

Speaking via video link, Pompeo said the US was committed to a "secure and stable" Middle East and had assembled a "global coalition of nations to confront Iran and support the aspirations of the Iranian people."

#### **Assad blocks access** for EU envoys

Syria's Bashar Assad has revoked special visas for EU diplomats and officials traveling regularly between Beirut and Damascus, complicating efforts to distribute aid to civil war victims, three senior EU diplomats said.

Since conflict broke out in Syria in 2011, the EU has used the Lebanese capital, the nearest major city, for its diplomatic base while closing most embassies in Damascus in protest over what they describe as Assad's brutal assault on the opposition.
