Trump vows no surrender on 32nd day of shutdown

President Donald Trump had a message yesterday for Democrats counting on him to relent in the Washington arm wrestle blocking funds to swaths of the government for a record 32 days: "No Cave!"

Trump's defiant tweet again blamed congressional Democrats for the chaos, insisting he will not lift his shutdown on federal government funding unless they approve his \$5.7 billion plan for more walls along the US-Mexican border.
