Madan was one of 10 competitors going for the podium yesterday. He completed his ride in a time of 31 minutes 46.43 seconds, and was just over a minute behind gold-medallist Saied Alali of Kuwait, who won in 30:39.79. Yousif Mohamed Mirza of the UAE took the silver in 31:27.71.

Madan's countryman Ahmed Naser also had a chance to make it onto the podium, but he narrowly missed out. He finished fourth in 31:57.64.

Nouf's silver and Madan's bronze brought Bahrain's tally so far at the Games to 46-a mark adjusted by organisers on the official medal table after previously not counting the men's team trial bronze in cycling.

The nationals thus have 17 gold medals, 17 silver and 12 bronze medals in second overall on the six-nation standings.
