

# Arnold Schwarzenegger reveals his children 'hated' his move from film to politics

The Former Governor of California and Hollywood legend Arnold Schwarzenegger recently opened up about his family life behind the scenes of his governorship from 2003 to 2011.

According to Fox News, on Saturday, the 73-year-old actor spoke about his family's sentiments with his eldest daughter Katherine, for her 32nd episode - a "grand finale of Father's Day week.", on her Instagram show: "Before, During and After Baby".

Within the near 34-minute interview, Arnold acknowledged his four children weren't

happy with his transition from action movie star to the 38th governor of California. The Schwarzenegger family moved from Hollywood to Sacramento, where Arnold served for two terms.

"First of all, I think it is very important to let everyone know how much you kids hated my job. It was one of those kind of odd things where I just thought that: 'Oh, my kids will be so proud of me being governor now. And all this stuff, but I don't think that you guys really kind of connected with that. I think you were so used to what we were doing when I was on a movie set,'" Arnold said.

plained that his children were more accustomed to doing their homework in movie studios and joining him on sets where he could be blowing up a building or filming a fight scene.

He further added, "This was your entertainment. So, when you think about after-school programs, you guys had like the perfect after-school program."

However, when all that changed as the family planted roots in Sacramento, Arnold noted that his kids would tell him outright that they hated his job as governor.

According to the Austrian-born bodybuilder turned American politician, his children didn't like the seriousness

of California's capital and would ask why their circumstances had changed.

While his kids weren't ecstatic about his time in office, there was a reason behind Arnold's governor. In his own words, he "had this fixation about fixing the state and making the state better. And so that's why I ran from one moment to the other when there was a recall."

Arnold also went on to commend his ex-wife Maria Shriver, for her support as a working mother and political confidant.

The couple were married from 1986 to 2017, and raised four children together, including Katherine, Patrick, Christopher, and Christina.

# David Schwimmer opens up about his 'crappy summer jobs' before he landed 'Friends'

Hollywood actor David Schwimmer, who has been in news for the widely loved 'Friends' reunion show, recently revealed about his 'crappy summer jobs', before he landed the role of Ross Geller on the popular sitcom series.

According to Fox News, while speaking to a media outlet Schwimmer revealed that before he made it big on "Friends," he worked on wheels for seven long years.

He said, "I was a roller-skating waiter in Chicago for seven years. You make your real money by doing stunts. Every-

one gets their burgers and fries, then you say: 'Hey, you want me to jump over your kids for five bucks?' They'd have their kids lie on the ground and I'd just jump over them at 30mph."

By then Schwimmer was used to hard work as he'd been hardened by a series of "really crappy summer jobs."

He recalled, "I worked at this place called Steve's Ice-Cream where you had to mix in

all the candy or cookie crumbs by hand on this big marble slab for three bucks an hour.

Speaking about his job at the age of 16, Schwimmer added, "I worked at this copy machine place. I had to pretend to be some guy from Xerox. I'd phone up customers and say: 'I see you have a Xerox 2-2500. Looks like you're running out of toner.' Some innocent secretary would say: 'I don't think we

are?' and I'd say: 'I think you are, let me send you a couple of boxes.' It wasn't exactly legal. I turned up one day and the whole place had been raided."

While he made the world fall in love with him on 'Friends', Schwimmer almost didn't become an actor at all.

Speaking about it, he said that as a child, "I wanted to be a surgeon. I was fascinated by the human body; I knew everything about the lymphatic, vascular and skeletal systems. I was a big science geek, but I found that I could talk to more girls in acting class than in the science lab. So that kind of derailed my medical career."

"I stepped in some shit,


