

Israel, Sudan said to reach deal for ties

Israel and Sudan will announce the establishment of diplomatic ties over the weekend or early next week in a US-brokered deal, Hebrew media reported Thursday, citing officials involved in the negotiations.

The announcement will likely come after a phone call between US President Donald Trump, Sudan's transitional leader Lt. Gen. Abdel Fattah al-Burhan, Sudan's Prime Minister Abdalla Hamdok and Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, according to the Walla news site.

Lebanese veteran politician Saad al-Hariri was named prime minister for a fourth time yesterday and pledged to form a new government that can tackle the country's worst crisis since its 1975-1990 civil war.

After his nomination, Hariri said he would quickly form a cabinet of specialists "with a mission to enact the economic and financial reforms" set out in a French roadmap to unlock foreign aid.

But he faces major challenges to navigate Lebanon's sectarian politics to agree a cabinet, which must then fix a mounting list of woes: a banking crisis, currency

crash, rising poverty and crippling state debts.

A new government will also have to contend with a COVID-19 surge and the fallout of the huge August explosion at Beirut port

that killed nearly 200 people and caused billions of dollars of damage.

At 50, Hariri has already served three terms since 2009 as premier - a post reserved for

one but said it would facilitate the process.

Mass protests against economic stagnation and corruption bring down the government of Saad Hariri, who was succeeded by the academic Hassan Diab.

a Sunni Muslim in Lebanon's power-sharing system. His last coalition cabinet was toppled almost exactly a year ago as protests gripped the country, furious at the ruling elite for decades of state graft and waste.

Hariri, the sole candidate in Thursday's talks, was backed by a majority of parliamentarians.

The nomination of Hariri follows weeks of political wrangling that has delayed a deal on a new government.

He was backed by his own Future Movement, the Shi'ite Amal party, Druze politician Walid Jumblatt's party and other small blocs.

The heavily armed Hezbollah, which took part in Hariri's last cabinet, did not nominate anyone but said it would facilitate the process.

"We will contribute to maintain the positive climate," said Mohammed Raad, head of Hezbollah's bloc. Together with its allies, including Amal and Aoun's party, they hold a majority in parliament.

Lebanon's two main Christian blocs did not nominate Hariri.

The Free Patriotic Movement, led by Aoun's son-in-law, said a veteran politician could not lead a technocrat government.

Its rival the Lebanese Forces, the second biggest Christian bloc and a staunch Hezbollah opponent, also declined to name him. "Has this political class that took people hostage learned they cannot continue in this way?" MP Georges Adwan said.

Former colonial power France has tried rallying Lebanon's sectarian leaders but has been frustrated by the apparent lack of urgency or progress.

Hariri has presented himself as the "natural candidate" to build a cabinet that can revive the French plan, which lists long-neglected reforms and calls for resuming IMF talks.

The Ministry clarified that the structure got demolished at the project site was a temporary precast factory as planned earlier.

"We razed the plant as its

services were no longer required with the project nearing completion," the Ministry confirmed.

The Works Ministry statement affirmed that the demolition of the factory occurred as scheduled earlier to complete the project.

The bridge, the Ministry said, is planned to reopen in the first quarter of 2021.

This 14-year-old's discovery could find a cure for Corona

As scientists around the world race to find a treatment for the coronavirus, a young girl among them stands out.

Anika Chebrolu, a 14-year-old from Frisco, Texas, has just won the 2020 3M Young Scientist Challenge -- and a \$25,000 prize -- for a discovery that

could provide a potential therapy to Covid-19.

Anika's winning invention uses in-silico methodology to discover a lead molecule that can selectively bind to the spike protein of the SARS-CoV-2 virus.

"The last two days, I saw that there is a lot of media hype about my project since it involves the SARS-CoV-2 virus and it reflects our collective hopes to end this

pandemic as I, like everyone else, wish that we go back to our normal lives soon," Anika said.

Anika said she was inspired to find potential cures to viruses after learning about the 1918 flu pandemic and finding out how many people die every year in the United States despite annual vaccinations and anti-influenza drugs on the market.

The oldest guesthouse in Kathmandu, which prides itself for welcoming legends like Edmund Hillary and Beatles, has added yet another name to its memorabilia.

Bahrain's mountaineering team, the conquerors of Manaslu peak 26,781 feet above the sea-level, has engraved the name of His Highness Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa at the stone site of Nepal's oldest guest house as a tribute.

The plaque now stays alongside great names like Chhang Dawa Sherpa and Mingma Sherpa, who holds the world record

as "first brothers to summit the 14 highest peaks", and Sir Edmund Percival Hillary, the first

to reach the summit of Mount Everest along with Sherpa mountaineer Tenzing Norgay.

As a guidebook on the Kathmandu guest house puts it, "Kathmandu Guest House acts as a magnet for mountaineers, pop stars, actors and eccentric characters." Even the Beatles stayed here in 1968.

Two days back Bahraini team also announced completing their COVID-19 tests as directed by the Nepal Government ahead of their journey back to Bahrain.

Besides, team members received their Mount Manaslu summit climbing certificates from Nepal deputy minister of Tourism.

Bahrain team conquered Manaslu summit after a gruelling eight days of climb in

bone-chilling conditions. The eighth-highest peak in the world at 8,163 meters above sea-level is in the Mansiri Himal, part of the Nepalese Himalayas.

"Amazing achievement and thanks go for our Commander @ nasser13hamad for vision and support on our task," wrote Bahraini mountaineers after raising the national flag at Mt Manaslu.

Manaslu was first climbed on May 9, 1956, by Toshio Imanishi and Gyalzen Norbu, members of a Japanese expedition.

Next stop for the Bahraini mountaineering team is Mount Everest. They will attempt to climb the summit next year.

SMC issues guidelines for bringing food for patients

Salmania Medical Complex (SMC) has issued precautionary guidelines for bringing in food for hospital patients.

Serving any food prepared outside the hospital facility will be allowed only during permitted visiting hours, SMC said.

Food thus served should meet the required standards and should not compromise the safety and health of the patients.

The precautionary measures, the hospital said, are to avoid the risk of infection to the patients admitted.

The new restrictions are required by the Health Ministry to prevent the spread of the deadly outbreak.

SMC also requires visitors to wear masks and maintain social distancing while at the hospital.

Terrified father discovers his new-borns alive at a graveyard after hospital handed them in "a bag" as dead bodies

In a bizarre set of events, a twin-babies presumed dead by SMC doctors were found alive at a funeral home as they were about to be buried.

The twin girls, both born prematurely, their father, a Bahraini man, alleged were handed over to him by doctors at Salmaniya Medical Complex (SMC) pronouncing them a dead.

The babies, Zahra and Fatima, the father claims, were handed over to him "in bags".

Later the man got the shock of his life when he found that his little babies were actually alive.

Signs of life were 'discovered' just in time for burial at Bilad Al Qadeem graveyard in the Capital Governorate.

Soon, the man rushed the babies to SMC, but he ended up heartbroken once again, with both of them failing to survive the horrific ordeal.

Authorities were quick to acknowledge the horrifying incident and launched an investigation.

A document, the hapless father shared online and went viral, showed that the appalling incident occurred on October 16,

Filing labour lawsuits made easy

Online legal support for expatriate workers includes translator service, full administrative assistance

Bahrain took yet another step yesterday to ensure the legal rights of workers here by establishing a system to help expatriate labourers file labour lawsuits online.

The system, which includes the support of qualified translators, works through an electronic platform developed by the Ministry of Justice, Islamic Affairs and Endowments.

The Ministry of Justice, Islamic Affairs and Endowments and the Labour Market Regulatory Authority signed a Memorandum of Understanding for this.

The deal calls for providing full administrative assistance to expatriate workers in filing labour lawsuits in the Kingdom.

In the approximately 1.6 million residents of Bahrain, more than 600,857 are migrant workers who make up around 54.7 per cent of the country's workforce—most working in unskilled or low-skilled jobs, in industries such as construction, retail and wholesale and domestic work.

"The deal aims at strengthening joint governmental work, and enabling expatriate workers to benefit from the administrative facilities provided by Bahrain, especially on workers' rights," said Justice Minister.

For his part, the CEO of the Labour Market Regulatory Authority announced appointing a specialised team for registering and recording labour cases.

"They are responsible for verifying that the complaints to ensure that they meet the necessary criteria," he added.

The Authority will provide workers, upon request, case numbers, dates of meeting with judge and dates of sessions.

LMRA said it also provides the assistance of qualified translators in the various languages spoken by the expatriate workers.

This cooperation, Al-Absi said, embodies the spirit of one team, and the keenness to support government work in a way that increases efficiency and reduces costs.

Zero COVID-19 deaths

Zero COVID-19 deaths were reported in the Kingdom yesterday, with the Kingdom also managing to bring down the number of new positive cases.

Bahrain's health ministry announced 304 new cases yesterday, out of which 88 are expatriate workers, 203 are cases of active contacts, and the rest of the 13 are travel related. Au-

thorities here also conducted 10,954 COVID-19 tests, taking the overall number of tests conducted in the Kingdom after reporting its first case in February to 1,69,781.

There are currently 78 COVID-19 patients receiving treatment, of which 29 are critically ill.

The number of active patients stands at 3,063, out of which 3,034 are healthwise stable.

Facebook launches dating service in Europe

Facebook Inc said on Wednesday it was launching its dating service in 32 European countries after the rollout was delayed earlier this year due to regulatory concerns.

The social media company in February postponed launching Facebook Dating in Europe after concerns were raised by Ireland's Data Protection Commissioner (DPC), the main regulator in the European Union for a number of the world's biggest technology firms including Facebook.

The DPC was very concerned about being given a short notice of the launch planned for Feb. 13. It was intimated about it on Feb. 3.

It had also said it was not given documentation regarding data protection impact assessment or decision-making processes that had been undertaken by Facebook.

Facebook Dating, a dedicated, opt-in space within the Facebook app, was launched in the United States in September last year. It is currently available in 20 other countries.

Adidas plans to sell ailing Reebok

German sportswear company Adidas is planning to sell its Reebok division, Germany's manager magazine reported on Thursday, as the group seeks to put an end to its ill-fated investment in the US-focused brand.

Adidas Chief Executive Kasper Rorsted plans to complete the sale by March 2021, the magazine said, without citing where it obtained the information.

BMP to lift BAPCO capacity by 42 pc

Minister of Oil visits Bapco Modernisation project site

Bapco said it is progressing with its Bapco Modernization Programme (BMP), to build the optimum refinery configuration that would place it firmly among the most competitive refineries in the region and the world.

BMP is a multi-billion-dollar investment, which is Bapco's largest capital investment in its 90-year history. The project will effectively increase the refinery's crude capacity by 42 per cent (from 267,000 to 380,000 barrels per day).

The Engineering, Procurement, and Construction (EPC) contract for the project is with a joint venture consortium of Technip FMC (Italy), Tecnicas Reunidas (Spain), Samsung Engineering (South Korea) reg-

istered in Bahrain under the name TTSJV.

As part of the project's construction activities, several super heavy and oversized pieces of equipment have arrived in Bahrain and are being installed at the project site.

Yesterday, the Minister of Oil, Shaikh Mohamed bin Khalifa bin Ahmed Al Khalifa, toured the greenfield project site and witnessed the lift of the heaviest piece of equipment, the new hydrocracker first stage reactor, weighing 1300t.

Bapco Chairman and Chief Executive, Dr Dawood Nassif, Deputy Chief Executive Ebrahim Talib, and BMP Project Director Hafedh AlQassab accompanied the minister.

The successful completion of this super heavy lift is a major project milestone. The minister congratulated all project team



members from Bapco, Worley, TTSJV and related subcontractors.

The Armenian recent act of aggression against Azerbaijan

Armenia's deliberate targeting of civilians and civilian infrastructure is by no means isolated case. Since early 1990s Armenia's aggression against Azerbaijan has been accompanied by serious violations of human rights and humanitarian law with respect to Azerbaijani civilians. Ethnic cleansing against all Azerbaijani population of the occupied territories is one of the egregious war crimes committed by Armenia. Close to one million Azerbaijan IDPs remain deprived of their basic human rights.

Cultural heritage of Azerbaijani people and 63 of 67 mosques on the territory of today's Armenia has been demolished and plundered. Armenia also destroyed all Azerbaijani historical and religious monuments in the occupied territories.

The new act of aggression by Armenia against Azerbaijan is the continuation of its provocations in political, military, economic and other domains, on July 12-16, 2020, the Armenian leadership carried out attack on Azerbaijan's military positions and residential areas in the Tovuz district at the Armenia-Azerbaijan state border. During five consecutive days, the armed units of Armenian subjected military positions and civilian infrastructure to intensive fire from heavy artillery in the area far from the conflict zone at the state border of two countries. The aims of Armenia in this attack were to introduce a new dimension to the conflict and thus, find a pretext for involvement of the CSTO into the conflict by provoking Azerbaijan for striking back the territory of Armenia, to spread panic among the Azerbaijani public and invade a new part of Azerbaijan. Armenia also aimed at threatening critical energy transportation lines running through the region, which is also of high importance for the European nations, and thus, risking the commencement of the Southern Gas Corridor.

Armed forces of Azerbaijan, despite Armenia's provocations, limited its actions to only responding Armenia's attack, and restored the control over the situation. The leadership of Azerbaijan has extensively brought the attention of international community to these actions of Armenia and revealed that Armenia did not want peace, instead exploited the peace process for continuation of its occupation of territories of Azerbaijan and securing their annexation.

Having observed Armenia's preparation for a new attack, the leadership of Azerbaijan had no question about the real intention of Armenia. Nikol Pashinyan's provocative "Karabakh is Armenia and period" statement, "new war for new territories" concept put forward by Armenia, as well as so-called "seven conditions" for the resumption of negotiations have finally rendered negotiations meaningless.

In this war, Armenia extensively uses terrorists and mercenaries against Azerbaijan. According to various estimations, currently thousands of mercenaries and terrorists from Middle East and CIS countries have already been deployed to the conflict zone by Armenia. Despite the ongoing pandemic, significant increase is being observed in flights from these countries to Armenia. This includes both regular flights to Armenia, as well as from those places where there have never been flights to Armenia. Mercenaries and terrorist are brought to Armenia via these flights and then are deployed to the occupied territories of Azerbaijan in order to fight against Azerbaijan and organize terrorist activities against Azerbaijani civilians.

Nagorno-Karabakh was made an autonomous region within Azerbaijan by the Soviet Union in the 1920s. During the dissolution of the Soviet Union in 1991, this autonomous region declared so called independence which is not recognized by any country including Armenia, but recognized as a part of Azerbaijan by entire international community.

In the intervening decades, the one constant has been the Armenian occupation of almost all of Azerbaijan's autonomous territory of Nagorno-Karabakh and seven surrounding regions of Azerbaijan that together form about 20 percent of the country's total territory. It is not the issue of dispute that these

lands are occupied illegally and they must be returned: four UN Security Council resolutions and various OSCE documents directly related to the conflict make this clear, as do the formal positions of all the major powers, not to mention the rest of the world.

The mediators – the co-chairs of the OSCE Minsk Group (Russia, France and the United States) – are at fault: there was a formal negotiation process that was launched in 1992, which had essentially produced no concrete results on the ground, in the sense that the occupation of Nagorno-Karabakh and the seven surrounding regions of the Republic of Azerbaijan has not come to an end, Azerbaijani refugees and IDPs have been prevented from exercising their right of return, and so on. In other words, for nearly three decades the Minsk Group led negotiations whose objectives were clearly and unambigu-

ously set down on paper. The Co-chairs gave themselves the responsibility to lead a defined process to achieve a defined result, and yet the conflict has remained frozen since a 1994 ceasefire was put into effect: none of the Minsk Group's defined objectives have been achieved – not even close.

On October 9, Russia called the parties to cease hostilities for humanitarian purposes. Following the call of president of Russia Vladimir Putin, agreement of humanitarian ceasefire was reached in Moscow at the meeting of foreign minister of Russia, Azerbaijan and Armenia with mediation of the Russian Federation. The purpose of the ceasefire was to exchange the dead bodies and prisoners of war. At the meeting, it was also agreed to immediately start substantive negotiations under the mediation of the co-chairs of the OSCE Minsk Group. Only 15 minutes after the ceasefire entered into force on October 10, at 12:00 Armenia continued its attacks on Azerbaijani positions. At night of October 11, Armenia launched missile attack on city Ganja, the second most populated city of Azerbaijan. As result, 10 civilians were killed more than 30 were seriously wounded. Extensive damage was inflicted upon civilian infrastructure.

Additional Protocols, as well as the requirements of the humanitarian ceasefire agreed after its own persistent requests in Moscow, continues to deliberately target residential settlements in Azerbaijan with heavy artillery fire.

On October 15, the armed forces of Armenia, grossly violating the humanitarian ceasefire regime, continue to shell the territories of Tartar district with heavy artillery, Armenians once again targeted civilians. The Armenian army fired on the graveyard in the territory of Tartar district during the funeral using heavy artillery. As a result of this act of vandalism, four civilians killed, and five wounded.

On the night of 17 October, 2020 the armed forces of Armenia attacked the Ganja city of Azerbaijan with ballistic missiles. This, third in a row atrocious attack on the second biggest city of Azerbaijan, since the new aggression of Armenia against Azerbaijan, situated far away from the frontline caused serious civilian casualties; 12 civilians, including 2 minors killed, more than 40 people injured.

Armenia's deliberate and indiscriminate targeting of civilians, in a blatant violation of norms and principles of international law, including international humanitarian law, as well as declared humanitarian ceasefire, the purposeful killing of peaceful people constitute a war crime and a crime against humanity and the leadership of Armenia bears full responsibility for this crime. The bombing of the Ganja, the city with a population of more than 500,000 people situated far from the conflict zone, without any military necessity by the Armenian political-military leadership, the deliberate and indiscriminate use of powerful destructive missiles such as SCUDs to kill innocent civilians will be included in the history books as the bloodiest war crime committed against humanity in the 21st century.

Armenian armed forces subjected to missile attacks the densely populated civilian areas in Ganja, Mingachevir, Barda, Beylagan, Tartar and some other cities of Azerbaijan. As a result of Armenia's artillery and missile attacks, more than 60 Azerbaijani civilians were killed, more than 290 injured, more than 2000 residential buildings and civilian objects destroyed (from 27 September to 19 October 2020).

Trump walks out of interview, complaining about questions

Trump Accuses CBS's '60 Minutes' of hatred, releases interview segment

US President Donald Trump routinely complains of what he calls biased treatment of him by the mainstream media in the US

US President Donald Trump went through yesterday with a threat to release his own footage of a yet-to-be-aired interview with CBS that he cut short, angrily complaining of bias.

Trump tweeted that he wanted to preempt the network's own broadcast of the interview on its "60 Minutes" show Sunday in order to reveal journalist Leslie Stahl's "bias, hatred and rudeness."

The raw footage posted by Trump's Facebook page, in contravention of the White House's agreement with the network, appears to show the encounter from beginning to end, with the president frustrated throughout at the tone of questioning.

Stahl does not raise her voice or interrupt Trump other than to firmly challenge his statements on handling of the coronavirus pandemic, his encouragement of supporters to chant for locking up political opponents, and other sensitive topics.

Trump takes issue with what he says was an ambush interview and announces he is cancelling the portion where Stahl was meant to have continued the discussion while also being joined by Vice President Mike Pence.

Democratic opponent Joe Biden equally tough questions, instead giving him "softball after softball."

"I've seen all his interviews. He's never been asked a question that's hard," Trump

said.

CBS also interviewed Biden for a separate "60 Minutes" segment, which is due to air Sunday.

Trump's meltdown over the interview, taped at the White House on Tuesday, came hours before his Thursday night debate with Biden -- their final direct clash before the election in less than two weeks.

On Twitter, he promised followers that the footage of him with Stahl displayed "her constant interruptions & anger. Compare my full, flowing and 'magnificently brilliant' answers to their 'Q's.'

CBS responded by calling Trump's breaking of the agreement on the footage "unprecedented" and said this "will not deter '60 Minutes' from providing its full, fair and contextual reporting which presidents have participated in for decades."

Landslide kills 11 miners in Indonesia

A landslide sparked by heavy rains has killed 11 miners in Indonesia, authorities said yesterday, marking the latest in a string of deadly mining accidents across the Southeast Asian archipelago.

The victims were about 20 metres (65 feet) underground at an unlicensed coal mine near a village in South Sumatra province when the accident happened on Wednesday.

"The ground wasn't firm because heavy rains have hit the area recently," said Ansori, an official with the local disaster mitigation agency, who like many Indonesians goes by one name.

"It was also a traditional mining site so safety regulations were generally ignored," he added.

The bodies of all the victims have been recovered, Ansori said.

Unlicensed mines are common across mineral-rich Indonesia and the scene of frequent accidents.

Earlier this year, nine people were killed by a landslide at an abandoned gold mine in West Sumatra province.

Scorched jaguar returns home after Brazil fire ordeal

A jaguar badly burned in the fires that ravaged Brazil's Pantanal wetlands this year has been returned to the wild after more than a month of intensive treatment for his burns.

Members of the veterinary team that treated the jaguar's scorched paws with ozone and laser therapies released him Tuesday at the same spot where he was rescued, along a river in the Encontro das Aguas nature reserve in central-western Brazil.

Named Ousado, which means "daring" or "bold" in Portuguese, the five-year-old jaguar was placed in a crate on the river bank.

A video of the release made by the wildlife protection organization that treated him, the Nex Institute, shows his handlers pulling a rope to open the door of the crate from the safe distance of a boat on the river.

Ousado tentatively left the crate, examined his surroundings, then bounded off into the forest, prompting his veterinary team to burst into applause.

"When we found him, he was in a lot of pain. He couldn't walk properly. Today, he was back to normal. He ran right up the bank. We're very happy with the result," veterinarian Jorge Salomao told AFP.

Known for its stunning biodi-

versity, the Pantanal is the largest tropical wetlands on Earth, stretching from Brazil into Bolivia and Paraguay.

An estimated 23 percent of the Brazilian Pantanal has gone up in smoke this year, amid the region's worst drought in nearly

half a century.

Images of charred landscapes strewn with animal carcasses have shocked the world, drawing criticism of far-right President Jair Bolsonaro's government.

Ousado got a happier ending

than that of another wounded jaguar rescued from the Pantanal, Amanaci.

She was found two months ago with third-degree burns, and is receiving stem cell treatments in a bid to help her heal.

But veterinarians say the fire damaged her tendons so badly she can no longer extend her claws, meaning it is unlikely she can be released back into the wild.

Thai PM revokes emergency decree despite protests



◆ Thailand's premier revoked an emergency decree that had been intended to quell pro-democracy rallies despite it failing to stamp out daily protests demanding he resign and for reforms of the unassailable monarchy. The student-led pro-democracy movement has been gaining momentum since mid-July, with mostly young demonstrators calling for Premier Prayut Chan-O-Cha's removal and a rewrite of a 2017 military-scripted constitution. Some protest leaders have also issued controversial demands to reform the ultra-powerful and wealthy monarchy, whose influence permeates every aspect of Thai society.

◆ Pope Francis voiced support for same-sex couples, calling them "children of God" and saying they should be allowed to have legally recognised civil unions, in a radical shift from previous pontiffs. The pope, whose opposition to gay marriage remains unchanged, said in a documentary premiered at the Rome Film Festival: "These are children of God, they have the right to a family."

Trudeau wins backing of opposition to avoid snap election

◆ Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau survived a confidence vote after a key opposition party backed his ruling Liberals, averting the chance of a snap election as a coronavirus outbreak worsens. Legislators voted 180-146 against a motion from the Conservatives, Trudeau's main rivals, to set up a committee with wide-ranging powers to probe whether the government improperly handed contracts to friends as it battled the pandemic earlier this year.

◆ Fugitive US whistleblower Edward Snowden has been granted permanent residency in Russia, his lawyer said. Snowden, the former US intelligence contractor who revealed in 2013 that the US government was spying on its citizens, has been living in exile in Russia since the revelations. The 37-year-old has said he would like to return to the United States.

China and Vatican renew historic deal on bishops

despite strident US condemnation and warnings from underground Chinese priests loyal to Rome that they have only become more marginalised since it was signed. The deal allows both Beijing and the Holy See a say in appointing bishops in an attempt to close a schism in China's 12-million-strong Catholic community. Washington had put intense pressure on the Vatican to scrap the agreement, saying it has failed to shield Chinese Catholics from persecution.

◆ The investigation into the murder of a French teacher for showing cartoons of the Prophet Mohammed in class turned to Syria on Thursday, where the killer had a jihadist contact, a source close to the case said. Seven people have been charged with being complicit in a "terrorist murder" after 18-year-old Chechen Abdulrahman Anzorov beheaded Samuel Paty on the outskirts of Paris on Friday, including two teenagers who helped him identify the teacher.

Nigeria's president tells security to respect law

Gunfire has erupted and jailbreaks have been reported in Nigeria, as unrest over the shooting of protesters in its biggest city continues

◆ Violence has escalated since Wednesday as groups of young men and armed police clashed in some neighbourhoods

Nigerian President Muhammadu Buhari has told security forces to act lawfully, the national security adviser said yesterday, as authorities in Lagos struggled to enforce a curfew imposed to contain anger over a crackdown on anti-police protesters.

Gunshots rang out and smoke rose from at least two fires in the commercial capital's affluent Ikoyi neighbourhood yesterday, witnesses said. A fire broke out in the district's prison, the state government said. Video footage showed a blaze in a shopping mall in another part of Lagos.

Violence in Lagos, Africa's biggest city, has escalated since Wednesday as groups of young men and armed police clashed in some neighbourhoods fol-

owing a shooting on Tuesday night in Lekki district.

Rights group Amnesty International said soldiers and police killed at least 12 protesters in Lekki and Alausa, another Lagos district. The army has denied soldiers were at the site of the shooting, where people had gathered in defiance of the curfew.

National Security Adviser Ba-

bagana Monguno, speaking to reporters in the capital Abuja

after a meeting with Buhari, said the president had directed all security agencies to operate within "the confines of legality" and "not to do anything that will aggravate the situation".

"Mr. President is very concerned about this development and does not want a situation in which everything breaks

down and results in anarchy, in lawlessness and people taking the law into their own hands," Monguno said.

Monguno said Buhari was expected to "come up with certain solutions" in the coming hours. In addition to flashpoints in Lagos - where witnesses have reported seeing young men, some armed with machetes, walking in Lagos - a number of southern states have imposed curfews to restore order.

S Korea sticks to flu vaccine plan despite safety fears after 25 die

South Korean officials refused to suspend a seasonal influenza inoculation effort, despite growing calls for a halt, including an appeal from a key group of doctors, after the deaths of at least 25 of those vaccinated.

Health authorities said they found no direct links between the deaths and the vaccines. At least 22 of the dead, including a 17-year-old boy, were part of a campaign to inoculate 19 million teenagers and senior citizens for free, the Korea Disease Control and Prevention Agency (KDCA) said.

"The number of deaths has increased, but our team sees low possibility that the deaths resulted from the shots," the agency's director, Jeong Eun-kyeong, told parliament.

Japan researchers show masks do block coronavirus, but not perfectly

Japanese researchers showed that masks can offer protection from airborne coronavirus particles, but even professional-grade coverings can't eliminate contagion risk entirely.

Scientists at the University of Tokyo built a secure chamber with mannequin heads facing each other. One head, fitted with a nebuliser, simulated coughing and expelled actual coronavirus particles. The other mimicked natural breathing, with a collection chamber for viruses coming through the

airway.

A cotton mask reduced viral uptake by the receiver head by up to 40 per cent compared to no mask. An N95 mask, used by medical professionals, blocked up to 90pc. However, even when the N95 was fitted to the face with tape, some virus particles still sneaked in.

When a mask was attached to the coughing head, cotton and surgical masks blocked more than 50pc of the virus transmission.

"There was a synergistic effect when both the virus receiver and virus spreader wore masks," the researchers wrote in a study published on Wednesday.

There has been a growing consensus among health experts that the COVID-19 virus can be spread through the air. The US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) revised its guidance this month to say the pathogen can linger in the air for hours.

North Korea's Kim lauds Chinese war dead on anniversary

Us-owned Haas will have a new Formula One driver lineup for 2021 after announcing the departure of Romain Grosjean and Kevin Magnussen, and money could play a part in deciding their replacements.

Team boss Guenther Steiner told reporters in a video conference at the Portuguese Grand Prix that the team had plenty of options but he did not want to talk about any names or numbers on the short list.

Frenchman Grosjean, 34, has been at Haas since 2016 with Danish driver Magnussen, 28, joining in 2017 but both are now looking likely to quit the scene with few openings elsewhere on the grid.

Asked whether the Ferrari-powered team, ninth in the standings, might look for a driver with financial backing, Steiner said talent was more important.

"But some people have got sponsorship they bring with them so we are looking at all the options out there as well," he added.

Russian Formula Two driver Nikita Mazepin is the son of a billionaire who tried to buy the Force India team, now Racing Point, in 2018 before the eventual sale of assets to Canadian Lawrence Stroll.

Mexican Sergio Perez, who is leaving Racing Point at the

end of the year, also has strong sponsorship and plenty of experience.

Ferrari are meanwhile looking to place some of their young drivers, with Michael Schumacher's 21-year-old son Mick leading the Formula Two championship and a strong candidate for Haas or Alfa Romeo.

Britain's Callum Ilott, another Ferrari Academy driver and second in the F2 standings, had been due to take part in Friday practice with Haas at the Nuerburgring two weeks ago but that was prevented by bad weather.

Steiner said the decision to replace Grosjean and Magnussen at the end of the season was made two to three weeks ago and the drivers were informed last week.

Yesterday's announcement, he said, was timed to help them.

"We could have kept it for us for a while, and then just do it. But I think the guys were good with us in the last years," he said.

Bayern begin title defence in style, Real stunned

Coman dazzles as Bayern open Champions League title defence by routing Atletico

● Real Madrid lose 2-3 to Shakhtar Donetsk in dramatic encounter

Bayern Munich began their defence of the Champions League title in ominous fashion by crushing Atletico Madrid 4-0 on Wednesday, while Liverpool and Manchester City also won but Real Madrid suffered a shock defeat.

Madrid, the record 13-time European champions, went down to a 3-2 home loss against Shakhtar Donetsk, showing how far Zinedine Zidane's side are just now from the standards being set by Bayern.

Two months after scoring the winner in the final against Paris Saint-Germain in Lisbon, Kingsley Coman put Bayern ahead against Atletico in Group A and later scored a stunning individual effort to wrap up the victory at an empty Allianz Arena.

In between Leon Goretzka and Corentin Tolisso were also on target for the German champions, with the latter's strike a stunner from long-range.

"The winning goal in last season's final is a good motivator, but it's in the past now and we have fresh goals this season," Coman told Sky Sports.

It was Bayern's 12th consecutive Champions League win while the result for Atletico equalled their worst defeat under Diego Simeone.

Bayern next go to Russia to play Lokomotiv Moscow, who battled back to draw 2-2 at Red Bull Salzburg on Wednesday.

Eder put Lokomotiv ahead in Austria, only for Dominik Szoboszlai to crash in a brilliant equaliser.

Van Dijk is set to miss the rest of the season with a knee injury but Jurgen Klopp's side kept a clean sheet and took all three points after Nicolas Tagliafico turned a Sadio Mane shot into his own net on 35 minutes.

Pep Guardiola's City made it three wins for English clubs this midweek as they came from behind at home to beat Porto 3-1.

F1 revises testing protocols, says Racing Point's Szafnauer

● Hulkenberg on standby Portuguese GP

Formula One has revised its protocols for managing Covid-19 testing after Racing Point driver Lance Stroll fell ill at the Eifel Grand Prix, but was not tested until he returned home, team boss Otmar Szafnauer said on Friday.

Szafnauer, who claimed Stroll was suffering from a severe stomach upset that led to him missing the race at the Nurburgring, where he was replaced by Nico Hulkenberg, said new rules were being introduced after an examination of that case.

Speaking ahead of this weekend's Portuguese Grand Prix, where Hulkenberg is on standby in case Stroll is unfit to drive, Szafnauer said: "The world is learning and the FIA (the sport's ruling body, the International Motoring Federation) are learning, we're learning."

"The FIA now, I understand,

have introduced a test you have to take 24 hours from (after) entering the paddock – that's new for everybody in the paddock.

"It's something they have changed. It's a good idea to add another test."

Canadian Stroll, 21, left the Eifel event early on Sunday, flying home to Switzerland, where he returned a positive test result on Monday.

Yet he had been unwell throughout that weekend without taking a test that resulted in proving he had the coronavirus.

Until now, all Formula One members have been required to return a negative test prior to travel and take further tests every five days.

The new weekend test is designed to identify anyone who develops the virus while attend-

ing an event.

Szafnauer said he was confident the new protocol, coupled with Stroll's negative test results ahead of the Portuguese race, ensured the Canadian would return.

"He had a negative test coming into this weekend. The probability of now giving a positive is low. Is it zero? I don't know, I don't know that much about it, but it's low," he said.

"Nico is here as a precaution, but I'm confident Lance will be in the car."

Szafnauer said he tests employees twice at the week and has returned six positives in more than 15,000 tests.

India given all clear to quarantine in Sydney

Cricket Australia have been given the all clear for the India squad to quarantine in Sydney ahead of their blockbuster test series around the New Year.

Hindley wins Stelvio stage, Kelderman takes Giro lead

Team Sunweb's Australian Jai Hindley won yesterday's gruelling Giro d'Italia 18th stage on the Stelvio climb in the northern Italian Alps ahead of Britain's Tao Geoghegan Hart.

Hindley's Dutch teammate Wilco Kelderman struggled on the final two climbs but took the overall leader's pink jersey three days before the race finishes in Milan.

Kelderman took the lead from Portugal's Joao Almeida of Deceuninck Quick-Step who had been in pink for more than two weeks since stage three in Sicily.

Three riders are battling at the top of the overall standings with Hindley 12 seconds behind teammate Wilco Kelderman and Geoghegan Hart third 15sec off the pace.

Almeida drops to fifth place after finishing the stage in 48th position.

Hart outpaced Kelderman with 8km to go towards the summit of the snow-capped Stelvio at an altitude of 2,758m.

Kelderman was overtaken by Spaniard Pello Bilbao and Dane Jakob Fuglsang on the final 8.7km climb with a gradient of 6.8 percent to the Canano Lakes.

It was a first WorldTour success for Hindley, 24, who had already impressed last Sunday at Piancavallo in the Dolomites.

Friday's 19th stage returns to the plains with a 253km run from Morbegno to Asti in Piedmont.

Cristiano Ronaldo has again tested positive for coronavirus as Juventus prepare for next week's Champions League clash against Barcelona, according to reports in Italy yesterday.

Ronaldo is currently isolating at his home in Turin after testing positive for Covid-19 on October 13 while with the Portuguese national team for Nations League matches.

The 35-year-old again received a positive result after a test carried out on Wednesday, Sky Sport Italia and Gazzetta Dello Sport reported.

The Portuguese forward could still be available for Sunday's Serie A game against Hellas Verona, and the clash against great rival Lionel Messi's Barcelona on October 28.

Under UEFA rules the five-time Ballon d'Or winner needs to test negative 24 hours before the Barcelona game in Turin to be included in the squad.

Ronaldo, who has no symptoms of the virus, has continued training at home posting a video on social media of himself training in his high-tech gym, sporting a new shaved head look.
