Jennifer Lopez didn't feel she was 'loving myself' while in her 'late 30s'

Jennifer Lopez is looking back on her life.

The "Hustlers" actress recently sat down for an interview with Coach and discussed her past relationships and how she felt about herself while in them.

"I remember when I was going through therapy at the beginning, you know, kind of in my late 30s and there was a lot of talk about loving yourself and I was like, 'I love myself,'" Lopez said.

But, she later came to realize there was a deeper meaning to loving yourself.

"But obviously I was doing all these things in like my per-

sonal relationships that didn't seem like I was loving myself, but I didn't even understand the concept of it," she admitted. "It took time and it's a journey and it's still a journey for me."

It's unclear which "past relationships" she was referring to, but Lopez was 34 when she married singer Marc Anthony in 2004. The pair -- they share 12-year-old twins Max and Emme -- split in 2011 and finalized their divorce three years later.

The star is now engaged to former baseball pro Alex Rodriguez. They were set to marry in 2020 but delayed their nuptials in response to the coronavirus pandemic.

Lopez previously spoke to W

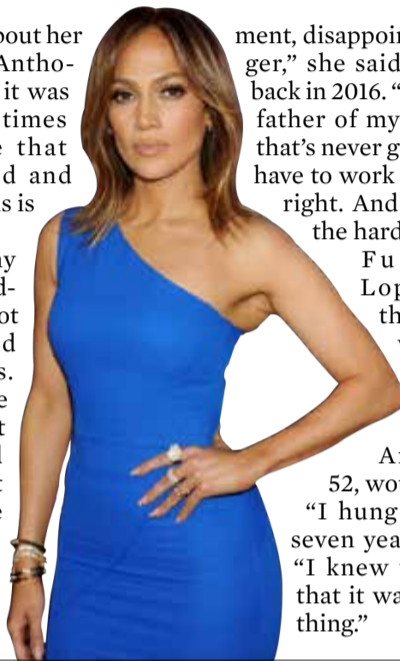
Magazine about her split from Anthony and said it was one of the times in her life that she stopped and thought "this is too hard."

"When my marriage ended, it was not easy to find forgiveness. It wasn't the dream that I had hoped for, and it would have been easier to fan the flames of resent-

ment, disappointment and anger," she said, per E! News back in 2016. "But Marc is the father of my children, and that's never going away. So, I have to work to make things right. And that is, by far, the hardest work I do."

Furthermore, Lopez admitted that though she was married for many years, she knew her marriage to Anthony, now 52, wouldn't last.

"I hung in there for seven years," she said. "I knew very quickly that it wasn't the right thing."

American actor George Clooney and Michelle Pfeiffer discussed their time on the sets of 'One Fine Day' while appearing on Variety's 'Entertainers on Actors' show.

The pair featured in the 1996 flick as outsiders who had a frenzied experience in New York City.

"It's been for such a long time. I don't think I've seen you since the debut of 'One Fine Day,'" Pfeiffer said.

Joking over the same, Clooney declared that it was Pfeiffer's "plan" from the start to avoid him for more than twenty years. The 'Painful Cruelty' star at that point opened up about arriving at work to film the movie after gulping down several drinks.

Adele reaches divorce settlement with Simon Konecki

Singer Adele on Friday finalised her divorce settlement with estranged husband Simon Konecki.

Simon, who is the CEO of Adele Drop4Drop charity, filed for settlement along with Adele on Thursday. The settlement of \$171 million got finalised a day later.

Although Adele and Simon have finished their work to finalise the divorce, the marriage won't officially end without the judge's approval, reports US Weekly.

Adele and Simon will share the custody of their eight-year-old son Angelo. "Financial and other confidential business information" about the proceed-

ings will not be made public.

The two were last seen together as a couple at an Elton John concert in the city shortly before they announced their separation last year.

Adele began dating Simon in 2011, and in October 2012 they welcomed their son Angelo. They got married in 2016. The couple announced that they were headed for a split in April 2019. The singer filed court documents five months after the news of their split became public.

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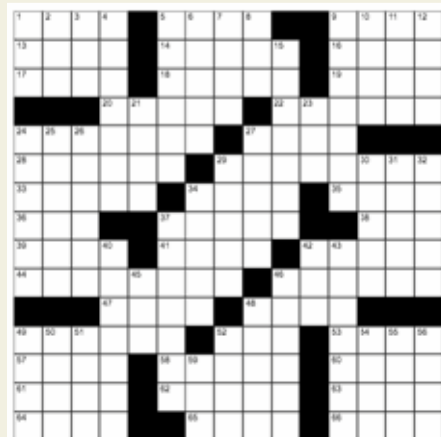
