Sovereignty

Cleaner future

Ban on single-use plastic bags under 57 microns

Single-use plastic carrier bags thinner than 57 microns will be barred from manufacture, import and sale under a new Ministry of Industry and Commerce decision published in the latest edition of the Official Gazette.

Decision No. 7 of 2026 bans any one-time-use bag made of plastic, or containing plastic, that falls below the threshold.

It applies to carry and hand-transport bags used for goods and equipment, with or without handles.

The rule covers bags handed to shoppers at points of sale as well as those sold on their own or in packs.

Categories

Three categories are exempt: bags used for household rubbish and hazardous healthcare waste, packaging bags pre-filled with food, and bags made for export. The ministry's standards and

metrology directorate must also produce an advisory guide, in coordination with the executive body of the Supreme Council for

Environment, describing the bag types covered and the design and use rules.

The guide will be updated from time to time.

Penalties

Anyone who breaches the decision faces the penalties laid down in Law No. 9 of 2016 on Standards and Metrology, without prejudice to harsher penalties under other laws.

The new decision repeals Decision No. 14 of 2022, which had banned single-use plastic bags thinner than 35 microns.

The ban takes effect six months after publication in the Official Gazette, with the undersecretary and relevant authorities tasked with implementation.

Housing relief

MPs seek urgent change to Mazaya loan instalment formula

Five MPs have lodged an urgent proposal calling for monthly instalments under the Mazaya housing programme to be worked out using only basic pay and the social allowance, excluding other allowances and bonuses.

In the memo, the MPs say instalments are now calculated on total salary, including allowances and bonuses, and that this can leave some beneficiaries with repayments above what they

can keep up with on a reliable basis.

They argue that basing instalments on basic pay plus the social allowance would better match repayments to income that does not change month to month, easing pressure on household budgets.

Calculations

The memo says the change would support fairer instalment calculations, help strengthen financial and social stability for Bahraini families on the scheme, and lower the risk of missed

payments by making repayment more manageable for beneficiaries and financing bodies.

The proposal was submitted by MPs Khaled Buanaq, Zainab AbdulAmeer, Ahmed Al Salloom, Hisham Al Awadhi and Mohammed Al Maarafi.

The MPs say the adjustment does not need a legal overhaul and could be made through an administrative direction resetting the basis used to calculate instalments, arguing that urgent action is needed to curb rising burdens on beneficiaries and to support the programme's goals.

Domestic worker wage hike 'voluntary'

● From \$400 to \$500

The increase in wages for domestic workers from the Philippines - from \$400 to \$500 - is entirely voluntary and is at the discretion of the employer.

This was emphasised by the

Bahrain Recruitment Offices Association.

In an official statement, the association noted that some recruitment offices have raised wages without any mandatory directive, stressing that the right of choice belongs to the citizen, who bears the financial responsibility.

No office is permitted to unilaterally impose a wage increase

that the employer has not approved.

The association criticised offices that have generally adopted the \$500 wage as mandatory, describing it as a violation of the official circular and an infringement on the employer's right to choose.

It also highlighted that the official stance of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries, as

expressed in ministerial meetings, rejects converting this increase into a universal obligation.

Any individual action contrary to this unified approach is considered unacceptable. The association reiterated that the standard wage remains \$400, and any increase to \$500 is a personal decision agreed upon by both the employer and the worker.

24 illegal workers detained, 81 other violators deported

Twenty-four violating and irregular workers were detained and 81 other violators deported following 1,514 inspection campaigns and field visits conducted by the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) between 15 and 21 February 2026.

The inspection campaigns and visits also resulted in monitoring a number of violations related to the provisions of a number of regulating laws, especially the Labour Market Regulatory Authority and the Residency Laws in the Kingdom of Bahrain, noting that legal measures were taken regarding the observed violations.

Inspection visits

The Authority pointed out that 1,476 inspection visits were carried out on various shops in all governorates, in addition to 38 joint inspection campaigns, 10 campaigns in the Capital Governorate, 11 campaigns in the Muharraq Governorate, 9 campaigns in the Northern Governorate, and 8 campaigns in the Southern Governorate.

The Authority affirmed the continuation of joint coordination with government agencies to intensify inspection campaigns in all governorates of the Kingdom, and to address any violations or practices that negatively affect the stability and competitiveness of the labour market or harm economic, and social security of the Kingdom.

Trump threatens countries that would 'play games' with tariffs

President Donald Trump threatened nations yesterday with punishing hikes on import duties if they choose to "play games" after the US Supreme Court struck down his global tariffs last week.

"Any Country that wants to 'play games' with the ridiculous supreme court decision, especially those that have 'Ripped Off' the U.S.A. for years, and even decades,

will be met with a much higher Tariff, and worse, than that which they just recently agreed to," Trump wrote on social media.

The high court's decision has dealt a sharp blow to Trump's economic agenda, of which tariffs -- and his ability to impose them rapidly -- have been a key feature.

For now, US Trade Representative Jamieens Greer has said that he expects partners to "stand by" the tariff deals they

have struck with Washington.

After Supreme Court ruled against Trump's country-specific tariffs last week, saying he exceeded his authority in tapping emergency economic powers to impose them, the US leader turned to a separate law to announce new 15-percent duties on imports.

Trump insisted in a separate Truth Social post Monday that "as President, I do not have to go back to Congress to get approval of tariffs."

SICO reports BD 5.5 m Net Profit

For the Year Ended 31 December 2025

SICO BSC (c), licensed as a conventional wholesale bank by the Central Bank of Bahrain "CBB", announced yesterday its consolidated results for the fourth quarter and year ended 31 December 2025.

For the quarter, SICO's recorded a consolidated net profit attributable to shareholders of BD 0.43 million (USD 1.1 million) compared to BD 0.29 million (USD 0.8 million) in the last quarter of the previous year, a 46% year-on-year rise. The increase was mainly driven by higher investment related income and brokerage & other income. Earnings per share (EPS) were 1.04 Bahraini fils in the fourth quarter of 2025 versus 0.72 Bahraini fils in the same period last year. SICO reported total comprehensive loss for the quarter of BD 27 thousand (USD 72 thousand) for the fourth quarter of 2025, compared to a total comprehensive income of BD 0.14 million (USD 0.38 million) reported in the same quarter of last year.

Total operating income for the fourth quarter of 2025 stood at BD 5.3 million (USD 14.1 million) compared to BD 5.0 million (USD 13.2 million) achieved in the same period of the previous year, reflecting an increase of

7%.

For the full year, SICO reported BD 5.5 million (USD 14.6 million) in consolidated net profit attributable to shareholders, unchanged from the last year. EPS stood at 13.49 Bahraini fils for 2025 compared to 13.48 Bahraini fils for 2024. SICO reported total comprehensive income attributable to shareholders of BD 5.4 million (USD 14.2 million) for the full year 2025, a 6% decrease from BD 5.7 million (USD 15.1 million) recorded in 2024.

Total operating income saw an increase of 6%, which grew from BD 21.6 million (USD 57.2 million) in 2024 to BD 22.9 million (USD 60.7 million) in 2025.

SICO's net investment income for the year grew 40% to BD 4.2 million (USD 11.2 million) compared to BD 3.0 million

(USD 8.0 million) in 2024. Net fee income witnessed a marginal growth in 2025 and stood at BD 11.0 million (USD 29.1 million) compared to BD 10.8 million (USD 28.8 million) recorded in 2024. Meanwhile net interest income saw a 6% increase to BD 4.2 million (USD 11.1 million) from BD 3.9 million (USD 10.5 million) in 2024. Finally, brokerage and other income came in at BD 3.5 million (USD 9.4 million) for the year, a 6% decline from the BD 3.8 million (USD 10.0 million) recorded in 2024, primarily due to the market conditions that led to lower brokerage activities in the regional markets.

Total equity attributable to shareholders increased to BD 76.1 million (USD 201.8 million) as of 31 December 2025, a 2.8%

rise from BD 74.0 million (USD 196.2 million) at the end of 2024. Total assets increased by 45% to BD 595.4 million (USD 1.6 billion) compared to BD 411.2 million (USD 1.1 billion) at year-end 2024.

Dividend

Board of Directors has recommended a dividend of 7.5% of the eligible share capital, aggregating to BD 3.2 million (USD 8.5 million), subject to the approval of the Central Bank of Bahrain (CBB) and the General Assembly.

Chairman of the Board of SICO, Mr. Abdulla Kamal, commented on SICO's full year performance, saying, "SICO's performance in 2025 is a testament to the resilience of our diversified business model and our ability to navigate a year characterized by regional and global market shifts. ◆ **Australian Prime Minister** Anthony Albanese yesterday backed calls to remove Andrew from the royal line of succession amid investigations into the disgraced former prince's ties with Jeffrey Epstein. In a letter to UK counterpart Keir Starmer, Albanese said: "My Government would agree to any proposal to remove him from the line of royal succession". "These are grave allegations and Australians take them seriously," Albanese added. Starmer's official spokesman confirmed the UK government had received Albanese's letter. "We're considering whether further steps are required in relation to Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor and we're not ruling anything out, but given the ongoing police investigation, it wouldn't be appropriate for the government to comment further at this stage," he told reporters.

US forces to complete withdrawal from Syria within a month

◆ **US forces** that led the coalition against the Islamic State group will complete their withdrawal from Syria within a month, three sources said yesterday, as they began leaving a major base. The withdrawal comes as Syria's government expanded its control to the country's northeast, previously controlled by US-allied Kurdish forces, and formally joined the coalition against IS. American forces have already withdrawn from two other bases in the past two weeks, Al-Tanf in the southeast and Shadadi in the northeast. "Within a month, they will have withdrawn from Syria and there will no longer be any military presence in the bases," a Syrian government official said, with a Kurdish source confirming the timeline.

◆ **European Union lawmakers** yesterday put a key trade deal with the United States on hold, demanding clarity after a Supreme Court ruling struck down many of President Donald Trump's tariffs. The move came as Trump warned that countries seeking to "play games" with tariffs risked much higher duties. Uncertainty has gripped markets since the Supreme Court ruled Friday that Trump does not have the authority to impose tariffs under a 1977 law he has relied on -- to which Trump responded by imposing a new 15 percent global duty on a different legal basis. That new threat raised worries in Brussels over its implications for the US trade deal struck last July, since European officials and lawmakers say EU goods could face higher duties than under the terms of the agreement.

BBC apologises for 'involuntary' Tourette's racial slur during BAFTA awards

The BBC apologised yesterday for not editing out a racial slur during the BAFTA awards, saying it was an "involuntary" verbal tic by a Tourette's sufferer who inspired a winning film.

British actor Robert Aramayo triumphed over established stars Timothee Chalamet and Leonardo DiCaprio to win the best actor prize for his portrayal of a man with Tourette's syndrome in "I Swear".

The film was inspired by the real life story of Tourette's campaigner John Davidson whose life has been irrevocably changed by the condition.

Davidson shouted the N-word as "Sinners" actors Delroy Lindo and Michael B Jordan, who are both black, presented the award for special visual effects.

Actor Alan Cumming, the ceremony's host, apologised for the language viewers may have heard during the broadcast.

But the BBC did not edit the offending language out of its broadcast which was shown on a two-hour delay on Sunday evening. It was edited out of the version on the BBC's streaming service on Monday morning.

"Some viewers may have heard strong and offensive language during the Bafta Film Awards," a BBC spokesperson said.

"This arose from involun-

tary verbal tics associated with Tourette syndrome, and as explained during the ceremony it was not intentional.

"We apologise that this was not edited out prior to broadcast and it will now be removed from the version on BBC iPlayer."

A spokesperson for the charity Tourettes Action said it "deeply" understood the offence and harm caused by racial slurs.

But they said it was "vital that the public understands a fundamental truth about Tourette syndrome -- tics are involuntary. They are not a reflection of a person's beliefs, intentions or character.

"People with Tourette's can say words or phrases they do not mean, do not endorse and feel great distress about afterwards," the spokesperson added.

The charity added it was "incredibly proud" of Davidson and others involved in the film.

Israeli minister says **army to occupy Gaza** if Hamas does not disarm

Peace plan also calls for a 20,000-strong peacekeeping force

Israeli far-right Finance Minister Bezalel Smotrich said yesterday that Palestinian Islamist group Hamas may soon be given a deadline to lay down its weapons.

"We estimate that in the coming days, Hamas will be given an ultimatum to disarm and completely demilitarise Gaza," Smotrich said in an interview with public broadcaster Kan.

"If it does not comply with it, the IDF (Israeli army) will have international legitimacy and American backing to do it itself, and the IDF is already preparing for this and is making plans," said the minister, who is a member of Israel's security cabinet charged with approving large-scale military operations.

Under the first phase of a

US-sponsored ceasefire in Gaza that halted two years of fighting between Israel and Hamas, the Israeli army withdrew to positions behind a so-called Yellow Line, but still controls over half of the territory.

The second phase that officially began last month plans for a gradual withdrawal of the Israeli army and the disarmament of Hamas, which the militant group has vehemently opposed.

"The (Israeli military) will definitely enter and occupy Gaza if Hamas does not disband," Smotrich said.

Asked how the military would do this, he said "there are two or three alternatives right now that we are examining".

The peace plan put forward by US President Donald Trump also calls for the establishment of a 20,000-strong peacekeeping force, called the International

Stabilisation Force (ISF), to which several countries have committed troops. Asked how the Israeli army would operate against Hamas when foreign soldiers are deployed on the ground, Smotrich said the latter would "pull out very quickly and allow the (Israeli military) to enter. This is coordinated with the Americans."

"By the way, I don't yet see them going in that fast," he added of the ISF.



Philippines' Duterte authorised murders

ICC hearings open

Rodrigo Duterte personally authorised murders and hand-picked some of the victims of his "war on drugs", the International Criminal Court heard yesterday, as proceedings against the former Philippines president kicked off.

ICC deputy prosecutor Mame Mandiaye Niang said that the week-long "confirmation of charges" hearings, where judges will decide whether to open a full trial against Duterte, was "a reminder that those in power are not above the law".

The 80-year-old Duterte did not appear after the court granted a defence request for his absence, despite judges ruling he was fit to take part.

Following the hearings, the judges will have 60 days to issue a written decision on whether he should face a full trial.

Niang said Duterte played a "pivotal" role in the extrajudicial killings of suspected drug dealers and users, first as mayor of Davao City then as president.

He "authorised murders and personally selected some of the victims", said Niang. Duterte's defence lawyer Nicholas Kaufman hit back, calling the charges "grievously misplaced and politically motivated."

Duterte "stands behind his legacy resolutely. He maintains his innocence absolutely," said Kaufman.

Kaufman acknowledged that his client was "a unique phenomenon" who was "gung-ho in his ways" and full of "hyperbole, bluster and rhetoric."

However, he accused the prosecution of "cherry-picking" through Duterte's speeches, adding that many of them insist on the importance of sticking to the law.

Rival groups of demonstrators camped outside the court from early Monday. Patricia Enriquez, a 36-year-old researcher, said it was a "historic moment" for victims of Duterte's alleged crimes.

"It is emotional. It is hopeful. It is also very painful," she told AFP.

"I'm hoping that all the Filipinos and everybody in the world will stand with us, stand with truth, stand with justice and stand with accountability."

However, 35-year-old chef Aldo Villarta said it was a "slap in the face" for the Philippines that an international court was trying the country's former leader.

"We've already suffered so long from colonisation," said Villarta, who also argued that Duterte's human rights were being infringed by im-

prisonment. 'High value targets'

Duterte faces three counts of crimes against humanity, with prosecutors alleging his involvement in at least 76 murders between 2013 and 2018.

The true number of killings during his campaign in the Philippines is thought to be in the thousands, and lawyers for the victims have argued that a full trial could encourage more families to come forward.

Niang said the murders charges were "merely a fraction" of the real numbers killed.

Duterte, who was president from 2016 to 2022, was arrested in Manila in March last year, flown to the Netherlands and has since been held at the ICC's detention unit at Scheveningen Prison.

He followed his initial hearing three days later by video link, appearing dazed and frail and barely speaking.

The first of three counts against Duterte concerns his alleged involvement as a co-perpetrator in 19 murders carried out between 2013 and 2016 while he was mayor of Davao City.

The second relates to 14 murders of so-called "High Value Targets" in 2016 and 2017 when he was president.

The third charge covers 43 murders committed during "clearance" operations of lower-level alleged drug users or pushers across the Philippines between 2016 and 2018.

In Manila, about 60 relatives of those killed in the crackdown gathered around two television monitors to watch the hearing at a Catholic Church-run community centre for the poor.

The mainly elderly and middle-aged women whose husbands or sons were shot dead in police operations told AFP they were disappointed Duterte had not been required to appear.

"Maybe he does not want to own up to his sins," said Gloria Sarmiento, whose boyfriend was found dead alongside his brother in the last few weeks of the Duterte presidency.

"Maybe he is a coward."

A – Accessible and Inclusive: AI should not be a monopoly.

V – Valid and Legitimate: AI must adhere to laws and be verifiable.

MANAV, which means 'human', offers principles that anchor AI in human values in the 21st century.

Trust is the foundation upon which AI's future rests. As generative systems flood the world with content, democratic societies face risks from deepfakes and disinformation. Just as food carries nutrition labels, digital content must carry authenticity labels. I urge the global community to come together to create shared standards for watermarking and source verification. India has already taken a step in this direction by legally requiring clear labelling of synthetically generated content.

The welfare of our children is a matter close to our hearts. AI systems must be built with safeguards that encourage responsible, family-guided engagement, reflecting the same care we bring to education systems worldwide.

Technology yields its greatest benefit when shared, rather than guarded as a strategic asset. Open platforms can help millions of youth contribute to making technology safer and more human-centric. This collective intelligence is humanity's greatest strength. AI must evolve as a global common good.

We are entering an era where humans and intelligent systems will co-create, co-work and co-evolve. Entirely new professions will emerge. When the internet began, no one could imagine the possibilities. It ended up creating a huge number of new opportunities and so will AI. I am confident that our empowered youth will be the true drivers of the AI age.

We are encouraging skilling, reskilling and lifelong learning by running some of the largest and most diverse skilling programmes in the world. India is home to one of the world's largest youth populations and technology talent. With our energy capacity and policy clarity, we are uniquely positioned to harness AI's full potential.

At this Summit, I was proud to see Indian companies launch indigenous AI models and applications, reflecting the technological depth of our young innovation community.





Ramadan Recipe

Yogurt Rice

Total Time: 1 hr
Yield: 2

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup uncooked medium-grain white rice (such as Bomba) or 2 cups cooked medium-grain white rice
- 1 1/2 cups water
- 1/2 cup plain whole-milk yogurt
- 1/4 cup whole milk
- Kosher salt, to taste
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 2 teaspoons dried split white urad dal
- 1/2 teaspoon brown mustard seeds
- 2 small dried whole red chil-

- es (such as chiles de árbol)
- 12 small fresh curry leaves (optional)

Step 1

If using cooked rice, skip step 1, and proceed to step 2.) Place uncooked rice in a small colander. Rinse under cold water, using your fingers to move rice around in colander, until water runs clear, about 1 minute. Drain well. Transfer rice to a small saucepan, and add 1 1/2 cups



water; bring to a boil over high. Stir once; cover and reduce heat to low. Gently simmer until water is absorbed, about 15 minutes. Remove

from heat; let stand, covered, 10 minutes. Spread rice evenly on a rimmed baking sheet; let cool to just slightly warmer than room temperature, about 20 minutes.

Step 2

Divide rice evenly between 2 shallow bowls. Add 1/4 cup yogurt and 2 tablespoons milk to each bowl; gently stir until combined. Stir in salt to taste, and set aside.

Step 3

Heat oil in small saucepan over medium until shimmering, about 3 minutes. Add urad dal and mustard seeds; cook, stirring constantly, 15 seconds (mixture will sizzle). Add chiles and, if using, curry leaves; cook, stirring constantly, until dal turns light brown and curry leaves become almost translucent, about 45 seconds. Immediately pour hot mixture (tadka) evenly over prepared yogurt rice.

India battle for World Cup survival after 'messaging up on grand scale'

Defending T20 World Cup champions India need "two big performances" to reach the semi-finals after Sunday's huge defeat to South Africa, said their assistant coach.

India came into the T20 World Cup as hot favourites on home soil but were thrashed by 76 runs in the Super Eights as 80,000 fans at the massive Narendra Modi stadium were stunned into silence.

In their first phase of the tournament, India's batting came up woefully short in the face of some disciplined South Africa bowling.

India collapsed to 111 all out in 18.5 overs in response to South Africa's 187-7 as their 12-match win streak in the T20 World Cup came to a crashing end.

The magnitude of the defeat has left India with a desperate net run-rate of -3.8 and likely needing to win their last two Super Eight matches convincingly to make it to the semi-finals.

Anything less and India will need to rely on a combination of other results going their way.

"Very disappointed in the performance," said Ryan ten Doeschate.

"When you set out to win a World Cup, don't expect someone to come and deliver it to you halfway through," the assistant coach added.

"We've messed up on a grand scale and now the onus is on this group of guys to turn it around and put in two solid performances."

India are grouped with South Africa, the West Indies and Zimbabwe in Super Eights, with the top two advancing to the semi-finals.

The West Indies faced Zimbabwe yesterday night in Mumbai in their Super Eights opener.

India next face giant-killers Zimbabwe, who have already beaten Australia and Sri Lanka, on Thursday in Chennai.

South Africa play the West Indies the same day in Ahmedabad where Aiden Markram's side could put one foot firmly in the semi-finals with another win.

'Cloak came off'

"Obviously with the way the group goes, you need at least four points to get through now, and it's going to need two big performances and a big bounce back from everyone," said Ten Doeschate.

India's fragile batting was exposed against an in-form bowling attack led by left-arm quick Marco Jansen, who returned figures of 4-22 from 3.5 overs. Keshav Maharaj took 3-24 with his left-arm spin.

India's media tore into the team on yesterday morning.

"The night the cloak came off," blazed a headline in the Indian Express newspaper.

"Sloppy India reach point of no return," said the Hindustan Times.

India's ultra-aggressive left-handed opening pair have failed to fire, leaving a shaky middle order to pick up the pieces.

Ishan Kishan was out without scoring to Markram on Sunday, while the world's top-ranked T20 batter Abhishek Sharma fell to Jansen for 15, his only runs of the tournament so far after three ducks.

"It's certainly not panic sta-

tions," said Ten Doeschate, who hinted there could be discussions about India's batting line-up.

"If those guys (Abhishek and Ishan) bat for six overs, the score is going to be 70-plus," said Ten Doeschate.

"So can we get them to temper the way they're playing and be a little bit smarter?"

"Or do we just let them go on the way they are?"

"Or do we bring in a right-hander at the top and make a change somewhere in the middle?"

Captain Suryakumar Yadav agreed India need to use their brains in the first six-over power play when only two fielders are allowed on the boundary.

"Chasing 180-185, you can't win the game in the power play, but you might lose it," he said after his side stumbled to 31-3 after six overs, which became 43-4 a few balls later and then 51-5.

"We lost too many wickets in the power play."

The 2024 champions also have the weight of history against them. No team has ever retained the T20 World Cup and no side have ever won the trophy on home soil.
