The Cabinet congratulated the State of Kuwait, its Amir, government, and people on Kuwait's National Day and Liberation Day, emphasising Kuwait's accomplishments across various sectors.

Sovereignty

It stressed the full sovereignty of Kuwait over its maritime areas and maritime elevations and expressed its categorical rejection of any claims by other parties to sovereignty over them.

The Cabinet urged the Republic of Iraq to take into consideration the course of historical relations between Kuwait and Iraq and their peoples, and to act responsibly in accordance with the rules and principles of international law, particularly the provisions of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea of 1982, in a manner consistent with the understandings, agreements, and bilateral memoranda of understanding between the two countries.
