### Rare knee surgery performed at Royal Bahrain Hospital successfully TDT | Manama

When Saleh, age 38, walked into the office of Dr Gianluca Cusma Guatteri, Consultant-Orthopedics at the Royal Bahrain Hospital, with severe knee arthritis secondary to congenital deformity, only one thing surfaced his mind - will I be able to walk freely without any pain?

For a condition like this, a normal approach would be total knee replacement, explained D Gianluca, considering the ultimate aim of the surgery would be to realign the limb.

"However, we evaluated the possibility of partial knee replacement and were weighing our chances should Hazem was to pursue the same. Which he ultimately did," he said.


