China's Xi visits Tibet for first time as president

President Xi Jinping is on a rare trip to China's politically sensitive region of Tibet, state media reported yesterday, the first such visit by the country's top leader in more than three decades.

Tibet has alternated over the centuries between independence and control by China, which says it "peacefully liberated" the rugged plateau in 1951 and brought infrastructure and education to the previously underdeveloped region.

In footage released yesterday by state broadcaster CCTV, Xi was seen greeting a crowd wearing ethnic costumes and waving Chinese flags as he left his plane, in a red carpet welcome as dancers performed around him.
