



Shared goals, joint growth

Bahrain and Lebanon pledge to deepen trade, investment and cultural cooperation

- **HM King Hamad and President Aoun hold fruitful discussions**
- **Lebanese leader departs Kingdom**

His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and Lebanese President Joseph Aoun agreed to broaden bilateral cooperation in trade, investment, education, tourism, and cultural exchange during talks held yesterday.

The meeting with HM King Hamad marked the Lebanese leader's official visit before his departure from the Kingdom yesterday.

They stressed the importance of fully activating existing agreements and memoranda of understanding, while boosting

coordination between public and private sectors to unlock new opportunities.

Emphasis was placed on increasing business delegations, expanding trade volume, and enhancing partnerships that benefit both countries' economies.

"Our cooperation must reflect the ambitions of our people," said HM the King. "By strength-

ening our economic and cultural ties, we open doors to shared prosperity."

Discussions also underscored the potential of people-to-people exchange, with both sides expressing commitment to deepen collaboration in education, health, and tourism.

The goal, they noted, is to foster mutual understanding

and build sustainable long-term partnerships rooted in trust and shared values.

Private sector

HM King Hamad and President Aoun highlighted the vital role of the private sector in driving innovation and investment.

They agreed to explore new channels for joint ventures and

encourage greater participation from entrepreneurs and business leaders across sectors.

On regional issues, the two leaders reviewed ongoing developments and reaffirmed their shared belief in diplomacy and dialogue as the path to peace.

They expressed concern over rising instability in parts of the Middle East and pledged joint

efforts to combat extremism and prevent terrorist financing.

His Majesty reiterated Bahrain's support for Lebanon's sovereignty and stability, emphasizing non-interference in internal affairs and the importance of safeguarding Lebanon's unique social and religious fabric.

"The Kingdom of Bahrain will always support Lebanon's efforts to achieve unity and economic reform," His Majesty said. "We believe in Lebanon's ability to overcome challenges and reclaim its vital role in the Arab world."

They also addressed security cooperation, particularly Lebanon's commitment to maintaining its ceasefire with Israel and fully implementing UN Security Council Resolution 1701.

HM the King stressed the importance of extending state authority across all Lebanese territory and ensuring arms remain in the hands of official security forces.

President Aoun visits Bahrain EDB and explores investment opportunities

Lebanese President Joseph Aoun visited the Bahrain Economic Development Board (EDB) in Bahrain Bay during his official visit to the Kingdom yesterday, underscoring growing economic ties between Bahrain and Lebanon.

President Aoun and his delegation were welcomed by Minister of Finance and National Economy, His Excellency Shaikh Salman bin Khalifa Al Khalifa, and Minister of Foreign Affairs, H.E. Dr. Abdullahif bin Rashid Al Zayani.

The visit focused on Bahrain's ongoing efforts to diversify its economy, attract foreign investment, and position itself as a regional gateway.

President Aoun was briefed on Bahrain's government work mechanism, the Kingdom's economic performance, and its achievements in sustainable growth and economic transformation.

Economic landscape

Shaikh Salman described the visit as an opportunity to gain firsthand insight into Bahrain's evolving economic landscape under the leadership of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and the guidance of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

He outlined the strategic plans led by the EDB to support national economic goals and foster long-term growth.

President Aoun expressed admiration for Bahrain's economic resilience and forward-looking

vision, emphasising the potential for future collaboration between the two countries' private sectors.

H.E. Noor bint Ali Alkhulaif, Minister of Sustainable Development and Chief Executive of the EDB, presented an overview of the EDB's role in attracting



global investors.

She highlighted Bahrain's competitive advantages, such as ease of doing business, skilled workforce, and modern infrastructure.

The Minister also noted the EDB's ongoing efforts to support

company formation, expansion, and investor success.

Exports

Bahrain's exports to Lebanon crossed the \$5.5 million mark in the first four months of 2025, extending a stretch of steady

trade growth between the two countries.

By the end of April, shipments from Bahrain to the Lebanese market reached \$5,517,000, according to data from the Information and eGovernment Authority.

This followed a total of \$11.86

million in non-oil exports to Lebanon during 2024.

Goods sent to Lebanon included cooked and processed cheeses, powdered mixes used for table cream, cardboard boxes, scented paper bags, aluminium trays, foil rolls, and wire.

The mix of exports points to a wider base of production within Bahrain's non-oil sector, with a growing list of consumer and industrial items now finding a place in regional markets.

Lebanon remains one of them. Trade links between the two have held firm for years, and both sides appear to be building on that. Data suggests that Bahrain aims to push its products further into neighbouring markets while offering more space for its private firms to expand abroad.

Trade between the two countries is expected to keep climbing as both look to make conditions easier for business and investment.

Bahrain to host ChemSafe 25

Bahrain will host the International Conference and Exhibition on Chemical Safety (ChemSafe 2025) from 27 to 30 October 2025, under the theme "Industrial Chemistry for a Safe and Sustainable Future".

Organised by the Bahraini Chemists Society and Al Mashreq Training, in cooperation with the Ministry of Oil and Environment, the event is expected to attract wide international participation from experts and decision-makers in the fields of chemical safety and industrial process safety.

His Excellency Dr. Mohammed bin Mubarak Bin Dainah, Minister of Oil and Environment and Special Envoy for Climate Affairs, highlighted that Bahrain's hosting of this global event underscores its ongoing efforts to strengthen chemical safety practices and minimise industrial and environmental risks.

Company ordered to pay BD13,597 to former partner over unpaid profits

A commercial company has been ordered to pay BD13,597 to a former business partner following a civil court ruling over unpaid profits and an unpaid board allowance.

The High Civil Court found that the claimant, once a partner alongside the second and third defendants, had not received his share of company profits from 2019 through 2023.

Financial records, signed off and accepted in court, showed the firm had made money dur-



ing those years.

Lawyer Sarah Fouad Atiq, acting on behalf of the claimant, told the court that a monthly allowance had also been agreed upon by the board for each partner.

Her client, she argued, had been left out of those payments.

Expert financial reports presented during the hearings confirmed the company had turned a profit.

Money

The court also noted that money had been moved to another firm, which, in its view, disrupted the proper distribution of earnings.

On that basis, the court ruled that the claimant was owed BD13,597. The company was also ordered to cover court charges, legal fees, and the cost of expert reports.

Two jailed over indecent social media posts

● Six months behind bars, fined BD200

Two social media users have each been handed six-month prison sentences and fined BD200 after a court found them guilty of spreading indecent content to thousands of followers.

The ruling, issued by the Third Minor Criminal Court, also ordered the confiscation of the mobile phones used to commit the offences. One defendant was cleared of an additional charge of inciting prostitution.

The Public Prosecution had received two separate reports from the Cyber Crime Directorate, concerning public accounts posting material deemed offensive to public morals and in breach of the law.

Once the suspects were identified, arrest warrants were issued.

During questioning, both admitted to the charges. They were held in custody and referred to the criminal court.

Shocking act of ‘animal cruelty’

Public outrage erupts after teen filmed hurling kitten against wall in Muharraq

● Incident prompts police complaint and demand swift justice

A teenager was filmed throwing a kitten against the walls of a residential building in Muharraq, in a video that has drawn widespread public anger and triggered a police complaint by the Bahrain Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals. The video, shared widely online, shows the young cat being hurled repeatedly inside the stairwell of what appears to be a block of flats. The teenager, whose identity remains unknown, is seen striking the animal without any visible provocation. The Society responded by lodging a formal complaint with



The disturbing footage shows the teenager abusing the kitten the police in Muharraq, urging an urgent investigation and calling for action to be taken against the boy shown in the footage. Chairman Mahmood Faraj said the video documented clear abuse and called for the law to be applied in full, regardless of the boy's age. **Basic decency** "What we saw goes against the grain of basic decency," he said. "There must be consequences. Without that, there is every chance we'll see more of the same." He also warned against brushing such behaviour aside. "Turning away sends a message. And it's the wrong one," he added. Calls for legal action were echoed by users on social media, many of whom posted messages of outrage beneath copies of the

The two-day event, held across Vienna and Geneva, focused on deepening understanding of the international regulatory framework governing satellite operations — from pre-launch radio frequency coordination to post-launch registration with the United Nations in accordance with international space treaties. His Excellency Dr. Mohamed Ibrahim Al-Asiri, CEO of



the Bahrain Space Agency, emphasized the significance of the workshop. “The sessions addressed critical areas of the space industry,” he said. “They covered satellite frequency registration with the ITU, spectrum and orbit resource management, and legal obligations related to space object registration under UN treaties.”

A dressmaking training course for Filipinos was held at the Majestic Hotel in Bahrain. It was the sixth batch of the Pinay Ikaw Na (PIN) dressmaking training program, in collaboration with the Philippine Embassy, Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA), and Migrant Workers Office (MWO). Participants showed their technical skills and creative abilities as they proudly presented their inaugural project, a balloon skirt, during their third challenging training exercise. Having become proficient in the skirt expose technique, the participants progressed to pattern making and cutting square pants, a more complicated garment design. The exercise highlighted not only the technological skill of the future designers but also their own personal creative interpretation of current trends. The seven-Friday training course is designed to embrace students with progressive learning. Following the introductory third week, which is devoted to theory of dressmaking then basic pattern making and cutting, the course advances towards the making of various simple dresses. The last learning phase will be the designing and making of their graduation gowns, a Filipiniana or a Maria Clara traditional fashion gown, as evidence that they are masters in learning the skill sets as they go through.

Tokyo surged over 3% after the US president announced a deal lowering tariffs on some Japanese goods to 15%, down from the threatened 25%.

The deal will also reduce tolls

on autos -- a sector accounting for eight% of Japanese jobs -- to 15%, compared with 25% for other countries.

In return, Japan pledged to invest \$550 billion in the United States, Trump said on social media.

Shares in carmaker Toyota rocketed higher by more than 14%, Mitsubishi 13% and Nissan 8%.

European carmakers also rallied, with Stellantis jumping more than six% in Paris.

Mercedes Benz, Porsche and Volkswagen all rose more than five%, while BMW climbed by more than 4%.

The deal is providing optimism that other countries can "seal good deals if they pledge investment into the US," said Kathleen Brooks, research director at trading group XTB.

Trump also hailed an agreement with Manila to lower levies on Philippine goods by one%age point to 19%, while tariffs on Indonesia were slashed from 32% to 19%.

Shares in Manila and Jakarta rallied.

The announcements boosted hopes of other deals before next Friday's deadline, though talks with the European Union and South Korea remain elusive.

The EU's top trade negotiator will speak to US Commerce Secretary Howard Lutnick later on Wednesday, but the EU has retaliatory tariffs worth over \$100 billion tied up no deal is reached and US tariffs go into force.

US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent will meet his Chinese counterparts in Stockholm next week, as a separate mid-August deadline approaches for levies on Chinese goods to snap back to steeper levels.

Saudi announces \$5 billion in Syria investments

Over 100 investors arrived in Damascus

- Trump lifted most sanctions against Syria in May
- Saudi Arabia and Qatar pledged to settle Syria's debt

A Saudi delegation visiting Damascus yesterday linked investment and partnership deals valued at \$5 billion to help rebuild war-battered Syria, the oil-rich Gulf kingdom announced. Saudi Arabia has been a major backer of the new Syrian gov-

ernment, which seized power after Islamist-led rebels toppled longtime ruler Bashar al-Assad in December following 14 years of civil war. The delegation of some 150 investors and representatives of the Saudi public and private sectors, led by Investment Minister Khalid Al-Falih, attended a forum in Damascus.

"The announced investments, valued at 19 billion Saudi riyals (about \$5 billion), span vital and strategic sectors, including real estate, infrastructure, communications and IT, transportation and logistics, industry, tourism, energy, trade" and more, a statement from the investment ministry said. On Tuesday, the ministry

had said the Damascus forum aimed to "explore cooperation opportunities and sign agreements that enhance sustainable development and serve the interests of the two brotherly peoples". Earlier this month, President Donald Trump formalised the dismantling of US sanctions on Syria, hoping to reintegrate the

country into the global economy. He had already lifted most of the measures in May, responding to appeals from Saudi Arabia and Turkey. The US president met Syria's interim leader Ahmed al-Sharaa during a visit to Saudi Arabia the same month. Sharaa, a former jihadist, had also paid a visit to Riyadh in

February in his first trip abroad since Assad's ouster. Earlier this year, Saudi Arabia and Qatar pledged to settle Syria's debt to the World Bank, totalling about \$15 million. Despite vows to unify the country, the new government in Damascus has struggled to maintain order, with deadly clashes involving minority groups raising questions about Syria's stability. Bloody violence in Sweida province earlier this month started with clashes between Druze fighters and Sunni Bedouin tribes but soon escalated, with Israel later intervening with air strikes targeting government installations. More than 1,300 people, mostly Druze, were estimated to have been killed during the fighting, according to the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights monitor.

UK seeks to curb Apple, Google's grip on mobile platforms

Britain's competition watchdog yesterday proposed measures to tackle Apple and Google's dominance in the mobile device market, as it looks to rein in the US tech giants' so-called duopoly.

The Competition and Markets Authority (CMA) said it proposes to designate Apple and Google's mobile platforms with "strategic market status (SMS)", subjecting them to special requirements under new UK regulations.

An investigation was launched in January into the companies' control over the mobile ecosystems, including operating systems, app stores and browsers.

The CMA described their dom-



inance as "an effective duopoly".

"Apple and Google's mobile platforms are both critical to the UK economy ... but our investigation so far has identified opportunities for more innovation and choice," CMA chief executive

Sarah Cardell said in a statement.

Google's spokesman

on competition, Oliver Bethell, said the announcement was "disappointing and unwarranted".

If approved, the SMS designation would allow the CMA to require Apple and Google to change how certain mobile services operate, with the aim of offering consumers greater choice.

The regulator stressed that the designation does not imply that these companies have acted anti-competitively.

The final decision is subject to consultation and expected by October 22.

A similar tech competition law from the European Union, the Digital Markets Act, carries the potential for hefty financial penalties.

The CMA in June proposed designating Google with SMS designation in the search engine market due to its dominant position.

China tariff deadline can be rolled forward 90 days: US Treasury

A deadline for tariffs between the United States and China to snap back to higher levels could be extended in a "90-day increment," US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent said Wednesday, ahead of trade talks next week.

Top officials from the world's two biggest economies are set to meet in Sweden on Monday and Tuesday, with Bessent in the US delegation and Chinese Vice Premier He Lifeng attending the talks.

"We're in a very good place with China now," Bessent told Bloomberg Television on Wednesday. He added that the upcoming talks would likely move beyond rare earths and

export controls, and "on to bigger discussions."

Asked about the August 12 deadline, when reduced tariff levels are due to bounce back to steeper levels, Bessent signaled openness to a significant extension.

"I think that we could roll it forward, maybe in a 90-day increment," he said in the interview.

"Both sides have de-escalated, and I think we can get into a very good cadence of regular meetings with them," he said.

Washington and Beijing had slapped escalating tariffs on each other's exports in April, reaching prohibitive triple-digit levels, but both sides reached an agreement to temporarily lower them after negotiations

in Geneva.

The truce, however, is set to expire in August.

Officials from the two countries also met in London in June.

On Wednesday, Bessent said he expected the upcoming discussions could include talks on Chinese purchases of Russian and Iranian oil, alongside security issues.

He said both countries would also discuss "purchasing agreements," especially on agriculture. Trade talks between the United States and China had initially stalled after their Geneva meeting, with Washington accusing Beijing of violating their pact and slow-walking export license approvals for rare earths.

Germany approves Eurofighter jet delivery to Turkey

Germany said yesterday it had approved the delivery of Eurofighter jets to Turkey, clearing the way for a deal that had been delayed by tensions between the two countries.

Turkey had been in talks for several years on buying 40 of the aircraft, which are constructed by a consortium from



Germany, Britain, Italy and Spain.

The Typhoon jets are to be built in Britain and London is leading the negotiations.

But all members of the consortium must sign off on the sale and Germany, which has clashed with Turkey over Israel's war on Gaza, had objected.

However, the defence ministry had now "sent a written confirmation to the Turkish

government confirming the approval of the export", government spokesman Stefan Kornelius told journalists in Berlin.

News outlet Der Spiegel reported that Chancellor Friedrich Merz had bowed to pressure from British Prime Minister Keir Starmer, as the project is expected to support about 20,000 jobs in Britain.

After Germany gave the green light to the sale, the Turkish and British defence ministers signed a preliminary agreement in Istanbul on Wednesday for the delivery of the jets.

Trump admin unveils AI strategy to maintain US dominance

The Trump administration on Wednesday unveiled an aggressive, low-regulation strategy boosting big tech's race to stay ahead of China on artificial intelligence and cement the United States' dominance in the fast-expanding field.

The 25-page "America's AI Action Plan" outlines three aims: accelerating innovation, building infrastructure, and leading interna-



tionally on AI.

Overall, the administration frames AI advancement as critical to maintaining economic and military supremacy. Environmental consequences in the planning document are sidelined.

"We believe we're in an AI race... and we want the

United States to win that race," said the White House's AI point person David Sacks in a call with reporters.

President Donald Trump was expected to announce the plan in a speech later Wednesday.

According to US media reports, Trump was also to announce a series of executive orders to give key components of the plan additional legal weight.

In its collection of more than 90 government proposals, the plan calls for sweeping deregulation, with the administration promising to "remove red tape and onerous regulation" that could hinder private sector AI development.

Much of that work has already been carried out through a Trump executive order repealing the AI policies of the Biden administration.

The Trump action plan also calls for AI systems to be "free from ideological bias" and designed to pursue objective truth rather than what the administration calls "social engineering agendas."

This criterion would apply to AI companies wanting to do business with the US government.

A senior White House official said the main target was AI models that gave attention to diversity and inclusion concerns

in programming their model output -- reflecting the Trump administration's anti-"woke" agenda.

A major focus in the plan involves building AI infrastructure, including streamlined permitting for data centers and energy facilities that would overlook environmental concerns in the name of building AI capability as swiftly as possible.

The administration, which largely rejects international science showing a growing climate crisis, proposes creating new environmental review exemptions for data center construction and expanding access to federal lands for AI infrastruc-

ture development.

Addressing fears that AI will replace humans and create mass job losses across entire sectors, the administration's plan says instead that "AI will improve the lives of Americans by complementing their work -- not replacing it."

The strategy calls for efforts to "counter Chinese influence in international governance bodies" and strengthen export controls on advanced AI computing technology.

The plan also proposes evaluating Chinese AI models "for alignment with Chinese Communist Party talking points and censorship."

News in brief

◆ The UK yesterday

sanctioned more than two dozen people, groups and suppliers accused of helping to smuggle migrants across the Channel, in the first such use of sanctions powers. The move comes as the UK government faces growing pressure to stem the migrant arrivals on small boats from northern France, as numbers hit record levels this year. The asset freezes and travel bans announced on Wednesday target individuals and entities “driving irregular migration to the UK”, the Foreign Office said. They include a small boat supplier in China, so-called “hawala” money movers in the Middle East, and gang leaders based in the Balkans and North Africa. Foreign Secretary David Lammy called it “a landmark moment in the government’s work to tackle organised immigration crime” linked to the UK.

◆ Donald Trump on Tuesday accused his predecessor Barack Obama of treason and called for his prosecution over a report alleging that officials in the Democrat’s administration manipulated information on Russia’s interference in the 2016 election. Director of National Intelligence (DNI) Tulsi Gabbard has sent criminal referrals to the Justice Department related to a report published Friday that asserted the Obama officials had been part of a “treasonous conspiracy.” Gabbard claimed Obama and his team had manufactured intelligence regarding Russian election interference to “lay the groundwork for what was essentially a years-long coup against President Trump.” Her accusations were widely criticized as they fly in the face of findings by four separate criminal, counterintelligence and watchdog probes between 2019 and 2023 -- all of which concluded that Russia did intervene on Trump’s behalf in the 2016 election.

◆ Relatives of a British victim killed in last

month’s Air India crash received a casket that contained mixed remains, a lawyer representing several families and UK media said yesterday. The family of a separate victim received the remains of another person, according to James Healy-Pratt, who is representing 20 British families who lost loved ones in the disaster. A total of 241 people on board the London-bound Boeing 787 Dreamliner died when the plane crashed shortly after take-off from Ahmedabad in western India on June 12. Some 169 Indian passengers and 52 British nationals were killed, making it one of the deadliest plane crashes in terms of the number of British fatalities. Several people on the ground also died while only one passenger, British citizen Vishwash Kumar Ramesh, survived the crash. Healy-Pratt told the Press Association news agency that the return of victims’ remains had been marred by serious errors, which had been identified following a probe by a British coroner.

Iran says it confronted US
destroyer in Gulf

Iranian forces confronted a US destroyer in the Gulf on Wednesday, warning it to stay out of waters claimed by Tehran, state television reported Thursday -- a month after US strikes on the Islamic republic.

An Iranian army helicopter flew over the USS Fitzgerald at about 10:00 am (0630 GMT) after the vessel “attempted to approach the waters under the supervision” of Iran, the broadcaster said.

The destroyer issued threats of its own, state TV said, adding however that “the Iranian pilot firmly continued the mission and reiterated the warning to stay away from Iranian waters”. Iranian forces then

urged the US ship to “alter its course southward”, forcing it to “give in” and turn away.

There was no immediate comment from the US Navy.

Iranian forces have a history of confronting US forces in the Gulf.

In 2023, Tehran said it forced a US submarine to surface while crossing the strategic Strait of Hormuz -- a claim Washington denied.

The latest confrontation comes after US strikes on June 22 targeted Iran’s nuclear sites during a 12-day war with Israel.

Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi said the damage was “serious and severe” but insisted uranium enrichment would continue.

The World Health Organization’s chief warned yesterday of widespread starvation in Gaza, saying food deliveries into the war-ravaged Palestinian territory were “far below what is needed for the survival of the population”.

“A large proportion of the population of Gaza is starving. I don’t

know what you would call it other than mass starvation -- and it’s man-made,” Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus told reporters.

His statement added his voice to those of 111 aid organisations and rights groups, including MSF and Oxfam, who warned earlier Wednesday that “mass starvation” was spreading in Gaza.

“Our colleagues and those we serve are wasting away,” they said in a joint statement.

Israel is facing mounting international pressure over the catastrophic humanitarian situation in Gaza, where more than two million people are facing severe shortages of food and other essentials after 21 months of conflict.

Even after Israel began easing a more than two-month aid blockade in late May, Gaza’s population is still suffering extreme scarcities.

“The 2.1 million people trapped in the war zone that is Gaza are

facing yet another killer on top of bombs and bullets: starvation,” Tedros said.

“We are now witnessing a deadly surge in malnutrition-related deaths,” he added.

Children starving to death

Tedros highlighted that “rates of global acute malnutrition exceed 10 percent, and over 20 percent of pregnant and breastfeeding women that have been screened are malnourished, often severely”.

The UN health agency has documented 21 deaths in Gaza related to malnutrition of children under the age of five since the beginning of the year, but acknowledges that that the true number is likely higher.

The head of Gaza’s largest hospital said Tuesday that 21 children had died due to malnutrition and starvation in the Palestinian territory over the previous three days alone.

Tedros warned that “the hunger crisis is being accelerated by the collapse of aid pipelines and restrictions on access”.

The starvation is “man-made” and clearly caused by Israel’s blockade on the territory, he said.

The WHO chief highlighted how starving people were risking their lives to access aid.

The UN rights office said Tuesday that Israeli forces have killed more than 1,000 Palestinians trying to get food aid in Gaza since the US- and Israel-backed Gaza Humanitarian Foundation started operations in late May.

“Not only 1,026 were killed while trying to feed themselves or find food for their family. Thousands were also wounded,” Tedros said.

“We demand that there is full access, and we demand that there is a ceasefire,” he said.

“We demand that there is a political solution to this problem, a lasting solution.”

Taliban says detained British couple receiving medical care

An elderly British couple detained for months in Afghanistan are receiving medical care, the Taliban government’s top diplomat said yesterday, after UN experts warned they were at risk of dying.

Peter and Barbie Reynolds, 80-years-old and 75-years-old, had lived in Afghanistan for 18 years when they were arrested in February along with Chinese-American friend Faye Hall, who has since been released, and an Afghan translator.

“All their human rights are being respected,” Afghan Foreign Minister Amir Khan Muttaqi told

a news conference in the capital Kabul. “They are being provided

with medical care. They are in occasional contact with their

families.” Muttaqi said “efforts are underway to secure their release, but the process is not complete”, echoing similar comments by the government in April.

Independent United Nations experts warned on Monday of the “rapid deterioration” of their physical and mental health, stating that they “risk irreparable harm or even death”.

The couple, against whom no charges have been brought, were held “in a high-security facility for several months, then in underground cells, without daylight, before being transferred last week” to the intelligence services in Kabul, according to the UN.

Israel, Ukraine announce 'dialogue' on countering Iran

Israel has long accused Iran of developing nuclear weapons

● Ukrainian described Iran as an "existential threat"

Israel and Ukraine said yesterday they had agreed to start talks on countering the "threat" posed by Iran, in a sign of deepening ties between the two countries.

Both see Iran, a close ally of Russia, as a malign actor on the world stage.

Israel has long accused Iran of developing nuclear weapons, an allegation it denies, while Ukraine is regularly attacked from Russia by Iranian-designed drones.

Ukrainian Foreign Minister Andriy Sybiga described Iran as an "existential threat" to global security during a joint press conference in Kyiv with Israeli Foreign Minister Gideon Saar -- the most senior Israeli official to visit Ukraine since 2023.

"Our countries face common security challenges. Today we have decided to launch a separate dialogue on the Iranian

threat," Sybiga said.

Saar said any effort to curb Tehran's access to weapons and technology contributed to the security of Europe and Ukraine.

"I thank President (Volodymyr) Zelensky and the Ukrainian government for its position that Iran must not have nuclear weapons," he said.

Ukraine has expressed frustration at Israel's neutral stance

on the Russian invasion, but the two share common interests.

Kyiv has long accused Tehran of supplying military hardware to Moscow.

Last month, Israel launched a surprise bombing campaign against Iran with the stated aim of destroying military and nuclear sites, an action that Kyiv supported.

Retrial opens for S. Korean woman who bit off attempted rapist's tongue

A South Korean court reopened a decades-old case on Wednesday after the country's #MeToo movement inspired a woman to challenge her conviction for defending herself against sexual violence 61 years ago.

Choi Mal-ja was 19 when she was attacked by a 21-year-old man in the southern town of Gimhae in 1964.

He pinned her to the ground and forced his tongue into her mouth, court records showed. Choi managed to break free by biting off about 1.5 centimetres (0.6 inches) of his tongue.

In one of South Korea's most contentious rulings on sexual violence, the aggressor received only six months in prison, suspended for two years, for trespassing and intimidation -- but not attempted rape. But Choi was convicted of causing griev-

ous bodily harm and handed a 10-month prison sentence, suspended for two years.

The court said at the time her action had "exceeded the reasonable bounds of legally permissible self-defence".

Choi's case gained renewed momentum decades later after #MeToo movement, which took off globally in 2017 and inspired her to seek justice.

In South Korea, massive women's rights protests led to

victories on issues ranging from abortion access to tougher penalties for spycam crimes.

Choi filed for a retrial in 2020, but lower courts initially rejected her petition.

After years of campaigning and an appeal, South Korea's top court finally ordered a retrial in 2024. "For 61 years, the state made me live as a criminal," Choi told reporters outside the Busan District Court ahead of Wednesday's retrial hearing.

Russia, Ukraine begin talks in Istanbul

Russia and Ukraine began a fresh round of talks in Istanbul yesterday but the Kremlin played down any expectations of a breakthrough after three and a half years of war.

A source in the Ukrainian delegation said the heads of the two delegations held a preparatory meeting with Turkish Foreign Minister Hakan Fidan ahead of wider talks.

A source close to the Russian delegation said officials from the two sides had a bilateral meeting.

The two sides previously met in the Turkish city in May and June, but managed to agree only on exchanges of prisoners and soldiers' bodies.

US President Donald Trump last week gave Russia 50 days to end the war or face sanctions, but the Kremlin has not indicated it is willing to compromise.

"No one expects an easy road. It will be very difficult," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov told reporters when asked about his expectations for the talks.

Ukraine said it hoped the two countries would discuss the release of prisoners and lay the ground for a meeting between President Volodymyr Zelensky and Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin.

"Everything will depend on whether Russia stops speaking in ultimatums and takes a constructive position," a source in the Ukrainian delegation told AFP.

"This will determine whether results can be achieved at this meeting."

But Moscow has said a lot of work is needed before even discussions can take place about possible talks between Putin and Zelensky, who last met in 2019.

300kmph kamikaze drones take flight

India's fastest combat UAV built in 60 days by 2 students in Hyderabad hostel room

Bomb-dropping Kamikaze drones — 300kmph, radar-proof. Assembled inside a hostel room of BITS Pilani's Hyderabad campus. The Army buys in.

Two 20-year-old engineering students of the institute have stunned India's defence circles by building and selling cutting-edge UAVs to Army units across Jammu, Haryana's Chandimandir, Bengal's Panagarh, and Arunachal Pradesh — all within two months of launching their start-up Apollyon Dynamics. Their mission: reduce India's dependency on imported drones.

Jayant Khatri, a mechanical engineering student from Rajasthan's Ajmer, and electrical



engineering student Sourya Choudhury from Kolkata built their drones with off-the-shelf parts, customised the systems for Indian terrain, and pitched them to Army officers via cold messages on LinkedIn.

"I just started shooting cold

emails to whoever I could find... Luckily, a colonel responded and called us to Chandigarh for a demo," Khatri said, speaking to TOI on Monday.

What followed was a whirlwind — a live demo of bomb-dropping and rac-

ing drones, followed by more demonstrations to military regiments. Orders began flowing in. The company was born.

Their standout product: a Kamikaze drone that hits speeds over 300kmph, five times faster than standard commercial UAVs, and delivers 1kg payloads with pinpoint accuracy. "Our drones are not just fast — they can't be detected on radar," said Choudhury.

The duo insists every UAV is built in-house with a focus on "ruggedness, reliability and adaptability". "Our shared love of robotics brought us together. We started with a defence-tech club on campus. Then came the orders — that's when we knew we had to go big," Choudhury

said.

The team now includes six second-year students and is working on next-generation VTOL (Vertical Take-off and Landing) and fixed-wing platforms to boost mission flexibility. They also offer hands-on training to military personnel — even those with no prior flight experience.

"It's heartening to see what they've achieved," said professor Sanket Goel of BITS Pilani. "Their start-up has already secured multiple orders from the armed forces." In "3 Idiots", Joy Lobo's passion for machines died in silence — no support, no takers. In real life, two students built war-ready drones in a hostel room. The Army called back.

Amazon acquires **AI wearable startup Bee**

Samsung may launch **tri-fold phone** by year-end

Apple expected to launch **ultra-slim iPhone 17 Air** with optional battery case

The iPhone 17 lineup is expected to feature a redesigned front camera system with a smaller Dynamic Island, thanks to Apple’s advancements in under-display camera technology. This could mark the beginning of a nearly bezel-free iPhone screen—bringing Apple closer to a true all-screen design for future models.

Apple is reportedly gearing up to launch the iPhone 17 Air, a new ultra-slim model likely to replace

the existing “Plus” lineup. Design leaks suggest the phone could be just 5.6mm thick, making

it one of Apple’s thinnest devices to date. However, concerns over battery life have surfaced. Accord-

ing to The Information, Apple may reintroduce an optional battery case accessory to extend the device’s runtime. While this could offer a few extra hours of power, it may compromise the slim aesthetic the phone is meant to highlight. The accessory is expected to be sold separately, potentially adding to the iPhone 17 Air’s projected price tag of around \$1,100.

Spec leaks indicate the iPhone 17 Air will feature a 6.5-inch OLED display with Dynamic Island and a 60Hz refresh rate. It is expected to run on the new A19 chip with 12GB RAM, a 48MP rear camera, and a 24MP selfie shooter—an upgrade over the current 12MP front camera. The phone will also likely retain the Action and Camera Capture buttons introduced with the iPhone 16 series.

Battery capacity is expected to remain under 3000mAh, making the optional case a likely necessity for power users.

Foldable iPhone could launch in 2026 with 7.8-inch inner display

Apple is reportedly preparing to launch its first foldable iPhone next year, and new details about its screen sizes have surfaced. According to a report by market research firm TrendForce, the upcoming “iPhone Fold” is expected to feature a 5.5-inch cover display and a 7.8-inch inner foldable screen.

Leaks over recent months have also hinted at Apple’s cautious but focused approach to foldables, with an emphasis on durability, user experience, and seamless integration with the iOS ecosystem.

Milan wins crash-marred sprint at Tour de France

● Mass fall eliminates most sprinters

● Pogacar, Vingegaard finish safely

Italy's Jonathan Milan won a crash-marred finale to stage 17 of the Tour de France in lashing rain on Wednesday, extending his lead in the sprint points race.

Overall leader Tadej Pogacar and his closest rival Jonas Vingegaard (4min 15sec behind) finished safely despite a mass fall 800m from the finish line at Valence at the foot of the Alps.

On the rain-slick roads at Valence once one rider had fallen his interminable slide across the tarmac sent riders flying like skittles leaving only 10 to contest the sprint.

This was a second stage win

for Milan, who won Italy's first stage since 2019 on stage eight.

The 24-year-old Lidl Trek rider now has 312 points, and is in a powerful position to win the battle for the green jersey in Paris as Pogacar is second at 240 with only two possible sprints left at 50pts each.

As the remaining 164 rid-

ers embarked from the sleepy Provence village of Bollene, the collective will of the peloton made for a slow approach of the Alps.

Billed as a sprinters stage on an unusually mild (22C) day the riders were also spared the 50kph winds that had been forecast.

Dawson strikes as England fight back against India

Liam Dawson marked his first Test in eight years with the key wicket of India's Yas- hasvi Jaiswal as England fought back on Wednesday's opening day at Old Trafford.

India, invited to bat by England captain Ben Stokes, got through the first session of the fourth Test without losing a wicket.

But at tea they were 149-3, with openers KL Rahul and Jaiswal, as well as India captain Shubman Gill all back in the pavilion.

The recalled Sai Sudharsan, dropped on 20, was 26 not out.

India, 2-1 down after three Tests, must win at Old Trafford if they are to keep alive their hopes of winning the five-match series.

But the tourists will have to make history as they have never managed to win in nine previ-

ous Tests at the Manchester ground.

They made a fine start after losing the toss and were 78-0 at lunch, with Jaiswal 36 not out after uppercutting Stokes for six and Rahul unbeaten on 40.

But Rahul had added just six

more runs to his score when, trying to force Chris Woakes off the back foot, he edged to Zak Crawley at third slip, leaving India 94-1.

Jaiswal late-cut Brydon Carse for four to go to 49 before completing a 96-ball fifty.

Venus wins in return, Osaka to face Raducanu

Venus Williams made a triumphant return to singles tennis on Tuesday after a 16-month hiatus, defeating fellow American Peyton Stearns 6-3, 6-4 to reach the second round of the WTA and ATP DC Open.

The 45-year-old winner of seven career Grand Slam singles titles rolled to her 819th career WTA singles victory in 97 minutes at the first US Open hardcourt tuneup event.

"It is not easy to come off after all that time and play the perfect match," she said. "Peyton played so well. I felt like I was trying to slow myself down from going faster and faster."

Williams had not played a WTA singles match since March of last year at Miami and had not won a match in 709 days -- since defeating Russian Veronika Kudermetova in the first round at Cincinnati in August 2023.

"I wanted to play a good match and win the match," Wil-

liams said. "It's so rewarding to come back after a layoff and injuries."

Williams became the oldest player to compete in a WTA tour-level match since Japan's Kimiko Date at 46 in Tokyo in 2017.

She became the oldest WTA match winner since Martina Navratilova at age 47 at Wimbledon in 2004.

"Thank you so much for the energy," Williams told the crowd. "We were literally living and dying together."

Williams broke for a 4-3 lead in the second set, winning nine of 10 points in one stretch, then held to 5-3 and pushed Stearns in a 12-minute ninth game but missed on four match points before Stearns held.

Russell’s sparkling farewell in vain as Australia sprint to T20 win

West Indies legend Russell’s final innings thrills home crowd, but Australia secure emphatic victory

Andre Russell struck a sparkling 36 off 15 balls in his final innings before retirement on Tuesday but could not save the West Indies from losing the second Twenty20 international against Australia in Kingston.

The 37-year-old all-rounder was unable to script a fairytale farewell to his glittering T20 career, but departed to a standing ovation on his home Sabina Park ground after hitting four trademark sixes and two fours.

Batting at number seven in his 85th and last T20 international, Russell’s cameo, plus a late flurry from Gudakesh Motie (18 off nine balls) added to 51 from opener Brandon King enabled the hosts to score 172-8 off their 20 overs.

But a record 131-run stand by Josh Inglis, who made 78 not out, and Cameron Green (56 not

out) saw Australia race to an eight-wicket win with more than four overs to spare.

It was Australia’s highest third-wicket partnership in Twenty20 internationals and, aided by six dropped catches by West Indies fielders, gave the visitors a 2-0 lead in the five-match series.

Inglis hit seven fours and five sixes while Green was barely more sedate, clearing the ropes four times and stroking three fours in his second consecutive fifty.

“I didn’t want to finish on a losing note,” said Russell, whose spectacular final knock had briefly thrilled his hometown

crowd.

“I enjoy seeing the ball go over the ropes,” he added.

“As a kid you dream about playing here. Thanks to all the fans who came out to support me.”

Russell, who was given a guard of honour before the match by both teams, played just one Test match.

It was as a Twenty20 specialist that he made his name, winning the T20 World Cup twice with the West Indies in 2012 and 2016.

A more than lively seam bowler, Russell’s free-scoring late-order batting and athletic fielding saw him sought after by T20 leagues around the world.

He has been with Kolkata Knight Riders in the IPL since 2014, scoring more than 2,400 runs.

If there were any doubts about Bahrain’s championship credentials in the WAVA Men’s Volleyball Championship, they were erased in their quarter-final performance last night. Led by French Olympian Arnaud Josserand, Bahrain swept Kuwait in straight sets (25-15, 25-22, 25-20) to reach the semi-finals against neighbors Saudi Arabia.

Bahrain is playing with confidence and an efficiency that few in the tournament can match. They haven’t dropped a single set in four matches, finishing Pool A with 3-0 wins over Jordan, Lebanon, and the UAE. Entering the knockout stage, they led the tournament in attacking and serving, including 22 points scored directly from serves, which is a stat they reinforced last night.

To their credit, Kuwait came in battle-tested after a 0-3 loss to Oman, a surprise 3-2 win over Saudi Arabia, and a close 2-3 loss to Qatar. Against Bahrain, they fought hard but couldn’t find answers to Bahrain’s control at the net.

Kuwait’s Rashed Anbar was the top scorer with 19 points, while Bahrain’s Ali Ibrahim led with 14 points. Mohammed Yaqoob added 11, Nasser Anan 8, Hassan Al Warqa 7, and Mohammed Jassim 5. Mahmoud Al Affiah and Mahmoud Abdulwahed matched each other’s tally of one point.

This team isn’t just in great form, they are decorated champions. Just last month, Bahrain won their first-ever AVC title at the 2025 Men’s Volleyball Nations Cup, following their Arab Championship win in November. Now, two wins stand between them and a historic regional treble.

Juventus make Conceicao loan permanent

Portuguese international Francisco Conceicao, who spent last year on loan at Juventus, has completed a full transfer from Porto, the Serie A club has announced.

The 22-year-old winger, who has 11 caps for Portugal and scored seven goals in 40 appearances in all competitions for Juventus last season, has signed a deal taking him up to 2030.

“Juventus announce that they have reached an agreement with FC Porto for the permanent acquisition of Francisco Conceicao,” Juve said in a statement released on Tuesday evening.

Juventus, the only Italian club listed on the stock exchange, said it had paid “30.4 million euros (\$35.6 million) payable in four annual instalments”, in addition to 1.6 million euros in fees and other costs.

According to the Italian press, Juventus are also close to finalising the transfer of another player from Porto, Portuguese right-back Joao Mario while defender Alberto Costa is expected to go in the other direction.

Juve, now coached by Igor Tudor, have already strengthened their attacking line with the signing of Canadian international Jonathan David from French side Lille.
