

# HM King appoints, transfers Interior Ministry officials

His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa issued Decree (41) of 2025 appointing and transferring officials within the Ministry of Interior, following a proposal by the Minister of Interior and the approval of the Cabinet.

nity Affairs at the Ministry of Interior, is transferred to serve as Deputy Governor of the Capital Governorate, succeeding Hassan Abdullah Mohammed Al Madani, for a four-year term.

Colonel Adnan Jumaa Abdullah Bahr is appointed Director-General of the General Directorate of Correction and Rehabilitation at the Ministry of Interior, succeeding Major General Abdulsalam Yousif Al Arifi.

The Minister of Interior shall implement the provisions of the decree, which takes effect upon its issuance, and shall be published in the Official Gazette.
