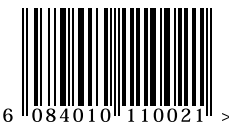
Bahrain mourns Saudi Grand Mufti's death

Following his remarks, a presentation was screened to showcase how these changes can benefit the food processing and agri-busi-

ness sectors.

Road safety boost

Security and speed cameras approved for Janabiyah Highway

The Northern Municipal Council has unanimously approved a proposal to install security and speed-enforcement cameras along Janabiyah Highway, covering avenues 91, 92 and 93 through to Madinat Salman, put forward by Third Constituency councillor Mohammed Saad Al Dosari.

The move follows repeated complaints from residents and regular users.

Al Dosari said the stretch between Janabiyah and Madinat Salman has seen rising speeds that put people at risk.

The councillor noted that limited patrol coverage by the General Directorate of Traffic makes offences harder to curb, and

He said installing speed cameras would cut crashes and repeat offences and encourage better driver conduct, improv-

ing safety for those using the highway.

Crashes

The proposal aims to address recurring crashes, keep a closer watch on the route and keep traffic moving more smoothly amid urban growth and higher population in the area.

Al Dosari added that the measure seeks to protect lives and public and private property, and that councillors backed it unanimously for its direct effect on road safety.

Verdict set in drug money trial

Bahrain's First High Criminal Court has scheduled October 14 to deliver its verdict in the trial of a 26-year-old Asian man accused of laundering over BD38,000 (approximately \$100,000) in proceeds from drug sales through crypto-currency transactions.

Investigators allege the defendant was part of an international drug trafficking network, tasked with receiving sales revenue and concealing its origins through various financial channels.

Authorities say he transferred the funds via exchange companies, ATM withdrawals, and bank deposits, before converting them into digital currencies that were later sold through an unwitting intermediary.

The man was charged with money laundering in 2024.

19 arrested with 16kg of narcotics worth BD113,000

A number of individuals were arrested for possessing narcotics weighing approximately 16 kilograms, worth BD113,000.

The Ministry of Interior confirmed that, within the framework of security efforts undertaken by the Anti-Narcotics Department of the General Department of Criminal Investigation and Evidence, measures are being taken to protect society from the scourge of drugs.

In various incidents, the administration, in cooperation with customs affairs and an

air freight company, was able to arrest 19 people of different nationalities in possession of a quantity of narcotic substances weighing approximately 16 kilograms and valued at more than BD11,000.

The administration explained that as soon as information about the incidents was received, searches and investigations were carried out, and information and evidence were collected, which resulted in identifying the accused and arresting them, with the narcotics in their possession.

The General Department of

Criminal Investigations and Evidence indicated that the items were seized and held, the necessary legal measures were taken, and the cases were referred to the Public Prosecution.

The Criminal Media Division noted the importance of continuing to activate community partnership with all institutions and groups to provide lectures and hold exhibitions to raise awareness and educate in the field of combating drugs.

It noted the necessity of communicating and cooperating with the security and competent authorities.

Indonesia, EU sign long-awaited trade deal

Indonesia and the European Union finalised negotiations on a trade agreement yesterday after nearly a decade of talks, a senior minister said.

The Indonesia-European Union Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) is the third deal Brussels has signed with Southeast Asian countries, after Singapore and Vietnam.

The pact was signed by EU Trade Commissioner Maros Sefcovic and Indonesian Minister of Economic Affairs Airlangga Hartarto in Bali and will open investment in strategic sectors such as electric vehicles, electronics, and pharmaceuticals.

“By finalising this agreement, the EU and Indonesia are sending a powerful message to the world that we stand united in our commitment to open rules-based and mutually beneficial international trade,” Sefcovic said after the signing.

“In all, EU exporters will save some 600 million euros (\$708 million) a year in duties paid on their goods entering the Indonesian market, and European products will be more affordable and available to Indonesian consumers,” EU President Ursula von der Leyen said in a statement.

Indonesia has been in talks with the EU since 2016, but negotiations for a trade deal initially saw little progress.

Issues such as palm oil and deforestation posed stumbling blocks, but US President Donald Trump’s sweeping tariff policy “created the urgency” to expedite an agreement, said Deni Friawan, researcher at the Centre for Strategic and International Studies.

The trade deal also included a protocol on palm oil, the EU said in a statement, without providing details. “This is a ten-year journey that has resulted in a milestone that reflects our commitment and the commitment of stakeholders to an open, fair, and sustainable economic assistance,” Airlangga told a news conference. The agreement is expected to be implemented by 2027, Airlangga added.

Around 80 percent of Indonesian exports to the EU will be tariff-free after the deal comes into force, Airlangga said in June.

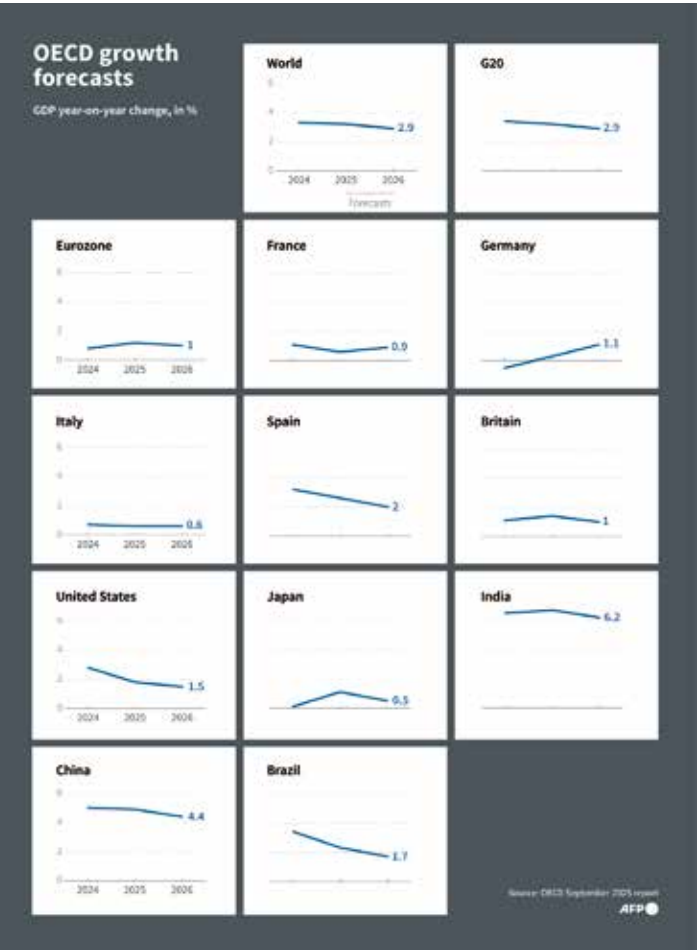


OECD raises world growth outlook as tariffs contained, for now

● **World growth is due to slow to 2.9% in 2026**

The world economy will grow more than previously forecast this year after absorbing the shock of US President Donald Trump’s tariffs, but their full impact remains uncertain, the OECD said Tuesday. In June, the Paris-based organisation had cut its forecast from 3.1% to 2.9%, warning at the time that Trump’s tariffs would stifle the world economy. But in an updated outlook on Tuesday, it raised the projection to 3.2%, saying the economy “proved more resilient than anticipated” in the first half of 2025. “The impact of tariffs is taking longer to reach the economy,” OECD chief economist Alvaro Pereira told AFP in an interview. The OECD report said “front-loading” -- companies rushing to import goods ahead of Trump’s tariffs -- “was an important source of support”. The economy also got a boost from strong AI-related investments in the United States and



government spending in China. The updated figure is still a slight slowdown from 3.3% in 2024. “The full effects of tariff increases have yet to be felt -- with many changes being phased in over time and companies initial-

ly absorbing some tariff increases through (profit) margins,” the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development said. “But (they) are becoming increasingly visible in spending choices, labour markets and consumer prices,” the report said. **‘Significant risks remain’** World growth is due to slow to 2.9% in 2026 “as front-loading ceases and higher tariff rates and still-high policy uncertainty dampen investment and trade”, the OECD said. Trump imposed a baseline 10% tariff on imports from around the world in April. He later hit dozens of countries with even higher duties, but the US leader also left the door open for negotiations, striking deals with Britain, Japan and the European Union, among others. The United States has yet to find a compromise with China, though the world’s two biggest economies have temporarily de-escalated their tit-for-tat tariffs while they negotiate. The overall effective US tariff rate rose to an estimated 19.5% in August, the highest level since 1933, the OECD said. “Significant risks to the economic outlook remain,” the OECD said. “Amid ongoing policy uncertainty, a key concern is that bilateral tariff rates could be raised further on merchandise imports,” it said. The OECD also warned that inflation could rise as food and energy prices climb, and companies begin to pass the cost of higher tariffs to consumers. “On the upside, reductions in trade restrictions or faster development and adoption of artificial intelligence technologies could strengthen growth prospects,” it said. **Growth due to slow** The OECD also upgraded the growth outlook of the United States for 2025 from 1.6% to 1.8% but that is much slower than 2.8% last year. US growth is expected to slow even further to 1.5% next year due to higher tariffs and elevated “policy uncertainty”. The OECD also pointed to the impact of Trump’s immigration crackdown and cuts in the federal workforce. The report was written before the White House raised the H-1B visa fee for high-skilled workers to \$100,000, which has rattled the tech industry. “We do think that continuing

to attract high-skilled individuals from the United States or from around the world is a key strength of the US economy,” said Pereira, noting that there is a labour shortage in the tech sector. The OECD raised the growth outlook of other major economies: to 4.9% in China, 1.2% in the eurozone and 1.1% in Japan. But it flagged a drop in industrial production in recent months in several countries, including Brazil, Germany and South Korea, and moderating consumption in the United States, China and the eurozone.

A call to support Taiwan's participation in ICAO

The International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) convenes its Assembly once every three years. During the event, multilateral meetings and discussions are held to draw up global civil aviation regulations and standards. Nations abide by the conclusions drawn at the Assembly, ensuring the safe and orderly growth of international civil aviation worldwide. The 42nd session of the ICAO Assembly will be held from September 23 to October 3 in Montreal, Canada.

In line with its long-term strategic plan called "Safe Skies, Sustainable Future," ICAO is emphasizing a commitment to working with all stakeholders—including member states, nonmember states, NGOs, and private enterprises—to build a more resilient, sustainable, and inclusive international aviation system. We call on ICAO to allow Taiwan to fully participate in its Assembly, technical meetings and mechanisms to ensure regional aviation safety and development needs, thereby achieving safe skies amid a sustainable future.

Meeting regional aviation safety and development needs

The Taipei Flight Information Region (FIR) covers one of the busiest regions in East Asia for air travel. It is an indispensable part of ICAO's network of over 300 FIRs. Taiwan's Civil Aviation Administration (CAA) is the sole entity responsible for overseeing the Taipei FIR. The CAA offers a comprehensive range of information services and manages air routes to ensure safety and efficiency for all flights and passengers arriving in, departing from, and transiting the Taipei FIR. From both a risk and safety management perspective, ICAO should permit Taiwan's CAA to participate on an equal footing with the oversight agencies of other FIRs. This will ensure that the Taipei FIR can communicate directly with other FIRs as well as with ICAO to ensure the free flow of timely information.

Global aviation faces many natural and manmade challenges such as climate change, power banks, and international geopolitical strife. Taiwan, which is responsible for the considerable traffic through the Taipei FIR, makes every effort to be a responsible stakeholder in the international aviation community. To undergird regional flight safety, Taiwan again calls on ICAO to recognize the importance of the Taipei FIR and of its participation in ICAO.

Achieving safe skies and a sustainable future

Taiwan's CAA does its best to collect the information it can via indirect channels. It also invites aviation experts from other countries to hold training courses. This helps it to achieve international aviation safety management standards. It also adopts or modifies regulations, systems, and procedures in line with ICAO standards in ways that benefit global and regional aviation safety. For example, the CAA has initiated a State Safety Program and collaborates with aviation industry stakeholders through this program to establish safety oversight systems. This has contributed to Taiwan's exceptional overall safety performance. From 2020 to 2024, the five-year moving occurrence rates of turboprop and turboprop aircraft were zero (zero accidents per million departures). The safety performance of Taiwan's aviation industry has also been remarkable. EVA Air, for instance, has been recognized as one of the world's safest full-service airlines by AirlineRatings.com and was ranked seventh-safest in 2025.

To further sustainable development of the aviation industry, Taiwan's CAA has incorporated the Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation (CORSIA) into domestic law and launched a sustainable aviation fuel pilot program in April 2025. This demonstrates the determination of Taiwan's aviation industry to take concrete steps toward a net-zero transformation.

Despite these efforts, to ensure access to timely and comprehensive information, the CAA must be allowed to participate in the technical meetings and training opportunities offered by ICAO. ICAO should act in line with its No One Left Behind initiative to rectify the fact that the CAA remains unable to participate in its activities.

Taiwan needs your support

Aviation safety knows no borders. For decades, the CAA has mandated and upheld the highest standards of service and safety for the Taipei FIR while meeting ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices. As a stakeholder in the international aviation community, Taiwan shares in the responsibility to safeguard regional and global aviation safety. Through participation in ICAO, Taiwan will be able to continue to work with other countries professionally to contribute to the further development of global aviation and the well-being of all mankind.

ICAO is set to convene the 42nd Assembly with the theme "Safe Skies, Sustainable Future." It is time for ICAO to bring Taiwan into the fold. With meaningful participation, Taiwan can contribute its professional expertise in pursuit of ICAO's vision of safer skies and a more sustainable future. Taiwan's CAA is committed to working with the international community to implement the Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs).

Palestinians rally to celebrate statehood

Majority of European powers now recognise a Palestinian state

Crowds of people rallied in the occupied West Bank yesterday, waving flags and holding posters of president Mahmud Abbas to celebrate the wave of recognition by Western powers of a Palestinian state.

Nationalist slogans blared from loudspeakers across the central square in the city of Ramallah, where a crowd of more than 100 clutched Palestinian and European flags alongside signs reading "stop the genocide".

High-ranking officials from Abbas's political movement, Fatah, and the Palestinian Authority -- which exerts limited control in the West Bank -- shook hands and smiled.

"This recognition is a first step in a process that we hope will continue," Jibril Rajoub, secretary-general of Fatah's central committee, told AFP.

"It is the result of more than a century of resistance and determination by our people."

Rajoub said he had felt moved listening to the speeches made at the UN General Assembly in New York the night before.

"We must learn from the past and unite the people," he said.

Maysoon Mahmud, 39, who is also a Fatah member, said: "We came here today to thank the countries that have recognised Palestine, but also to ask them to continue to support us in stopping the war."

"It is time for the world to take responsibility," she added.

Further north in Tulkarem, dozens more gathered, holding the flags of countries that now recognise a Palestinian state.

A majority of European powers now recognise a Palestinian state, following official declarations on Monday by France, Belgium, Luxembourg, Malta and others, after nearly two years of war in Gaza and soaring violence in the West Bank.

A day earlier Britain, Australia, Canada and Portugal also took the step.

'We want action'

But many Palestinians interviewed by AFP expressed ambivalence at the move due to the bitter reality of the situation on the ground.

Roula Ghaneb, an academic from Tulkarem, stood impassively in the middle of the Ramallah rally, holding a photo of her 20-year-old son, Yazan.

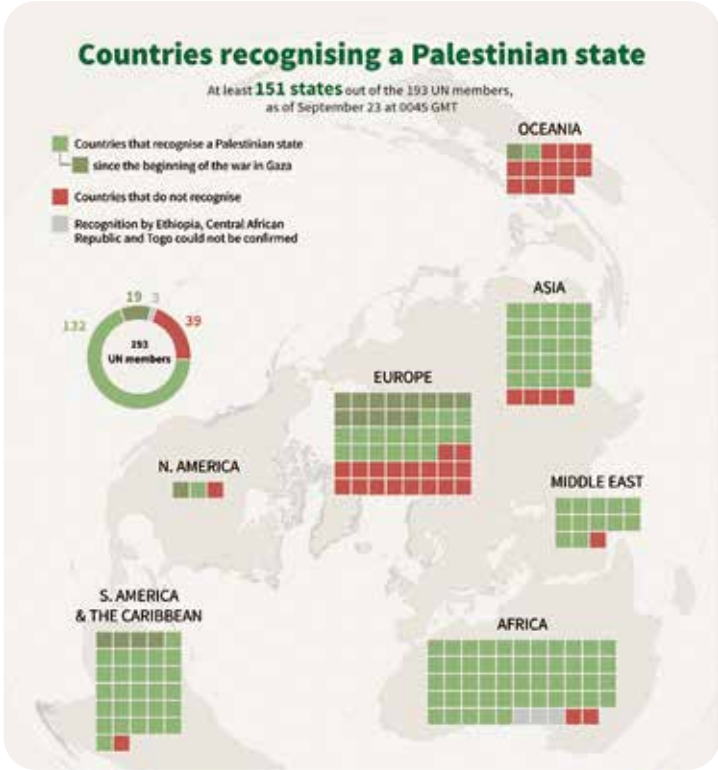
"He was arrested at our home eight months ago," she said, adding that he was being held in poor conditions.

Ghaneb said she wanted an end to all violence, insisting: "We don't want words, we want action."

Indonesia leader offers 20,000 troops for post-war Gaza

Indonesia's leader on Tuesday offered to send at least 20,000 troops as peacekeepers to Gaza to safeguard any future peace deal.

Addressing the UN General Assembly, President Prabowo Subianto said that the world's most populous Muslim-majority country wanted a peace that shows that "might cannot make right."

"We believe in the UN. We

will continue to serve where peace needs guardians -- not with just words, but with boots on the ground," he said.

"If and when the UN Security Council and this great Assembly decide, Indonesia is prepared to deploy 20,000 or even more of our sons and daughters to help secure peace in Gaza," he said.

He said that Indonesia was also willing to send peacekeepers elsewhere including in Ukraine, Sudan or Libya.

Hardline Israeli government ministers have made little secret of their desire to annex the West

Bank, which Israel has occupied since 1967 and where roadblocks are multiplying and Israeli settlements are expanding.

The diplomatic push also comes as Israel is intensifying its military offensive in Gaza City, after nearly two years of war triggered by Hamas's deadly attack in October 2023.

"If they want to recognise something, they must recognise the genocide that is taking place today, put an end to these atrocities and punish Israel for these crimes," said Abdul.

Palestinians, Jordan say Israel to indefinitely close West Bank crossing

Ramallah, Palestinian Territories

Palestinian and Jordanian authorities said Israel was indefinitely closing the only crossing between the Israeli-occupied West Bank and Jordan from today.

"The chairman of the Palestinian General Authority for Crossings and Borders, Mr Nazmi Muhanna, announced that the Israeli side has informed us of the closure of the Al-Karama crossing starting tomorrow, Wednesday... until further notice, in both directions," a statement from the Palestinian borders authority said, referring to the Allenby crossing.

The crossing in the Jordan Valley is the only international gateway for Palestinians from the West Bank that does not require entering Israel, which has occupied the territory since 1967.

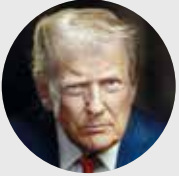

Hundreds trapped as typhoon triggers lake burst in Taiwan

Ragasa lashed the northern Philippines and Taiwan on Monday

A decades-old barrier lake formed by a landslide in eastern Taiwan burst yesterday as Super Typhoon Ragasa pounded the island with torrential rains, flooding a nearby town and trapping over 260 people, officials said.

Ragasa lashed the northern Philippines and Taiwan on Monday with heavy rains and strong winds, forcing thousands to evacuate.

In Taiwan's eastern Hualien county, where downpours continued on Tuesday, the barrier lake on the upper Mataian Creek burst around 3:00 pm (0700 GMT), washing away a bridge and sweeping into a town, a local fire official said.

At its peak, Ragasa had one-minute sustained winds estimated at around 270 km/h (165 mph), making it a Category 5-equivalent super typhoon, and it's currently the strongest tropical cyclone recorded in 2025 in the northwest Pacific basin.

"In some places, water temporarily rose as high as the second floor of a house and was about (as high as) one floor in the town centre, where the water has been receding," Lee Lung-sheng, deputy chief of Hualien County Fire Department, told AFP.

"About 263 people were trapped and moved up to higher ground when the river suddenly rose. They are not in immediate danger, but they are very worried about the high water,"

he said.

He added that two people were missing, and a search was underway to recover them.

The stranded residents were asked to stay put and wait for the water to recede, he added.

Footage released by Taiwan's National Fire Agency showed flooded streets and half-submerged cars as trees were uprooted in the area.

Across Taiwan, more than 7,600 people were evacuated

due to Typhoon Ragasa.

Around 3,100 people were evacuated beforehand and moved in with relatives in the area near the creek in Hualien, according to the fire agency.

Taiwan experiences frequent tropical storms from July to October.

Typhoon Danas, which hit the island in early July, killed two people and injured hundreds as the storm dumped more than 20 inches of rain across the south over a weekend.

Man charged with shining laser pointer at Trump helicopter

US authorities charged a man who shone a laser pointer at the presidential helicopter as it departed the White House with President Trump aboard, according to a court filing Monday.

A Secret Service officer saw Jacob Samuel Winkler, 33, shine a red laser beam from the sidewalk outside the White House grounds, pointing it at the Marine One helicopter as it took off on Saturday, an affidavit said. Winkler was detained at the scene and charged with aiming a laser pointer at an aircraft -- a felony punishable by up to five years in prison.

Winkler's "conduct posed a risk of flash blindness and pilot disorientation, especially during low-level flight near other helicopters... and the Washington Monument," the filing said.

"This placed Marine One at

risk of an airborne collision."

After he was handcuffed, Winkler "got on his knees and started saying things like, 'I should apologize to Donald Trump,'" the filing, signed by the Secret Service officer, showed.

Winkler later told authorities that "he did not know he could not point the laser at Marine One" and that "he points the laser at all kinds of things, such as stop signs."

The filing did not mention whether anyone aboard the helicopter noticed the laser.

Trump had been travelling to the state of Virginia to give a speech to the American Cornerstone Institute, according to US media.

The Federal Aviation Administration says lasers pose a "serious safety threat" to aircraft and can incapacitate pilots.

The agency recorded 5,913 laser incidents this year.

Australia probes how Bali body returned home without heart

Australian officials have demanded answers from Indonesian counterparts after the body of a young man who died on the resort island of Bali was repatriated without his heart.

Queensland man Byron Haddow, 23, was found dead in the plunge pool of his Bali villa this year while on holiday. His body was returned to Australia four weeks later, where a second autopsy found he was missing his heart.

A spokesperson for Australia's foreign ministry said Tuesday they were providing consular assistance to Haddow's family but could not comment further owing to privacy obligations.

"They just rung us to ask if we were aware that his heart had been retained over in Bali," mother Chantal Haddow told Australia's Channel Nine.

"Just when I thought I couldn't feel any more heartbroken, it was another kick in the guts," she said.

"I feel like there was foul play. I think that something's happened to him prior to being in the pool."

Senior Australian officials



in Bali and Jakarta have made representations to the Indonesian Government regarding the matter.

The Australian Consulate-General in Bali has also conveyed the family's concerns to hospital officials.

But the forensic doctor who performed the original autopsy rejected claims of wrongdoing.

"For forensic purposes, his heart was tested and was kept behind when the family repatriated the body home," doctor Nola Margaret Gunawan told The Sydney Morning Herald newspaper on Monday.

"I have given the autopsy result and explanation to the family. They have accepted my explanation."

Trump demands Europe stop buying Russian oil, hits India and China

US President Donald Trump demanded yesterday that European allies immediately stop buying oil from Russia and accused China and India of funding the Ukraine war through their purchases.

"They have to immediately cease all energy purchases from Russia. Otherwise we're all wasting a lot of time," Trump said of Europe in an address at the UN General Assembly.

US says dismantled telecoms shutdown threat during UN summit

New York, United States

The US Secret Service said yesterday it had dismantled a network of electronic devices that could have crashed New York's telecommunications network in an attack ahead of the UN General Assembly.

The protective agency did not say who was responsible for the sophisticated material but linked it to "nation-state" actors and "individuals that are known to federal law enforcement."

ABC News quoted a law enforcement source briefed on the investigation as saying officials "believe the plot is connected to the Chinese government."

"The potential for disruption to our country's telecommunications posed by this network of devices cannot be overstated," Secret Service Director Sean Curran said.

Iranian, European ministers to hold nuclear talks Tuesday

United Nations, United States

Iranian and European ministers will hold nuclear talks in New York yesterday, a French diplomatic source said, after the UN Security Council voted to reimpose sanctions over Tehran's atomic program.

Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi has until the end of Saturday to reach a deal with his British, French, German and EU counterparts to avoid the reinstatement of UN sanctions, which had been suspended under a deal signed in 2015. The meeting on the sidelines of the United Nations' signature high-level week, is scheduled for 10:00 am local time (1400 GMT), a diplomatic source told AFP. European countries and the United States suspect the Iranian government of seeking to acquire the atomic bomb.

WHO sees no autism links to Tylenol, vaccines

Neither the painkiller Tylenol nor vaccines have been shown to cause autism, the World Health Organization said yesterday, following comments from the US president and his administration to the contrary.

President Donald Trump insisted on Monday that pregnant women should "tough it out" and avoid Tylenol due to an unproven link to autism and also urged major changes to the standard vaccines administered to babies.

Medical groups have long cited acetaminophen, or paracetamol -- the primary ingredient in Tylenol -- as among the safest painkillers to take during pregnancy.

WHO spokesman Tarik Jasarevic acknowledged that some observational studies -- which are based purely on observations and do not include control or treatment groups -- had "suggested a possible association between prenatal exposure to acetaminophen or paracetamol and autism".

But, he told reporters in Geneva, "the evidence remains inconsistent" with other studies finding "no such relationship".

"If the link between acetaminophen and autism were strong, it would likely have been consistently observed across multiple studies," he said, warning against "drawing casual conclusions about the role of acetaminophen in autism".

'No evidence'

European medical regulators meanwhile said their recommendations that pregnant women can use paracetamol for pain

relief had not changed.

"Patient safety is our top priority. There is no evidence that taking paracetamol during pregnancy causes autism in children," Alison Cave, safety chief at Britain's Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA), said in a statement.

Steffen Thirstrup, chief medical officer at the European Medicines Agency, agreed.

"Our advice is based on a rigorous assessment of the available scientific data and we have found no evidence that taking paracetamol during pregnancy causes autism in children," he said.

Vaccines were also on the rambling agenda of Trump's press conference on Monday, when he repeated anti-vax movement talking points.

He sowed doubt over standard vaccines including the MMR shot -- which covers measles, mumps and rubella -- and implied he would end the common use of aluminium in vaccines, the safety of which has been widely studied.

Identifying the root of autism

-- a complex condition connected to brain development that many experts believe occurs for predominantly genetic reasons -- has been a pet cause of Trump's health secretary, Robert F. Kennedy Jr.

Kennedy has for decades spread claims that vaccines cause autism.

'Vaccine schedules evolve with science'

Asked about the fears raised by the US president and his administration over childhood vaccines, Jasaravic said: "Vaccines do not cause autism."

"The childhood immunisation schedule, carefully guided by WHO, has been adopted by all countries and has saved at least 154 million lives over the past 50 years," he added.

"These schedules have continually evolved with science and now safeguard children, adolescents and adults against 30 infectious diseases," he said.

He warned, however, that "when immunisation schedules are delayed or disrupted, or altered without evidence review,



there is a sharp increase in the risk of infection not only for the child but also for the wider community".

"Each missed dose increases the chances of contracting a life-threatening infectious disease."

The WHO spokesman said that 62 million people were known to be living with autism spectrum

disorder worldwide.

The global community needed to do more, he acknowledged, "to understand the causes of autism and how best to care for and support the needs of autistic people and their families".

But science had "proven" there was no link to vaccines, he said, adding: "These things should not really be questioned."



The exact cause of autism is still not fully understood, but research shows it results from a combination of genetic and environmental factors that affect early brain development

Genetic factors: Autism tends to run in families. Certain gene changes (mutations) have been linked to a higher likelihood of autism spectrum disorder (ASD).

Brain development: Differences in how brain networks are formed and connected appear very early in life, even before clear symptoms show.

Environmental influences: Things like advanced parental age, pregnancy complications, low birth weight, or exposure to certain toxins or infections during pregnancy may increase risk.

US President Donald Trump relentlessly mocked the United Nations on Tuesday in his first address since his White House comeback, blasting it for failing to bring peace and claiming the world body encourages illegal migration.

In his return to the UN General Assembly podium, Trump accused the UN of

fostering an "assault" through migration on Western countries that he said were "going to hell." He likewise used the major forum to denounce efforts to reduce global warming, calling climate change concerns "the greatest con job ever perpetrated on the world."

"What is the purpose of the United Nations?" asked Trump. "All they seem to do is write a really strongly worded letter," he said. "It's empty words, and empty words don't solve war"

The 79-year-old even complained about a broken escalator and teleprompter at the New York headquarters of the UN, which he has repeatedly targeted during both of his presiden-

tial terms.

"This is these are the two things I got from the United Nations, a bad escalator and a bad teleprompter," he said.

Touting what he said were his efforts to end seven wars, Trump turned to two where his outreach has produced no results -- Russia's invasion of Ukraine and Israel's war in Gaza following Hamas's October 7, 2023 attack.

He called recognition by a slate of Washington's allies of a Palestinian state a "reward" to armed group Hamas for "horrible atrocities" and urged the group to release hostages to reach peace.

Trump lashed out at European allies, as well as China and India, for failing to stop oil purchases from Russia, while remaining relatively restrained on Moscow even as he said Washington was ready to impose unspecified sanctions.

Some of his strongest language was reserved for migration as he lambasted the UN for "funding an assault" on Western nations.

"It's time to end the failed experiment of open borders,"

Trump said. "Your countries are going to hell," he said, also attacking London's Mayor Sadiq Khan, the first Muslim mayor of a Western capital.

'Wreaking havoc'

Trump's second term has opened with a blaze of nationalist policies curbing cooperation with the rest of the world.

He has moved to pull the United States out of the World Health Organization and the UN climate pact, severely curtailed US development assistance and wielded sanctions against foreign judges over rulings he sees as violating sovereignty.

Opening the annual summit, UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres warned that aid cuts led by the United States were "wreaking havoc" in the world. "What kind of world will we choose? A world of raw power -- or a world of laws?" Guterres said.

On Ukraine, Trump will meet President Volodymyr Zelensky for the second time since he sat down in Alaska with Russian President Vladimir Putin on August 15 -- a summit that broke Moscow's isolation in the West

but yielded no breakthrough on Ukraine.

Despite Trump's insistence that he can broker a quick end to the war, Russia has not only kept up its barrage of attacks on Ukraine in the past month but rattled nerves with drone or air incursions in NATO members Poland, Estonia and Romania.

Trump said last week that Putin had "really let me down."

One of Trump's few other one-on-one meetings will be with Argentina's right-wing President Javier Milei, an ideological ally to whose government the United States is considering offering an economic lifeline.

Ahead of his visit to the UN district, swarming with heavily armed police and agents and crisscrossed with barricades and road closures, the US Secret Service said they had disrupted a "telecommunications-related" plot.

The Secret Service said it a weaponized farm of more than 100,000 cellphone SIM cards that was capable of blocking communications around the UN, and that it "nation-state threat actors" were involved.

Sebastian to promote “*Couture*” directed by French filmmaker Alice Winocour, which is competing for the festival’s top prize, the Golden Shell. She plays Maxine Walker, an American film director facing divorce and a serious illness while navigating Paris Fashion Week and embarking on a romance with a colleague, played by French actor Louis Garrel. The Oscar-winning actress -- honoured in 1999 for her role in “*Girl, Interrupted*” -- said she related personally to the struggles of her latest character. Jolie underwent a double mastectomy in 2013 and later had her ovaries and fallopian tubes removed to reduce her high genetic risk of cancer, which claimed the lives of her mother and grandmother.

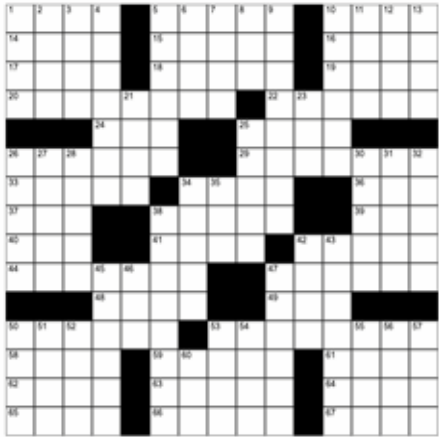

Dembele beats Yamal to Ballon d'Or

PSG's Ousmane Dembele wins the men's prize, while Aitana Bonmati claims the women's award

● Dembele helped PSG win Champions League

● Luis Enrique named best coach

● Donnarumma wins best goalkeeper

Paris Saint-Germain winger Ousmane Dembele won the Ballon d'Or on Monday as a reward for his starring role in the club's Champions League triumph last season, while Spain's Aitana Bonmati claimed the women's prize for the third year in a row.

Dembele, 28, edged out Barcelona sensation Lamine Yamal to succeed Manchester City and Spain midfielder Rodri, who took the trophy in 2024, as the winner of the most prestigious individual prize in football -- an award that for many years had been dominated by Lionel Messi and Cristiano Ronaldo.

Former Borussia Dortmund and Barcelona forward Dembele, who was part of the France team that won the World Cup in 2018, scored 35 goals in all competitions as PSG claimed a French league and cup double as well as winning the Champions League.

With Dembele converted into a centre-forward following Kylian Mbappe's departure for Real Madrid, PSG went on to hammer Inter Milan 5-0 in the final in Munich to win the European Cup for the first time in their history.

"I really don't have the words. It was an incredible season with PSG," an emotional Dembele

said on the stage at the Theatre du Chatelet in central Paris.

He added that his boss Luis Enrique -- who won the award for club coach of the year -- had been "like a father" to him.

"It is an individual trophy but it was really the collective that won it," insisted Dembele, who was one of nine members of the triumphant PSG team from last season to be nominated for the prize.

"The Ballon d'Or has not really been an objective for me in my career but I worked hard for the team to win the Champions League."

The 18-year-old Yamal, who was a teammate of Dembele's at Barcelona when he first broke through in 2023, did earlier win the Kopa Trophy for the best player aged under 21 -- the second year running he has taken that award.

Dembele was at the ceremony to pick up his prize while his PSG teammates were losing 1-0 in a Ligue 1 game in Marseille at the same time -- that match had been scheduled for Sunday but was put back 24 hours due to bad weather in the south of France.

Three in a row

Barcelona and Spain midfielder Bonmati won the women's prize by edging out her international teammate Mariona Caldentey, with whom she played in the Spain side who were beaten on penalties by England in the Women's Euro 2025 final.

Bonmati, 27, also lost the Women's Champions League final with her club last season, at the hands of Caldentey's Arsenal.

Bonmati was named player of the tournament at the Euros,

despite not starting either of Spain's first two matches as she recovered from a bout of viral meningitis.

"I am very proud," said Bonmati, who credited her teammates for their role in her personal triumph.

"I think I am here for the third consecutive time because of the teams I play in, so all of this is because of them."

Alessia Russo, one of the nominees from the triumphant England

European Championship team and also of Arsenal, came third.

Bonmati's run of three in a row follows back-to-back victories for her Barcelona and Spain teammate Alexia Putellas.

Norway's Ada Hegerberg and USA star Megan Rapinoe are the only other players to have won the Women's Ballon d'Or since it was introduced in 2018.

The Ballon d'Or is voted for by a panel of journalists, one from each of the top 100 countries in the FIFA world rankings for the men, and from the top 50 for the women.

Vicky Lopez, the 19-year-old forward who is a teammate of Bonmati's with Barcelona and Spain, was named best young women's player.

Gianluigi Donnarumma, who excelled in the PSG team that swept all aside last season before moving to Manchester City, claimed the Yashin trophy for best goalkeeper.

England's Euro winner Hannah Hampton claimed the best women's goalkeeper award, while her international manager Sarina Wiegman was named best women's coach.

Tough lessons learned

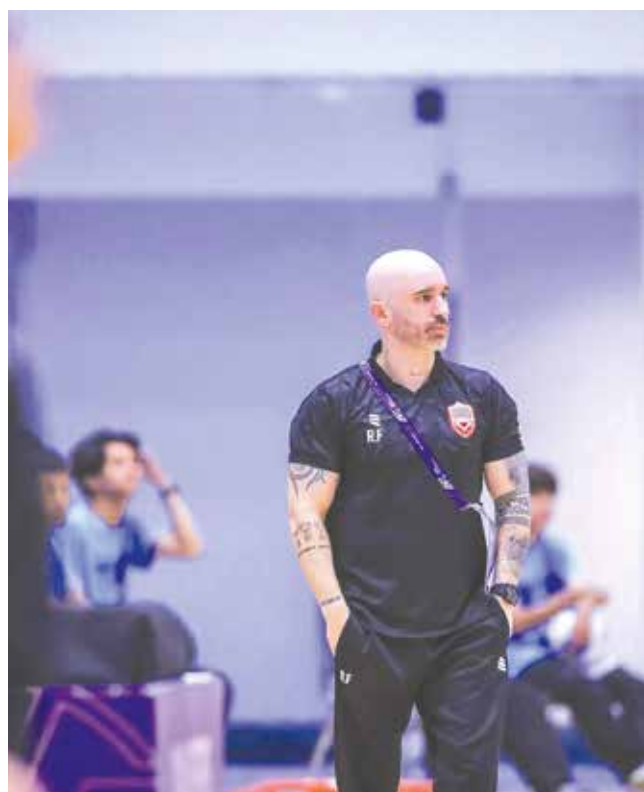

The SRMC is rounded out by the DD2 MAX category, which features three drivers in Raoul Sadi, Musaad Al Bassam, and Abdulqader Qassim.

Following this weekend’s action, the SRMC wraps up its 2025/2026 schedule with another double-header on 17 and 18 October, when rounds three and four will light up the track.

That will then set the stage for the new BRMC season, which is set to feature eight rounds, flagging off on October 31 and continuing until April of next year.

This weekend’s SRMC events are open to the public. Entrance to BIKC is free of charge.

“To maintain my focus, I deliberately keep myself away

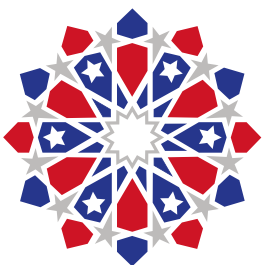
