Road safety boost

Security and speed cameras approved for Janabiyah Highway

he Northern Municipal Council has unanimously approved a proposal to install security and speed-enforcement cameras along Janabiyah Highway, covering avenues 91, 92 and 93 through to Madinat Salman, put forward by Third Constituency councillor Mohammed Saad Al Dosari.

The move follows repeated complaints from residents and regular users.

Al Dosari said the stretch between Janabiyah and Madinat Salman has seen rising speeds that put people at risk.

The councillor noted that limited patrol coverage by the General Directorate of Traffic makes offences harder to curb, and

Verdict set in drug money trial

Bahrain's First High Criminal Court has scheduled October 14 to deliver its verdict in the trial of a 26-year-old Asian man accused of laundering over BD38,000 (approximately \$100,000) in proceeds from drug sales through cryptocurrency transactions.

Investigators allege the defendant was part of an international drug trafficking network, tasked with receiving sales revenue and concealing its origins through various financial channels.

Authorities say he transferred the funds via exchange companies, ATM withdrawals, and bank deposits, before converting them into digital currencies that were later sold through an unwitting intermediary.
