Bottas tops incident-packed **Portuguese GP practice**

The Finn, who is 69 points adrift of Mercedes team-mate Lewis Hamilton in the title race, clocked a best lap in one out producing a competitive minute and 17.940 seconds to beat Red Bull's Max Verstappen by six-tenths of a second.

It was the sixth consecutive Grand Prix at which Bottas, who topped both of the day's sessions, was fastest in opening practice.


