## Bahrain and Turkmenistan review relations

# Penalty reform

New Press Law amendments propose replacing jail terms for publishing offences with BD10,000 fine

Prison terms for publishing offences would be scrapped under Press Law changes going to the Shura Council on Sunday.

The draft would license professional electronic media and give existing outlets six months to comply.

Fines would replace jail, with penalties up to BD10,000.

Professional online platforms would need licences. Foreign correspondents would require permission to work in Bahrain, with the arrangements to be set by royal decree.

Courts could suspend newspapers or block websites at the investigation stage where content is judged to threaten national security or public order.

### Notices

Media outlets, in print and online, must carry official notices on sovereignty, defence, security or health if received in time for release.

The ministry, working with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, may direct outlets not to publish certain material issued by foreign governments, with breaches punishable by fines.

A wide clause that would have allowed the Minister of Information to license media work and advertising activity outside current laws was removed after MPs questioned its scope and checks.

Platforms

The revised text defines ‘electronic media’, ‘electronic media platforms’ and ‘media and advertising activity’ to set the law’s reach, and exempts government-run platforms.

It also draws a line between regular, professional media work and personal accounts, leaving the latter outside its scope.

MPs passed the amendments on 8 May. The bill was sent back to the Services Committee in October 2023 for redrafting, which produced tighter limits on ministerial powers and a revised penalty scale.

### Jurisdiction

A proposal to move publishing-offence cases entirely to the civil courts was dropped; jurisdiction stays with the High Criminal Court.

The Ministry of Information says the draft balances freedom of opinion and expression with legal oversight.

It was prepared with Parliament’s Services Committee, working with the Public Prosecution, newspapers and the Bahrain Journalists Association (BJA), and drew written input from MPs, journalists and social-media figures.

### Aims

The National Institution for Human Rights supports the aims but asked the Shura Council to

revisit Parliament’s wording for Articles 71, 78 and 85 in light of Article 19 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and General Comment No. 34.

The BJA told the committee on 27 July that it had no further remarks.

Al Watan urged that any change rest on Article 23 of the Constitution, welcomed the removal of jail terms and called for clearer binding protections for the profession.

### Protections

Al Ayam backed the bill and Parliament’s changes, saying passage would strengthen legal protections for journalists, widen media freedoms and help Bahrain’s standing in global press-freedom and media-transparency rankings.

Committee papers say the draft is sound in constitutional and legal terms.

It would retitling Decree-Law 47 of 2002 as the Decree-Law on the Regulation of the Press and Electronic Media, replace ‘discipline’ with ‘accountability’ in Chapter Five of Part Three, and substitute ‘Kingdom’ for ‘State’ in Articles 19, 25 and 90.

### Provisions

It would update a set of provisions, add new definitions to Article 3, insert Articles 71 bis and 73 bis and a new paragraph in Article 90, and create a new Chapter Five bis on electronic media covering Articles 67 bis to 67 bis (9).

It would repeal Articles 70 and 72 and remove a cross-reference to Article 70 in Article 80. Existing electronic media sites would have six months to regularise their status once the law takes effect.

## Balance-of-payments surplus stands at BD858m in 2024

● **Current account forecast at 6.5pct of GDP**

BD858 million was Bahrain's 2024 balance-of-payments surplus, equal to 5.3 per cent of

GDP, with the current account forecast to reach about 6.5 per cent by year-end.

The rise was linked to stronger non-oil export takings and the growing weight of financial services and logistics.

Workers' remittances stayed firm. Foreign direct investment was steady.

**Banking assets**

GDP for 2024 was about \$471 billion. Non-oil output rose 3.8 per cent. Broad money (M3) was

up 5.2 per cent. Total banking assets stood near \$244.7 billion by April 2025.

The current account, the main part of the balance of payments,

tracks trade, investment and remittances between Bahrain and the rest of the world.

It has been used to steady the dinar and to ease pressure on foreign-exchange reserves.

**Projects**

A lasting surplus gives room to fund development projects without drawing on foreign reserves

or leaning on heavy borrowing, which helps credit standing and can draw long-term investors.

Keeping the line will rest on further growth in non-oil sectors, tighter production chains at home and a wider export base.

Lower non-essential imports and higher value added in local goods would also help the current account over time.

## Bahrain backs connectivity across GCC

● **Collaboration in transport, communications**

**Kuwait**

Bahrain supports all efforts to strengthen GCC integration in the transport and communications sectors.

This was emphasised by His Excellency Dr. Shaikh Abdulla bin Ahmed Al Khalifa, Minister of Transportation and Telecommunications, noting that such efforts contribute to economic growth, facilitate trade, and enhance the movement of individuals in line with Bahrain's Economic Vision 2030 and the GCC's vision for deeper connectivity and integration among member states.

Dr. Shaikh Abdulla was speaking as he participated in the 27th meeting of the GCC Ministerial Committee for Transport and Communications, held in the State of Kuwait.

**Cooperation**

Dr. Shaikh Abdulla also emphasised the importance of continued coordination and co-operation among GCC countries to achieve integration in the transport and communications sector, stressing that Bahrain remains committed to adopting initiatives and projects that enhance GCC connectivity and develop transport infrastructure, reinforcing its position as a regional logistics hub and gateway for international trade.

**Focus**

The meeting discussed enhancing the transport system among GCC countries, including road and maritime connectivity projects, the development of unified regulations for international land transport, and updates on the implementation of the GCC railway project.

The discussions also covered means to strengthen logistical integration and develop infrastructure that supports sustainable transport, contributing to economic growth and boosting trade activity.

**Fight against corruption**



The Deputy Interior Minister, Lt-General Adel bin Khalifa Al Fadhel, headed Bahrain's delegation to the 11th Meeting of the GCC Ministerial Committee on Combating Corruption, held in Kuwait, with the participation of senior officials responsible for integrity protection and anti-corruption agencies in GCC countries. He affirmed that the ministerial committee serves as a key pillar supporting joint GCC action to safeguard national resources and reinforce the principles of transparency and integrity, in line with the directives of Their Majesties and Highnesses, the leaders of the GCC countries.

## Parliamentarians attend IPU session

The session also discussed joint initiatives and projects between the IPU and national parliaments in the domains of development and sustainable peace.

His Highness Lieutenant-General Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, National Security Advisor and Commander of the Royal Guard, underscored the significance of the longstanding strategic partnership between the Kingdom of Bahrain and the US, which is founded on mutual respect and shared interests. He emphasised that the partnership continues to support efforts to enhance regional security, stability, and peace. HH Shaikh Nasser was speaking as he received a delegation from the Washington Institute for Near East Policy (WINEP), led by Dana Stroul, Director of Research. The delegation is currently visiting the Kingdom of Bahrain, in the presence of Deputy National Security Adviser Shaikh Khalid bin Ali Al Khalifa.

Bahraini woman acquitted of failing to disclose assets

The Third Minor Criminal Court has acquitted a Bahraini woman of charges that she failed to disclose her financial assets, after finding that she had never been properly notified of the legal procedures against her.

The verdict was confirmed by her defense lawyer, Sayed Ali Mahfood.

According to court documents, the Public Prosecution had accused the defendant of refusing to declare her assets in 2023 within the Kingdom of Bahrain.

In its detailed judgment, the court stated that after carefully

reviewing the case, its circumstances, and the evidence presented, it found the prosecution's case unconvincing.

The court said it was not satisfied with the proof relied upon by the Public Prosecution to establish the charge.

The court explained that under Law No. 22 of 2021 concerning the issuance of the Civil and Commercial Execution Law, Article 24 clearly outlines the disclosure obligations: "The person subject to enforcement shall, within seven days from the date of being notified or becoming aware of any enforcement procedures, disclose his or her assets to the extent necessary to cover the debt."

However, upon reviewing the

case file, the court found no evidence that the defendant had been officially notified of any enforcement procedures or had any knowledge of them.

It added that a letter from the Enforcement Directorate claiming that the defendant had been notified at the address stated in the execution order was insufficient since it did not specify a date or proof that the notice was actually received.

The court concluded that there was reasonable doubt regarding whether the defendant had ever been aware of the enforcement actions, and therefore, it could not be said that she had deliberately failed to disclose her assets.

# Search intensifies

Man missing after fishing boat collision with Coast Guard patrol

A man is missing after a fishing boat struck a Coast Guard patrol during an attempted stop off Bahrain's coast, the Public Prosecution said.

Two suspects have been remanded in custody, a child who was on board has been released, and the seized boat remains impounded while searches continue.

The patrol drew alongside the vessel to address suspected breaches when the crew tried

to flee.

Their boat veered towards the Coast Guard craft and hit it after the suspects cut the ropes to their bottom-trawl nets known locally as 'Karaf'.

Chase

One man fell into the sea and was helped back on board. The chase carried on until the boat

was intercepted.

It later emerged a second person had fallen into the water during the pursuit and could not be found.

Police searched the area but did not locate him.

According to the Prosecution, the suspects reported this only after they were detained, about an hour into the chase.

Investigators said the crew had not switched on navigation lights, had concealed the boat's plate and had failed to activate the Automatic Identification System.

On questioning, the suspects admitted they had not complied with the Coast Guard during monitoring and inspection and that they had been fishing with bottom-trawl gear.

The Prosecution has ordered the search for the missing person to continue and confirmed that inquiries are still in progress.

## Dialysis unit for Shaikh Jaber Health Centre sent to committee

The Northern Municipal Council has sent a plan to add a dialysis unit at the Sheikh Jaber AlAhmad Al-Sabah Health Center to the Services and Public Facilities Committee for study, before referral to the relevant authorities.

Council member Mohammed Al Doseri, who put the plan forward, said the move answers residents' needs as the Northern Governorate's population grows.

Distance

He added that the distance to current dialysis centres places a strain on patients, especially older people who travel long stretches for treatment.

Al Doseri said the unit would ease load on other hospitals and bring specialist care within the governorate.

He called for delivery without delay after a wait dating back to the fifth legislative term.

Council member Abdullah Al Qubaisi said the idea was raised in the previous term, before the Riffa dialysis centre opened, yet patients in the Northern Governorate still move between governorates for sessions.

Hope

He added: "The planned health centre in Salman City is supposed to include a dialysis unit, and we hope the Ministry of Health will set out its plan in this regard."

Council chairman Shubber Al Wedaei said the proposal warrants a full study with figures on patient numbers and local needs, to present a complete case before any formal recommendation is sent to the relevant bodies.

## BD86,000 school fund embezzlement case set for review

The Fifth High Criminal Appeals Court has ordered the formation of a three-member expert committee to prepare a detailed report in the appeal case of three employees from an industrial secondary school convicted of embezzling more than BD86,000 from school funds.

The court also suspended the execution of the first appellant's sentence until the final ruling, setting the next hearing for November 12.

The First High Criminal Court had earlier sentenced the



first defendant to 10 years in prison, fined him BD75,204.345, and ordered him to repay the same amount to the school.

The second defendant was sentenced to three years in prison, fined BD10,897.550, and or-

dered to return the same sum, while the third defendant received a one-year jail term, a BD790 fine, and was also ordered to return the embezzled amount.

During the previous hear-

ing, the Head of the Financial Crimes and Money Laundering Prosecution urged the court to impose the maximum penalties, emphasizing the seriousness of the crimes.

He stated that the case was supported by strong evidence, including witness testimonies from the investigation committee, the defendants' confessions, and forensic findings from the first defendant's device and financial analysis reports.

Investigations by the Anti-Corruption Directorate revealed that the first and third defendants handled the school's financial dealings with suppliers and traders.



# Greener growth

Works Minister announces registration opening for Innovation in Irrigation Solution Competition

The Ministry of Works has announced the launch of the Innovation in Irrigation Solution Competition.

His Excellency Ibrahim bin Hassan Al Hawaj, Minister of Works, said that registration for the competition is open from October 23 to November 6, with idea submissions due by February 10, 2026, via the ministry's official website [www.works.gov.bh](http://www.works.gov.bh).

The competition is in line with the directives of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

It aims to encourage creative ideas and solutions that optimise the use of surplus treated water, enhance efficiency in agriculture and afforestation, protect the environment, and expand irrigation networks in support of the Kingdom of Bahrain's comprehensive development goals under the leadership of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa.

**Targets**

Al Hawaj said that the competition targets individuals, engineering firms, contractors,

universities, research centres, and other institutions to submit practical innovations that improve water use efficiency and ensure balanced irrigation of trees and crops.

He noted that this will support agricultural and urban beautification efforts across Bahrain.

The Minister added that the initiative also aims to increase the use of surplus treated water in irrigating public parks and expand its application in new projects, offering economic and sustainable irrigation solutions that contribute to environmental and water sustainability goals.

**Projects**

He underscored that smart irrigation solutions are expected to enhance water management and reduce consumption in road and public area projects.

The Works Minister ex-

plained that the ministry, in collaboration with relevant authorities, has established regulatory mechanisms to ensure the competition meets its objectives of developing and expanding irrigation networks using advanced technology.

He emphasised the ministry's commitment to integrating infrastructure and environmental projects to achieve sustainable development.

**Structure**

Regarding the competition structure, Al Hawaj said it includes two main categories: one focuses on innovative irrigation solutions in specific locations such as King Hamad Highway, Gulf of Bahrain Avenue, and Sheikh Jaber Al Ahmad Al Sabah Highway; the other involves selecting an area without treated water services to assess its needs and propose integrated solutions.

Entries will be evaluated based on economic feasibility, cost, durability, sustainability, innovation, creativity, and design quality to ensure high standards and support national efforts to sustain water resources and increase green areas.

News in brief

◆ **Brazilian President** Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva, who turns 80 next week, confirmed Thursday he will run for a fourth term in office in 2026 elections. “I’m about to turn 80 years old, but you can be sure I have the same energy I had when I was 30. And I will run for a fourth term in Brazil,” Lula said at a joint press conference with his Indonesian counterpart Prabowo Subianto in Jakarta. Lula is on a state visit to Indonesia as he seeks to expand ties in a country Brazil sees as a fellow rising economic power with similar perspectives on global issues. “I’m telling you this because we’re still going to see each other many times,” Lula told Subianto. Lula had hinted in recent months at a fourth-term run, without confirming he would be a candidate.

◆ **Turkey is in talks** with its other countries over its potential participation in an international Gaza peacekeeping mission with its military “ready” if needed, a defence ministry source said Thursday. “We are continuing contact with our counterparts regarding our participation in the task force to be established in Gaza,” the source said. The task force will operate as part of the US-led Civil-Military Coordination Centre (CMCC) for monitoring the ceasefire, which is based in the southern Israeli town of Kiryat Gat and was inaugurated on Tuesday by US Vice President JD Vance. “The CMCC has been established to facilitate the formation of the Gaza task force. Under this structure, an International Stabilisation Force (ISF) will be set up that will be in charge of monitoring the ceasefire and preventing conflict,” the source said. “For now, nothing is confirmed about the level of Turkey’s participation in such structures but it will probably be confirmed next week.”

◆ **The Colombian** government has asked the United States to stop attacking vessels in the Pacific and the Caribbean as part of an operation that Washington says is targeting drug smuggling. US Secretary of Defense Pete Hegseth on Wednesday announced strikes on two alleged drug-running boats in the Pacific that left five people dead. The strikes, which Hegseth said were carried out in international waters, bring the total number of such US attacks to at least nine, with 37 people dead, according to US figures. “Colombia calls on the US government to cease these attacks and urges it to respect the norms dictated by international law,” the foreign ministry said in a statement Wednesday evening. The government of leftist President Gustavo Petro, who has been embroiled in a war of words with Trump, “rejects the destruction by the United States of a vessel allegedly related to drug trafficking in the Pacific Ocean,” the statement added.

India plans tightening AI rules to stem deepfake surge

India has proposed sweeping new regulations to govern artificial intelligence, aiming to curb a surge in misinformation and deepfake videos in the world’s most populous nation.

The Ministry of Information Technology announced the proposed amendments, citing “the growing misuse of technologies used for the creation or generation of synthetic media”.

“Recent incidents of deepfake audio, videos and synthetic media going viral on social platforms have demonstrated the potential of generative AI to create convincing falsehoods,” a briefing note from the ministry issued late Wednesday read.

“Such content can be weaponised to spread misinformation, damage reputations, manipulate or influence elections, or commit financial fraud,” it added.

The government has already launched an online portal called Sahyog -- meaning “cooperate” in Hindi -- aimed at automating the process of sending government notices to content intermediaries such as X and Facebook.

“These proposed amendments provide a clear legal basis for labelling, traceability, and accountability,” it added,

saying it would “strengthen the due diligence obligations” of social media intermediaries.

Major AI firms looking to court users in the world’s fifth-largest economy have made a flurry of announcements about expansion this year.

This month, US startup Anthropic said it plans to open an office in India, with its chief executive Dario Amodei meeting Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

OpenAI has said it will open an India office, with its chief Sam Altman noting that ChatGPT usage in the country had grown fourfold over the past year.

AI firm Perplexity also announced a major partnership in July with Indian telecom giant Airtel.

Israeli minister regrets ‘unfortunate’ remarks about Saudi Arabia

He had earlier told Saudi Arabia it could “keep riding camels”

Israel’s far-right Finance Minister Bezalel Smotrich yesterday expressed regret for what he called his “unfortunate” remarks about Saudi Arabia.

He had earlier told Saudi Arabia it could “keep riding camels” if it tried to demand an independent Palestinian state in return for normalising relations with Israel.

“My statement regarding Saudi Arabia was unfortunate, and I regret any offence it may have caused,” Smotrich said in a video statement he posted on X. But he said that he also expected Saudis not to offend Israel.

*“Keep riding camels on the sand in the Saudi desert; we’ll keep truly developing -- with an economy, a society, a state and all the great and wonderful things we know how to do”, Smotrich said, prompting sharp responses in Israel.*

“I’m also not willing to accept hypocrisy. Just as I don’t intend to offend the Saudis, I expect from them not to offend me, or rather, offend us,” he said. “And anyone who denies the living and very deep connection we have to the regions of our homeland in Judea and Samaria, offends us,” he added, using the Israeli Biblical term for the

occupied West Bank. Smotrich, who lives in a West Bank settlement, is an outspoken supporter of annexing the Palestinian territory, which has been occupied by Israel since 1967.

Earlier on Thursday, he had told a conference in Israel that, “if Saudi Arabia tells us normalisation in exchange for a Palestinian state, friends, no thank you”. “Keep riding camels on the

sand in the Saudi desert; we’ll keep truly developing -- with an economy, a society, a state and all the great and wonderful things we know how to do”, Smotrich said, prompting sharp responses in Israel.

Opposition leader Yair Lapid had swiftly denounced the comments.

“To our friends in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the Middle East, Smotrich does not represent the State of Israel”, Lapid posted on X in Arabic, later calling for him to apologise.

Former defence minister Benny Gantz, another opposition figure, said that Smotrich’s comments “indicate ignorance, and a lack of internalisation of his responsibility as a senior minister in the government and cabinet”. Saudi Arabia’s own normalisation talks with Israel were frozen after Hamas’s October 2023 attack sparked the Gaza war.

Trump says would pull US support if Israel annexes West Bank

President Donald Trump said Israel would lose its crucial backing from the United States if it annexes the occupied West Bank, in a Time magazine interview published yesterday.

Trump’s comments, which Time said were made by telephone on October 15, were published as both Vice President JD Vance and Secretary of State Marco Rubio warned against any annexation.

“It won’t happen. It won’t happen because I gave my word to the Arab countries. And you can’t do that now. We’ve had great Arab support,” Trump said when asked what the consequences would be for Israel if it did so.

“Israel would lose all of its support from the United States if that happened.”

Trump also told Time that he believed Saudi Arabia would join the Abraham Accords, which normalize relations between Israel and Arab states, by the end of the year.

“Yes, I do. I do,” he said when asked if he thought Riyadh would join in that timeframe.

“See they had a problem. They had a Gaza problem and they had an Iran problem. Now they don’t have those two problems,” he said, referring to Israel’s war in Gaza and Iran’s nuclear program, which US airstrikes targeted earlier this year.

Trump then said that he would be “making a decision” on whether Israel should release high-profile Palestinian prisoner Marwan Barghouti as part of peace moves.

Barghouti -- from Hamas’s ri-

val, the Fatah movement -- was among the Palestinian prisoners Hamas wanted to see released as part of the Gaza deal, according to Egyptian state-linked media.

Trump has dispatched a stream of top officials to Israel in recent days to shore up the fragile Gaza

ceasefire he brokered earlier this month.

But as Vance wrapped up his three-day visit and Rubio arrived, Israeli lawmakers advanced two bills paving the way for West Bank annexation.

Vance said it was a “very stupid

political stunt and I personally take some insult to it.”

As Rubio left Washington he warned Israel against annexing the West Bank, saying steps taken by parliament and settler violence threatened the Gaza truce.

# 'No basic means to live'

Exhausted Gazans struggle to rebuild

AFP | Gaza City, Palestinian Territories

A fragile ceasefire has brought respite to Gazans exhausted by two years of fighting, but even without the daily bombing they are struggling to live amid the catastrophic destruction wrought by the war.

The reconstruction task ahead is enormous, given that vast swathes of the Palestinian territory were flattened during Israel's military campaign and most of the population were displaced at least once.

Many in the southern city of Khan Yunis have now been told by Israeli forces to move again to avoid the so-called Yellow Line, behind which Israeli troops are stationed under the ceasefire deal with Hamas.

"I am tired of displacement, very tired. I prefer to die, just like my son. It is better for the dead," Riyadh Abu Anza said.

AFP footage showed Palestinians carrying buckets, brooms and backpacks through a sandy neighbourhood of rubble and tents.

Umm Mohammed Muhareb, who was displaced to the coastal area of Al-Mawasi, said that fear

lingered despite the fighting largely halting.

"The situation now is calmer than before," the 45-year-old told AFP.

"We don't hear the sounds of bombing like we used to, but the fear is still in our hearts, because we never know when things might get worse again".

The truce faced its toughest test on Sunday, when Israeli forces unleashed a wave of strikes in Gaza after two soldiers were killed.

The strikes killed at least 45 Palestinians, according to the health ministry in the Hamas-run territory.

There have also been violent

incidents since, with Nasser Hospital reporting one person killed in an Israeli drone strike in the Khan Yunis area on Thursday.

The Israeli military told AFP that it conducted a strike that killed a "terrorist who was approaching troops" after crossing the yellow line.

## Zelensky hopes for 'positive decision' on EU use of Russian assets

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky expressed hope yesterday that the European Union would move forward with plans to help Ukraine with a mammoth new "reparations loan" funded by frozen Russian assets.

Zelensky was in Brussels for talks with EU leaders, who dis-

cussed plans to hand 140 billion euros (\$162 billion) to Kyiv over the next few years, to keep it afloat as the war with Russia drags on.

"I hope that they will make a political decision, positive decision in one or another way to help Ukraine with funds," Zelensky told a press conference after the meeting.

The European Commission,

the EU's executive, has floated a complex scheme that would see Ukraine pay back the money only once Russia coughs up for the damages it has caused.

The move is fraught with legal and political perils. Belgium, where the bulk of the money is held, has demanded guarantees that the rest of the bloc will share any liabilities if Russia

takes the matter to court.

EU officials are hoping that the EU's 27 leaders will give a preliminary go-ahead on Thursday for the commission to draw up a formal legal proposal for the loan.

"I think that the dialogue was really, maybe not simple, but it was very good," Zelensky said of the talks. "Really we count on decisions on this topic."

## Oil prices surge as Trump hits Russian crude with sanctions

Oil prices jumped more than 5% yesterday after US President Donald Trump targeted Russia's key oil industry with new sanctions in a bid to end the war in Ukraine.

The international benchmark contract, Brent North Sea crude, jumped 5.4% while West Texas Intermediate was up 5.7%.

Trump on Wednesday announced new sanctions against Russia's two largest oil companies, Rosneft and Lukoil, saying his peace talks with President Vladimir Putin were not going "anywhere".

The move was joined by another round of punishments by the European Union as part of attempts to pressure Moscow

### Russia says immune to new US oil sanctions

Moscow, Russia

Russia said yesterday that new US sanctions on its oil industry risked hurting diplomatic efforts to end the Ukraine war, and that it had developed a "strong immunity" to them.

"We view this step as being entirely counterproductive, including in terms of signal-

ling the need to achieve meaningful negotiated solutions to the Ukrainian conflict," Russian foreign ministry spokes-

woman Maria Zakharova told a weekly briefing.

"Our country has developed a strong immunity to Western restrictions and will continue to confidently develop its economic potential, including its energy potential," she added.

Russia's foreign ministry

warned that the sanctions risked jeopardising diplomatic efforts to end the Ukraine war, and that it had developed a "strong immunity" to them.

Trump had resisted imposing new restrictions against Moscow for months, but his patience snapped after plans for a new summit with Putin in Budapest collapsed.

He had already claimed that India agreed to cut its Russian oil purchases as part of a US trade deal, something New Delhi has not confirmed.

Bloomberg on Thursday cited unnamed Indian refinery sources as saying flows of Russian crude were expected to plunge almost to zero as a result of the US sanctions.

"As Rosneft and Lukoil pro-

duce around four million barrels per day between them, if India were to reduce its purchases, that would severely hamper Russia's ability to fund its war," said Trade Nation analyst David Morrison.

Trump in August raised tariffs on Indian exports to the United States to 50%, with Trump's aides accusing India of fuelling Russia's war in Ukraine.

Elsewhere Thursday, major stock markets diverged as traders assessed US-China trade prospects and another batch of mixed company earnings.

Beijing said it would hold tariff talks with Washington from Friday, tempering trade fears over reports of potential US curbs on software exports to China.

## No reduction in Gaza hunger since truce: WHO

Geneva, Switzerland

The World Health Organization said yesterday there had been little improvement in the amount of aid going into Gaza since a ceasefire took hold -- and no observable reduction in hunger.

"The situation still remains catastrophic because what's entering is not enough," WHO chief Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus told an online press briefing from the UN health agency's Geneva headquarters.

Since the US-brokered ceasefire between Israel and Hamas came into effect on October 10, there has been "no dent in hunger, because there is not enough food", he warned.

Israel repeatedly cut off aid to the Gaza Strip during the war, exacerbating dire humanitarian conditions. The United Nations said that caused a famine in parts of the Palestinian territory.

Since the start of 2025, 411 people are known to have died from the effects of malnutrition in Gaza, including 109 children, Richard Peeperkorn, the WHO's representative in the Palestinian territories, told reporters.

"All of these deaths were preventable," stressed Teresa Zakaria, WHO's unit head for humanitarian and disaster action. More than 600,000 people in Gaza were currently facing "catastrophic levels of food insecurity", she added.

But while the agreement brokered by US President Donald Trump provides for the entry of 600 trucks per day, Tedros said currently only between 200 and 300 trucks were getting in daily.

And "a good number of the trucks are commercial", he said, when many people in the territory have no resources to buy goods.

"That reduces the beneficiary size," he said.

Bahrain’s hosting of the 3rd Asian Youth Games continued yesterday with its first international boxing event, a milestone years in the making for national coach Tony Davis. Momentum continued as Japan’s Kira Hasegawa won 4-1 over Jordan’s Osama Al-Khalidi, China’s Zhang Zhengkun defeated Thailand’s Chainarong Siwa 3-2. The crowd were particularly impressed in Iran’s

day, with track, field, and team events providing early clues to which nations could dominate the remaining week of the tournament. Following an unforgettable opening ceremony, athletes from across Asia were in full swing, with China, Thailand, Malaysia, Iraq, and the Philippines all making their mark.

Thailand proved unstoppable in table tennis, claiming multiple gold medals across singles and doubles. In the Girls' Singles final, Noppasorn Jaikum edged out China's Jiang Xinyan 2-0 to lift gold, while Indonesia's Syifa Zahrotus secured bronze. On the boys' side, Thammanun Chokkittikul overcame Iraq's Nooruldeen Khammas 2-0, leaving Kuwait's Naser Alsaqer with bronze. Doubles action was equally compelling: Thailand's Phatrawan Simawong and Chiratchayaphon Kenkhunthod defeated China's Jiang Xinyan and Chen Jiayi to claim Girls' Doubles gold, with the Philippines' Crystal Cariño and Nicole Tabucol taking bronze. In Boys' Doubles, Iraq struck gold through Abulfadhel Al Elayawi and Nooruldeen Khammas, while Malaysia secured bronze. Mixed Doubles saw Thailand continue their dominance, defeating Iraq for gold, with Malaysia rounding out the podium.
