Cabinet commends Kingdom's education professionals' efforts

His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, has directed the activation of the consolidated system for internal auditing and for the guide to be circulated across all ministries

and government agencies.

This came as the Cabinet yesterday activated a new unified system for the internal auditing of government agencies to ensure greater oversight over them, and is based on specific audit frameworks.

The Cabinet also adopted the unified guide for the internal auditing of government agencies.

It is a project of the Government Priority Framework, with the aim of further strengthening the government's internal audit capacity, assist internal auditors adhere to the best professional

auditing standards and practices, and strengthen public sector's internal audit framework.

This was discussed during yesterday's weekly Cabinet meeting chaired by HRH the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

Education process

To mark the International Day of Education, the Cabinet commended the Kingdom's education professionals, thanking them for their efforts to best continue the education process

in exceptional circumstances throughout the COVID-19 global pandemic.

The Cabinet affirmed Bahrain's support for Saudi Arabia and the UAE as they respond to the terror attacks and implement measures to protect their national security.

It welcomed the statement by the United Nations Security Council and the League of Arab States that condemned the attack on the UAE.

Bahrain to join growing Gulf economies this year

The economies in the six-member Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) will grow at their fastest paces in several years, according to a Reuters poll of economists who cautioned the risk to that outlook was skewed to the downside.

Economic growth in Bahrain, Qatar and Oman is expected to average between three to four per cent for 2022. If realised, that would be the best these countries have witnessed in several



Slowly but surely, Bahrain's economy is bouncing back

years.

"Despite relatively tight fiscal policy, and some external headwinds, we expect the GCC economies to see faster growth in 2022 as they continue to build on the progress made last year," said Khatija Haque, head of research and chief economist at Emirates NBD.

"While the outlook for 2022 remains broadly constructive, there is still a high degree of uncertainty, especially with regards to the evolution of the coronavirus

pandemic."

The January 11-19 poll of 25 economists forecast all six economies in the GCC would grow faster this year than was expected three months ago.

Saudi Arabia was predicted to top the list with growth of 5.7 per cent, followed by Kuwait and the UAE with 5.3 per cent and 4.8 per cent respectively.

As the global economy deals with the prospect of persistent inflation, the region's price outlook was modest, but varied.

Applicants must be Bahraini nationals, aged between

18 and 55, have good conduct and have not been convicted for a felony or a misdemeanor that breaches honor or trust, and medically fit for military service in the reserve force and successfully pass the medical examination prescribed according to the BDF military medical committees. The age limit does not apply to technicians and specialists.

Applicants should fill in the form available on the website, the BDF added.

In the first stage, registration will only be for male citizens, whose relatives are members of BDF or the National Guard.

COVID-19 Rapid Test Protocol updates

Following the emergence of the Omicron variant Updates have been made to the COVID-19 Rapid Test Protocol to include swabs for both the throat and nose

Follow the instructions provided with the COVID-19 rapid testing device

How to use the device?

Step 1 Swipe the soft tip of the swab across the very back of the throat behind the Arch by opening mouth wide and stick out the tongue, ensure to swab the sides of the arch. Don't swab the tongue or teeth.

Step 2 Using the same swab, place tip of the cotton swab inside nostril and gently wipe around inside of the nose, no force needed & repeat it to other nostril.

The result is **negative** if one line appears in area (C).

The result is **positive** if two lines appear in the (C) / (T) areas. If so, a PCR test must be performed.

Note: The test shall be considered **invalid** and must be repeated if no line appears in area (C).

Note

You should **not** be eating or drinking 30 mins before the procedure to yield reliable result.

The used tools must be sealed in a **plastic bag** and kept outside for 3 days. After 3 days, it can be treated as normal waste.

You must report the result via the "BeAware" application

- Muharraq Drive-Through Testing Centre, near the King Hamad University Hospital
- Southern Governorate Drive-Through Testing Centre, near the Bahrain Centre for Strategic, International, and Energy Studies (Derasat)
- Northern Governorate Drive-Through Testing Centre in Salman City

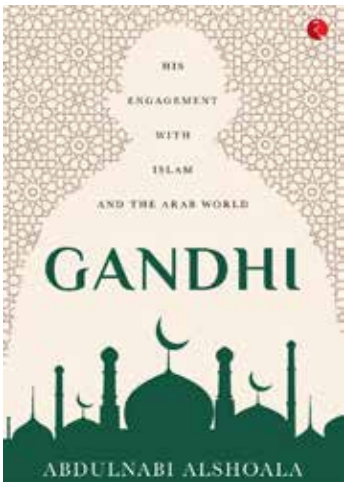
2. A memorandum by the Minister of Industry, Commerce and Tourism regarding the electronic transformation of 22 services within the Ministry's Industrial Development Sector.

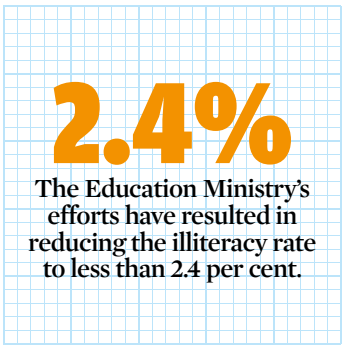

Lebanon's response to confidence-building measures proposed by Kuwait will be ready before Saturday, Foreign Minister Abdallah Bou Habib told reporters yesterday. Two US aircraft carrier groups have entered the disputed South China Sea for training, the Department of Defense said on Monday as Taiwan reported a new Chinese air force incursion at the top of the waterway including a fearsome new electronic warfare jet. The South China Sea and self-governing Taiwan are two of China's most sensitive territorial issues and both are frequent areas of tension between the United States and China. US Navy ships routinely sail close to Chinese-occupied islands in the South China Sea to challenge Chinese sovereignty claims, as well as through the Taiwan Strait, to Beijing's anger.

The United Arab Emirates yesterday said it had foiled another Houthi missile attack following last week's deadly assault on the Gulf state.

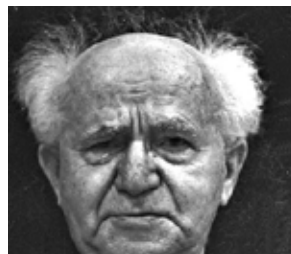

Ex-Pope Benedict acknowledges faulty testimony in German abuse case

Former Pope Benedict XVI
acknowledged on Monday
he had been at a 1980 meeting
over a sexual abuse case when
archbishop of Munich, saying
he mistakenly told German
investigators he was not there.

A report released last week
on abuse in the archdiocese
from 1945 to 2019 said then
Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger
failed to take action against
clerics in four cases of alleged
abuse when he was its arch-
bishop between 1977-1982.

At Thursday's news confer-
ence in Munich, lawyers who
investigated the abuse contest-
ed an assertion by Benedict
in an 82-page statement that
he did not recall attending a
meeting in 1980 to discuss the
case of an abuser priest.

They said this contradicted
documents in their possession.

In a statement on Monday,
the former pope's personal
secretary, Archbishop Georg
Ganswein, said Benedict did
attend the meeting but the
omission "was the result of an
oversight in the editing of the
statement" and "not done out
of bad faith."

Ganswein said no decision
was made at the 1980 meeting
about a new assignment for
the priest but only a request
to provide him with accom-
modation during therapeutic
treatment.

to explain how the error hap-
pened after he finishes exam-
ining the nearly 2,000-page
report, sent electronically last
Thursday.

Benedict, 94, infirm and liv-
ing in the Vatican, resigned the
papacy in 2013.

Fourth COVID vaccine shot raises resistance to serious illness for over-60s: Israel

Iran rules out US prisoner release as nuclear talks precondition

Iran yesterday ruled out
any US preconditions for
reviving a 2015 nuclear deal,
including the release of Amer-
ican prisoners held by the Is-
lamic Republic while blaming
Washington for the slow pace
of talks between Tehran and
world powers in Vienna.

The lead US nuclear negotia-
tor said on Sunday the United
States was unlikely to strike an
agreement with Iran to revive
the nuclear pact unless Teh-
ran released four US citizens
Washington says it is holding
hostage.

"Iran has never accepted any
preconditions ... The US offi-
cial's comments on the release
of US prisoners in Iran is for
domestic use," Iranian Foreign
Ministry spokesman Saeed
Khatibzadeh told a weekly
news conference.

Iran has been in talks with

world powers since April to re-
instate the deal. In 2018, then-
US President Donald Trump
had ditched the agreement and
reimposed crippling sanctions
on Tehran, prompting Iran to
gradually breach limits of the
deal on its nuclear programme.

The two sides have done
prisoner swaps in the past.
Navy veteran Michael White,
detained in 2018, returned
home in June 2020 in return
for the United States allowing
an Iranian-American physici-
an Majid Taheri to visit Iran.
White said he contracted COV-
ID-19 while in detention.

In December 2018, Wash-
ington and Tehran worked on
a prisoner exchange in which
Iran freed US citizen Xiyue
Wang, who had been held for
three years on spying charges,
and the United States freed
Iranian Massoud Soleimani,
who faced charges of violating
US sanctions on Iran.

Tim Allen to star in new 'Santa Clause' series

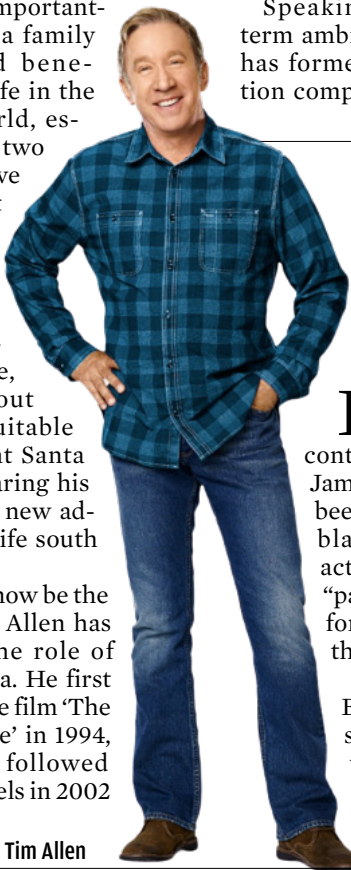

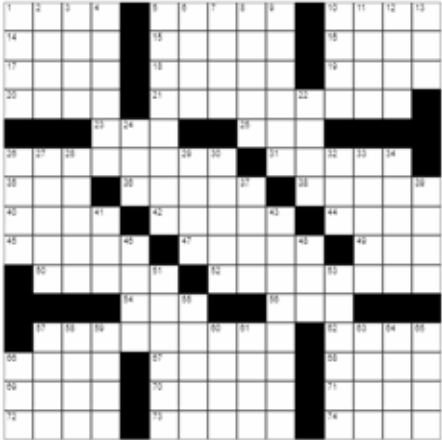

The Bahrain Rotax MAX Challenge (BRMC) kicked off its 2022 season over the weekend at Bahrain International Karting Circuit (BIKC) in Sakhir, and there was plenty of hotly contested racing right from the get-go in the Kingdom's premier national karting championship.

Taking the honours in the first round were Najashi Rashdan in

the Senior MAX category, Luca Kane Houghton in the Junior MAX, Khaled Alnajjar in the Mini MAX and Yousif Alghaith in the Micro MAX class.

All the action was held along BIKC's 1.414-kilometre CIK-FIA track, with the Kingdom's top karters of various ages and nationalities competing in Ro-

tax-powered karts.

In the Senior MAX division, Najashi Rashdan secured first place following a thrilling Final that saw him take the lead only on the penultimate lap.

Rashdan started the race in fourth from 10 participants on the grid, with chief rival Fahad Almuqla on pole. Almuqla held

on to his position at the front for much of the 15-lap sprint, but on lap 14, Rashdan was able to gain two places—from third to first—and eventually kept up the pace until the chequered flag, which he took in a winning time of 13 minutes 38.355 seconds.

Almuqla had to settle for second, finishing 1.193 seconds behind, while Lewis Smith completed the podium-placers in third 2.089s back.

Shaikha Haya bint Saqr Al Khalifa was classified fourth

in class and Abdulrahman Waleed came fifth, while Yusuf Mathkooor, Faisal Jamsheer and Suliman Alkandari were sixth through eighth, respectively.

Meanwhile, Luca Kane Houghton won the Junior MAX category by the narrowest of margins in the group's Final.

Luca Kane started from third on the grid and was able to charge to the front on lap two, taking over for pole-sitter Tye Mejia. Luca Kane then had to buckle down the rest of the way as fellow-competitor Mohammad Wally gave him a furious fight to the finish.

At the chequered flag, only 0.434s separated the pair, with Luca Kane winning in 13:53.357 after 15 laps. Gracie Rose Grantham also put in a strong challenge, ending the race behind Wally in third just 1.047s from Luca Kane.

Completing the top eight amongst the 11 Junior MAX participants were Tye Mejia, Mohammed Alhasan, Vedant Menon, Musaad Albassam and Abdulqader Qasem.

In the Mini MAX class, Khaled Alnajjar claimed an outright victory from pole, securing the chequered flag in 8:57.954 after nine laps. Alnajjar was classified 7.446s ahead of runner-up Shaikh Rashid bin Salman Al Khalifa.

In the Micro MAX category, Yousif Alghaith took first place in 10:03.365 after nine laps of racing.

Following all the races, the winners were presented their respective trophies in podium ceremonies attended by officials from Bahrain International Circuit, BIKC and the Bahrain Motor Federation.

The BRMC is set to feature seven rounds in its 2022 season. Rounds two and three are set to be held on February 4 and 5, while the fourth round is set to take place on February 26. Rounds five and six will then be held on March 11 and 12, setting the stage for the season-finale on March 25.

Between 2006 and 2008, Calzaghe was ranked by The Ring Magazine as one of the world's Top Ten active boxers, reaching a peak ranking of third

in January 2009.

He retired in February 2009 with an undefeated record of 46-0 with 32 knockouts and as a reigning world champion.

As of 2021, BoxRec.com ranks Calzaghe as the 13th greatest pugilist of all time, as well as the greatest European boxer to ever lace up a pair of gloves.

Organized by KHK Boxing and sanctioned by the Bahrain Boxing Federation, "Royal Rumble" is set to take place at the Bahrain Rugby Football Club in Janabiya, which will also be attended by Calzaghe's fellow former world titleholder Darren Barker.

Bahrain book Asian handball semis berth

Senior men's national team defeat counterparts from Iraq 34-31 to secure final four ticket in Asian championship and also clinch a spot in the 2023 IHF World Men's Handball Championship

Bahrain defeated Iraq 34-31 last night to secure their berths in the semi-finals of the 2022 Asian Men's Handball Championship in Saudi Arabia.

The win was their second in a row in Group II of the tournament's main round, being held in Dammam, and it also ensured their berth in next year's IHF World Men's Handball Championship, to be jointly hosted by Poland and Sweden.

The top five teams from this continental competition book their berths in the worlds, and Bahrain have earned one of the spots having made it into the final four.

Also joining the Bahrainis as through to the semis yesterday was Iran, who narrowly beat Kuwait 27-26. The Iranians also claimed their second win in as many contests but are behind Bahrain on the group standings.

The two top-placers meet tomorrow in their final clash of the main round. The victor will march through to the next stage as Group II winners and take on the Group I runners-up in the last four. The losers finish as Group II runners-up and will play the winners of Group I, which features defending champions Qatar, South Korea, Saudi Arabia and Uzbekistan.

The semis are scheduled for Saturday.

In Bahrain's win last night, they led 18-15 at the half, but needed to grind it out over the final 30 minutes to come away with the result.

Iraq were resilient and well-prepared for the contest. They were able to tie the proceedings early in the second half at 22-

eight saves in the game.

The Bahrainis, coached by Icelandic tactician Aron Kristjansson, are still undefeated in the championship and will be looking to ride their momentum all the way to the finals.

The nationals are gunning for their very first Asian title. In the previous edition of this competition held in January of 2020, Bahrain finished fourth overall. Bahrain have been runners-up four times in the last six editions and bronze-medallists once.

Next year's world championship will be the fifth time the national team will feature in the sport's premier global event.

They first competed in 2011, and then also in three successive editions in 2017, 2019 and 2021. Last year, they finished 21st overall, but made history after making it past the preliminary stages for the first time.

all, but Bahrain's experience proved to be decisive in the end.

National team skipper Hussain Al Sayyad top scored in the contest, finishing the game with nine goals. Rising talent Qassim Qambar added five goals, while fellow-youngster Mohammed Mohammed scored four.

The draw for the competition was held Sunday night by the Arab Volleyball Federation (AVF), which is headed by Bahrain Volleyball Association president Shaikh Ali bin Mohammed Al Khalifa. The event took place at the AVF headquarters at Isa Sports City in Riffa.

Dar Kulaib are one of 19 teams from 12 countries participating in the tournament, which is scheduled for February 15 to 27.

The other sides in the Bahrainis' division are Seeb of Oman, Peshmerga SC from Iraq, and a club from Yemen.

Group A consists of clubs from Tunisia, Kuwait, Algeria,

Al Ahly from Egypt are the defending champions but are not participating this year. They won the last edition of the tournament, which was held in February of 2020.

Last year's event was not held

due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Dar Kulaib are one of the top volleyball clubs in Bahrain. Last year, they were crowned back-to-back champions of the prestigious Crown Prince's Volleyball Cup. Their team is set to be spearheaded by top talents Ali Ebrahim, Mahmood Abdulwahed and Mohamed Yaqoob, among others.

Tetchy Medvedev fells stubborn Cressy as Sabalenka crashes out

Tetchy title favourite Daniil Medvedev was pushed to the limit before reaching the last eight of the Australian Open yesterday but women's world number two Aryna Sabalenka crashed out after an epic that finished on the stroke of midnight.

Men's fourth seed Stefanos Tsitsipas survived a late-night fright to reach his third Australian Open quarter-final after a pulsating day of marathon matches, frayed tempers and searing heat at Melbourne Park.

Tsitsipas was staring at defeat, trailing two sets to one before clawing back to beat the 20th seed Taylor Fritz 4-6, 6-4, 4-6, 6-3, 6-4 in 3hr 23min of classic punch and counter-punch tennis on Rod

Laver Arena.

"It was an epic match. I gave everything out on the court today, I am very proud of myself with the way I fought," said the 23-year-old Tsitsipas who will now play Italian Jannik Sinner, who beat Australia's Alex de Minaur 7-6 (7/3), 6-3, 6-4.
