Bahrain shines at WEF 2025 P2

The high-level delegation from Bahrain, led by His Highness Shaikh Isa bin Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Isa bin Salman Educational Charitable Trust and Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Labour Fund, successfully concluded its participation in the 2025 Annual Meeting of the World Economic Forum. The event took place in Davos, Switzerland, from January 20 to 24, under the theme "Cooperation for the Smart Age." The forum saw extensive participation from the delegation, with His Highness Shaikh Isa bin Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa and his team engaging in bilateral meetings. His Highness also attended several high-level strategic discussions and sessions, where he highlighted Bahrain's efforts and achievements in diversifying its economy, promoting sustainability, and fostering innovation.

Macron hails Bahrain's role in regional stability

French President Emmanuel Macron yesterday praised Bahrain and His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa for efforts to enhance regional stability and security.

Macron made the remarks as he welcomed HM King, who is in France for an official visit, to the Élysée Palace in Paris.

During their discussions, the leaders reviewed the strong ties between Bahrain and France, exploring ways to further strengthen collaboration in various areas.

Both HM King and Macron reaffirmed their commitment to broadening cooperation for mutual benefit and shared interests.

His Majesty highlighted the deep-rooted and enduring relations between the two nations, emphasizing the significant growth in multiple fields under the leadership of both countries. The meeting also touched on regional and international developments. The leaders reviewed the close partnership and discussed means to enhance collaboration across various domains.

Upon His Majesty's arrival at the Élysée Palace, HM the King was greeted with an official welcome ceremony, with President Macron personally leading the reception.

Privatize Gulf Air Retain 51% stake



MPs propose partial sale of Gulf Air

● A parliamentary committee recommends selling part of Gulf Air to reduce government subsidies and financial strain.

It seems the Gulf Air is flying directly into yet another turbulence.

This happens at a time when the carrier is still struggling to leave behind controversies surrounding key route cancellations.

This time, MPs are also involved, and they want to partially sell off the airline.

Privatisation is the key word here.

Yeah, you heard that right. A parliamentary committee has recommended partially selling Bahrain's national airline to reduce the financial burden on the government.

Members of the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee point out that a significant portion of the budget is currently consumed by Gulf Air in the form of substantial government subsidies.

This, they say, needs to end to ease the financial strain on the government.

The recommendation follows a proposal by MP Khalid Buanaq and includes measures the committee believes are essential to

safeguard the airline's future. However, MPs say they are comfortable with Mumtalakat Holding Company, the investment arm of the Bahraini government, retaining a 51% controlling stake.

But they suggest offloading the rest.

By doing this, the committee sees an opportunity not only to reduce subsidies but also to restructure the airline comprehensively.

MPs argue this step is crucial to boosting the airline's performance, operational efficiency, and profitability.

Their report highlights the potential benefits of allowing private sector players to have a greater role in the airline's day-to-day operations.

Privatisation, they argue, would bring valuable expertise to Gulf Air's board, which is essential for the carrier's revitalisation.

They also point out that this is vital for Gulf Air to achieve

greater financial stability and competitiveness in the ever-evolving global aviation landscape.

Still, we'll have to wait until Tuesday's voting to learn the fate of the proposal.

Will MPs' decision steer Gulf Air to clearer skies, or will it face even more turbulence in its flight to recovery?



Gulf Air is one of the oldest carriers in the Middle East, established in 1950. It started as a small commuter airline called "Gulf Aviation Company," serving oil company staff in Bahrain, Doha, and Dhahran, and has since grown into Bahrain's national carrier, connecting destinations across the globe!

Hamas names hostages to be freed in next swap with Israel

Hamas named yesterday four Israeli "women soldiers" held hostage since October 7 whom it plans to release from captivity in a second exchange under a ceasefire deal that has halted the Gaza war.

Israel confirmed it had received the list of names.

If all goes according to plan, after Hamas releases the four hostages today, Israel should free a group of Palestinian prisoners, though neither side has specified how many they will be. The exchange is part of a ceasefire agreement between Israel and Hamas in the Gaza war, which took effect on Sunday.

Putin says 'Ukraine crisis' might not have happened were Trump president

"I cannot but agree with him that if he had been president -- if his victory hadn't been stolen in 2020 -- then maybe there would not have been the crisis in Ukraine that emerged in 2022," Putin told a state TV reporter.

Strengthens ties and showcases economic innovations

A high-level Bahraini delegation, led by His Highness Shaikh Isa bin Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Isa bin Salman Education Charitable Trust and Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Labour Fund (Tamkeen), successfully concluded its participation in the World Economic Forum (WEF) Annual Meeting 2025.

Paper-to-Cash scam exposed: Two arrested for fraud

In a shocking scam exposed by authorities, two individuals were arrested yesterday for allegedly defrauding people with a bizarre promise: double your money by turning ordinary paper into real currency.

The arrests were made following a tip-off that led the General Department of Anti-Corruption, Economic, and Electronic Security, in collaboration with the Capital Governorate Police Directorate, to launch an immediate investigation. The suspects were swiftly identified and apprehended.

Authorities acted quickly to refer the case to the Public Prosecution, ensuring the fraudsters would face legal consequences.

In a statement, the General Department of Anti-Corruption, Economic, and Electronic Security urged both citizens and residents to remain vigilant. They advised the public to steer clear of such deceptive individuals and to report any suspicious activity to the Department of Combating Economic Crimes at the hotline 992.



2% tax on remittances!

Expatriate remittances in Bahrain may soon face a 2% tax, with parliament scheduled to discuss and vote on the proposal this Tuesday.

Initially rejected by the Shura Council in January 2024, the tax faced criticism for potentially driving expats toward black markets or cryptocurrencies, threatening Bahrain's financial stability.


The draft law has undergone several revisions since its first submission in February 2023. The original version proposed a tiered tax system: 1% for transfers under 200 dinars, 2% for transfers between 201 and 400 dinars, and 3% for amounts above 400 dinars. Exemptions were also proposed for investment agreements, capital transfers, and specific cases under Bahrain's tax rules.

The bill, fronted by Lulwa Al Rumaihi and supported by Dr. Muneer Seroor and three other MPs, aims to reduce Bahrain's dependence on oil revenue and keep more money circulating locally, giving the economy a boost.

However, the Shura Council's Financial and Economic Affairs

The revised proposal outlines four main points:

1. Article One establishes the 2% tax on remittances.
2. Article Two tasks licensed financial institutions with collecting the tax under the oversight of the National Revenue Authority.
3. Article Three grants the finance minister the authority to issue supporting regulations.
4. Article Four states that the law will take effect the day after its publication in the official gazette.

Committee warned that taxing remittances could backfire, leading to an increase in illegal transfers and money laundering. These concerns could undermine Bahrain's standing as a financial hub in the Gulf. The committee also raised concerns

about Bahrain's international obligations, noting that treaties like the "Unified Agreement for the Investment of Arab Capital in Arab Countries" guarantee the free movement of capital and profits without tax. The bill's lack of provisions to ensure com-

pliance with such treaties could expose Bahrain to legal disputes.

The committee also flagged practical issues in tracking remittances. Transfers made via apps, digital wallets, or foreign-issued cards could complicate enforcement. Furthermore,

the draft law lacks penalties for violations, making it difficult to ensure compliance.

Despite these concerns, Parliament remains determined to push the bill through. Following the Shura's rejection, its Financial and Economic Affairs Committee recommended moving forward with the plan, albeit with some revisions to clarify language. Terms like "foreigners" were changed to "every natural foreign person," and ambiguous terms like "borders" were removed.

The Ministry of Finance

and National Economy also expressed concerns, warning that the lack of detail in the bill could harm Bahrain's ability to attract investment and skilled workers. The Central Bank of Bahrain further cautioned that low-wage expats might resort to unregulated channels to avoid the tax, potentially undermining anti-money laundering efforts and making Bahrain less competitive compared to tax-free neighbours.

With these details in place, the fate of the proposal will be decided on Tuesday.

When delivery turns deliworry

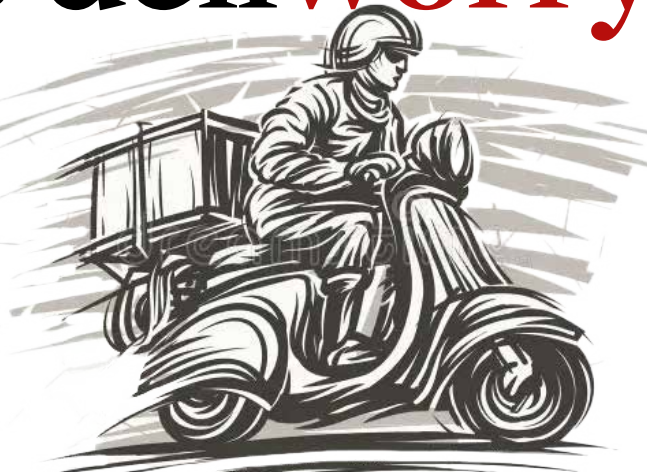
Riding on pavements and pedestrian paths in the name of delivery is not acceptable.

This is the stance of MPs in Bahrain regarding delivery riders employed by restaurants.

Reports also accuse some riders of tampering with orders—eating from the delivery and resealing the packaging before handing it over.

"This is unacceptable, and stricter oversight is needed to stop these behaviours," said MP Maryam Saleh Al Dhaen.

Her proposal to tighten regulations on food delivery riders will be put to a vote this



Tuesday.

The proposal seeks to address the increasing number of traffic violations involving delivery riders and ensure proper hygiene standards for delivery boxes.

A joint committee comprising members of the Foreign Affairs, Defence and National Security Committee, and the Services Committee has endorsed the proposal.

Citing reports of riders using pavements and pedestrian paths, Al Dhaen stated: "These shortcuts pose a real risk to pedestrians and other road users. Stricter traffic enforcement is necessary to prevent this dangerous behaviour."

She also highlighted hygiene concerns: "Poor packaging and unhygienic practices can lead to food poisoning and the spread of diseases. This is a risk we

cannot afford to take."

Al Dhaen further pointed to incidents reported on social media where riders tampered with food: "There have been cases where delivery workers ate from the food, resealed the packaging, and delivered it."

According to the Ministry of Interior, traffic offences committed by delivery riders rose from 2,378 in 2020 to 4,188 in 2023. Serious violations resulted in 364 motorcycles being seized last year alone. The ministry has intensified efforts through initiatives like the 'Ride Safe' campaign, which educated more than 1,500 delivery riders on traffic safety last year.

On the health front, the Ministry of Health has engaged with delivery companies to promote food safety requirements and is working to include these standards in licensing conditions.

Just an energy-focused entity

New holding co will not impact tariffs or jobs, says minister

The newly established Electricity and Water Holding Company will focus solely on managing government investments in the energy sector, clarified Yasser Humaidan, Minister of Electricity and Water.

Addressing concerns, the minister assured that the company's creation under Royal Decree No. 20 of 2024 will not impact electricity and water tariffs or the jobs of Electricity and Water Authority (EWA) staff. He emphasised that the holding company will not oversee the day-to-day operations of electricity and water services.

"This entity is designed to facilitate participation in new power generation and water desalination projects," Minister Humaidan explained. He added

that the new structure provides greater flexibility for strategic planning while attracting private sector investment and fostering innovation in the energy sector.

The holding company will focus on managing the government's stakes in new energy and water facilities, ensuring efficient resource allocation and long-term sustainability.

Responding to concerns raised by MP Ahmed Al Salloom, the minister reiterated that the existing services provided by EWA will remain unaffected.

Further discussions and clarifications are expected during the upcoming parliamentary session on Tuesday, where the minister will address MPs directly.

Hotel turns battleground as woman attacks officer

A hotel reception turned into a battleground when a woman's refusal to leave a public space escalated into a violent confrontation with police. The incident unfolded when staff at the hotel called authorities after the woman, who was not a guest, refused to

vacate the reception area where she had been sleeping on a chair. Despite multiple requests, she remained in the hotel, prompting the intervention of the police.

When a policewoman arrived to remove her, the woman allegedly exploded in fury, verbally abusing the officer and hurling a lamp at her. The attack didn't end there. As she

was handcuffed and restrained, the woman continued her tirade, subjecting the officer to both verbal and physical assault.

The building's manager sup-

ported the officers' version of events, confirming that security had been alerted to the woman's behavior. Meanwhile, the Public Prosecution has charged her with assaulting a public security

officer, who sustained minor injuries that did not prevent her from returning to work. The woman also faces charges of verbally abusing a public employee and intentionally damaging hotel property.

The case will continue on 28 January, where a lawyer is expected to be appointed for the defendant's defence.

Man fatally stabs friend in drunken rage; Court orders psychiatric evaluation

A man accused of stabbing his best friend to death in a drunken rage over a family insult is to undergo a psychiatric evaluation before his trial resumes on Monday, as ordered by the First High Criminal Court.

The incident reportedly occurred on 23rd September in the Northern Governorate.

Prosecutors claim that the defendant had worked with the victim for over a decade across various Arab countries before relocating to Bahrain.

The attack allegedly followed a heated argument between the victim and the defendant's older brother, during which the victim insulted the defendant's mother and sister.

At the time of the argument, the defendant was not present as he had been drinking alcohol.

Upon returning to the resi-

dence, he learned about the insult from a co-worker. However, the defendant's brother advised him to leave the house and cool off. The two stayed away for

several hours before returning.

When the defendant re-entered the house, he confronted the victim.

According to prosecutors, the

victim admitted to the remarks, prompting the defendant to retrieve a kitchen knife, which he had pocketed.

A confrontation ensued, and despite other workers attempting to intervene, the defendant fatally stabbed the victim in the chest.

The victim, unaware of the seriousness of his injury, reportedly asked others to restrain the defendant before collapsing and dying.

In his confession, the defendant admitted to drinking alcohol and killing the victim in a fit of anger. He claimed he fled the scene and wandered aimlessly before being arrested.

The court has ordered a psychiatric evaluation to assess whether the defendant was mentally responsible for his actions at the time of the incident. The trial is set to resume later this month.

Lack of evidence: Court acquits doctor of medical negligence

A Bahraini consultant doctor has been acquitted of medical negligence charges by the Lower Criminal Court. The case stemmed from allegations that the doctor prescribed inappropriate medication, resulting in an 18% impairment to the patient's health, as assessed by a forensic physician.

The court's acquittal was based on insufficient evidence to prove the charges. It cited Article 255 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, which mandates acquittal if the alleged offense is unproven or not punishable. The court specifically highlighted the lack of supporting evidence for a single doctor's testimony accusing the defendant of medical negligence.

The decision was further supported by a report from the National Committee for the Regulation of Professions and Health Services, which concluded that no medical negligence had occurred. Additional medical testimony presented during the investigation and trial also corroborated this finding.

The court emphasized that the prosecution's evidence failed to establish guilt beyond a reasonable doubt, and thus the defendant was acquitted.

The defense lawyer, Mahmood Rabie, argued that the prosecution's evidence did

not meet the legal standard of proof required in criminal cases. He stressed, "Criminal judgments must be based on certainty, not mere conjecture or probability."

Rabie also cited Article 27 of Decree-Law No. 7 of 1989, concerning the practice of human and dental medicine, which states that a doctor is not liable if they have exercised due diligence and used all available means for diagnosis and treatment. Liability only arises from proven errors due to technical ignorance, negligence, or conducting unauthorized experiments or research.

"The prosecution failed to demonstrate any such negligence or error on the part of the doctor," Rabie concluded. "The absence of conclusive evidence necessitates a verdict of acquittal, in line with the legal principle that doubt benefits the accused."

The minister highlighted the development of several key sectors, with a particular focus on attracting investment in five strategic areas: logistics, tourism, technology, financial services, and manufacturing. "The government also plans to support investment in other promising sectors," she stated, adding that a key focus is the digitalisation of the financial and banking sectors.

"Investment in Bahrain has seen remarkable growth, with a 150% increase between 2022 and 2023, representing a sig-

nificant leap forward, according to the minister," Alkhulaif explained. She noted that the current investment level equals 100% of Bahrain's GDP and expressed confidence that the Kingdom will continue to attract substantial investment in 2025.

Looking ahead, the minister highlighted the central role of artificial intelligence (AI) in Bahrain's future plans. "The Kingdom is integrating AI into many of its programmes, particularly to enhance productivity. This commitment is underpinned by the development of a robust AI infrastructure," she pointed out.

MPs push to double job opportunities for Bahrainis

A proposal to double job opportunities for Bahrainis by capitalising on new economic and investment projects is set to dominate parliamentary discussions on Tuesday.

The initiative aims to guide university graduates into private sector roles, align education with market needs, and expand employment options for citizens.

Proposed by MPs Hassan Ebrahim Hassan, Dr Hesham Ahmed Al Ashiri, Dr Ali Majid Al Nuaimi, First Deputy Speaker Abdulnabi Salman, and Hassan Bu Khumas, the plan seeks to leverage Bahrain's real estate and investment opportunities, addressing the demands of large-scale development projects underway across the country.

The proposal references Bahrain's constitution, particularly Article 13, which asserts that work is a duty for every citizen, rooted in dignity and

public good. Bahrain's push to attract investors has already

been yielding positive results, strengthening the economy and

creating more job opportunities for citizens, according to the explanatory memorandum. The General Federation of Bahrain Trade Unions has expressed support for the plan, proposing measures such as setting Bahrainisation quotas for different sectors, prioritising Bahrainis for job placements, reserving top positions for locals, and imposing penalties on companies that fail to meet these targets.

Additionally, the MPs are urging universities to collaborate with government authorities to better equip graduates for the private sector, ensuring they possess the skills needed to fill available roles.

The proposal also calls on government ministries to prioritise the hiring of more citizens, particularly young Bahrainis, as part of their broader workforce strategies. Job creation efforts are expected to be supported by developments in sectors such as healthcare, education, and large-scale infrastructure projects.

Riffa Avenue to get dual carriageway and flyovers

Riffa Avenue is getting a major facelift, with plans to turn it into a dual carriageway featuring four lanes in each direction and multi-level flyovers to ease congestion and shave time off journeys, the Ministry of Works has announced.

Meanwhile, the ministry confirmed that the Clock Roundabout is set for an upgrade too. The plan is to transform it into a multi-level interchange, allowing traffic to flow freely east and west between Shaikh Salman Avenue and Riffa Avenue without the usual stop-and-start delays.

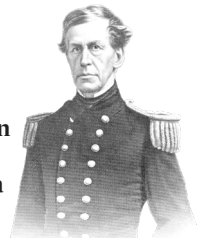

Federal judge blocks Trump bid to restrict birthright citizenship

A federal judge blocked Donald Trump's attempt to restrict birthright citizenship in the United States on Thursday as liberal states scored their first victory against the new president's hardline agenda.

The ruling imposes a 14-day stay on the enforcement of one of the most controversial executive orders Trump signed in the hours after he was sworn into office for a second term.

"This is a blatantly unconstitutional order," US District Judge John Coughenour was reported as saying during the hearing in Washington state.

"I've been on the bench for over four decades, I can't remember another case where the question presented is as clear as this one is," said Coughenour, who was appointed by a Republican president, Ronald Reagan.

Trump told reporters his administration would "obviously" appeal the ruling, while the Department of Justice said it would defend the executive order, which a spokesman said "correctly interprets" the US Constitution.

"We look forward to presenting a full merits argument to the court and to the American people, who are desperate to see our nation's laws enforced," the spokesman said.

Birthright citizenship is enshrined in the US Constitution under the 14th Amendment which decrees that anyone born on US soil is a citizen.

It says, in part: "All persons born or naturalized in the

Saudi FM in Syria for first visit since Assad's ouster

Saudi Arabia's top diplomat said yesterday the kingdom was seeking to help Syria's new authorities secure the lifting of international sanctions, during his first visit to Damascus since Bashar al-Assad's overthrow.

Prince Faisal bin Farhan was received by Syria's Islamist interim leader, Ahmed al-Sharaa, who is eyeing investments from wealthy Gulf states to rebuild the war-torn country.

The Saudi diplomat flew to Damascus from Beirut, an AFP correspondent said, following meetings on Thursday with Lebanon's new leadership.

During a press conference yesterday with his Syrian counterpart, bin Farhan said Saudi Arabia was standing by Syria, pointing to "the importance of accelerating the lifting and freezing of all sanctions".

He added that Riyadh is engaged in "active dialogue with all relevant countries, whether the United States or the European Union, and we are hearing positive messages".

Washington had already eased sanctions on Syria following

The Syrian interim leader, Ahmed al-Sharaa, was born in Saudi Arabia and lived there for the first few years of his life, adding a personal connection to the diplomatic efforts

Assad's overthrow, with the EU widely expected to follow suit when it addresses the issue at its next foreign ministers' meeting on Monday.

Syrian Foreign Minister Asaad al-Shaibani, who was in Riyadh earlier in January, said the lifting of sanctions would allow for "the opening of new channels for investment and trade", as well as rebuilding infrastructure and creating jobs.

The last time bin Farhan was in Damascus, in April 2023, he met Assad in a landmark visit that ended more than a decade of strained relations.

Riyadh was key to the Assad government's return to the Arab League, after severing ties in 2012 over his crackdown on pro-democracy protests that sparked the civil war.

Taliban reject ICC arrest warrant as 'politically motivated'

Afghanistan's Taliban government said yesterday an arrest warrant sought by the International Criminal Court (ICC) for its leaders was "politically motivated".

It comes a day after the ICC chief prosecutor said he was seeking warrants against senior Taliban leaders in Afghanistan over the persecution of women -- a crime against humanity.

"Like many other decisions of the (ICC), it is devoid of a fair legal basis, is a matter of double stand-

ards and is politically motivated," said a statement from the Foreign Ministry posted on social media platform X.

"It is regrettable that this institution has turned a blind eye to war crimes and crimes against humanity committed by foreign forces and their domestic allies during the twenty-year occupation of Afghanistan."

It said the court should "not attempt to impose a particular interpretation of human rights on the entire world and ignore the religious and national values of people of the rest of the world".

Emilia Perez leads Oscar nods

Netflix's Mexico-set drama earns record 13 nods as wildfires cast shadow on announcements

● "The Brutalist" and "Wicked" each receive 10 nominations

● Oscars ceremony is scheduled for March 2nd

Cartel musical "Emilia Perez" topped this year's Oscar nominations, earning 13 nods in an announcement on Thursday postponed by the devastating Los Angeles wildfires.

French director Jacques Audiard's Mexico-set movie, released by Netflix, shattered the record for the most Academy Award nominations for a non-English-language film.

It was followed by epic immigrant saga "The Brutalist," and show-stopping Broadway adaptation "Wicked," which each picked up 10 nominations.

Bob Dylan biopic "A Complete Unknown" and Vatican thriller "Conclave" bagged eight nods apiece.

Voting deadlines had to be extended this month, as Los Angeles -- the US entertainment capital and home city of the Academy Awards -- was devastated by multiple blazes that have killed more than two dozen people and forced tens of thousands to flee.

Nominees were unveiled in subdued circumstances, as a town that typically fixates on the Oscars race was instead fixated on yet more new fires burning north of the city.

Even so, the glitzy Oscars ceremony is still set for March 2, capping months and millions

tional film, as well as multiple song, score and sound nods.

Audiard told AFP on Thursday that he was "extremely thrilled" by the sweeping recognition.

The movie's star Karla Sofia Gascon became the first openly trans acting nominee in best actress, and Zoe Saldana was nominated for best supporting actress.

Their more famous co-star, Selena Gomez, who has been criticized for her Spanish-language dialogue, missed out.

Nevertheless, the film easily surpassed the record for the most nominations for a non-English-language movie -- previously held by "Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon" and "Roma," each with 10.

"I wonder if it's becoming a trend -- a desire to make films with different linguistic elements, unique actors, and distinctive themes," said Audiard.

'The Apprentice'

For best actor, firm favorite Adrien Brody was nominated for "The Brutalist" along with Timothee Chalamet ("A Complete Unknown"), Ralph Fiennes ("Conclave") and Colman Domingo ("Sing Sing").

But in an unexpected pick sure to ruffle a few feathers in the new White House, the fifth and final spot went to Sebastian Stan, for his unsettling transformation into a young Donald Trump in

"The Apprentice."

The movie has drawn threats of lawsuits from the US president's attorneys, particularly for a scene in which the then-property developer is shown raping his first wife, Ivana.

In real life, Ivana accused Trump of raping her during divorce proceedings, but later rescinded the allegation. She died in 2022.

Jeremy Strong, who plays the youthful Trump's sinister mentor Roy Cohn, was also nominated for his supporting role, edging out the likes of Denzel Washington ("Gladiator II").

Meanwhile, in an intense race for best actress, A-listers Angelina Jolie and Nicole Kidman -- who went all-out with their performances in "Maria" and "Babygirl," respectively --

missed the cut.

Instead, comeback queen Demi Moore, who charmed the industry with her Golden Globes acceptance speech for satirical body-horror "The Substance," was nominated and is seen as the favorite.

Her rivals include Gascon, "Anora" star Mikey Madison, and Brazil's Fernanda Torres for "I'm Still Here."

"Wicked" lead Cynthia Erivo was also nominated for best actress, alongside her co-star and pop music sensation Ariana Grande, in the supporting category.

'Hope'

Audiard was joined in the best director running by fellow French filmmaker Coralie Fargeat for "The Substance."

The only woman nominated in her category, Fargeat told AFP it would give other female filmmakers "confidence" and "hope."

"The most touching messages that I've received are from young women directors. It gives confidence, strength and role models," she said.

The Los Angeles wildfires have cast a somber shadow on this year's Oscars.

"This has certainly been a difficult time for Los Angeles, where many members

of our film community industry work and live," said Academy present Janet Yang at the start of Thursday's announcement.

The Oscars gala in March will "pay tribute to our brave first responders," added Academy CEO Bill Kramer.

The chaos and displacement caused by the California fires could have prevented many Academy members there from voting, Pete Hammond, awards columnist for movie trade outlet Deadline, told AFP.

He predicted the upheaval could have increased the influence of the Academy's many overseas voters -- who often opt for more artsy fare from outside of the US-centric Hollywood orbit.

And it was indeed a strong morning for international films.

Beyond "Emilia Perez" and "The Substance," there was an unexpected best picture nod for "I'm Still Here," set during Brazil's 1970s dictatorship.

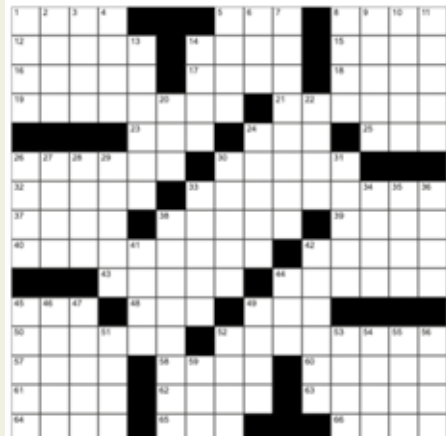

Guardiola overhauls City squad

Manchester City's injury crisis prompts early, costly squad rebuild in January

● City make three January signings worth £123 million

● Walker set for loan to AC Milan

Pep Guardiola has admitted Manchester City's injury woes and dismal form this season forced the club to start an overhaul of his squad sooner than expected.

After winning the Premier League six times in the past seven seasons, City's bid for a fifth successive title has crumbled in shocking fashion.

Instead of chasing yet more glory in the title race, Guardiola's side will host Chelsea on Saturday locked in a desperate battle just to qualify for next season's Champions League.

City's astonishing decline has prompted Guardiola and the club's hierarchy to launch a comprehensive rebuild of his team in a bid to get back on track.

Normally cautious spenders in the January transfer window, City have signed Uzbekistan defender Abdulkodir Khusanov from Lens, teenaged Brazilian defender Vitor Reis from Palmeiras and Egypt forward Omar Marmoush from Eintracht Frankfurt.

That trio cost around £123 million (\$152 million) in combined transfer fees and opened the door for unsettled City right-back Kyle Walker's imminent loan move to AC Milan.

"Last season, we didn't do much (in the transfer market)

with the exceptional qualities of this team," Guardiola told reporters on Friday.

"Normally we would wait three or four months, but we decided to do it here with the amount of injuries and problems we have.

"They will make us strong and I'm pretty sure that the club decided for these prospective players for the future and many years."

With City hampered by fresh injuries to Ruben Dias and Jeremy Doku, Guardiola said Marmoush, Khusanov and Reis would be available for Chelsea's visit to the Etihad Stadium.

'Two finals'

Guardiola said Marmoush, who will bolster City's attacking options, has an "exceptional future".

He added: "Vitor is young, a huge personality, but he needs time. He is here with us. Of course he can start with the situations we have at the back. He

comes for many years, not just for now.

"Khusanov has already settled because he played in the French league, handling tough, fast players."

Wednesday's 4-2 defeat at Paris Saint-Germain, in which City blew a two-goal lead, left Guardiola's team in danger of Champions League elimination

ahead of their do-or-die showdown with Club Brugge next week.

"We can make it. Why should I think differently? I think it is going to happen," Guardiola said defiantly of City's hopes of reaching the Champions League play-off round.

Fifth-placed City must also secure Champions League qualification for next season and beating fourth-placed Chelsea would be a step in the right direction.

City would go above Chelsea with a victory, but Guardiola is well aware of the threat posed by his former assistant Enzo Maresca in the Italian's first season in charge of the Blues.

"It's really important. We are close in the table, even with the big problems we have had. The next two games are finals. Chelsea and after that Brugge," Guardiola said.

"Chelsea have improved a lot under Enzo. I recognised it from day one when we played in the summer. I was lucky to work with him in the last years."

Man Utd, Spurs enjoy Europa League boost

Manchester United and Tottenham both enjoyed some much needed respite from their Premier League woes with victories in the Europa League on Thursday.

Bruno Fernandes conjured up the injury time winner in United's 2-1 defeat of Scottish giants Rangers, while in Germany Son Heung-min scored twice in a 3-2 win for Spurs at Hoffenheim.

Both English teams closed in on direct qualification to the last 16.

The Red Devils looked set to suffer more disappointment at Old Trafford when Cyriel

United move up to fourth in the table with one match of the league phase remaining.

The top eight will qualify directly for the last 16, which may now be beyond Rangers who slip to 13th.

Sinner to face Zverev in Melbourne final

Sinner defeats Shelton as Djokovic retires injured against Zverev in Australian Open semi-finals

● **Djokovic loses first set 7-6 (7/5), hints at possible last Australian Open appearance**

Novak Djokovic retired injured from his Australian Open semi-final against Alexander Zverev yesterday and left the court to boos, with defending champion Jannik Sinner to face the German for the title.

Top-ranked Sinner blew past Ben Shelton 7-6 (7/2), 6-2, 6-2 in the second semi-final in Melbourne to set up a meeting between the Italian and German second seed Zverev.

The Rod Laver Arena crowd jeered Djokovic, who played with a heavily taped leg, when he called it a day after losing a gruelling first set against Zverev, leaving his bid for a record 25th Grand Slam crown in tatters.

The 37-year-old Serbian great shook hands after going down 7-6 (7/5) and said he had been hampered by a muscle tear.

Djokovic hinted that he may have played his last Australian Open.

"There is a chance. Who knows?" Djokovic said when asked if he may have graced the Melbourne Park courts for a last time.

"I normally like to come to

Australia to play. I've had the biggest success in my career here. So if I'm fit, healthy, motivated, I don't see a reason why I wouldn't come," he added.

Djokovic has now gone five Grand Slams without winning the title he needs to surpass Margaret Court's 24 and become the all-time leader.

In the other semi-final, Sinner had to save two set points in a tight opening act that lasted a marathon 71 minutes and he

suffered in the latter stages after long rallies against his high-octane American opponent.

"I had some tension today, slightly cramps," Sinner admitted.

"But he was also suffering today a little bit in his legs.

"So I tried to move him around, tried to stay a little bit more aggressive which today helped a lot."

Once Sinner grittily snared the opening set on a tiebreak he took

only another 85 minutes to win the next two sets against his 22-year-old Shelton.

"For three sets. Two and a half hours is quite a time. So happy to finish today in three," the Italian said.

"But, you know, as I said, I'm very happy to be back in the finals and then we see what is coming Sunday."

'I liked my chances'

It is unclear what the immediate future holds for Djokovic, a 10-time Melbourne champion who had been ominously warming to the task before injury struck.

"I actually thought I played really well, as well as I played the last 12 months," he said of his run to the last four.

"I liked my chances if I was physically fit and ready to battle."

Sinner is on the cusp of a first successful Grand Slam title defence after winning his maiden major crown in Melbourne last year.

He had won the last four of his five career meetings with Shelton.

The Italian was not at his best in the opening set, dropping his serve twice and having to dig deep to save two set points with Shelton serving at 6-5.

But the 23-year-old easily took control of the tiebreak to move a set ahead.

He broke Shelton right at the start of the second and ran away with it.

The American raised himself for one last effort in the third, lashing running forehand winners in an attempt to turn the tide.

Sinner was not moving freely by now, but he saved two break points and when Shelton then dropped his serve to go 3-2 down, the Italian upped the ante and sprinted to the finish line on the back of some unreturnable ground strokes.

The final will be a battle of the top two seeds with Zverev in his first Australian Open final.

The German has been a Grand Slam runner-up twice before, at last year's French Open and the 2020 US Open, but has never lifted one of the big four majors.

Arteta doubles down on need for Arsenal striker

Mikel Arteta reiterated yesterday that Arsenal are actively looking to sign a striker, admitting they "lack options" as the clock ticks down towards the end of the January transfer window.

Serious injuries to forwards Gabriel Jesus and Bukayo Saka have added to concerns over Arsenal's lack of goalscoring threat as they try to chase down Premier League leaders Liverpool.

The Gunners are the only club in the Premier League's top six without a goalscorer in double figures -- Kai Havertz has eight in the English top flight this season.

Arsenal manager Arteta was asked about the need for reinforcements ahead of his side's trip to struggling Wolves on Saturday.

Liverpool's Slot disagrees with dad over 'exciting' football

Liverpool manager Arne Slot joked yesterday that his father sometimes complains that his football is not "exciting" enough.

The Premier League leaders, six points clear of second-placed Arsenal, play relegation-threatened Ipswich on Saturday but the Dutchman is expecting a difficult game.

"They've been a bit unlucky sometimes in the last moments of games," said Slot, who faced Ipswich in his first game in charge at Anfield in August, winning 2-0.

"The second half of the season is always more difficult than the first half because some teams strengthen themselves during the winter break.

"Many teams work with their manager for half a sea-

son and that normally leads to a team becoming better."

Kieran McKenna's Ipswich have had the occasional encouraging result but last week they were hammered 6-0 by Manchester City.

Slot was asked at his pre-match press conference whether Liverpool fans would expect a similar result at Anfield.

"That is difficult for fans, and my father is a fan as well, and when I call him after the game he can also say it wasn't as exciting as other games of Liverpool when he watched the game against Lille (a 2-1 Champions League win in midweek)," he said.

"And then I have to try to explain to him that these games you can easily lose if you're starting to force all kinds of difficult balls. But he's not always agreeing with me.

Klopp 'needs time' to make impact as Red Bull boss, says Alonso

Bayer Leverkusen coach Xabi Alonso yesterday backed Jurgen Klopp to make an impact in his new job at Red Bull, but said the former Liverpool manager "needs time".

Klopp took over as Red Bull's global head of soccer in January, overseeing a stable of clubs including RB Leipzig, who host Alonso's Leverkusen on Saturday.

Klopp won back-to-back Bundesliga titles with Borussia Dortmund and lifted the Champions League and Premier

League trophies with Liverpool. The 57-year-old has already been seen watching Leipzig and French second-tier club Paris FC from the stands.

"In the future, yes," Alonso said of Klopp's influence.

"I think that he's only been in the job for around a month. His influence, his personality, his charisma are huge in the football world.

"But everyone needs a bit of time."

Leipzig beat Leverkusen 3-2 in August, making them the only team to beat Alonso's defending champions in the league since May 2023, a run of 52 games.

Alonso's side are four points behind league leaders Bayern Munich, who play at Freiburg on Saturday.

The Spaniard confirmed Nigeria striker Victor Boniface was in the squad and could play for the first time since picking up an injury in November.
