Pressing call

Arab and Islamic leaders push for urgent end to Gaza war in talks with Trump

Eight leaders and ministers from Arab and Islamic states issued a unified call to end the war in Gaza during talks with US President Donald Trump on the sidelines of the 80th UN General Assembly session yesterday.

The leaders of Qatar, Jordan, Turkiye, Indonesia and Pakistan, along with Egypt's prime minister and the foreign ministers of the UAE and Saudi Arabia, stressed the urgent need for a ceasefire and immediate humanitarian access to the besieged enclave.

They warned of the "humanitarian catastrophe and high human toll" in Gaza, where more than 65,000 Palestinians have been killed since October 2023.

Serious consequences

The leaders also rejected any forced displacement of Palestinians, describing the war as a conflict with "serious consequences

for the region and impact on the Muslim world."

In their joint appeal, they called for the release of Israeli hostages held by Hamas, alongside the entry of sufficient hu-

manitarian aid, as the first step toward achieving a just and lasting peace.

They also underscored their commitment to rebuilding Gaza, urging the creation of a com-

prehensive reconstruction plan with security arrangements and international support for the Palestinian Authority in its reform efforts.

The leaders further empha-

Israeli forces killed dozens of people across the Palestinian territory yesterday, as the military pressed its assault on Gaza City.

sised the importance of protecting Jerusalem's holy sites and preserving stability in the occupied West Bank, where violence by Israeli settlers has escalated since late 2023.

The high-level meeting was co-hosted by Qatari Emir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani, Jordan's King Abdullah II, Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan, Indonesian President Prabowo Subianto, Pakistani Prime Minister Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif, Egyptian Prime Minister Moustafa Kamal Madbouly, UAE Foreign Minister Sheikh Abdullah bin Zayed Al-Nahyan, and Saudi Foreign Minister Prince Faisal bin Farhan.

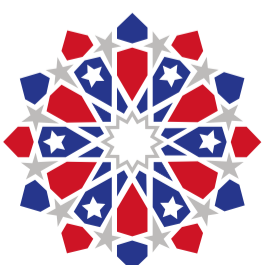

Deceiving investors

BD6 million fraud trial for investment firm owner and executives

Six million-dinar fraud case heads to court as prosecutors charge an investment company owner, the chief executive and two board members with fraud, forgery, embezzlement and money-laundering.

The Financial Crimes and Money Laundering Prosecution said the Public Prosecution moved to trial after an inquiry sparked by a report from the Financial Intelligence National Centre (FINC) at the Interior Ministry.

FINC's report said the company owner deceived investors, falsified papers and washed the proceeds.



Prosecutors said the chief executive and two board members helped through steps within their remit that let the owner siphon investors' money via

sham deals. According to FINC, the owner issued fake cheques, made unjustified cash withdrawals and deposits from the company ac-

count, and authorised payments absent from contracts.

Funds

FINC concluded these acts led to the taking of investors' funds without right.

Prosecutors said the owner leaned on commercial records, falsely claiming their holders had sought finance, then put the supposed deals to investors for approval, drawing in sums that topped BD6 million.

The inquiry also found the chief executive and two board members allowed the owner to push through two transactions without telling investors their true nature, which, prosecutors said, enabled him to seize more funds.

Bahrain is set to experience one of Ethiopia's most treasured cultural traditions as the Ethiopian Orthodox Tewahedo Church community invites the public to join its annual Meskel Festival tomorrow at Bahrain Beach Bay in Zallaq.

The festival, recognised by UNESCO as part of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity, commemorates the 4th century discovery of the True Cross by Empress Saint Helena. At its heart is the "Demera," a towering ceremonial bonfire whose flames symbolise the guiding fire that led to the Cross's revelation.

Ancient roots

According to tradition, Empress Helena was directed in a dream to light a great pyre,

and the smoke pointed to the site where the Cross lay buried. Today, that moment is remembered through the dramatic lighting of the Demera, often decorated with Meskel daisies, followed by blessings as the faithful mark their foreheads

with ash.

Meskel is more than a religious observance. In Ethiopia, it signals the end of the rainy season and the beginning of a new year, bringing communities together in unity, reconciliation, and joyful spirit. In

Bahrain, the festival reflects the Kingdom's multicultural ethos, offering residents and visitors a chance to witness Yaredawi hymns, communal expressions of gratitude, and the warmth of Ethiopian hospitality.

Invitation to all

Organisers have extended the invitation beyond their community, calling on Bahrainis and expatriates alike to take part in this rare cultural occasion. The celebration begins at 4:30 pm and will continue till 6:00 pm, with hymns, prayers, and the climactic bonfire.

The Ethiopian Orthodox Tewahedo Church Community describes Meskel as a living link between history, faith, and culture, an event that not only honours tradition but also builds bridges of understanding in Bahrain's diverse society.

Joint maritime exercise

Proposal approved to revive Dilapidated Houses Project

The Southern Municipal Council yesterday approved a proposal from member Ahmed Abdullah Al Abdullah to revive the Dilapidated Houses Project under the Ministry of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture, working with municipal councils.

The scheme is intended to secure safe, suitable homes for low-income citizens and raise housing standards across the Kingdom. The file sat with the ministry and the councils from early 2008.

After Cabinet Decision No. 2133/06 of 23 October 2011, it moved to the Ministry of Housing, with the transfer taking effect in 2012.

According to the submission, the project then stalled.

In 2017, Housing set an approach that treated cas-

The proposal points to large numbers of houses built around fifty years ago by the Ministry of Housing in areas such as Isa Town, Riffa and Al Buhair.

es under the same terms as a home-repair loan, which, the proposer argues, shut out many households in need.

The paper says a BD20,000 loan ceiling is too small to cover demolition and a rebuild, while about BD30,000 is nearer the mark.

Bahrain Chamber's new app and digital assistant are closely linked to the Kingdom's national digital strategy, leaders of the Bahrain Chamber said on Wednesday, highlighting that the initiative reflects Bahrain's determination to remain at the forefront regionally and globally.

Speaking on the sidelines of the launch of the app and the digital assistant, His Excellency Sameer Abdulla Nass, Chairman of the Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry, revealed

that the Chamber initiated the idea of having an app to communicate with its members, solve their queries, and provide access to services six years ago. Zelensky cast doubt Wednesday on NATO's ability to guarantee Ukraine's security but praised Donald Trump after the US president unexpectedly flip-flopped to say he thinks Russia can be defeated. Addressing the United Nations, Zelensky suggested that even NATO membership -- which Trump has ruled out for Ukraine -- might not be enough. "Because international institutions are too weak, this madness continues. Even being part of the long-standing military alliance doesn't automatically mean you are safe," he told the UN General Assembly. But Zelensky praised Trump after their meeting Tuesday. "We had a good meeting with President Trump, and I also spoke with many other strong leaders, and together, we can change a lot," he said. "Of course we are doing everything to make sure Europe truly helps and of course, we count on the United States."

◆ **Canada bank staffer accused of unauthorized viewing of PM Carney's accounts**

Canada's largest bank accused of viewing Prime Minister Mark Carney's personal accounts without approval has been charged with fraud, federal police told AFP yesterday. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police said the 23-year-old suspect from Ottawa was also charged with unauthorized use of a computer and identity theft, among other offenses, after the Royal Bank of Canada raised alarm about suspicious conduct. The suspect "allegedly consulted the personal data of Prime Minister Mark Carney," RCMP spokesperson Eriq Gasse said in an email. The investigation so far does not point toward a risk to national security or to Carney's personal safety, Gasse said. RBC spokesperson Cheryl Breen told AFP that the bank "took immediate action" once the suspicious conduct was identified and "the individual... is no longer employed at the bank."

◆ **Yemen drone attack wounds five in Israeli resort town; army, rescuers**

Israel's military said a drone launched from Yemen struck the southern town of Eilat yesterday, with rescuers reporting five wounded including two in serious condition. A military statement said the drone "fell in the area of Eilat" on the Red Sea coast after air defences had failed to intercept it. There was no immediate claim of responsibility for the attack, which occurred on the second day of Rosh Hashanah, the Jewish New Year. Yemen's Iran-backed Huthi rebels have claimed similar attacks throughout the Gaza war since late 2023. Israel's Magen David Adom emergency medical service said its teams had treated five casualties with shrapnel wound, including two men who were in serious condition. Police said the drone fell in Eilat's city centre, causing damage in the area frequented by tourists.

UN demands probe, Italy deploys frigate after drone 'attack' on Gaza aid flotilla

The United Nations called yesterday for an investigation into alleged drone attacks against a Gaza-bound aid flotilla, as Brussels slammed the strikes as unacceptable and Italy sent a navy frigate to assist. The Global Sumud Flotilla blamed Israel for the more than a dozen explosions heard around the flotilla late Tuesday off Greece, with damage caused by "unidentified objects" dropped on deck. "Israel escalates dangerous attacks", including "the deployment of explosive and incendiary devices, deliberate dispersal of chemical substances onto civilian vessels" and attempts to render the boats unseaworthy, it said. UN Human Rights Office spokesperson Thameen Al-Kheetan said anyone re-

sponsible for the "violations" should be held accountable. The Global Sumud Flotilla (GSF) set sail from Barcelona this month with the aim of breaking the Israeli blockade of Gaza and delivering humanitarian aid. Israel, which blocked two previous attempts by activists to reach Gaza by sea in June and July, has said it will not allow the flotilla to reach the embattled Palestinian territory. "Israel will not allow vessels to enter an active combat zone and will not allow any breach of the lawful naval blockade," foreign ministry spokesman Oren Marmorstein told AFP. "If their intentions are sincere, they should transfer any such aid to the nearby Ashkelon Marina so it can be forwarded promptly to the Gaza Strip in a non-violent manner," he said.

'The time has come'

France recognises Palestinian state, urges end to Gaza war

French President Emmanuel Macron declared on Tuesday that France recognises the State of Palestine, calling for an immediate end to the war in Gaza and the release of hostages held by Hamas.

"We are here because the time has come. The time has come for release of the 48 hostages held by Hamas. The time has come to stop the war, the bombardment of Gaza, the massacres and the flight of civilians," Macron told world leaders at the UN General Assembly. "One thing is certain: we can no longer wait."

The announcement places France among the most prominent Western nations to formally endorse Palestinian statehood, joining Ireland, Norway, Slovenia, Spain and others who took similar steps in recent years.

Historical responsibility

Macron reminded delegates of the 1947 UN decision to partition Palestine into a Jewish and an Arab state. Israel's independence was secured, he said, but "the promise of an Arab state remains unfulfilled to this day."

"For decades, Israelis and Palestinians have travelled down a long road of hope mixed with despair," he said. "We bear collective responsibility for failing to build a just and lasting peace in the Middle East thus far."

The shock of October 7

The French leader recalled the 7 October 2023 Hamas attacks, which killed 1,224 people in Israel, wounded nearly 5,000 and led to 251 hostages being taken into Gaza.

"The barbarity of Hamas stunned Israel and the world," he said. "For the Israeli soul and the world's conscience, 7 October is a wound that is still raw. We unequivocally condemn it because nothing, ever, anywhere can justify the use of terrorism."

France, he added, has not forgotten the 51 French citizens killed in the assault, honouring them at a national ceremony. "We will not forget them. Ever. Just as we will never end the existential fight against anti-Semitism."

Equal value of lives

While standing with Israel against terrorism, Macron insisted the ongoing war in Gaza cannot continue.

"Nothing, nothing justifies continuing the war in Gaza any longer," he declared. "To save lives -- the lives of Israeli hostages... and the lives of Palestinian civilians wracked by hunger and grief. All lives are equally valuable."

He cited his encounters with both Israeli hostage families and Palestinian victims. "The duty that we all have is to protect one another -- a duty that is indivisible, just like our humanity."

Recognition of Palestine
Macron framed France's recognition of Palestinian statehood as an overdue step to keep



There is a solution that can break the cycle of war and destruction. It is by recognizing one another -- every person's legitimacy, humanity and dignity. Let those on both sides open their eyes again and see human faces instead of the enemy's mask or a target drawn over them by the war. It's the recognition that Israelis and Palestinians live in a parallel solitude -- the solitude of the Israelis following the historic nightmare of 7 October 2023, and the solitude of the Palestinians, who are completely exhausted by this endless war.

alive the two-state solution.

"This recognition is a way of affirming that the Palestinian people are not a people too many," he said. "The recognition of the legitimate rights of the Palestinian people does not subtract in any way from the rights of the Israeli people. Indeed, we are convinced that this recognition is the only solution that will bring peace to Israel."

He stressed the move was not a victory for Hamas but a blow against extremism: "This recognition of the State of Palestine is a defeat for Hamas and for all those who incite anti-Semitic hatred."

International momentum

France's move was coordinated with several partners, Macron revealed. "Andorra, Australia, Belgium, Canada, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Portugal, San Marino and the United Kingdom" would also announce recognition, he said, following the path taken by Ireland, Norway, Slovenia and

Spain in 2024.

"This follows the choice made by many others before. It reflects a common ambition to break the cycle of violence and to change the situation on the ground."

A plan for peace

The French president outlined a three-phase plan, developed with Saudi Arabia and backed by a UN resolution adopted by a wide majority.

1. Immediate ceasefire and hostage release -- pairing the liberation of the remaining 48 hostages with a halt to Israeli military operations. Macron credited Qatar, Egypt and the United States for their mediation and urged Israel not to obstruct progress.

2. Stabilisation and reconstruction of Gaza -- a transitional administration involving the Palestinian Authority, young Palestinian leaders and security forces, supported by international partners. France and the EU, he said, stood ready

to help train and equip Palestinian security services, while an international mission could assist in stabilisation.

3. Renewed Palestinian governance and negotiations -- Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas has pledged reforms, disarmament of Hamas, rejection of hate speech and preparation for elections. Macron said France would monitor progress and could open an embassy in Palestine once a ceasefire is in place and all hostages are freed.

France would also condition cooperation with Israel on its willingness to end the war and negotiate. "This will be the path that will lead us to a sovereign, independent and demilitarized State of Palestine that brings together all of its territories, recognizes Israel, and is recognized by Israel," Macron said.

Regional appeal

Macron urged Arab and Muslim states to recognise Israel once Palestine becomes sovereign, creating "mutual recognition which will further peace and security of all in the Middle East."

He argued that Israeli-Palestinian peace could serve as "the first pillar of a new peace and security architecture in the Middle East" and pave the way for deeper regional economic integration.

Call to Israel

The French president acknowledged Israeli fears and scepticism but called on its leaders to seize the moment.

"I understand their reservations and their fears. I am listening to the Israeli people with great respect and have heard their sorrow and fatigue," he said. "I want to believe that the Israeli authorities will also listen and, in turn, commit themselves."

Macron invoked the memory of Yitzhak Rabin, the Israeli prime minister assassinated nearly 30 years ago for pursuing peace. Quoting Rabin, he said: "I waged war as long as there was no chance for peace."

"This chance exists today," Macron insisted. "A total of 142 States are proposing this peace with their hands held out, ready to be shaken."

'The time has come'

He concluded with the same refrain that opened his address: "Yes, the time has come to stop the war in Gaza, the massacres, the death, immediately. The time has come for Israel to live in peace and security... The time has come to deliver justice to the Palestinian people and thereby recognize a State of Palestine, a brother and neighbour, in Gaza and the West Bank, by way of Jerusalem. The time has come to drive the hideous face of terrorism from these lands and build peace. Peace is much more demanding, much more difficult than any war. But the time has come."

The time has come. That is why, true to my country's historic commitment in the Middle East, for peace between the Israeli people and the Palestinian people, I declare that France today recognizes the State of Palestine.

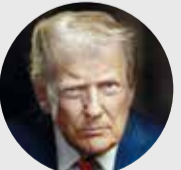

US bans Iranian officials at UN from 'shopping spree'

State Department spokesman described it as "maximum pressure"

Iranian officials at the UN summit this week won't be able to shop in New York after the US government barred them from purchasing everything from bulk household goods to expensive watches.

The restrictions on the visiting Iranians were described by

a State Department spokesman as "maximum pressure."

"We will not allow the Iranian regime to allow its clerical elites to have a shopping spree in New York while the Iranian people endure poverty, crumbling infra-

structure, and dire shortages of water and electricity," Thomas Pigott said.

The move restricts Iranian diplomats and other officials from visiting popular stores such as Costco, Sam's Club

and BJ's Wholesale Club, according to a notice published in the Federal Register on Tuesday.

The notice in the Federal Register also said Iranian officials would need to seek permission

from the State Department to buy "luxury goods."

A range of items, including watches, electronics and fountain pens, were listed, with restrictions kicking in if they were valued at more than \$1,000.

Vehicles worth more than \$60,000 were also listed as luxury goods.

Iran's economy has been hard hit by US sanctions, impacting imports of a range of goods and also Tehran's ability to sell its oil and other exports abroad.

US President Donald Trump has sought to cripple Iran's nuclear program since taking office this year, ordering bomb and missile attacks on three nuclear sites in June.

US Secretary of State Marco Rubio on Monday met External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar on the sidelines of the 80th session of the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) in New York, where both leaders discussed strengthening strategic cooperation between India and the United States across key sectors, including trade, defence, energy, pharmaceuticals, and critical minerals.

In a post on social media platform X, Secretary Rubio stat-

ed that the meeting focused on various aspects of the bilateral partnership aimed at "enhancing prosperity for both nations."

"Met with Indian External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar at UNGA. We discussed key areas of our bilateral relationship, including trade, energy, pharmaceuticals, and critical minerals and more to generate prosperity for India and the United States," Rubio posted on X.

The US Department of State, in an official release, reaffirmed

India's "critical importance" to Washington and welcomed India's continued engagement on core sectors of mutual interest.

"Secretary Rubio, reiterating that India is a relationship of critical importance to the United States, expressed his appreciation for the Indian government's continued engagement on a number of issues, including trade, defence, energy, pharmaceuticals, critical minerals, and other items related to the bilateral relationship," the US

Department of State said in a statement.

The statement added, "Secretary Rubio and External Affairs Minister Jaishankar agreed that the United States and India will continue working together to promote a free and open Indo-Pacific region, including through the Quad."

On Monday, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar held a bilateral meeting with US Secretary of State Marco Rubio. He described the meeting as con-

structive and underlined the importance of sustained engagement.

In a post on X, EAM Jaishankar said, "Good to meet Secretary of State Marco Rubio this morning in New York. Our conversation covered a range of bilateral and international issues of current concern. Agreed on the importance of sustained engagement to progress on priority areas. We will remain in touch."

The meeting marked their first direct interaction since trade tensions escalated following steep tariffs imposed by US President Donald Trump on Indian goods over India's purchase of Russian oil.

Despite recent challenges, the meeting is seen as part of a broader effort to reinforce India-US ties, which had shown signs of strain but are now moving towards recovery.

The two leaders had last met in Washington during the 10th Quad Foreign Ministers' Meeting in July and had also interacted earlier in January this year. However, the upcoming bilateral meeting will be their first face-to-face interaction since trade frictions flared up after President Donald Trump imposed steep tariffs on Indian goods over the purchase of Russian oil.

The 80th session of the UNGA formally opened on September 9, 2025, with the High-Level General Debate commencing on September 23.

Iran will never seek nuclear weapons, president tells UN

US intelligence has not concluded that the country has decided to build a nuclear weapon

Iran's president repeated yesterday that his country is not seeking nuclear weapons, after military strikes by Israel and the United States earlier this year, and impending sanctions triggered by European powers. "I hereby declare once more before this assembly that Iran has never sought and will never seek to build a nuclear bomb,"

President Masoud Pezeshkian told the United Nations General Assembly.

"The one disturbing peace and stability in the region is Israel,

but Iran is the one that gets punished," he said.

Iran has long contended that it is not seeking nuclear weapons, pointing to an edict by Supreme

Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, and US intelligence has not concluded that the country has decided to build a nuclear weapon. But Israel, the United States

and European countries have long been skeptical due to the country's advanced nuclear work, believing it could quickly pursue a bomb if it so decided.

Britain, France and Germany have moved to reimpose UN sanctions that had been suspended under a 2015 nuclear deal that was negotiated by the United States and then torn up by US President Donald Trump.

The sanctions are set to go into effect on Saturday. Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi met Tuesday with his European counterparts, leading to no clear headway other than an agreement to keep talking.

Pezeshkian accused the Europeans of bad faith, saying that Iran's lack of cooperation was in response to Trump's withdrawal from the nuclear deal, formally known as the Joint Comprehen-

sive Plan of Action (JCPOA).

"They falsely presented themselves as parties of good standing to the agreement, and they disparaged Iran's sincere efforts as insufficient," Pezeshkian said.

"All of this was in pursuit of nothing less than the destruction of the very JCPOA which they themselves had once held as a foremost achievement."

Standing at the General Assembly rostrum, Pezeshkian showed pictures of people killed in the Israeli military campaign against Iran, which Tehran says killed more than 1,000 people.

"Aerial assaults of the Zionist regime and the United States of America against Iran's cities, homes and infrastructure at the very time we were treading the path of diplomatic negotiations constituted a grave betrayal of diplomacy," he said.

Fierce winds, pounding rain and rough seas battered southern China on Wednesday as powerful Typhoon Ragasa made landfall in Guangdong province after killing at least 17 in Taiwan.

Ragasa churned into Guangdong, home to tens of millions of people, and AFP journalists at the impact point in the city of Yangjiang saw flying debris and gusts ripping advertisements off of buildings.

The typhoon had hours earlier swept past Hong Kong, with the densely-populated city's weather service ranking the storm the strongest yet in the northwest-

ern Pacific this year.

Ragasa's passage in Taiwan killed at least 17 and injured 18 when a decades-old barrier lake burst in eastern Hualien county under the storm's heavy rains, according to regional officials.

Authorities earlier said 152 people were unaccounted for, but later revised that figure down to 17, saying they had made contact with more than 100 of those previously deemed missing.

More than 7,600 people were evacuated due to Ragasa and footage released by the fire agency showed flooded streets, half-submerged cars and uprooted trees.

Authorities across mainland China ordered businesses and schools to shut down in at least 10 cities across the nation's south, affecting tens of millions of people.

More than 1.89 million people across different cities in Guang-

dong had been relocated as of Tuesday night, its emergency management said in an online statement.

The storm made landfall along the coast of Hailing Island, near Yangjiang City around 5:00 pm (0900 GMT), Chinese meteorologists said.

Ferocious winds destroyed fences and downed trees, leaving fallen branches on the ground, AFP journalists saw.

The Yangjiang train station -- normally bustling with activity, locals said -- stood empty, with rail travel suspended Wednesday across Guangdong.

For a period of several hours, the powerful typhoon shook buildings as sheets of rain poured down on the city.

Fire trucks drove through mostly deserted streets as the winds whipped branches along the road and toppled motorbikes that had been parked along the pavement.

The weather service said that at the time of landfall, the maximum wind speed near the centre of the storm was 145 kilometres per hour (90 miles per hour).

Hong Kong battered

Hong Kong authorities said 90 people have been treated for injuries sustained during the typhoon period at public hospitals as of Wednesday nightfall.

More than 860 people sought refuge at the 50 temporary shelters across the city.

The Chinese finance hub recorded hundreds of fallen trees and flooding in multiple neighbourhoods. Many of the city's tall buildings swayed and rattled in the harsh winds.

At the Fullerton Ocean Park Hotel, next to a theme park, a man was seen losing his balance after a storm surge shattered the glass front doors and swept into its lobby, according to a video circulated online and verified by AFP.

A hotel spokesperson said there were no injuries.

Floodwaters rushed into the seaside Heng Fa Chuen residential estate and covered its interior courtyards, another video clip showed.

"It's like the end of the world... I never expected to see it as bad as this," said IT manager Paul

Yendle near a heavily damaged restaurant in the Tseung Kwan O area, another area near the harbour.

An off-duty firefighter surnamed Tse told AFP he was "a bit worried" about the safety of nearby bamboo scaffolding as he walked home after an 11-hour shift of "non-stop" work.

Rail operator MTR said it would take time for workers to check and repair outdoor sections of train tracks.

The Airport Authority said "only a limited number of cargo flights" were scheduled for Wednesday, with its website listing hundreds of cancelled passenger flights.

A five-year-old boy and his mother fell into the sea on Tuesday afternoon while they were watching the waves in the Chai Wan district, according to police.

Both were rushed to hospital and the mother remained in critical condition on Wednesday morning.

The publication also reports that bosses at Sony - which is co-producing the £150 million movie with Marvel Studios - will "meet on Monday to decide how to move forward with the production".

Spider-Man: Brand New Day - which is slated to hit screens on July 31, 2026 - will see Holland become a "proper Spider-Man".

Marvel Studios boss Kevin Feige, 52, recently said Holland's Wall-Crawler will be his own fully-fledged superhero by Spider-Man: Brand New Day.

Speaking at a roundtable interview for The Fantastic Four: First Steps, Feige said: "I think there's a promise at the end of No Way Home, that for as sad as it is that Peter is forgotten by everyone in his life, we are seeing for the first time in the Tom Holland Spider-Man stories, him being a proper Spider-Man."

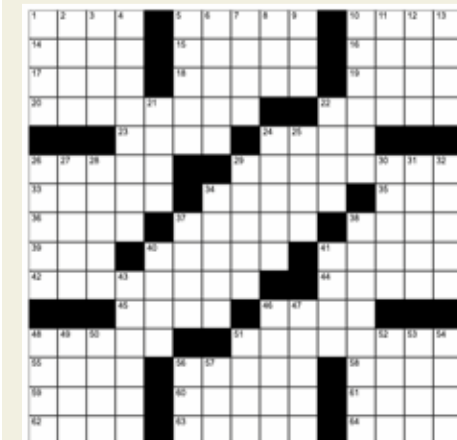

Isak scores first Liverpool goal in League Cup win, Chelsea survive scare

● Liverpool beat Southampton 2-1

● Chelsea come back to beat Lincoln

Alexander Isak scored his first Liverpool goal to inspire a 2-1 win against Southampton in the League Cup third round, while Chelsea survived a scare to beat third-tier Lincoln on Tuesday.

Isak was making his third appearance for Liverpool since his British record £125 million (\$169 million) move from Newcastle on transfer deadline day.

The 26-year-old had drawn a blank in his 58-minute debut

appearance against Atletico Madrid and also failed to net after coming off the bench for the last 23 minutes of Saturday's Merseyside derby win over Everton.

But Isak got off the mark in the 43rd minute as Southampton goalkeeper Alex McCarthy tried a short pass that was intercepted by Federico Chiesa, who picked out the Sweden striker to fire home.

It was a belated birthday present for Isak, who turned 26 on Sunday.

Isak, who had scored for Newcastle in their League Cup final win against Liverpool last season, was taken off at half-time as he builds up his fitness after missing pre-season training while his transfer was being negotiated.

Shea Charles equalised for

the Championship side in the 76th minute with a close-range finish after a wayward header from Liverpool's Wataru Endo.

Arne Slot had made 11 changes from the Everton game but substitute Hugo Ekitike saved Liverpool's understudies from

a penalty shoot-out when he finished off Chiesa's pass in the 85th minute.

The French striker took off his shirt to celebrate and was dismissed for a second bookable offence.

Liverpool have made a perfect start to the season, with seven successive wins, including five in the Premier League to take them to the top of the table and one in the Champions League against Atletico.

Chelsea survive

Chelsea were in danger of a humiliating exit after boss Enzo Maresca made eight changes following the 2-1 defeat at Manchester United on Saturday.

In their first meeting with Chelsea since 1911, Lincoln took the lead thanks to a Blues blunder in the 42nd minute.

The countdown is nearing its end for the third Asian Youth Games, set to take place in Bahrain from October 22 to 31 under the patronage of His Majesty King Hamad.

Originally awarded to Tashkent, Uzbekistan in 2019, the Games were reassigned to Bahrain in record time after construction delays and Uzbekistan's withdrawal in December 2024, giving the Kingdom less than a year to prepare.

The event will now welcome more than 5,000 athletes aged 14 to 18 from 45 nations, all competing across 24 sports.

Bahrain's Teams Take Place

Preparations are well un-



derway as Bahrain finalizes its squads for the Games, with the Olympic Committee confirming participation in athletics, 3x3 basketball, jiu-jitsu, badminton, and E-sports.

The under-16 3x3 basketball squad includes Somto Patrick Onoduenyi, Hassan Abdulkadir, Divine Tochukwu Abochi, Ali Hussain Mahdi, Yousif Yaqoob

Meshaei, and Hussain Fuad Ghuloom, guided by Serbian coach Bogdan Dragovic and Bahraini coach Murtadha Mohammed.

On the track, Bahrain will be represented by Salah Rashid, Yousef Ayman Rizq, Talal Al Dossary, Maryam Ateeq, and others across sprints, middle distance, and cross-country.

Jiu-jitsu competitors include European champion Pedro Bisi de Jesus, Yousif Mercer, and Hamad Fuad Waheed. Badminton features the likes of Ali Ashoor, Fatima Ebrahim, while the E-sports team is led by Hussain Al Jowder.

ming, athletics, badminton, 3x3 basketball, boxing, camel racing, cycling, equestrian, E-sports, indoor football, golf, handball, jiu-jitsu, judo, kabaddi, mixed martial arts, Muay Thai, table tennis, taekwondo, teqball, triathlon, volleyball, weightlifting, and wrestling. Kurash joins the programme for the first time at the Asian Youth Games as announced yesterday.

Venues are organised into zones. Zone 1, around Isa Sports City and Bahrain National Stadium, hosts athletics, handball, futsal, volleyball, kabaddi, and badminton. Zone 2, at Exhibition World Bahrain, stages table tennis, MMA, E-sports, taekwondo, Muay Thai, jiu-jitsu, boxing, judo, teqball, weightlifting, and wrestling.

Additional venues include the Military Sports Union for equestrian jumping, Bahrain Royal

Equestrian and Endurance Federation for camel racing and endurance events, Royal Golf Club for golf, Sofitel Bahrain Zallaq Thalassa for triathlon, NBH Loop for road cycling, and Sama Bay for beach volleyball and beach wrestling.

Exhibition World Bahrain also hosts the opening ceremony on October 22, the first indoor inauguration in the Games' history.

Competition begins before the ceremony, with boys' futsal, handball, and volleyball on October 19, followed by girls' futsal, kabaddi, teqball, and beach volleyball on October 21.

The Games conclude on October 31 with swimming finals and the closing ceremony.

Gateway to Dakar

The Asian Youth Games is Asia's second-largest multi-sport event after the Asian Games. Previous editions were held in Singapore (2009) and Nanjing (2013), with later editions cancelled.

The Games also serve as a qualification pathway for the 2026 Youth Olympic Games in Dakar.

For Bahrain, the event builds on the ISF Gymnasiade 2024, which featured more than 5,000 participants from 80 countries, with the focus now on the Kingdom's own athletes competing on home soil.

World number one Alcaraz prepares for a stronger Sinner after US Open defeat

World number one Carlos Alcaraz said yesterday that he will have to prepare for a new and improved Jannik Sinner after beating his great rival in the US Open final.

Italy's Sinner admitted he needed to overhaul his "predictable" game after losing to Alcaraz in New York earlier this month in the latest of a string of recent defeats to his Spanish nemesis.

Alcaraz is playing at the Japan Open in Tokyo this week, while Sinner will compete at the China Open in Beijing in his first appearance since the US Open.

Alcaraz and Sinner have dominated men's tennis this season, with the pair contesting all four Grand Slam finals, winning two each.

Alcaraz is only 22 and Sinner is just two years older, and the two look set to monopolise the sport's top titles for years to come.

"Our rivalry is getting better, which for me and for tennis I would say is great," said Alcaraz.

"We will see in the future how many times I'm going to play

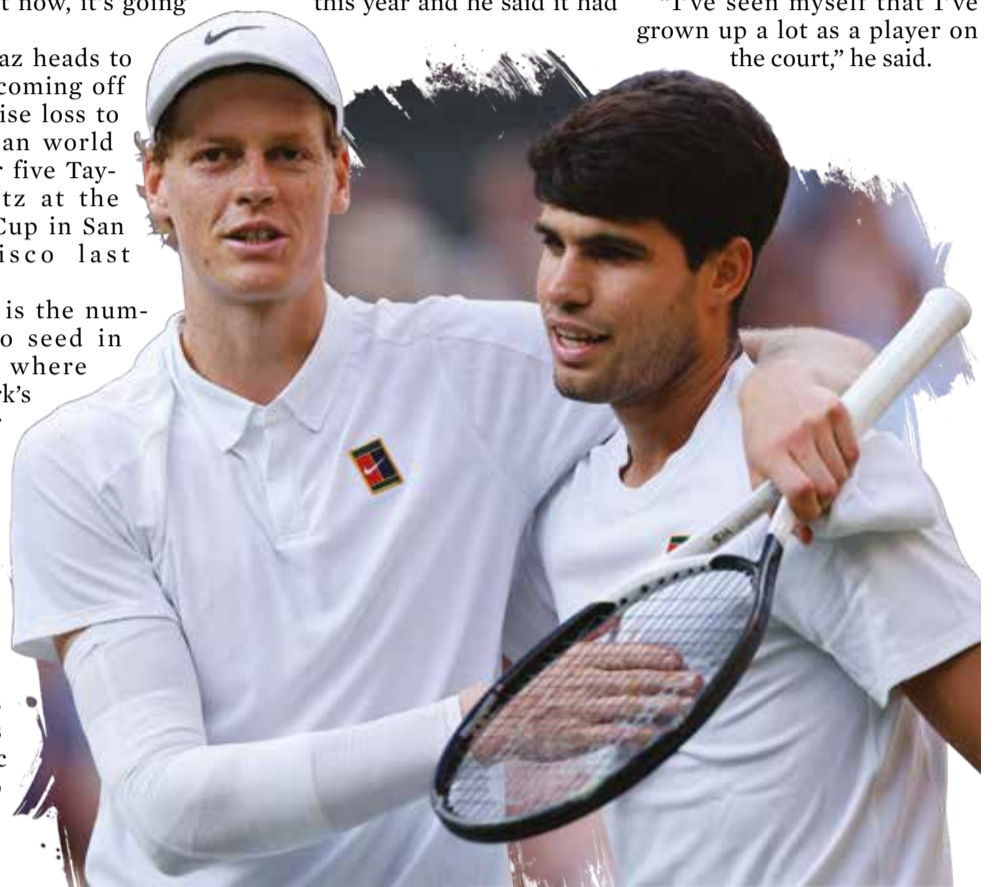
