



Arab and Islamic leaders push for urgent end to Gaza war in talks with Trump

ight leaders and ministers from Arab and Islamic states issued a unified call to end the war in Gaza during talks with US President Donald Trump on the sidelines of the 80th UN General Assembly session yesterday.

The leaders of Qatar, Jordan, Turkiye, Indonesia and Pakistan, along with Egypt's prime minister and the foreign ministers of the UAE and Saudi Arabia, stressed the urgent need for a ceasefire and immediate humanitarian access to the besieged enclave.

They warned of the "humanitarian catastrophe and high human toll" in Gaza, where more than 65,000 Palestinians have been killed since October 2023.
