In a post on X, EAM Jaishankar said, "Good to meet Secretary of State Marco Rubio this morning in New York. Our conversation covered a range of bilateral and international issues of current concern. Agreed on the importance of sustained engagement to progress on priority areas. We will remain in touch.'

The meeting marked their first direct interaction since trade tensions escalated following steep tariffs imposed by US President Donald Trump on Indian goods over India's purchase of Russian oil.

Despite recent challenges, the meeting is seen as part of a broader effort to reinforce India-US ties, which had shown signs of strain but are now moving towards recovery.

The two leaders had last met in Washington during the 10th Quad Foreign Ministers' Meeting in July and had also interacted earlier in January this year. However, the upcoming bilateral meeting will be their Russian oil.
