**20,340 Bahrainis employed under national programme**

# Strengthening national plan for 'gender balance'

● **Report bolsters Bahrain position as centre of international expertise in women's affairs**

The Cabinet yesterday approved a memorandum by the Minister of Finance and National Economy on the National Gender Balance Report (2019-2020) prepared by the Supreme Council for Women.

The report aims to measure the effectiveness and impact of policies and legislation in achieving the national plan for the further advancement of Bahraini women and strengthening the position of the Kingdom of Bahrain as a centre of international expertise in women's affairs.

The report revealed that the Kingdom's overall gender balance index for the years 2019-2020 increased to 69%, reaching 73% in key areas reviewed.

Institutional performance index reached 65%, with an increase in participation of women in specialised jobs, the legislative authority, commercial activity, and representation in boards of directors and committees.

This was among the memorandums discussed yesterday during the weekly Cabinet meeting held at Gudaibiya Palace and

chaired by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

The Cabinet also approved the following:

1. A memorandum by the Ministerial Committee for Legal and Legislative Affairs regarding several MoUs and an execution plan between the Kingdom of Bahrain and the UAE, which aims to further strengthen bilateral cooperation.

2. A memorandum by the Ministerial Committee for Legal and Legislative Affairs regarding a

request by the Supreme Council for the Environment to join an agreement on the establishment of the Global Green Growth Institute, which aims to promote sustainable development and improve economic, environmental, and social conditions through international partnerships between the public and private sectors.

3. A memorandum by the Ministerial Committee for Legal and Legislative Affairs on pledges related to health and climate change, which are in line with the Kingdom of Bahrain's

international commitments, and steps towards achieving an active role in climate action and the further development of the national health system.

4. A memorandum by the Minister of Industry, Commerce and Tourism on the Kingdom of Bahrain's tourism strategy (2022-2026). The strategy aims to highlight the Kingdom's status as a global tourism centre. This includes increasing the tourism sector's contribution to GDP and diversifying tourism through several initiatives and projects. The strategy intends

to enhance tourist attractions, accommodation, and investment opportunities in the Kingdom.

5. A memorandum by the Minister of Youth and Sports Affairs, Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Education and Training Quality Authority, regarding the annual report of the Education and Training Quality Authority for 2021. The report outlines the performance of education and training institutions after applying exceptional frameworks for evaluation during the global COVID-19 pandemic.

6. A memorandum on digital policies that aim to enhance e-government services and facilitate their use for business development.

7. A memorandum by the Ministerial Committee for Legal and Legislative Affairs regarding the government's response to a law proposal submitted by the Shura Council.

# Bahrain in 'growth' paths amid pandemic

Focus on implementing royal directives for economic recovery, financial stability

● **Finance Minister holds remote meeting with key officials to discuss development initiatives**

Bahrain is stepping up efforts to achieve economic recovery and enhance financial stability amid the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

This was emphasised by Finance and National Economy Minister Shaikh Salman bin Khalifa Al Khalifa as he met remotely with Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BCCI) Chairman Samir Nass in the presence of other key officials to discuss a number of initiatives aimed at developing the economy and creating a qualitative opportunity for citizens.

## Green garbage begins at your doorstep

There is a lot of talk in decision-making circles these days about the 'aesthetics' of garbage dumpsters.

There has even been a suggestion to stick artificial grass panels to the dumpsters to give an impression of 'green cover'. Personally, I think that is a very unhygienic solution.

Inevitably people dropping off their waste will let the trash overflow and bits of waste will get stuck in the artificial turf cover, leading to the menace of flies and odour.

Indeed, we are going about the whole garbage issue in the wrong way.

In Bahrain, we are fast running out of landfill area and our garbage is just increasing every month because of rapid urbanisation and general uptick in the use of disposables.

In April this year, the Southern Governorate alone saw the removal of over 700 tonnes of discarded furniture. Luckily, these did not end up in landfills but were recycled to needy families.

What we need are strong garbage disposal ethics. Household waste is one of the biggest contributors to Bahrain's trash burden.

Why not start at the beginning of the cycle and get people to segregate their trash into recyclables and non-recyclable garbage so that we can lessen the burden on our landfills and our planet too.

The impact of household-level segregation of garbage is enormous and many countries are practising this civic duty. In places like the UK and Germany, unsegregated garbage is left uncollected and this kind of public exposure of carelessness is a great deterrent.

In our Eastern culture, we sadly believe that garbage is not worth our time once discarded, forgetting that if we do not make it ecologically suitable for disposal, it will impact our children's lives more than ours.

In these times of climate change and global warming, begin the renewal of our planet at every doorstep – simply separate your trash into glass, paper, plastic and organic waste and lessen the burden on Mother Earth.

Leave the ideas of "beautification of garbage bins" to dreamers.

# A training programme for university students

Goal is to address environmental and climate challenges and problems in Kingdom

## Higher Education Council and British Council launch event

A training programme of the international "Climate Champions" research project for undergraduate students in public and private higher education institutions in the Kingdom was opened yesterday in partnership with the British Council.

The event, set from October 23 to 28 at the Wyndham Grand Hotel in Bahrain Bay, is held under the patronage of the Secretary-General of the Higher Education Council (HEC) and the Deputy Chairperson of its Board of Trustees, Dr Shaikha Rana bint Isa bin Duaij Al Khalifa.

Attended by the UK Ambassador to Bahrain Roddy Drummond and heads of higher education institutions in the Kingdom, the programme aims to enhance the research ca-

abilities of students in a way that contributes to addressing environmental and climate challenges and problems in the Kingdom.

Environment, climate and scientific research skills experts Dan Boyden and Daniel Smith will lecture during the programme.

Addressing the opening session, Dr Shaikha Rana expressed thanks to the British Embassy and the British Council for their partnership in implementing this training programme, which relates to an important issue closely related to various areas

of development.

It also coincides with the national "Forever Green" campaign, launched under the patronage of Her Royal Highness Princess Sabeeka bint Ibrahim Al Khalifa, Wife of HM the King, to achieve the goals of sustainable development in the areas of climate and the environment.

She stressed the importance of scientific research in the field of environment and climate in addressing the associated challenges from which various countries suffer.

Dr Shaikha Rana highlighted the distinguished level of

this training programme and its participants, noting that it defines the ecosystem, nature and cultural identity, shows how our identities shape our relationship with nature and promotes innovation in climate action.

She also praised the participation of ten academicians and 50 undergraduate students from various disciplines in the kingdom's higher education institutions.

The HEC Secretary General added that the programme will continue throughout the first semester of this academic year, as the participants in the workshops will be divided into groups, with each group tasked with preparing a research and a social project on one of the environmental and climatic problems in the Kingdom, based on the recommendations of the Supreme Council for the Environment.

Each group will be supervised by a member of the academic staff participating in the programme, and will contact trainers in the United Kingdom virtually.

## Filipinos updated on Philippine COVID-19 vaccine rollout

The Philippine Embassy has been regularly updating Filipinos residing and working in the Kingdom of Bahrain on the coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccine rollout back home.

To date, the total number of first and second vaccine doses administered in the Philippines has reached more than 53,315,069 million as of 19 October. There are now 24,694,717 million people who have been fully vaccinated from the virus.

COVID-19 vaccination in the Philippines started in March 2021 and the country aims to vaccinate 58 million people by the end of the year.

Through its official Facebook account, the Embassy also provides the guides to be followed by Bahrain-based Filipinos to reduce inconvenience they encounter going home.

Under existing protocol, returning Filipinos from overseas are subjected to 10-day facility quarantine.



In compliance with Philippine government regulations, travellers arriving in the Philippines starting 8 October and onwards, who are unvaccinated, partially vaccinated or individuals whose vaccination status cannot be independently validated, and those vaccinated but failed to comply with the test-before-travel requirements, shall undergo 14 days of quarantine, eight days of which shall be observed at an accredited hotel or facility, and the remaining six to be completed at home under the monitoring of their respective Local Government Units.

Travellers shall also undergo an RT-PCR test on the seventh day of their quarantine stay.

A traveller must stay at a hotel accredited by our Tourism and Health Agencies while waiting for scheduled test and the release of results. He/she can only check out from the hotel until the release of the negative RT-PCR test taken on the seventh day. Day 1 starts on arrival date.

ASEAN foreign ministers decided on Oct. 15 to sideline Min Aung Hlaing, leader of a Feb. 1 Myanmar coup, for his failure to implement that plan, which included ending hostilities, initiating dialogue, allowing humanitarian support and granting a special envoy full access in the country.

## Libyan elections commission to start registering candidates in Nov

Registration for candidates in Libya's presidential and parliamentary elections should open in November, the head of the electoral commission said yesterday.

Elections are a key step in a UN-backed process to end a decade of violence by creating a new political leadership whose legitimacy is widely accepted.

But wrangling over the constitutional basis for elections, the rules governing them and questions over their credibility have threatened to unravel the peace process in recent months.

The first round of the presidential election is due to be held on Dec. 24. A second round, along with a parliamentary election, will then be held at a later date, said the commission head, Emad al-Sayah.

He said the registration process should open by mid-November, after technical and logistical preparations were complete.

But the complexities of the political patchwork resulting from divisions between eastern and western Libya mean there are still hurdles to overcome.

Although parliament has issued a law enabling the presidential election to be held on Dec. 24, it has also issued another law saying the parliamentary election will happen separately, at a later date. Other political institutions have rejected parliament's proposals.

## 'Vibrant' cinematographer re

The crew was setting up a difficult shot during filming on the New Mexico set of "Rust", and the movie's cinematographer, Halyna Hutchins, wasn't quite satisfied.

She turned to Lane Luper, a member of the camera crew, who suggested some adjustments that she found worked perfectly. That kind of collaborative spirit, Luper said at a candlelight vigil on Saturday, was what made Hutchins such a joy to work with.

"Her photography was beautiful, and every day, everybody on the camera team was proud to be there for her, because we

were proud of what we were creating - what she was creating," he told the crowd, two days after Hutchins was killed in an accident when actor Alec Baldwin fired a prop gun on set.

Luper said he would have been lucky to work with her again. "And I don't get to. And it sucks," he said, breaking into tears.

While organisers emphasized that the vigil in Albuquerque, New Mexico, was to honor Hutchins' memory, rather than focus on her death, some in the crowd held signs that read "Safety on Set," a reminder that the circumstances surrounding Thursday's shooting remain murky.

## More than 260 Houthis killed in strikes near Marib, coalition says

The Saudi-led coalition fighting in Yemen said yesterday it had killed more than 260 Houthi rebels in the past three days near the strategic city of Marib.

"Thirty-six military vehicles were destroyed and more than 264" rebel fighters were killed in strikes in the past 72 hours in

The Iran-backed Houthi rebels rarely comment on losses and AFP could not independently verify the toll.

The coalition has for the past two weeks reported almost daily

strikes around Marib, the internationally recognised government's last bastion in oil-rich northern Yemen.

It says it has killed hundreds of Houthi rebels in the fighting.

The Houthis began a major push to seize Marib in February and have renewed their offensive since September after a lull.

When Baldwin fired the gun, Hutchins was fatally struck in the chest, according to the sheriff's office.

It is unclear why the gun contained a projectile. The person in charge of weapons on set is

known as an armorer. The armorer for "Rust," Hannah Gutierrez, had set up the gun and two others, according to the affidavit.

Halls and Gutierrez could not be reached for comment on Saturday.

Rust Movie Productions said in a statement on Friday it had not been aware of any safety concerns but was investigating the incident.

"Though we were not made aware of any official complaints concerning weapon or prop safety on set, we will be conducting an internal review of our procedures while production is shut down," the company said. Baldwin is among the film's producers.

## Israel to build over new 1,300 W.Bank settler homes

Israel yesterday announced plans to build more residences for Jewish settlers in the occupied West Bank, drawing immediate condemnation from Palestinians, peace activists and neighbouring Jordan.

The announcement from the housing and construction ministry in right-wing Prime Minister Naftali Bennett's government said tenders had been published for 1,355 homes in the West Bank, which has been occupied by Israel since the 1967 Six-Day War.

Those new homes add to the more than 2,000 residences which defence sources have said in August would be authorised for West Bank settlers.

Final approval is expected from the defence ministry this week for those homes.

## Fire blazes on cargo ship off British Columbia

A fire broke out on Saturday on containers on a cargo ship carrying mining chemicals off British Columbia, and the Canadian Coast Guard said it is working with the US Coast Guard to assess the situation, including environmental hazards.

Sixteen crew members have been evacuated from the MV Zim Kingston, while five remained onboard to fight the fire, the Canadian Coast Guard said in a statement on Saturday.

"No injuries were reported," Danaos Shipping Co, the company that manages the container ship, said in a statement to Reuters on Sunday.

The fire "appears to have

been contained," and a salvage and fire extinguishing agency have been roped in to ensure the safe return of the vessel's crew, Danaos said.

Ten containers were currently burning, the coast guard had earlier said, adding that the fire continued to spread but the ship itself was not on fire.

Meanwhile, the agency said it was working with its US counterpart to track 40 containers that had fallen overboard, saying they pose a significant risk to mariners.

"Mariners are advised to stay clear of the area. Currently there is no safety risk to people on shore, however the situation

will continue to be monitored," the agency said.

Video obtained by Reuters showed fire cascading down from the deck of the ship into the water.

The Zim Kingston reported on Friday that it had encountered rough weather west of the Strait of Juan de Fuca.

"This is extremely concerning. The ship and containers are very close to Victoria, BC, and a big storm is forecast to hit tonight. We ... are worried this may be yet another environmental disaster," said David Boudinot, president of Surfrider Foundation Canada, an environmental organization.

## Picasso works fetch more than \$100 million at Sotheby's Las Vegas auction

Eleven Picasso paintings and other works that helped turn Las Vegas into an unlikely destination for art were sold at auction on Saturday for more than \$100 million.

The Sotheby's auction was held at the Bellagio hotel in Las Vegas, where the works had been on display for years, and took place two days before the 140th birthday of the Spanish artist on Oct. 25.

Five of the paintings had hung on the walls of the Bellagio's fine dining restaurant, Picasso. The restaurant will continue to display 12 other Picasso works.

The highest price was fetched by the 1938 painting "Femme au beret rouge-orange" of Picasso's lover and muse Marie-Therese Walter, which sold for \$40.5 million, some \$10 million over the high pre-sale estimate.

The large-scale portraits "Homme et Enfant" and "Buste d'homme" sold for \$24.4 million and \$9.5 million respectively, while smaller works on ceramic, like "Le Dejeuner sur

l'herbe" which sold for \$2.1 million, went for three or four times their pre-sale estimate.

The buyers' names were not disclosed.

Saturday's sale was part of a bid by casino and hotel group MGM Resorts to further diversify its vast collection to include more art from women, people of color and emerging nations as well as from LGBTQ artists and artists with disabilities.

A 2019 Public Library of Science study of 18 leading US museums found that 85% of the artists on display are white and 87% are men.

## Deadly blast in Ugandan capital 'seems to be a terrorist act' - president

A deadly blast in Kampala late on Saturday appeared to be an act of terrorism, Ugandan President Yoweri Museveni said yesterday.

He said the explosion in the capital killed one person, although the Uganda Police chief political commissar Asan Kasinye said late on Saturday that two people were killed.

At least seven people were injured, TV station NTV reported.

"It seems to be a terrorist act," Museveni Tweeted on Sunday.

"The information I have is that 3 people came and left a package in kaveera [plastic bag] which later on exploded," Museveni said.

There was no immediate claim of responsibility.

The blast occurred at Digida Pork Joint, a restaurant, local



Najma improved to a 4-2 win-loss record while Sitra dropped to a 1-5 mark.

# Pakistan thrash India by 10 wickets at T20 World Cup

Pakistan recorded their first ever T20 World Cup win over India after reaching a target of 152 without losing a wicket

● Fifties by Babar Azam and Mohammad Rizwan help Pakistan triumph

Captain Babar Azam led by example as Pakistan beat India in a World Cup match for the first time ever with a 10-wicket romp in a Super 12 blockbuster at the Twenty20 World Cup yesterday.

Virat Kohli played a captain's knock of 57 to rescue India from a top-order wobble and help them post a competitive 151-7 in a rematch of the inaugural 2007 final.

His counterpart Babar combined with Mohammad Rizwan to get Pakistan off to a flying start and then overwhelmed the target with 13 balls to spare to snap India's 100% win record against them in limited-overs World Cups.

Babar remained not out on 68, while Rizwan made an unbeaten 79.

Wary of the dew factor, captains have preferred to field and Babar too followed that trend after win-ning the toss.

Pakistan did not have to wait long for a breakthrough as Shaheen Afridi (3-31) struck twice in his first seven deliveries to

rattle India.

The left-arm pacer fired in a searing yorker-length delivery to dismiss Rohit Sharma lbw for a golden duck and, in his next over, rifled one through KL Rahul's gate to rearrange the stumps.

Suryakumar Yadav hit Afridi for a six but Rizwan took a diving catch behind the stumps to dismiss the batsman and reduce India to 31-3 in the sixth over.

Kohli and Rishabh Pant calmed nerves in the Indian camp and guided the team to 60-3 at the halfway stage of the innings.

Pant then decided to counter-attack and hit Hasan Ali for back-to-back sixes but his ultra-aggression ultimately did him in.

Shadab Khan foxed Pant with a googly to induce a skier which the spinner caught himself to dismiss the batsman for 39.

Kohli fell in the penultimate over of the innings trying to accelerate but India still made the 150-mark.

Pakistan, in their reply, not only kept their wickets intact in the powerplay overs but also scored briskly with Babar and Rizwan effectively killing off the contest with their rock-solid stand.

Babar brought up his fifty in style, hitting spinner Varun Chakravarthy for a six, while Rizwan reached his own fifty with a pulled boundary off Jasprit Bumrah.

Pakistan next play New Zealand on Wednesday morning.

Meanwhile in the other group, Charith Asalanka and Bhanuka Rajapaksa shared a partnership of 86 to give Sri Lanka a five-wicket win over Bangladesh in their opening match.

Asalanka remained unbeaten on 80 from 49 balls - his first T20 international half century - and Rajapaksa, celebrating his 30th birthday, hit a 31-ball 53 to help Sri Lanka chase down a 172-run target with seven balls to spare.

Put in to bat, Bangladesh posted 171 for four after opening batsman Mohammad Naim anchored the innings with a 52-ball 62 and the experienced Mushfiqur Rahim smashed an unbeaten 57 off 37 balls.



Japan, Australia, China and hosts India had automatic berths and did not compete in the qualification process.
