◆ At least three people were killed and six were injured in a major road collision involving over 40 vehicles and a chemical tanker in central China

yesterday. About 10 vehicles caught fire in the crash, which occurred at about 7am on Baomao highway in the city of Tongchuan, in Shaanxi province. Emergency efforts were continuing with many people trapped, state broadcaster CCTV reported. Two people had so far been rescued. The response involved at least 16 fire engines and more than 100 firefighters.

The flames were extinguished before they spread to the 34-tonne tanker, which was carrying highly flammable methanol, according to CCTV.

Biden forges ahead with building team

s President-elect Joe Biden yesterday began a new phase in his transition to the White House after the Trump administration gave the Democrat access to critical resources that will enable him to take the reins of power in January.

The General Services Administration's announcement on Monday that it would formally recognize Biden's transition leadership team. came after weeks of the president falsely claiming that the Nov. 3 election had been marred by widespread voter fraud.

Trump, in a post on Twitter,

offered support for the move. Critics have said the president's refusal to accept the results undermined US democracy and undercut the next administration's ability to fight the novel coronavirus.

While Trump stopped short of conceding, it was the closest he has come to acknowledging that it is time to hand over power to Biden, who will take office on Jan. 20.
