It is implementing more than 20 major development projects worth over \$30 billion under a new Strategic Projects Plan to drive investment, advance infrastructure, create jobs, boost economy and enhance its long-term competitiveness. Edict issued on land distribution

● **Determining rules and provisions for planning or re-planning projects**

His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, yesterday issued Edict (64) of 2021, determining the rules and provisions for distributing the lands of the planning or re-planning projects for which the expropriation has taken place.

Article (1): Owners of the expropriated areas and lands for planning or re-planning purposes shall be compensated in kind, with plots of land from the planning or re-planning project for which the expropriation is taking place, according to the basic price estimated by the appraisal committee for each plot.

The following cases shall be exempted from in-kind compensation:

a. Insufficient number of plots of land for the project or the plan for distribution to those whose property has been expropriated and seek in-kind compensation. The compensation shall be in cash and/or in kind with lands in other regions, according to the basic price estimated by the appraisal committee, provided that the compensation value is not less than the price of the property before the planning or re-planning.

b. If in-kind compensation is impossible for any reason, including the fact that the property does not meet the minimum real estate area set forth in Article (13) of the Executive

Regulations of Decree-Law (3) of 1994 on the Division of Land for Reconstruction and Development issued by Edict (56) of 2009. The compensation shall be in cash, provided that the compensation value is not less than the price of the property before the planning or re-planning.

Article (2): The plots of land for the planning or re-planning project for which the expropriation has taken place shall be distributed in accordance with the following rules:

1. The owner of the real estate located in the area that has been expropriated shall have the priority right to be compensated with one or more plots of land from the new plan at the basic price estimated by the appraisal committee for each plot.

2. Taking into consideration the location of the property before planning or re-planning and the extent of its connection to the road network.

3. Taking into account the classification of the property before the planning or re-planning.

4. The difference between the area of the alternative property and the expropriated property

must not exceed 30% whenever possible.

5. Making sure that the compensation shall be by one or more plots of land in the location or surroundings of the expropriated property whenever it is possible.

6. The value of the alternative plot of land shall not be less than that of the expropriated property prior to planning or re-planning.

Article (3) In-kind compensation may be by combined or separate plots of land in the new plan according to the basic price of each plot.

Article (4) In case of a group of endowment plots (charitable endowments) that do not partially or fully meet the minimum real estate area set forth in Article (13) of the Executive Regulations of Decree-Law (3) of 1994 on the Division of Land for Reconstruction and Development issued by Edict (56) of 2009, the expropriated property may be compensated with one or more plots, provided that registration is made in the common ownership system according to the basic price of each plot, and that all plots are under the management of one endowment.

Article (5) In case the value of the compensated plot of land exceeds the compensation determined for the expropriated property, the beneficiary shall pay the difference through one of the following ways:

1. Payment of the full amount of the difference in one go through one of the payment channels approved by the Ministry of Finance and National Economy. In this case, the owner shall be granted a reduction of 20% of the value of the difference.

The package of new mega projects represents one of Bahrain's most significant ever injections of capital investment to enhance financial sustainability and economic stability as the Kingdom is well on its way out of the pandemic.

The Economic Recovery Plan comprises 22 signature projects across key sectors, including telecoms, tourism, education, housing, manufacturing, health and youth and sports.

Among the most prominent projects is the creation of five cities situated on newly constructed islands, increasing Bahrain's total land area by more than 60%.

The new cities are Fasht Al Jarim, Suhaila Island, Fasht Al

Adham, Bahrain Bay and Hawar Islands.

Fasht Al Jarim, the largest city, will span 183km² providing a residential, logistics, and tourism hub that will house a new airport.

The new 25km, four-lane King Hamad Causeway will facilitate cross border trade and travel with Saudi Arabia and the wider GCC, and strengthen political, strategic, economic, and cultural ties.

Within Bahrain, a new metro system will offer travel choice, reduce congestion, and contribute to the Kingdom's plans to achieve net zero.

The metro network of over 109 kms will connect all major

population hubs in the country. The 20-station first phase of the metro will run from Bahrain International Airport to the residential and commercial area of Seef, linking both to Manama and the Diplomatic Area.

Transport connectivity will be complemented by technology investment in land and sea fiber optics, connecting all regions of the Kingdom and enhancing competitiveness.

Next generation cloud-computing services will be supported by significant investment in several new data centre projects.

The building of "Sports City", a complex that will house the largest sports stadium in Bahrain and a multi-purpose indoor

The new projects announced under the Strategic Projects Plan will build upon the Kingdom's 2015 infrastructure plan that delivered the new Bahrain International Airport terminal, ALBA's Line 6 expansion project, and the AB-4 Pipeline.

More than 587 eServices are currently being provided via the National Portal, bahrain.bh and self-service kiosks, in cooperation with public and private entities.

They are also available via the eGovernment Apps Store, bahrain.bh/apps, which offers over 20 apps including the eTraffic, GovEmployee, and Electricity and Water Authority (EWA) apps. This is in addition to the services of the Government Services Contact Center on 80008001.

About her achievement, she







Apple files lawsuit against NSO Group, saying US citizens were targets

Apple Inc said on Tuesday it has filed a lawsuit against Israeli cyber firm NSO Group and its parent company OSY Technologies for alleged surveillance and targeting of US Apple users with its Pegasus spyware. The iPhone maker said it is also seeking to ban NSO

Group from using any Apple software, services or devices to prevent further abuse.

Apple is the latest in a string of companies and governments to come after NSO, the maker of the Pegasus hacking tool that watchdog groups say targeted human rights workers and journalists. Earlier this month, US officials placed the company

on a trade blacklist. NSO has also faced either legal action or criticism from Microsoft Corp, Meta Platforms Inc, Alphabet Inc and Cisco Systems Inc.

NSO is allegedly involved in circumventing security for products made by these companies and selling that circumvention in the form of hacking tools to foreign governments.

"As a rule, naturalization should be possible after five years, with special integration achievements after three years," the document said. The current time requirement for naturalization is eight years which could be cut to six years in special integration cases, the agreement said.

◆ **Apple Inc issued yesterday alert messages to at least six Thai activists and researchers** who have been critical of the government, warning it believed their iPhones had been targeted by "state-sponsored attackers", according to activists and the alerts reviewed by Reuters. Apple and Thailand's Digital Ministry did not immediately respond to a request for comment.

Apple warns Thai activists "state-sponsored attackers" may have targeted iPhones



Prajak Kongkirati, a political scientist at Bangkok's Thammasat University, said he had received two

emails from Apple warning it believed his iPhone and iCloud accounts had been targeted, along with a "threat notification" on his Apple account.

◆ **European Union ambassadors approved the renewal of sanctions on four Chinese officials** and one Chinese entity on Wednesday as part of an extension of a human rights blacklist, two diplomats said.

EU extends human rights sanctions, including on Chinese officials



The decision, which will formally be adopted early next month, puts in jeopardy a Chinese-EU investment agreement signed in late December 2020. The EU added the four Chinese officials, including a top security director, to its sanctions list in March over accusations of human rights abuses in China's Xinjiang region. Beijing responded with its own sanctions on Europeans.

Lebanon has yet to give IMF figure for financial losses, central bank governor says



◆ **Lebanon has yet to give the IMF its estimate of losses in the financial system** as discussions on the issue continue, but is working hard to sign a memorandum of

understanding with the Fund by year-end, governor Riad Salameh said on Tuesday. Disagreements in Lebanon over the size of the losses and how they should be distributed torpedoed IMF talks last year. The central bank, banks and political elite rejected figures set out in a government plan that was endorsed by the IMF at the time. The issue has obstructed attempts to chart a way out of the crisis that has devastated Lebanon since 2019, sinking the currency by more than 90%, causing poverty to skyrocket and leading many Lebanese to emigrate.

UAE holds talks with Taliban Kabul airport - foreign diplomats

The United Arab Emirates has held talks with the Taliban to run Kabul airport, according to four sources with knowledge of the matter.

UAE officials have held a series of discussions with the group in recent weeks to discuss operating the airport that serves as landlocked Afghanistan's main air link to the world, the foreign diplomats based in the Gulf region told Reuters.

The Qataris have been helping run the Hamid Karzai International Airport along with Turkey after playing a major role in evacuation efforts following the chaotic US withdrawal in August, and have said they are willing to take over the operations.

Yet the Taliban has not yet formalised an arrangement with Qatar, the four diplomats said.

A senior Emirati foreign ministry official said the UAE, which previously ran Kabul airport during the US-backed Afghan republic, "remains committed to continuing to assist in operating" it to ensure humanitarian access and safe passage.

Abu Dhabi also aided recent evacuation efforts.

The Taliban and Qatari authorities did not respond to request for comment. Two of the diplomats said the Taliban has also sought financial assistance from the UAE, though they added it was not clear if this was related to the airport discussions.

The Emirati foreign ministry

official, Salem Al Zaabi, director of international security co-operation, did not respond to a question on whether the UAE was considering providing financial help to the Taliban.

Airport intelligence

One key issue that's still to be resolved between the Taliban and potential airport operators is who would provide security at the site, the four diplomats said. The Tal-

iban say they do not want foreign forces in the country following their return to power after two decades of war.

Still, Qatari special forces are presently providing security within the airport's perimeter, the diplomats added, while Taliban special forces were patrolling areas outside.

So far countries have been reluctant to formally recognise the Taliban's government, accusing the group of backtracking on pledges to uphold the rights of women and minorities.

German parties set to announce coalition deal to end

The deal will install Germany's first three-way federal coalition government since the 1950s and end 16 years of Merkel-led conservative government, marking a new era for relations with Europe and the rest of the world.

Iran's top nuclear negotiator holds talks in UAE

Iran's top nuclear negotiator Ali Bagheri Kani met with senior Emirati officials yesterday during a visit to the United Arab Emirates, state news agency WAM reported, in a rare visit that comes as Abu Dhabi moves to reduce tensions with Tehran.

WAM said Bagheri Kani, who is Iran's deputy foreign minister, met with the diplomatic adviser to the UAE president, Anwar Gargash, and Emirati minister of state for foreign affairs Khalifa Shaheen Almarar.

The discussions stressed the importance of strengthening relations "on the basis of good neighbourliness and mutual respect", working for greater regional stability and prosperity and developing bilateral

economic and commercial ties, WAM said.

The visit comes ahead of the expected resumption of talks

between global powers and Iran in Vienna on Monday to try to revive a 2015 nuclear pact, which Gulf states have criticised

for not addressing Tehran's missile programme and regional proxies.

Gargash earlier this month said that the UAE was taking steps to de-escalate tensions with Iran.

Senior Iranian and Gulf officials told Reuters last week that a top UAE delegation would visit Tehran soon. US President Joe Biden wants to negotiate a return to compliance with the nuclear deal that his predecessor Donald Trump quit in 2018, re-imposing sanctions. Iran, which denies pursuing nuclear weapons, responded by resuming building its stockpile of enriched uranium.

Saudi Arabia launched direct talks with Iran in April. Riyadh has described the talks as "cordial" but said they remained largely exploratory.

Yet Qatari officials have urged greater international engagement with the Taliban to prevent impoverished Afghanistan from falling into a humanitarian crisis. Gulf states have also voiced concern that the US withdrawal would allow al Qaeda to regain a foothold in Afghanistan.

While there is little commercial benefit for any operator, the airport would provide a much-needed source of intelligence on movements in and out of the country, according to the four diplomats, who said that since the withdrawal many countries have lacked real-time information.

The UAE has maintained ties with the Taliban too, according to two of the diplomats. They said the country had been home to some members of the group in recent years, including Sher Mohammad Abbas Stanikzai, who they added lived in the Sharjah emirate with his family from at least 2013. Stanikzai is now deputy foreign minister in the Taliban administration.

Al Zaabi did not respond to questions on the UAE's relationship with Stanikzai. The Taliban did not immediately respond to queries on Stanikzai living in the UAE.

The Taliban said this month that the UAE had reopened its embassy in Kabul. The UAE has not commented.

Russia and Ukraine both step up military alert

Russia staged military drills in the Black Sea, south of Ukraine, yesterday and said it needed to sharpen the combat-readiness of its conventional and nuclear forces because of heightened NATO activity near its borders.

Ukraine, which with its ally the United States has said it believes Russia may be preparing an invasion, staged exercises of its own near the border with Belarus.

The United States and NATO have signalled their backing for Ukraine in ways that Moscow considers provocative, including through warship manoeuvres this month in the Black Sea and a delivery of U.S. patrol boats to the Ukrainian navy.

British Foreign Secretary Liz Truss told Reuters on Wednesday it would be "a grave mistake from Russia" to attack Ukraine.

Russian fighter planes and ships practiced repelling air

attacks on naval bases and responding with air strikes during military drills on Wednesday in the Black Sea, Interfax reported.

Separately, the news agency quoted Defence Minister Sergei Shoigu as saying the need for Russia to further develop its armed forces was dictated by "the complicated military and political conditions in the world and the growing activity of NATO countries near Russia's borders".

He said raising the armed forces' capabilities, supporting the combat readiness of nuclear forces and strengthening the potential of non-nuclear deterrence were among the priorities.

Shoigu on Tuesday complained that US bombers had rehearsed a nuclear strike on Russia from two different directions earlier this month and complained that the planes had come too close to the Russian border, drills the Pentagon said had adhered to international protocols.

Children at lower risk from COVID, vaccines should go to poor - WHO

● **WHO issues guidance on vaccination of children, adolescents**

COVID-19 disease, countries should prioritise adults and sharing vaccine doses with the COVAX programme to bring supplies to poorer countries, the World Health Organisation said yesterday.

Some rare cases of heart inflammation called myocarditis have been reported in younger men who received vaccines based on mRNA technology - Pfizer BioNTech and Moderna - but these

were generally mild and responded to treatment, it said.

Although that risk had not been fully determined, it was less than the risk of myocarditis linked to SARS-CoV-2 infection, it said.

The WHO's interim guidance was issued as more regulatory agencies authorise certain vaccines for use in children, including the United States, China, European Union, India and Israel, and most recently Canada last week. "As children and adolescents tend to have milder disease compared to adults, unless they are in a group at higher risk of severe COVID-19, it is less urgent to vaccinate them than older people, those with chronic health conditions and health workers," the WHO said.

Children can experience "long COVID-19" with prolonged symptoms but this was still under in-

vestigation, it said.

Several risk factors for severe COVID-19 in children have been reported including older age, obesity and pre-existing conditions including type 2 diabetes, asthma and heart disease, it added.

Maintaining education for all school-aged children should be an important priority during the pandemic, although transmission mitigation measures might be needed in schools, the WHO said.

Given vaccine supply constraints, immunisation programmes should focus on protecting groups at high risk of hospitalisation and death, the WHO said.

"As many parts of the world face extreme vaccine shortages, countries with high coverage in at-risk populations should prioritize global sharing of COVID-19 vaccines before vaccinating children, adolescents," it said.

Can't take India lightly in home conditions, says Williamson

New Zealand are the number one Test side and reigning World Test champions but are still wary of the hosts, who have often proved formidable in home conditions.

"I don't think we are favour-

ites," Williamson said on the eve of the first Test in Kanpur.

"One of the key strengths of Indian cricket is its depth. India has great knowledge of their own conditions, we know the challenge is a big one."

Williamson led his side to an eight-wicket win against India at the World Test Championship (WTC) final in Southampton in June, which the hosts will be looking to avenge.

Ronaldo sends Man United into last 16, Chelsea thrash Juventus

Manchester United booked their place in the Champions League last 16 as Cristiano Ronaldo scored in a 2-0 victory at Villarreal on Tuesday, while holders Chelsea also reached the knockout phase by thumping Juventus.

Three-time European champions United went into their first game since sacking Ole Gunnar Solskjaer at the weekend needing a win to confirm a top-two finish in Group F.

But they were under massive pressure as defeat would have left their fate out of their own hands.

David de Gea made two crucial saves and United, with Michael Carrick in caretaker charge, took advantage through Ronaldo's 78th-minute lob.

Jadon Sancho, so often a peripheral figure since his big-money move from Borussia Dortmund in the close-season, capped a fine individual display with his first goal for the club late on.

"It's not an important result for me personally. It's an important one for the players and the club," said Carrick.

Ronaldo's goal was the 799th of his career, his 140th in the Champions League and his sixth in the competition this season.

The other qualification spot in the group remains up for grabs after Young Boys and Atalanta played out a thrilling 3-3 draw in Bern.

Late goals from Vincent Sierro and Silvan Hefti gave the Swiss champions a 3-2 lead, but Luis Muriel struck in the 88th
