



Russia says will 'deploy' tactical nuclear weapons



Turkish City names avenue after His **Majesty King** Hamad TDT | Manama

n honour of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa's humanitarian efforts, the Turkish city of Elbistan in Kahramanmaras has named an avenue there "King of Bahrain."

The "King of Bahrain Avenue" is located in Al Bustan City, which was hit hard by a devastating earthquake that left many residents in need of assistance.

Bahrain was quick to respond to the disaster, sending several shipments of relief materials and raising over \$3.7 million for urgent humanitarian relief for the victims of the quake in Syria and Turkey.

RHF Secretary-General, Dr Mustafa Al-Sayed, said the "King of Bahrain Avenue" is in a strategic location in Elbistan City, which suffered violent tremors and where Bahrain concentrated its relief efforts.

Under the directives of HM King, Dr Al Sayed said, the Bahraini relief team visited the affected areas to identify urgent needs, dispatched four shipments of relief aid containing medical supplies, tents, and food, in addition to sending a Search and Rescue Taskforce from the Royal Guard. Bahrain also signed agreements with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, the Turkish Red Crescent, and the Foreign Economic Relations Board of Turkey (DEiK) to support quake-affected areas by establishing relief, educational, and health projects.

"Blue-collar workers frequently express dissatisfaction with their living arrangements in camps and staff accommodations, which can be inhumane at times, with men and women crammed together with very little space to move," Evone stated.

In addition, she mentioned that a significant number of low-income workers in Bahrain send their salaries to their families to improve their standard of living. As the cost-of-living increases, low-income migrant workers in the Kingdom become even more susceptible to financial hardship.



To avoid a sudden drop in sugar levels, Dr Isa recommended adjusting the meal time from Suhoor to breakfast and taking medications a few minutes before breakfast. This helps to balance the decrease in food intake and avoid acute effects. Additionally, reducing the medication dose in proportion to the decrease in food intake is also advisable.

Dr Isa further stressed the importance of moisturising the body during Ramadan to prevent dehydration.

He stated, "There are other important factors besides water, which are vitamins such as vitamins A, E, C, and B, in addition to omega 3. They are very impor-

Minister releases 30,000 mead, 1,000 grouper fish

Wael bin Nasser Al Mubarak, the Minister of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture, released over 30,000 mead and 1,000 large grouper fish during a visit to the National Aquaculture Centre in Ras Hayyan on Thursday. The centre, which includes hatcheries, aims to achieve a production capacity of 15 million fingerlings by 2025 and has successfully produced young mead fish through hatching and breeding.

During the visit, the minister also reviewed the process of establishing Gulf Aquaculture, which will soon contribute to the provision of marine products in local markets.

Dr Khaled Ahmed Hassan, the Acting Undersecretary for Agriculture and Marine Resources Affairs, and Hussein Jaafar Makki, the Director of the Fish Farming Department, were also present.

The ministry, Al-Mubarak said, is keen to utilise modern technology to overcome challenges and to prepare the necessary laboratories for the fish farming process.

Large asteroid zoom between Earth and Moon

Alarge asteroid safely zoomed between Earth and the Moon yesterday, a once-in-a-decade event that was used as a training exercise for planetary defence efforts, according to the European Space Agency. The asteroid, named 2023 DZ2, is estimated to be 40 to 70 metres (130 to 230 feet) wide, roughly the size of the Parthenon, and big enough to wipe out a large city if it hit our planet. At 19:49 GMT yesterday it came within a third of the distance from the Earth to the Moon, said Richard Moissl, the head of the ESA's planetary defence office. he told AFP. around once every 10 years, he 27. added.

Despite its presence in Japan's parks and gardens, it took researchers at Kobe University a decade to confirm that the plant -- dubbed the "Spiranthes hachijoensis" -- was a previously unknown species.

"It was a surprise to discover a new species of spiranthes, which is so common that you can see it in parks, gardens and among potted plants," lead researcher Kenji Suetsugu said.



Early wildfire in Spain rages out of control

C ome 700 firefighters were Dbattling Spain's first major forest fire of the year yesterday. which was raging out of control 48 hours after it began, forcing 1,500 people to flee.

In an update on Twitter, the regional emergency services said the fire in Villanueva de Viver, some 90 kilometres (55 miles) north of Valencia, was a "highly-complex blaze taking place in weather conditions similar to those of the summer".

"700 people have been mobilised for the operation (to fight the fire). It has affected 3,900 hectares and has a 35-kilometre perimeter," they said, indicating the number of people forced out of their homes on Friday, some 1,500, had not changed.

They said the huge blaze remained "very voracious" with the work to put it out "very complicated".

Firefighters tweeted that they had deployed some 20 aerial units to help tackle the fire. "Clearly the fire has not stabi-





Ramadan Recipe

Cauliflower and squash fritters with mint and feta dip

Ingredients

- 100g gram (chickpea) flour
- 1 tsp turmeric
- 1 tsp ground cumin
- small bunch coriander, finely chopped (optional)
- oil, for shallow frying
- 150g natural yogurt
- 1 garlic clove, crushed
- 75g vegetarian feta, mashed
- 2 tbsp finely chopped mint
- pitta breads and salad, to serve

For the roast cauliflower & squash base

- 1 cauliflower, split into florets, the stalk cut into cubes
- 1/2 large butternut squash, cut into cubes
- 1 tbsp oil



Method:

- Heat oven to 180C/160C fan/gas 4. • Toss the cauliflower and squash in oil and spread it out on a large oven tray. Roast for 25 mins, or until tender. If you're making the base ahead of time, you can leave it to cool at this stage then freeze in an airtight container for up to a month. (Defrost fully before using in the next step.)
- Put the flour in a bowl and gradually 2. Stir in 125-150ml water to make a batter as thick as double cream. Stir in the turmeric and cumin and some seasoning. Break up the cauliflower and squash a little and mix it gently into the batter.

Libya revives cannon salute to break Ramadan fast





Bagnaia wins first ever sprint at Portugal MotoGP

World champion Francesco Bagnaia won yesterday's Portuguese MotoGP sprint ahead of fellow Ducati rider Jorge Martin and Honda's Marc Marquez.

This was the inaugural sprint in an innovation that will see the riders contest a 12-lap race for half the points awarded for Sunday's showpiece event.

Marquez, a six-time MotoGP world champion, had surprisingly started from his 64th career pole position ahead of Bagnaia and Martin having struggled in Friday practice where he also crashed out.

"I spent a lot of energy. It was only 12 laps, but we did an extraordinary job today," said Marquez, whose career has stalled after undergoing four surgeries in recent seasons.

The high-speed crash suffered by 31-yearold Espargaro on his KTM Tech3 GASGAS bike caused a long interruption to the ses-
