Budget boost

MPs prioritise citizens' needs in approving BD8.9 billion state spending bill

Five hours of debate in Parliament ended yesterday with MPs giving their approval to Bahrain's 2025-2026 state budget.

The bill, which sets out BD8.91 billion in spending and BD6.38 billion in revenue, passed with 33 votes in favour, six against, and one absence. It now moves to the Shura Council.

The budget takes effect from January, backdated. It gives the Finance Minister room to shift up to BD134.4 million during execution. A BD2.53 billion shortfall is forecast.

Allowance

Pensions are being increased by BD40 a month. All retirees, including those earning over BD1,500, will receive a new cost-of-living allowance, covering both years.

A total of BD624 million will fund the new Citizen Account. BD596 million a year will go towards boosting pension incomes.

Rent aid is marked at BD54 million in 2025. Food subsidies are set at BD32.4 million for the

period.

Housing loan instalments will be eased with BD4 million per year.

Subsidy

Speaking during the session, Finance Minister, His Excellency Shaikh Salman bin Khalifa Al Khalifa, confirmed that Clause 5 — offering cash to low-income households in the event of subsidy changes — had been dropped. "That provision is no longer in

place," he said.

He also told MPs that Bahrain recorded a primary surplus last year — the first since 2011.

"It's a major achievement," he said, pointing to improved fiscal discipline.

Corporate taxes

He added that revenue from corporate taxes is set to rise next year, as collections from multinational companies increase.

"There was no delay from the

government," he said in response to MPs who raised concerns over timing. "These processes take place under set timeframes. We followed what had been agreed."

He thanked both chambers, and said the drafting process involved daily coordination, even during Ramadan.

"The work doesn't stop here. Dealing with the deficit and carrying through these projects will take several years of steady effort."

New expat residency scheme to boost economy

Investors and skilled expats will be able to apply for permanent residency, designed to attract longer-term capital and talent.

The new measure is part of Bahrain's economic recovery plan, set out in the 2025-2026 state budget alongside a raft of other policies aimed at boosting

growth and curbing debt.

Every year, the government aims to place 25,000 Bahrainis into work and make room in the labour market for 8,000 new graduates.

Employer needs

The Labour Fund, Tamkeen, is leading this effort, offering training tailored to employer needs.

Spending on infrastructure will increase, with money set aside for roads, sewage works, and solar power.

Labour fees will also be adjusted to narrow the cost gap

between hiring Bahrainis and expats — an imbalance long criticised by the public.

Efforts to improve the business climate are also moving ahead.

'Sijilat', Bahrain's online registry, is due for an upgrade, while planning permits are going digital to reduce delays.

Legal changes are in progress to ease restrictions on growing

firms.

Private investment

A new public land platform is already live, opening up idle plots to private investment.

At the border, customs procedures are being simplified.

Public services, meanwhile, will soon be bound by clearer, stricter deadlines under new service-level agreements.

Main sites across Kingdom ready for Eid Al Fitr prayers

Closures include Hamad bin Ali Kanoo Mosque, Al Ghawiy Mosque, and Dhabiya bint Rashid Mosque.

4. Prayer Area in Busaiteen (Sahil Al Sayah); Closure of Um-mahat Al Mu'mineen Mosque (near Muharraq Municipality).

5. Prayer Area in Arad (Arad Fort Square); No surrounding

mosques will be closed.

6. Prayer Area in Diyar Al Muharraq (southern parking area at Souq Al Baraha); Souq Al Baraha Mosque to be closed.

7. Prayer Area in Salmaniya; No surrounding mosques will be closed.

8. Prayer Area in Northern Riffa (near Al Estiqlal Walkway).

Future finances

BD8.9bln spending, BD6.4bln income, and BD2.5bln deficit in Bahrain’s 2025-2026 budget

Bahrain’s 2025-2026 budget lays out BD8.9 billion in planned spending against BD6.4 billion in income, leaving a shortfall of BD2.5 billion, fuelled largely by interest payments that account for nearly a quarter of annual outgoings. Revenue for 2025 is expected to reach BD2.92 billion, rising to BD3.46 billion by 2026. Spending will climb alongside this, from BD4.38 billion to BD4.54 billion. The gap, BD1.45 billion in 2025 and BD1.08 billion in 2026, is to be bridged by borrowing, primarily from financial institutions and regional lenders. Income from oil and gas, still the backbone of the treasury, is gradually giving ground to other sources. After allocating funds to the Future Generations Reserve, oil revenue is set at BD1.49 billion in 2025 and BD1.63 billion in 2026. Meanwhile, revenue from tax

and services is quickly rising, from BD1.43 billion to BD1.83 billion over the two years. VAT and excise taxes, managed by the National Bureau for Revenue, will generate BD756.9 million in 2025 and BD866.8 million in 2026. Customs duties will provide just over BD112 million annually. Earnings from state-owned firms — including Eskin Bank, Bapco Energies, and Mumtallakat — are estimated at around BD185 million each year. Other ministries are also increasing their contributions. Revenue from the general public services sector will triple from BD114.3 million to BD368.2 million, helped by the Survey and Land Registration Bureau (SLRB), expected to bring in over BD17 million annually. Fees and charges Miscellaneous fees and charges will rise from BD90.5 million to BD343.6 million. Public Order and Safety, led by the Ministry of Interior and

Customs, is expected to generate nearly BD200 million each year. Economic ministries — Transportation and Telecommunications, Industry and Commerce, and Works — will collect BD126.7 million in 2025 and BD142.4 million in 2026. Health sector income, including the Supreme Council of Health, will rise from BD43.6 million to BD50.1 million. The Youth, Culture and Media

Retirees will receive BD298 million per year, with BD312.6 million earmarked for the Citizen Account and another BD54 million reserved for rent subsidies. Education is allocated BD354 million each year, covering the Ministry of Education, universities, and training bodies. Health follows closely at BD360 million annually, nearly half going to government hospitals. Defence spending remains steady at BD550.8 million, with Public Order and Safety rising slightly to BD471.6 million in 2026. Spending by economic and infrastructure ministries will rise slightly from BD115.4 million to BD118.9 million, driven by the Ministry of Works and the Economic Development Board. Housing and community amenities will receive around BD13 million each year, and environmental programmes will maintain a steady BD6.8 million. The impact of public debt is stark.

Interest payments alone will reach BD1.03 billion in 2025 and BD1.16 billion in 2026 — making it the largest budget line outside social protection. Higher borrowing costs and accumulated debt have created a significant fiscal burden. A contingency reserve of BD119.6 million in 2025 and BD124.1 million in 2026 is also set aside for unexpected expenses. Despite fiscal pressures, infrastructure investment will continue steadily at BD275 million annually. The Ministry of Works will receive BD60 million each year, with BD81 million allocated to housing. Budget The Ministry of Interior is earmarked BD7.4 million per year for its projects, and the health sector will receive BD2.35 million. Education infrastructure funding is set at BD11 million in 2025, rising slightly to BD11.6 million in 2026.

Alert as road accidents and traffic offences on the rise

● 47% of January crashes caused severe injuries, and 11% fatal

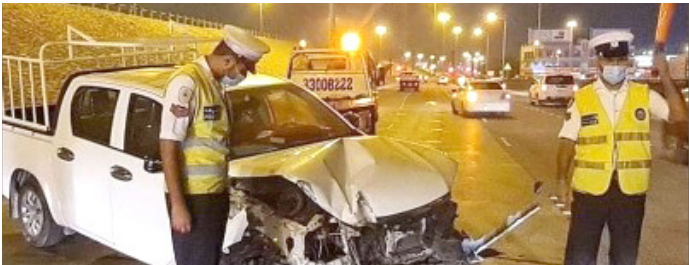

A recent report from the Ministry of Interior shows a rise in road accidents and traffic offences across Bahrain during January 2025. Severe injuries were recorded in 47 per cent of all accidents, while 42 per cent involved minor injuries. The remaining 11 per cent ended in death. Emergency calls Rescue patrols were busiest responding to emergency calls, which made up 62 per cent of their work, ranging from fires to medical aid and various community services. Traffic incidents followed at

33 per cent, with security matters making up the remaining 5 per cent. Of the traffic violations caught, mobile phone use while driving topped the list at 39 per cent. Jumping red lights came next at 22 per cent. Illegal parking Speeding made up 20 per cent, while illegal parking accounted for 13 per cent. Just 1 per cent were fined for not wearing a seatbelt, and 5 per cent for driving with expired registration.

Travel figures through entry points were also included in the data. King Fahd Causeway remained the busiest route, with a total of 3,286,444 people crossing, 1,633,160 entering Bahrain and 1,653,284 leaving. At Bahrain International Airport, 488,072 travellers were recorded. Of those, 252,109 arrived and 235,963 departed. Sea travel saw smaller but steady movement, with 84,056 passengers passing through the ports — 42,016 arrivals and 42,040 departures.

Five inmates’ jail time extended

Four convicted murderers were among five inmates who set upon three others inside a locked room at Jaw Prison, leaving one man with a smashed face, broken jaws, and five teeth missing. The attack, which happened behind a sealed door at the Reform and Rehabilitation Centre (Jaw), caused lasting injuries to the main victim, including a 10 per cent permanent disability.

Court papers show that four of the assailants were serving time for murder, among them the man jailed for the killing of an inmate inside the same prison. The High Criminal Court of Appeal upheld an earlier ruling, handing each of the five men an additional three-year sentence. Conviction They were convicted of attacking three fellow prisoners, leaving one with serious dam-

age to his jaw, mouth, and skull. The injuries were confirmed in a forensic report and included fractures across the face and jaw, loss of five front teeth, and a misaligned bite that affected his ability to chew. The head trauma alone was enough to leave a permanent mark, assessed at 10 per cent. The other two victims were also injured, though their wounds were less serious and did not stop them from going about their daily routines for long.

Bogus judgment

Former lawyer sentenced to five years in jail for crafting fake court ruling

A forged court ruling that nearly fooled the Justice Ministry has landed a former lawyer in prison for five years.

The appeals court upheld the original sentence and ordered the fake documents to be confiscated.

The man had drawn up a bogus judgment, making it appear as though the court had approved the enforcement of a preliminary sale contract.

The civil case named a real estate firm as the claimant, with the two original owners and the Survey and Land Registration Bureau (SLRB) listed as defendants.

The forged ruling was used in an attempt to transfer ownership of the property to the company, on the basis that the sale had been cleared by the courts.

Verification

When the document was sent to the Ministry of Justice for verification, a member of staff began to check its details.

The case numbers didn't match anything in the system.

The court said to have issued the judgment hadn't even sat on the dates shown.

Official records

The panel of judges named in the ruling didn't match any official records either.

The ministry replied in writing that no such ruling existed in its files.

Questioned by the Public Prosecution, the defendant admitted he had read the forged ruling and sent it to someone

acting on behalf of the property owners, fully aware it was false.

Computer

He said he had used the computer of another lawyer, whose name appeared on the document, to file the case.

That lawyer told investigators he had only given the defendant access to his account on the government portal and had no part in preparing or submitting the documents.

A witness from the real es-

tate company said the defendant was the only person at the firm handling the property matter.

Ruling

He recalled the man informing him that the court had ruled in their favour.

One of the victims confirmed they had received the ruling from the defendant, and said it had already been marked for use.

Court records also showed the defendant had a previous conviction for forging a private document.

Court rejects woman's bid to sell family home

A court has dismissed a woman's attempt to compel the sale of her late father's house, ruling that the property, still home to her mother and siblings, cannot be divided or sold without the written consent of every heir.

The woman had filed a claim against her mother and siblings, arguing that she was entitled to have her share separated from the inherited property.

She no longer wished to remain part of the joint ownership and sought to have her stake isolated through the courts.

Legal heirs

Her lawyer, Hanan bin Hamouda, said that the property formed part of the late father's estate and that all parties involved were his legal heirs.

The claimant had asked the court to assess the value of her share and to have it transferred to her.

The court requested a statement from the Ministry of Housing regarding the status of the property.

In its response, the ministry confirmed that the house

had belonged to the deceased and that, under Islamic inheritance rules, the claimant was entitled to one share out of 24.

The Urban Planning and Development Authority later gave its view, assessing the value of the house at BD85,000.

On that basis, the woman's share would be worth BD3,438.

However, the authority added that the share could not be physically delineated or handed over, as the structure of the house and the regulations governing land use made that impossible.

House

Some of the heirs were also still residing in the house.

With no way to partition the property, the woman asked the court to order its sale at public auction so she could receive her share in cash.

The court examined the property deeds and found a clause stating that no sale could take place unless all heirs agreed in writing.

It also noted that the house was the only asset left by the deceased, and that some family members who would be adversely affected had nowhere else to live.

US says **Russia, Ukraine agree to** end Black Sea military action

Russia and Ukraine agreed yesterday to halt military strikes in the Black Sea and on energy sites during talks brokered by the United States, which offered as a first concrete incentive to Moscow to ease pressure on agricultural exports.

With President Donald Trump pushing for a rapid end to the war that has killed tens of thousands of people, US negotiators shuttled separately over three days in the Saudi capital Riyadh between delegations from Ukraine and Russia.

In parallel statements, the White House said that each country “agreed to ensure safe navigation, eliminate the use of force and prevent the use of commercial vessels for military purposes in the Black Sea.”

The United States said it would also look for ways to en-

force a ban on strikes on energy infrastructure in the two countries.

The Kremlin meanwhile said the agreement to halt strikes on the Black Sea could only come

into force after the lifting of restrictions on its agriculture sector.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky, who has turned to diplomacy after heavy pressure

from Trump including a brief ban on US aid and intelligence sharing, said it was too early to tell if the agreements will work but that they were “the right steps.”

“No one can accuse Ukraine of not moving towards sustainable peace after this,” Zelensky told a news conference in Kyiv.

Zelensky said that the talks also discussed bringing in third parties to oversee a future truce.

He said that Turkey, which has maintained ties with both sides, could monitor the situation on the Black Sea and that a Middle Eastern nation could look at the energy agreement.

Offer on agriculture

Trump after taking office spoke directly to Russian President Vladimir Putin, ending the ostracization of him by the West since he ordered the invasion of Ukraine in 2022.

In the first concrete step by the United States toward Russia in return for the engagement, the White House said it would “help restore access to the world market” for Russian agricultural and fertilizer exports.

The United States never directly put sanctions on Russian agriculture but had restricted access to payment systems used for international transactions.

The issue became a major talking point for Russia, which

told countries in the developing world that US policies -- not the war itself -- were contributing to higher prices.

Moscow said the deal would “come into force” after the “lifting of sanctions restrictions” on the Russian Agricultural Bank and other “financial institutions involved in international trade of food,” and only after they are reconnected to the SWIFT international payment system.

Zelensky, while saying he did not know full details of the US decision, voiced alarm.

“We believe that this is a weakening of the position and a weakening of sanctions,” he said.

Ukrainian Defense Minister Rustem Umerov, who took part in the talks, said that details on the Black Sea agreement were still being worked out.

He also warned that if Russian warships moved from the eastern part of the Black Sea then “Ukraine will have full right to exercise right to self-defense.”

Ukraine earlier this month agreed to a US-proposed unconditional ceasefire, but Russia turned it down, with Kyiv accusing it of wanting to gain more battlefield advantage first.

Trump brushes off **Yemen chat breach** as a ‘glitch’

US President Donald Trump yesterday dismissed the accidental addition of a journalist to a group chat about Yemen air strikes as a “glitch” and stood by his top national security team despite the stunning breach.

Trump’s administration faces mounting pressure following a report on Monday by The Atlantic magazine’s editor-in-chief Jeffrey Goldberg about the conversation on the Signal messaging app.

The chat about attacks on Iran-backed Huthi rebels involved some of the administration’s most senior officials, including Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth, Vice President JD Vance and National Security Advisor Mike Waltz.

Trump, who returned to the office in January, told broadcaster NBC in a phone interview that the breach was “the only glitch in two months, and it turned out not to be a serious one.”

The president added that Waltz, his top security official in the White House, “has learned a lesson, and he’s a good man.”

Goldberg said he had received a connection request from a user identified as Michael Waltz on Signal. Trump said however that “it was one of Michael’s people on the phone. A staffer had his number on there.”

The White House had earlier pushed back more forcefully on day two of the scandal, after confirming the breach on Monday.

Press Secretary Karoline Leavitt said in a post on X on Tuesday that “no ‘war plans’

‘Houthi PC small group’

The breach became public on Monday after The Atlantic magazine’s editor-in-chief Jeffrey Goldberg published an article recounting how he was inadvertently invited into the group chat.

On March 11, Goldberg said he received a Signal invite from a user called Mike Waltz, Donald Trump’s national security advisor and a figure he had previously met.

Despite skepticism that

a scam to entrap him for information, he accepted it and found himself in a group called “Houthi PC small group” -- apparently referring to a “principals committee.”

In the group were 18 members mostly identifying themselves as senior American officials -- including Vance, Hegseth, Secretary of State Marco Rubio and CIA Director John Ratcliffe.

Strong reaction

National Security Council spokesman Brian Hughes said Monday the chain cited in the article appeared to be “authentic.”

Trump on Tuesday brushed off the breach as “the only glitch in two months, and it turned out not to be a serious one.”

In a phone interview with broadcaster NBC, Trump also said that Waltz “has learned a lesson, and he’s a good man.”

Hegseth for his part remained defiant, saying “no one sent any war plans, and that’s all I have to say about it.”

He also launched a verbal

attack on Goldberg, calling him a “highly discredited so-called journalist” who peddles hoaxes.

But some Republican lawmakers could not hide their embarrassment.

“Someone screwed up,” Senator Tim Sheehy reportedly told journalists.

On the other side of the aisle, top Democrat lawmakers were outraged.

Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer described it as “one of the most stunning breaches of military intelligence I have read about” and called for a full investigation.

Journalist access

On March 14, messages in the group indicated that a US strike was being prepared against Yemen’s Iran-backed Huthi rebels.

The group has been trying to interrupt trade via the Red Sea and has targeted US military vessels several times in recent months.

In discussing military action, Vance notably objected by saying it would benefit Europeans much more than Americans, while the Trump administration is pushing for Europe to do more for its own defense.

On Saturday, Hegseth told the group chat that strikes would be launched against the Huthis in the coming hours.

Goldberg said he chose not to reveal many message in his article for fear of compromising security. After the message exchange, the group’s members congratulated each other using emojis.

The journalist said he believed the group to be authentic after this, before leaving the group without any apparent reaction.

He said he communicated as safely and efficiently as possible.”

Sweet Eid Celebrations

Brighten up the Eid holidays with sweet memories and the finest sweet treats

Growing up, I had the opportunity to experience Eid in the Middle East. A close friend invited me to her home, where her mother had prepared a feast fit for the occasion. After savouring a delicious biryani, I relished a dessert that left a lasting impression—Phirni.

Phirni is a rich and creamy rice pudding prepared with coarsely ground rice cooked in sweetened milk until thick and velvety. This dessert is traditionally adorned with silver warakh (edible silver leaf) and crunchy nuts for a festive touch. Furthermore, the infusion of warm and comforting flavours of cardamom or saffron takes this dessert to a new level. That evening remains etched in my memory—the laughter, the heartfelt conversations, and, of course, the irresistible flavours. Because at its heart, Eid is about sharing joy through good food and cherished moments.

When planning an Eid gathering, the focus is always on delighting family and guests. Moreover, what better way to

impress than with beautifully presented desserts that do not just look stunning but taste divine? The final course of a meal is often the most memorable, leaving a lasting impression on everyone at the table.

Make an impression with these eye-catching desserts that will capture the hearts of your guests this Eid.

ZARDA OR MUTANJAN – A SWEET TRADITION

A classic Eid dessert, Zarda is a vibrant and aromatic sweet rice dish. The name comes from the Persian word zard, meaning yellow, referring to its signature golden hue from saffron or food colouring. The rice is cooked with ghee, sugar, and fragrant spices. The garnishing is special as it consists of a generous amount of dried fruits, nuts, khoya (reduced milk), mini gulab jamuns and rasgulla. Zarda has deep roots in Mughal cuisine, where royal chefs created variations by adding coconut, cherries, or even small pieces of gulab jamun for an extra burst of sweetness. This dish represents

a party on a plate making it a staple for joyful events.

PISTACHIO CHEESECAKE – A MODERN DELIGHT

For those looking to add a touch of elegance to their Eid celebrations, pistachio cheesecake is a must-try. This dessert is a perfect blend of creamy indulgence and nutty richness, with a velvety smooth texture and a buttery biscuit base. This beautiful dessert reminds me of the trending pistachio kunafa chocolate.

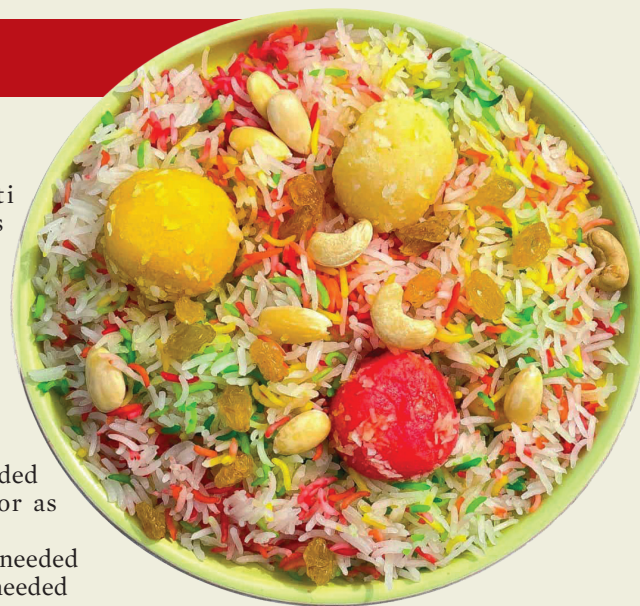
Each bite is a luxurious combination of delicate pistachio flavour and creamy goodness, making it a showstopper at any gathering. The natural green hue of pistachios and pistachio spread adds a festive touch, while their crunch balances the cheesecake's smoothness beautifully. I would add a light drizzle of semi-sweet chocolate as well.

This Eid, make a lasting impression with a mix of traditional favourites and contemporary delights. After all, sweet moments deserve sweet endings!

Zarda/ Mutanjan

INGREDIENTS:

- 3 cups (600 g) white basmati rice washed and soaked for 30 minutes
- 11tablespoonghee/unsalted butter for cooking the rice with
- 8green cardamoms
- ½ cup (75 g) almonds blanched and halved
- small handful sultanas
- ¼ cup (65 g) oil/ghee
- 2.5 cups (½ kg) white sugar
- ¼teaspoonred food colour or as needed
- ¼ teaspoon orange food colour or as needed
- ¼teaspoonyellow food colour or as needed
- ¼teaspoongreen food colour or as needed



INSTRUCTIONS:

- Cook the presoaked basmati rice until 75% done with a spoonful of ghee or unsalted butter. Drain and set aside.
- In 4 separate bowls/glasses, add 1/4 teaspoon of each food colour to 1.5 teaspoon of water and add 2 tsp of rice in each bowl/glass. Mix to coat all the rice in the colour. If you want a stronger colour, add some more food colour. Keep this aside till needed.
- In a pot, add the oil/ghee and blanched almonds, raisins and cardamom. Cook this on a medium high heat, stirring often, until the raisins begin to swell.
- Add sugar and a splash of water. Cook this on high heat until the sugar granules dissolve in the water and the mixture becomes thick and gloopy. Make sure you do not cook the sugar down so much that it becomes hard. Keep stirring. This process could take about 15 minutes.
- Once the sugar has thickened and reduced, add your rice and stir to coat the rice with the sugar. Reduce excess water.
- The rice will look wet and there will be moisture gathering around the rim of the pot. Now, add the coloured rice, each colour placed separately on top of the white rice. Turn the heat to the lowest possible setting, cover and allow the zarda to steam cook for 15 minutes.
- Serve immediately if possible. If you are not serving immediately, fluff the rice up so it does not stick together. Garnish with a variety of nuts, raisins, and Indian sweets etc.

Pistachio Cheesecake

INGREDIENTS:

For The Crust

- ¼ cup granulated sugar
- 9 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 17 graham cracker sheets 2 sleeves, 260g

For The Filling

- 4 8oz. blocks cream cheese room temperature
- ¼ cup sour cream
- ¼ cup pistachio cream
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1¼ cups powdered sugar (or more, to taste)
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- ½ cup chopped pistachios

For The Topping

- ½-1 cup pistachio cream

INSTRUCTIONS:

To make the crust

- Add the graham crackers to a food processor and process until fine. Add the sugar and melted butter and combine well.
- Line a 9-inch springform pan with parchment paper. Add the butter cookie mixture and press it firmly into the bottom of the pan, optionally bringing some up the sides. Ensure it's packed tightly so it holds together.
- Freeze for 30 minutes to 1 hour.

To make the cheesecake filling

- In a large bowl, add the room-temperature cream cheese and beat with an electric mixer for about 5 minutes until smooth.
- Add the powdered sugar, vanilla, lemon juice, and sour cream. Beat again until everything is smooth and well incorporated, scraping down the sides as needed.
- Add the pistachio cream and chopped pistachios, and mix again until evenly distributed.
- In a separate bowl, beat the heavy cream until stiff peaks form, about 3-5 minutes. Fold the whipped heavy cream into the cheese mixture until just incorporated.
- Add the mixture over the chilled crust smoothing it evenly, and freeze for 2 hours.

To add the topping

- In a microwave-safe bowl, heat ½ to 1 cup of pistachio cream (depending on your desired thickness) for about 10 seconds until the consistency is slightly runnier.
- Pour it on top of the cheesecake and spread it evenly.
- Refrigerate for 4 hours, or best overnight.

News in brief

- Bolsonaro headed ‘criminal organization’ to stay in power, court told



Brazil’s attorney general yesterday accused far-right former president Jair Bolsonaro of having steered a “criminal organization” whose objective in 2022 was “to ensure he remains in power.” Bolsonaro was one of the leaders of a criminal enterprise to keep him in office “regardless of the outcome of 2022 elections” he lost to leftist rival Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva, top prosecutor Paulo Gonet told the Supreme Court in Brasilia. Five judges of the court started weighing Tuesday whether to put 70-year-old Bolsonaro on trial for allegedly masterminding efforts to wrest power from Lula, who was sworn in as president on January 1, 2023 after beating Bolsonaro by a razor-thin margin. The ex-army captain was charged in February with crimes including overseeing a “coup d’etat,” the “attempted violent abolition of the democratic state of law” and “armed criminal organization.”

King Charles, Queen Camilla postpone pope visit: palace



The UK’s King Charles III and Queen Camilla have postponed a planned state visit to the Vatican in early April following medical advice from the pope’s doctors, Buckingham Palace said yesterday. “Medical advice has now suggested that Pope Francis would benefit from an extended period of rest and recuperation. Their Majesties send the pope their best wishes for his convalescence and look forward to visiting him in The Holy See, once he has recovered,” a statement said. The UK’s head of state wrote to Francis when the 88-year-old pontiff was struck down with pneumonia in both lungs in February, amid fears he might not survive. Francis was discharged on Sunday following almost 40 days in Rome’s Gemelli hospital.

Zelensky says Trump envoy statements ‘in line’ with Kremlin claims



Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky on Tuesday criticised statements by White House envoy Steve Witkoff, who recently praised Russian leader Vladimir Putin and appeared to legitimise Russia’s annexation of some Ukrainian regions. The comments by Witkoff, in an interview with the right-wing podcast host Tucker Carlson, were seen in Kyiv as another sign of how far some in US President Donald Trump’s administration have shifted away from Ukraine toward Russia. “A lot of the information spread by some people and the person you mentioned... are very much in line with the messages of the Kremlin,” Zelensky said, answering a question on the interview given by Witkoff. Trump’s envoy said “there’s a view within the country of Russia that these are Russian territories”.

Chewing gum releases microplastics into mouth: researchers



AFP | Paris, France (UCLA). The pilot study instead sought to illustrate yet another little-researched way that these mostly invisible plastic pieces enter our bodies -- chewing gum. Lisa Lowe, a PhD student at UCLA, chewed seven pieces each of 10 brands of gum, before the researchers then ran a chemical analysis on her saliva. They found that a gram (0.04 ounces) of gum released an average of 100 microplastic fragments, though some shed more than 600. The average weight of a stick of gum is around 1.5 grams. People who chew around 180 pieces of gum a year could be ingesting roughly 30,000 microplastics, the researchers said. This pales in comparison to the many other ways that humans ingest microplastics, Mohanty emphasised. For example, other researchers estimated last year that a litre (34 fluid ounces) of water in a plastic bottle contained an average of 240,000 microplastics.

Chewing gum releases hundreds of tiny plastic pieces straight into people’s mouths, researchers said on Tuesday, also warning of the pollution created by the rubber-based sweet. The small study comes as researchers have increasingly been finding small shards of plastic called microplastics throughout the world, from the tops of mountains to the bottom of the ocean -- and even in the air we breathe. They have also discovered microplastics riddled throughout human bodies -- including inside our lungs, blood and brains -- sparking fears about the potential effect this could be having on health. “I don’t want to alarm people,” Sanjay Mohanty, the lead researcher behind the new study which has not yet been peer-reviewed, told AFP. There is no evidence directly showing that microplastics are harmful to human health, said Mohanty of the University of California, Los Angeles

Temple burned, UNESCO village evacuated as S.Korea wildfires spread

Residents of a UNESCO-listed village were ordered to evacuate while a historic Buddhist temple was burned to the ground yesterday as South Korea scrambled to contain worsening wildfires. Blazes tearing across the country’s southeast have killed four people, with authorities transferring thousands of prisoners and residents as dry windy weather hampers efforts to contain more than a dozen different fires which broke out over the weekend. The fires are collectively the

third largest in South Korea’s history, with acting Interior and Safety Minister Ko Ki-dong saying 14,694 hectares (36,310 acres) had been affected early Tuesday. “Strong winds, dry weather, and haze are hampering fire-fighting efforts,” Ko told a disaster and safety meeting. The government has declared a state of emergency in four regions. “The wind was so strong that I couldn’t stand still,” said evacuated Andong resident Kwon So-han. “The fire came from the mountain and fell on my house.

Nothing could be done,” the 79-year-old told AFP. Authorities in Andong issued an emergency alert late Tuesday to residents of the historic Hahoe Folk Village -- a UNESCO-listed world heritage site popular with tourists -- as the blaze drew closer. “The Uiseong Angye wildfire is moving in the direction” of that area, the alert said. “Residents are requested to evacuate immediately.” In Uiseong, AFP reporters saw the sky full of smoke and haze, with the Korea Forest Service saying that the containment rate for the fire in that area had decreased from

60 to 55 percent on Tuesday. Early in the morning, workers at the Gounsa Temple, which was more than a thousand years old, were attempting to move valuable artefacts and cover up Buddhist statues to protect them from possible damage. “We used fire retardant blankets,” Joo Jung-wan, a Gyeongbuk Seobu Cultural Heritage Care Center worker told AFP, saying that a giant gilded Buddha statue was too large to move so had been carefully covered. Hours later, an official at the Korea Heritage Service told AFP that the temple had been burnt down.

Israel releases Palestinian Oscar winner after West Bank detention

Israeli police yesterday released Oscar-winning Palestinian filmmaker Hamdan Ballal, detained a day earlier for “hurling rocks” following what activists described as an attack by Israeli settlers in the occupied West Bank. Basel Adra, who worked with Ballal on the Oscar-winning documentary film “No Other Land”, posted on X a photo of him from a hospital after his release -- which police has also confirmed -- with blood stains

on his shirt. “Hamdan has been released and is currently in the hospital in Hebron receiving treatment. He was beaten by soldiers and settlers all over his body,” said Adra, adding that “soldiers left him blindfolded and handcuffed” overnight. According to the Israeli military, three Palestinians were apprehended on Monday for “hurling rocks” during a “violent confrontation” between Israelis and Palestinians in the southern West Bank village of Susya.

Flight makes U-turn to US after pilot forgets passport

Passengers headed to China aboard a recent United Airlines flight faced an unexpected travel headache after a pilot's forgotten passport prompted their return to the United States. Flight UA198 from Los Angeles

to Shanghai was out over the Pacific Ocean on Saturday afternoon when it made a u-turn and headed to San Francisco, tracking data showed.

United confirmed Tuesday to AFP in an email that the plane, a Boeing 787 with

270 people onboard, made a stop in San Francisco "as the pilot did not have their passport onboard."

"We arranged for a new crew to take our customers to their destination that evening," the company said, adding that "customers were pro-

vided with meal vouchers and compensation," without specifying.

Flight tracking data showed the plane landed at Shanghai's Pudong International Airport after midnight, about six hours behind its normal arrival time.

The United flight's rerouting came as travelers around the world continued to face disruptions over the shutdown at London's Heathrow Airport, Europe's busiest hub, due to a power outage the day prior.



Spain seeks to criminalise AI-generated sexual images

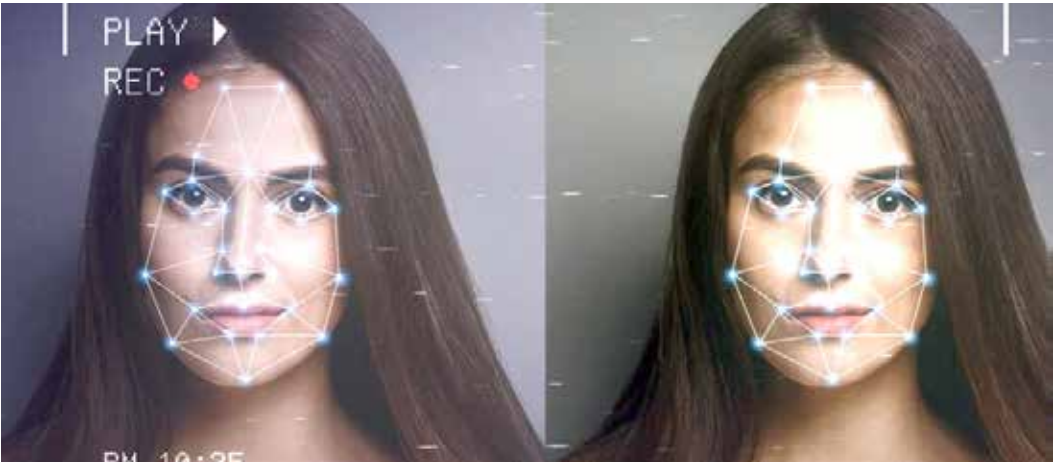

Spain's leftist government unveiled a draft bill yesterday that would criminalise the use of artificial intelligence to generate sexually explicit video images of a person's face or body without their consent.

AI is causing growing concern around the world because the technology can be used for malicious purposes such as the creation of "deepfakes" -- realistic computer-generated images and video based on a real template.

Around 96 percent of deepfake videos online are non-consensual pornography, and most of them depict women, according to a 2019 study by the Dutch AI company Sensity.

The government wants "deepfakes of a sexual or seriously insulting nature" to be "con-

sidered crimes against moral integrity", Justice Minister Felix Bolanos told a news conference after a weekly cabinet meeting.

In a statement, the government said the measure would

be part of a bill aimed at "protecting young girls and boys as well as adolescents" from the dangers of "digital technology" and guarantee "their right to privacy".

The move comes as Spain has grappled in recent years with several cases of the distribution of fake nude images of underage girls created using an AI app.

In some cases, the fake nudes

were used to try to blackmail the minors depicted after the alleged creators demanded money not to distribute them.

The draft bill would also require smartphone and tablet manufacturers to include free parental control systems in their devices that are activated by default, and force online influencers to use "age verification systems" for their subscribers.

SpaceX rocket fuel makes stunning swirl in European sky

A stunning blue and white spiral spotted in skies across Europe late Monday was created by frozen fuel tumbling from a SpaceX rocket, according to weather forecasters and scientists.

The UK's Met Office said on X it had received many reports of an "illuminated swirl" in the sky on Monday evening likely caused by a rocket that had blasted off earlier from Cape Canaveral in Florida.

"Don't panic! No, it wasn't a UFO but the degassing of a SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket," said the French state weather forecaster Meteo France in the country's central Loire Valley.

Pictures of the vivid swirl were also posted by social media users in countries includ-

ing Sweden, Poland, Hungary and Croatia. People across Europe may have had the chance to see the phenomenon -- as long as it was not obscured by clouds, planetary scientist James O'Donoghue of the UK's University of Reading told AFP.

The spiral was created after the rocket's first-stage booster, which blasted it off the ground,

separated and the upper stage took over, he said.

As the booster fell back to Earth, it vented leftover fuel, which froze into reflective crystals. "These crystals caught the sunlight, creating the bright spiral pattern in the sky," O'Donoghue said. "The spiral shape happened because the tumbling rocket was spinning as it

released the fuel."

Spy satellite?

The swirl was created by the launch of SpaceX's NROL-69 mission. Exactly what it was carrying into space was classified.

But the mission was conducted for the National Reconnaissance Office, which manages the

US military's spy satellites.

"The Falcon 9 reusable rocket booster returned safely to Landing Zone 1 after delivering the national security payload to orbit," the office said in a statement. A similar spiral was spotted above New Zealand in 2022, also from the workhorse Falcon 9 rocket, according to reports at the time.

The venting of the gas that creates these spirals is not dangerous, O'Donoghue said. It can happen to other rockets, but the sheer number of Falcon 9 launches makes it a likely suspect. The timing of this launch -- during the European twilight -- as well as the season, cloud cover and other factors affect whether people on the ground can see such spirals, O'Donoghue said.

Billionaire Elon Musk's SpaceX has taken a "fail fast, learn fast" approach that has helped it become the world's dominant launch services provider. The company's massive Starship rocket exploded during its latest test flight this month, with social media footage showing red-hot debris raining down over the Bahamas.

Boom of Iftar cannons echoes through Dubai during Ramadan

Ancient Ramadan tradition echoes through Dubai, uniting communities and preserving cultural

- Iftar cannons mark the end of daily fasting
- Introduced in Dubai during the 1960s
- Cannons fired at iconic sites like Burj Khalifa
- Dubai Police oversee ceremonial cannon firings

As the sun dips below the horizon during Ramadan, the thunderous boom of iftar cannons reverberates across Dubai, signaling to Muslims that it is time to break their daily fast. This centuries-old tradition, known locally as “midfa al iftar,” continues to hold deep cultural significance in the United Arab Emirates, blending history with modern life.

For many in Dubai, the sound of the iftar cannon remains an iconic part of their Ramadan experience, reminding them not only of the time to break their fast but also of the city’s enduring cultural traditions.

An Ancient Practice With Deep Roots

The tradition of firing cannons to mark the end of the daily fast

is believed to have originated in 10th-century Egypt. In the absence of modern technology, the cannon’s loud boom was a practical way to inform communities of iftar time. The practice arrived in Dubai in the 1960s, when the city was still developing and relied on the cannon as an essential community service before the advent of loudspeaker systems in mosques.

Today, the ritual continues to be a beloved custom, maintained to honor the country’s cultural heritage. In Dubai, the cannon is fired from key locations, includ-

ing the area near Burj Khalifa, using a replica of the original antique artillery piece that once performed the same duty decades ago.

A Symbol of Unity in a Diverse City

Beyond its functional origins, the iftar cannon has evolved into a symbol of unity and communal spirit. In a city known for its diverse population, the ceremonial firing brings together people from various cultural backgrounds and religious beliefs, fostering a sense of collec-

tive celebration. Families and visitors alike gather near cannon sites, sharing the moment as they break their fast and reflect on the spirit of Ramadan.

Dubai Police now oversee the ceremonial firing at several designated locations across the emirate. In addition to the iconic Burj Khalifa site, cannons are also stationed at prayer grounds in areas like Al Mankhool and Al Baraha. Each evening, a single cannon shot marks the end of the fast, while two consecutive shots announce the beginning of Ramadan. When the month

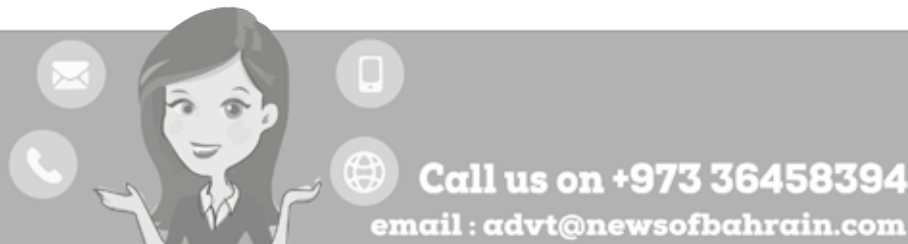

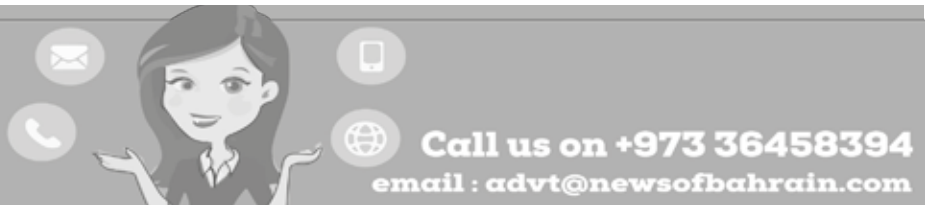

Australia's Alex de Minaur put an end to Brazilian talent Joao Fonseca's challenge at the Miami Open, outlasting the 18-year-old 5-7, 7-5, 6-3 in an enthralling contest.

Attendance on stadium court had been sparse throughout Monday, but the Hard Rock Stadium turned into a mini-Marachana Stadium for Fonseca's match, complete with Brazilian flags and football-style chanting.

Fonseca brought his energetic brand of ultra-attacking tennis, but De Minaur was up to the challenge, coping with both the blistering forehands and the partisan crowd.

Such was the dominance of Fonseca's raucous support that the referee switched to Portuguese for his appeals for quiet.

But de Minaur won six of the final seven games to move into the fourth round, keeping his cool even when the crowd,

at times, disrupted his serve preparation.

Top seed Alexander Zverev recovered from a slow start to power into the fourth round of the Miami Open with a 7-5, 6-4 win against Australia's Jordan Thompson.

The German was 4-1 down in the first set but then went on a roll, winning eight of the next nine games to progress.

Zverev lost in the opening round at Indian Wells, but with Carlos Alcaraz already out in Miami he will fancy his chances of adding to his list of seven Masters 1000 titles.

Third-seed Taylor Fritz also moved into the fourth round beating Denis Shapovalov of Canada 7-5, 6-3.

The American let slip a 5-2 lead in the first set, but regained control with his serve proving too much for Shapovalov.

In the women's draw, third-seed Coco Gauff's bid ended with a 6-4 6-4 loss to Poland's Magda Linette.

Top-seeded Aryna Sabalenka eased her way into the last eight with a 6-4, 6-4 win over last year's winner Danielle Collins of the USA.

Blatter and Platini cleared in FIFA graft case

Former FIFA president Sepp Blatter and ex-UEFA chief Michel Platini yesterday were acquitted on appeal by a Swiss court in a long-running corruption case that shattered their careers as the most powerful figures in world football.

Blatter, 89, and Platini, 69, listened in silence as the Extraordinary Court of Appeal clerk in the town of Muttenz, near Basel, read out a decision identical to the one handed down in 2022, which had initially cleared them.

Prosecutors had requested suspended sentences of 20 months for the pair, but charges of fraud, for which they risked five years' imprisonment, as well as disloyal management, breach of trust and forgery of documents were all dismissed.

"Lots of life left in the old dog," Du Plessis told commentator and former England player Graeme Swann after Delhi's nail-biting win.

"New team, new challenge for me. I almost see it as a new chapter you can look forward to," he added.

"Moving from Chennai to RCB was a really good chapter. Now the last chapter of the book, for however long the pages may be, will be with the new team."
