**Gulf and Jordan
 condemn Iran's
 aggression**

Bahrain, the UAE, Saudi
 Arabia, Qatar, Kuwait,
 and Jordan issued a joint
 statement strongly con-
 demning Iran's acts of ag-
 gression.

They described them as
 violations of sovereignty,
 territorial integrity, inter-
 national law, humanitarian
 law, and the United Nations
 Charter.

The statement empha-
 sised that the condemna-
 tion applies to aggression
 carried out directly by Iran
 or through its proxies and
 armed groups operating in
 the region.

The signatory states spe-
 cifically denounced attacks
 launched from Iraq by Irani-
 an-backed armed groups
 against multiple countries,
 targeting civilian facilities
 and critical infrastructure.
