#### 49 dead after boat capsizes in Congo

**▼**ongolese officials say 🔾 at least 49 people have died after a boat tipped over on the Momboyo River, a tributary of the Congo River in the country's northwest region.

The vice governor of Tshuapa province, Richard Mboyo Iluka, says the boat was taking people from Monkoto to Mbandaka city on Thursday but capsized just outside Wafania.

He tells The Associated Press that a team has been dispatched to investigate and get a more realistic death toll.

He says he doesn't know how many people were on the boat or how many are thought to have survived.

## Two hurt in Indiana middle school shooting; suspect in custody

The attack at Noblesville West Middle School happened around 9 am, police Chief Kevin Jowitt said at a news conference. He said investigators believe the suspect acted alone, but didn't detail what happened or the severity of the injuries to the victims, who were taken to hospitals in Indianapolis. The identities of those involved weren't immediately released.
