### Cargo Ship briefly grounded in Egypt's Suez Canal

♦ A cargo ship ran aground yesterday in Egypt's Suez Canal

It added that the Xin Hai Tong 23 measures 190 metres (208 yards) in length and 32 metres in width, with a loading capacity of 34,000 tonnes..

two women and two men aged between 40 and 50 were discovered with gunshot wounds in Constantia, an affluent suburb of the South African port city, in the morning, police stated in a statement. "The motive for the multiple murders is yet to be determined," police said adding an investigation has been opened.
