

## **Tony Blair** to speak at workshop

Former British Prime Minister Tony Blair will speak today at the 'Peace to Prosperity Workshop' being held in the Kingdom.

Blair served as Prime Minister of the United Kingdom from 1997 to 2007 and Leader of the Labour Party from 1994 to 2007.

He was Leader of the Opposition from 1994 to 1997. As of 2017, Blair is the last British Labour Party leader to have won a general election.

On the day that Blair resigned as Prime Minister, he was appointed the official Special Envoy of the Quartet on the Middle East, an office which he held until May 2015. He currently runs the Tony Blair Institute for Global Change

Blair joined the Labour Party shortly after graduating from Oxford in 1975. In the early 1980s, he was involved in Labour politics in Hackney South and Shoreditch, where he aligned himself with the 'soft left" of the party.

# 50 billion

The plan seeks \$50 billion in investment for the Palestinians in the form of more than 150 projects.

The most ambitious of the proposed projects is a new transportation channel between the occupied West Bank and the Gaza Strip.



## For neighbours

The plan allocates \$27bn for those two territories, and the remaining \$23bn for Egypt, Lebanon, Jordan and Israel.
