The Friends actress, 56, opened the doors of her Los Angeles home to Vanity Fair, declaring it a sanctuary from the pressures of both Hollywood and the

wider world.

She said when told during the chat it exudes calmness: “Good! That’s the whole point.”

Motioning towards the outside world, she added: “Out there, it causes nerves. In here, there should be no nerves.”

The actress’ \$21 million abode, located in L.A., was opened to Vanity Fair’s Julie Miller, who took a detailed look inside the residence for the magazine’s September cover story.

Jennifer added: “I’ve basically

incorporated all of the healing modalities in order to create a calm environment in the chaos of the wonderful industry and the world at large.”

The home features crystals including raw amethyst and a white stone for clarity, an incense holder decorated with crows, and a curated selection of design books.

Designed by the architects A. Quincy Jones and Frederick Emmons, the house maintains a serene atmosphere through pale

cream couches, white peonies and taper candles.

Large panoramic windows take up an entire wall, offering sweeping views from Downtown L.A. to the Pacific Ocean, reinforcing the home’s spa-like calm.

The space notably lacks screens or ambient noise, enhancing its anxiety-suppressing effect.

Jennifer also shared her passion for interior design, a hobby she shares with her longtime

Friends co-star Courteney Cox, 59.

She said: “We usually talk interior design.

“It kind of bores people to tears when we get into a room together. But it’s what we love. It’s our love language.”

The actress described how she curates her life around architecture, animals, hair, and spiritual affirmations to find inspiration without being overwhelmed by online noise.

Leonardo DiCaprio caught in stop-and-search drama in Ibiza

Leonardo DiCaprio was caught in a stop-and-search drama in Ibiza.

The 50-year-old actor and his entourage were held up by Spanish police before entering an exclusive tequila event, held at a private villa by Patron and Spanish actor and singer Aron Piper, according to a video obtained by the Daily Mail.

A woman in the background of the footage could be heard saying: “They are searching me full-on right now.”

It is not known if the woman speaking was Leonardo’s girlfriend, 27-year-old model Vittoria Ceretti, who was with him in Ibiza.

But an insider told Page Six that the A-list actor wasn’t singled out by police.

A source told the

outlet: “Every single person was patted down, and ID’d.

“The Spanish cops just didn’t initially recognize DiCaprio.

“It’s funny, they did a double take and then he went in!”

Leonardo was seen dressed in an all-black outfit with his signature baseball cap and chain, and appeared absorbed in his phone while waiting for his turn to be searched.

Other celebrities at the party included Kendall Jenner and Leonardo’s longtime friend Tobey Maguire, while Travis Scott was reportedly denied entry.

Leonardo has long been a regular visitor to Ibiza, returning repeatedly over the years for leisure and private events.

Earlier in August, he and Vittoria were photographed boarding the mega yacht of Jeff Bezos and Lauren Sánchez, also on the Spanish island.

The couple had previously attended the couple’s wedding in Venice, Italy, in June, during which Vittoria experienced a wardrobe malfunction in her vintage Dolce Gabbana dress. Leonardo and the Italian-born model have been linked since summer 2023.

John Cena ‘isn’t ashamed’ of hair transplant

John Cena is pleased with the results of his hair transplant.

The 48-year-old actor was initially hesitant to discuss the procedure before he could see that it was working - but John insists he doesn’t feel “ashamed” at all.

The wrestler-turned-actor - who has been married to Shay Shariatzadeh since 2020 - told Extra: “I just wanted it to work.

“It worked. I went into [Dr. Anderson] with significant hair loss, and he not only taught me how to take care of myself, to keep the hair that I have healthy, the treatments that I do every day, he also helped me move some of the hair up here, put it up here, and man, I feel great

about it. I’m not ashamed to say it.”

John has encouraged other men to consider undergoing the same procedure.

The Hollywood star also admitted that it’s helped to increase his confidence and boost his career.

He shared: “It was a single-day process. It’s available and accessible. And I just preach if you’re one of the seven of 10 out there, there are options for you, and you’re not alone ... It’s not for everybody, but it certainly was for me.

“And even just the aesthetic confidence is one thing, but man, I want to entertain audiences and the variation of a hairstyle, you can become a different character. I viewed it as also a

good work opportunity for me. So there are multiple reasons why I wanted to lean in. And again, I made the choice. I’m confident with the choice. I’m not ashamed of what I did at all.”

John recently admitted that he wishes he had his hair transplant a decade ago.

The WWE star underwent the procedure on his thinning locks last November and he lamented the “shame” he previously felt around the treatment.

He told People: “I hate the fact that if there wasn’t so much shame around it, I’d have gotten it done 10 years ago.”

Sarah Jessica Parker won’t rewatch And Just Like That... or Sex and the City.

The 60-year-old actress is best known for playing Carrie Bradshaw in both programmes but now her stint as the character has finally come to an end, she has no plans to look back because she doesn’t “find it pleasant” to see herself on screen.

According to People magazine, Sarah Jessica - who first appeared as Carrie in the first season of Sex and the City in 1995 - said when asked about

a rewatch during a Q+A hosted by Threads in New York earlier this week: “No. I’ve been talked to about this by the best lungs, and they all have really good reasons why I should.

“I wouldn’t want my time back. It’s not like I would regret it. I don’t like watching myself. I don’t find it pleasant, it’s not fun for me. I don’t find it enjoyable.”

And as time goes by, Sarah Jessica thinks revisiting the shows would grow more “complicated”.

She said: “And I think the further away it gets from me, the more complicated it would be for sentimental reasons, and maybe even for emotional reasons. “It’s sort of a hard chapter, to try to make simple.”

But when John Corbett reprised his Sex and the City role of Aidan Shaw in spin-off And Just Like That..., he rewatched the original programme and urged his co-star to check out at least some episodes.

Sarah Jessica said: “The beloved John Corbett, whom I’m so deeply fond of, said, ‘You just got to watch these four episodes,’ because when he came back, he watched everything.

“He was so swept away and so sentimental, and he was so proud of the work.

“I don’t want to say that it shouldn’t sound like he’s so proud of the work he did, but I think he didn’t realize how wonderful he was.”
