



Supreme Council for Youth & Sport Chairman, Bahrain Olympic Committee President & Royal Charity Organisation (RCO) Chairman HH Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa received IAAF President Lord Sebastian Coe in the presence of Supreme Council for Youth & Sport First Vice Chairman and Bahrain Royal Equestrian & Endurance Federation President HH Shaikh Khalid bin Hamad Al Khalifa, and Minister of Youth Affairs Hisham bin Mohammed Al Jowder. Shaikh Nasser hailed the enormous efforts being made by the International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF) to bolster ties among the members of the organisation, stating this has contributed to improve and develop the sport of athletics.
