Vaccination rate for children aged 12 to 17 reaches 91%; more than 17,000 from 3 to 11 immunised

Bahrain COVID-19 alert level to remain at yellow

The vaccination rate for children aged 12 to 17 has reached 91% in yet another success for the Kingdom of Bahrain's fight against the coronavirus (COVID-19).

Meanwhile, the National Medical Taskforce for Combatting the Coronavirus (COVID-19) announced that the Kingdom will remain on the Yellow Alert Level until 14 February.

The number of children aged 3 to 11 who were immunised has reached more than 17,000, while those who are already registered and waiting for their turn reached more than 25,000.

This was announced by Lt. Col. Doctor Manaf Al Qahtani, Infectious Disease Consultant and Microbiologist at the BDF Hospital and member of the National Medical Taskforce for Combatting the Coronavirus (COVID-19), at a press conference yesterday.

Dr Al Qahtani thanked parents for allowing their children to get vaccinated as part of the

Kingdom's national efforts to combat COVID-19.

He called on other parents to have their children received their doses as soon as possible to ensure their own safety and of those around them.

The health official noted that vaccinations and the booster shot have proven to be effective in reducing the severity of symptoms and mortality rates in case of infection.

Dr Al Qahtani called on all eligible individuals to get fully vaccinated, and take the booster

shot, according to updated vaccination protocols.

The health and safety of citizens and residents continues to be a top priority, he noted.

Dr Al Qahtani said that the national vaccination campaign was introduced with the aim of preserving public health, and since its inception until today, its procedures and protocols have been updated in accordance with international best practice.

He highlighted the importance of getting fully vaccinated and receiving a booster shot, as

vaccinations provide protection against the virus by bolstering the body's immunity.

The taskforce member also underlined the success of the national vaccination campaign, saying that ensuring community awareness has resulted in widespread acceptance of vaccination, with 94% of eligible individuals who are over 18 having received two vaccine doses, and 83% of eligible individuals having received a booster shot.

This came as HM the King took part in a quartet summit held in Abu Dhabi yesterday with the UAE Vice President, Prime Minister and Dubai Ruler, Shaikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, the Abu Dhabi Crown Prince, Deputy Supreme Commander of the UAE Armed Forces, Shaikh Mohammed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, and Egyptian President Abdel Fattah Al Sisi.

His Majesty and President Al Sisi voiced their countries' solidarity with the UAE and support to all steps taken to preserve its security and territorial safety.

During the meeting held at Qasr Al Watan in Abu Dhabi, the leaders discussed the ter-

rorist attacks carried out by the Houthi militias on civilian places and facilities in the UAE and their launch of two ballistic missiles towards the country.

They described the attacks as

a dangerous threat to regional security and stability, affirming that those hostile practices are in breach of all international laws and conventions and pose a threat to international peace and security.

The leaders also focused on cooperation and coordinating stances regarding issues of common concern. Regional and international developments and common challenges facing the Arab region were also spotlighted.

At the end of the meeting, they affirmed the importance of continuous coordination and consultation between the three countries regarding issues of common interest.

Gulf Air operates first flight out of Istanbul amidst snow storm

Gulf Air confirmed operating its first flight from Istanbul to return the first batch of stranded passengers to Bahrain following recent severe snow storms that resulted in halting air traffic in the Turkish city.

Bahrain's national carrier has operated a special flight from Tekirdag Corlu Airport to Istanbul International Airport then to Bahrain International Airport as its final destination, to bring back stranded passengers affected by recent bad

weather conditions.

The airline worked with Turkish authorities to exceptionally operate the flight and help return passengers home safely.

Gulf Air is amongst the first airlines to operate such a special flight out of Istanbul amidst this weather crisis that affected flights due to recent closure in Istanbul.

While Gulf Air is committed to the safety of its passengers and crew members, it affirms its continuous efforts to operate similar flights from Istanbul to return all stranded passengers at the soonest.

HRH Prince Salman issues edict aimed at restructuring Taqyeem

His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, yesterday issued Edict (6) of 2022, restructuring the Government Service Centre Evaluation Committee (Taqyeem).

Chaired by the Chief Executive Officer of the Information and e-Government Authority (IGA), the committee will comprise the following members, who will serve for a renewable four-year term: Dr Raed Mohammed bin Shams, Yousif Mohammed Al Binkhalil, Dr Hamad Ebrahim Abdulla, Osama Saleh Hashem Al Alawi, Shaikh Muath bin Duaij Al Khalifa, Dr Mohammed Abdulla Baqer, Nada Abdulmajeed Al Qassab, Hussain Ali Al Shehab, Fadheela Ebrahim Mohammed Al Akram, Ahmed Abdulhay Al Awadhi.

The relevant authorities, each in their capacity, shall implement the provisions of this edict, which comes into effect upon its publication in the Official Gazette.

HRH Prince Salman issued Edict (7) of 2022, amending some provisions of Edict (27) of 2020 on re-structuring the Board of Directors of the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibition Authority (BTEA).

According to the edict, clause (5) of Edict (27) of 2020 shall be replaced by the following:



HRH the Crown Prince and Prime Minister

"5- Mohammed Ahmed Abdulla Ali- Representative of Mumtalakat Holding Company (Mumtalakat).

The aforementioned shall serve until the end of the term of his predecessor."

The edict shall take immediate effect, and will be published in the Official Gazette.

His Royal Highness also issued Edict (8) of 2022, promulgating the issuance of the Executive Regulation of Law (7) of 2019 on Regulating the Registration of Births and Deaths.

Article (1): The provisions of the Executive Regulation of Law (7) of 2019 on Regulating the Registration of Births and Deaths, accompanying this edict, shall come into force.

Article (2): The Minister of Interior and those concerned, each in their own capacity, shall implement the provisions of this edict, which takes effect upon its publication in the Official Gazette.

Food safety rule violators warned by Industry Ministry

The Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Tourism has warned retail stores and supermarkets of tough actions if they fail to adhere to food safety standards set by the authorities.

Action was taken across the Kingdom against many shops and supermarkets for violating the rules as well as engaging in repacking and storing food materials without obtaining the required licence.

Ministry official Abdulaziz Al Ashraf said that the ministry has been carrying out periodic inspections throughout the past week. "Action was taken against a shop in the Capital Governorate for stocking expired food materials."

He said the shop has only been licensed to sell food products while they were stocking food products, most of them expired ones, illegally. "We have seized large quantities of rice, flour, spices, wheat, tea, sugar and other food products from the shop. The shop owners also engaged in repacking activities, which furthered the violations."

The Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Tourism earlier urged restaurants, cafes, shisha cafes and other food and beverage establishments to uphold COVID-19 mitigation rules to reduce the spread of

The ministry had reiterated that food service facilities are required to observe seating capacity restrictions and social distancing requirements stipulated by the Ministry of Health.

The ministry noted that noncompliance is an act of wrongdoing that undercuts preventative efforts, and may result in legal action against violators consistent with Public Health Law.

Adherence to these measures is particularly important considering the recent increase in reported cases as well as the emergence of a new variant.

Bahrain's COVID-19 alert level will remain at yellow until 14 February, meaning the Kingdom will see most activities limited to those who have been fully vaccinated.

Following approval by the Government Executive Committee, the National Medical Taskforce for Combatting the Coronavirus (COVID-19) made the announcement at a press conference yesterday at the Crown Prince Centre for Training and Medical Research, in Bahrain's Defence Force Hospital.

The taskforce noted that this decision was made to maintain the progress of national efforts to combat COVID-19 and pre-

serve public health.

Dr Waleed Khalifa Al Manea, Undersecretary at the Ministry of Health and member of the National Taskforce for

Combatting the Coronavirus (COVID-19), stressed the need for everyone to adhere to the previously announced Yellow Alert Level procedures.

He noted that health inspections are continuing, and violators will be penalised in accordance with the Kingdom's legal frameworks.

The health expert urged eligible individuals to head to the previously announced health centres to receive a booster shot without the need to make an appointment.

He said that that the current focus is on maintaining the low number of patients requiring treatment in hospital or intensive care units.

Preventive measures

Masks must be worn at all

times, and vaccinated and recovered individuals must show their green shield on the BeAware application in order to enter the various facilities.

During the yellow-level level, entry to malls, indoor and outdoor dining facilities, salons, shops and spas, gyms and sporting amusement parks, sports centres, sporting events and conferences will be limited to COVID-19 vaccinated and recovered individuals. Children below 12 years must be accompanied by a vaccinated or recovered adult.

Non-vaccinated individuals can attend schools in-person, enter shops outside malls, enter government centres and be part of events of up to 30 individuals, the committee said.

Cinemas will be limited to 50 percent of the total capacity.



Court Story

'Kidnappers' lose appeal to reverse jail term

The Court of Cassation upheld a three-year prison sentence for three Asians who are implicated in a kidnapping case.

The suspects are said to have abducted a man, also Asian, due to a dispute over borrowed money estimated at around BD700.

According to court files, the victim had reported that one of the accused came to him, ac-

companied by others, and asked him to come with them to an apartment in Hamala.

However, the victim refused, and the accused assaulted him by beating him and forced him to enter a car by threatening him with a knife that the accused had. They took him to an apartment in Hamala and locked him in it for two days after being beaten.

After two days, the victim managed to escape through one

of the windows and headed to one of the garages to ask for the workers' help. At the same time, a police patrol was passing by chance, so the victim went to the police car and told them about the incident.

The security forces were able to arrest the suspects.

The first accused admitted that he had previous disputes with the victim because he gave him BD700, and the victim did

not return the amount. The accused and his accomplices decided to kidnap the victim and keep him locked in the apartment.

They took the victim's phone and an amount of BD100 that was in his possession, and their purpose was to obtain the full amount from the victim. The second accused admitted the incident, while the third accused denied his participation with the other two.

◆ **Germany reported a new daily record of 164,000 COVID-19 infections yesterday as the lower house of parliament prepared to debate proposals to either require or robustly encourage residents to be vaccinated.** Around 75% of the population have received at least one dose of a vaccine - less than in western European peers such as France, Italy or Spain, where the equivalent figures are 80%, 83% and 86% - and the vaccination campaign is stuttering. The proposals being debated include requiring all adult residents to be vaccinated against COVID-19, or only those above 50, or merely requiring all those who have not been vaccinated to receive counselling. Early on in the coronavirus pandemic, Germany was more successful than many of its peers in limiting infections through case tracking, strict lockdowns and quarantines.

COVID is less severe with Omicron than Delta, US study suggests



◆ **The Omicron variant appears to result in less severe COVID-19 than seen during previous periods of high coronavirus transmission including the Delta wave, with shorter hospital stays, less need for intensive care and fewer deaths, according to a new US study.** However, the fast-spreading Omicron variant has led to record numbers of infections and hospitalizations, straining the U.S. healthcare system. Despite the steep spike in COVID cases, the percentage of hospitalized patients admitted to intensive care units (ICU) during the current Omicron wave was about 29% lower than during last winter's surge and some 26% lower than during the Delta wave, the study published on Tuesday in the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report found. The lower COVID-19 disease severity during the Omicron period is likely related to higher vaccination coverage, booster use among those eligible for the extra shots, as well as prior infections providing some immune protection, the study said.

◆ **Early research suggesting that a popular non-psychoactive compound derived from marijuana might help prevent or treat COVID-19 warrants further investigation in rigorous clinical trials, researchers say.** Several recent laboratory studies of cannabidiol, or CBD, have shown promising results, attracting media attention. However, many other potential COVID treatments that showed promise in test tubes, from hydroxychloroquine to various drugs used to treat cancer and other diseases, ultimately failed to show benefit for COVID-19 patients once studied in clinical trials. Marsha Rosner of the University of Chicago led a team that found CBD appeared to help curb SARS-CoV-2 in infected cells in laboratory experiments. "Our findings do not say this will work in patients. Our findings make a strong case for a clinical trial," she said. Using small doses of highly purified CBD that approximate what patients receive in an oral drug already approved for severe epilepsy, Rosner and colleagues found that CBD did not keep the coronavirus from infecting cells in test tubes. Rather, it acted soon after the virus entered the cells, blocking it from making copies of itself in part via effects on the inflammatory protein interferon. They found similar effects in infected mice, according to a report in Science Advances.

Saudi, Thailand agree to restore full diplomatic relations

Saudi Arabia and Thailand agreed yesterday to exchange ambassadors in the first high-level meeting between the two countries since a row over a jewellery theft nearly three decades ago led the Gulf state to downgrade ties.

Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman and visiting Thai Prime Minister Prayuth Chan-ocha agreed on the appointment of ambassadors "in the near future" and to strengthen economic and trade relations, said a joint statement on Saudi state media.

Saudi Arabian Airlines announced in a Twitter post on Tuesday that it would restart direct flights to Thailand in May.

The statement said Prayuth expressed "sincere regret over the tragic events in Thailand between 1989 and 1990" and said his government was ready to "raise cases to the competent authorities in the event of new, relevant evidence".

The theft of the jewels remains one of Thailand's biggest unsolved mysteries and was followed by a bloody trail of destruction that saw some of Thailand's top police generals implicated.

India celebrates 73rd Republic Day

Thousands of Indians have braved chilly morning temperatures to gather on a ceremonial boulevard in the capital New Delhi to watch a display of the country's military power and cultural diversity, though the colourful spectacle was curtailed by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Nearly 500 schoolchildren, folk dancers, police and military battalions, floats and stunt performers on motorbikes paraded from the presidential palace through the refurbished, tree-lined Rajpath Boulevard on Wednesday.

President Ram Nath Kovind took the salute from the marching columns, which also included a camel-mounted Border Security Force regiment, its moustachioed riders led by shiny brass bands with tubas.

The 90-minute parade ended with a flypast featuring 75 air force fighters, including Rafale jets, transport planes and helicopters.

Earlier on Wednesday, Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited the National War Memorial in New Delhi, where he laid a wreath as he paid his respects during a ceremony also attended by military personnel.

Only double-vaccinated adults and single-dose vaccinated children of 15 and above were allowed to attend the parade.

With COVID-19 cases surging around the country, attendance was slashed to between 5,000 and 8,000 from last year's 25,000, and there were no foreign guests of honour.

Republic Day marks the anniversary of the adoption of the country's constitution on January 26, 1950. India won independence from British colonial rule in 1947.

Saudi Arabia downgraded relations with Bangkok after a diplomatic row over a theft in 1989 of around \$20 million of jewels by a Thai janitor working in the palace of a Saudi prince, in what became known as the "Blue Diamond Affair". A year after the theft, three Saudi diplomats in Thailand were killed in three separate assassinations in a single night.

A large number of the gems, including the rare blue diamond, are yet to be recovered.

In 2014, a Thai criminal court dismissed a case against five men, including a senior police officer, charged with murdering Saudi businessman Mohammad al-Ruwaili, who disappeared one

month after witnessing one of the shootings of the Saudi diplomats.

Thailand has been eager to normalise ties with oil-rich Saudi Arabia after the spat that has cost billions of dollars in two-way trade and tourism revenues and the loss of jobs for tens of thousands of Thai migrant workers.

Israel, Lebanon to resume maritime border talks

Israel's Energy Ministry and Lebanon President Michel Aoun had expressed their intention yesterday to resume negotiations for setting maritime border next week.

Israeli Energy Minister Karine Elharrar said they would meet with US envoy Amos Hochstein next week as part of efforts to settle the dispute, the ministry said.

Indirect talks between Israel and Lebanon have stalled several times.

Lebanon President Michel Aoun said that his country is ready to resume negotiations over the demarcation of a

southern maritime border that is disputed with Israel.

Long time foes Lebanon and Israel started indirect negotiations through a US mediator in 2020 at a UN peacekeeping base in Lebanon's Naqoura, but the talks have stalled several times.

The maritime border dispute has held up exploration in the potentially gas-rich area.

Separately, Aoun said that his nation welcomes last week's Kuwaiti proposal of confidence-building measures to end a diplomatic rift with Gulf states.

Aoun added on Twitter that the answers to the initiative will be conveyed by Lebanon's foreign minister to the Arab ministerial meeting in Kuwait.

Nearly eight years after Russia seized Crimea and backed separatist fighters in Donbass in eastern Ukraine, the former Soviet republic has become the flashpoint in potentially the most dangerous East-West confrontation since the Cold War.

Russia says the crisis is being driven by NATO and US actions, and is demanding security guarantees from the West, including a promise by NATO never to admit Ukraine. Moscow sees Ukraine as a buffer between Russia and NATO countries.

Western allies have threatened economic sanctions against Russia if it attacks Ukraine, and the United States has been talking to major energy-producing countries and companies around the world over a potential diversion of supplies to Europe if Russia invades Ukraine.

The EU depends on Russia for around a third of its gas supplies. Any interruptions to its Russian imports would exacerbate an existing energy crisis

caused by shortages.

'NORMANDY' TALKS

In Paris, officials from France, Germany, Russia and Ukraine began talks on the simmering Donbass war in which some 15,000 people have been killed since 2014.

Andriy Yermak, chief of staff to Ukraine's President Volodymyr Zelenskiy, called the talks "a strong signal towards achieving peace in eastern Ukraine".

But he said major ceasefire violations were taking place, and ruled out the prospect of speaking directly to the separatists.

The four-way "Normandy format" talks, which have not been held for more than

six months, are seen by the European powers as

vital to remaining relevant in the broader dialogue with Moscow while the United States and NATO hold separate crisis negotiations.

French officials said they hoped that some progress could be made that would help the wider efforts to reduce tensions.

A French presidential official said the aim was to set a date for talks on humanitarian measures and prisoner releases that would then lead to negotiations on the future of the Donbass region. However, he said the reality was that they would use the Paris talks to determine whether Russia was serious.

"Either President Putin will seek maximum tension with us, which means it will be very difficult to progress in the Normandy talks, or he assesses that in this great period of volatility, it's useful to use this format to reduce tensions."

Interfax news agency quoted the Russian defence ministry as saying it a paratrooper unit had been deployed to Belarus on Wednesday, a day after moving in artillery forces and marines ahead of joint exercises next month.

It said Russia was also moving Su-35 fighter jets to Belarus for the "Allied Resolve" exercises.

The buildup of Russian forces in Belarus, a close Russian ally and former Soviet republic north of Ukraine, creates a new front for a possible attack, read more RIA news agency said more than 20 Russian vessels had embarked on exercises in the Black Sea, south of Ukraine.

Separately, Russian artillery forces in the southern Rostov region that borders Ukraine were set to practice firing on Wednesday as part of a combat readiness inspection of the Southern Military District, the Defence Ministry said.

Russian authorities have said the country plans to begin year-round shipping via the Northern Sea Route in 2022 or 2023.

As officials began four-nation talks in Paris, Russia held new military drills on land and sea and moved more paratroops and fighter jets to Belarus, north of Ukraine, for what it describes as joint exercises there next month.

Russia warned on Wednesday that imposing sanctions on President Vladimir Putin personally would not hurt him but would be "politically destructive", after US President Joe Biden said he would consider such a move if Russia invaded Ukraine.

Biden said on Tuesday personal sanctions on Putin, though a rare step, could be considered as part of a concerted drive by the United States and its allies to convince Moscow that any new aggression against Ukraine would bring swift and massive costs.

Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said US Congressmen and senators discussing personal sanctions against Russia's top leaders were ignorant of the fact they were legally barred from holding assets, property and bank accounts abroad.

Individual sanctions against Putin would be "not painful (but) politically destructive", said Peskov, who





Medvedev mounts astonishing comeback after Tsitsipas romps into semis

Men's title favourite Daniil Medvedev fought back from the brink of a shock exit yesterday to reach the Australian Open semi-final and keep his dream of a second Grand Slam crown alive.

Medvedev, the world number two, looked down and out as he lost the opening two sets to Canadian 21-year-old sensation Felix Auger-Aliassime before mounting a remarkable turnaround.

The Russian saved a match point at 4-5, 30-40 in the fourth set before completing an astonishing revival to beat the ninth seed 6-7 (4/7), 3-6, 7-6 (7/2), 7-5, 6-4 in a marathon 4hr 42min quarter-final that finished well after midnight on Rod Laver Arena.

Asked how he managed to win, the US Open champion Medvedev admitted: "I have no idea."

Derby winning trainer Michael Bell has made the trip over to Bahrain ahead of the race and spoke of his chances. He said: "Ace Rothstein won a couple of races back in England having had a late start to his three-year-old career. He came out to Bahrain just before Christmas and was a bit unlucky in one of the Turf Series races when he got a bit squeezed on the rail. He then won a nice trial race for the Crown Prince's Cup 10 days ago."

Bell continued: "In theory, he'll have to step up again. He was getting six-and-a-half pounds from Medal Winner who is one of the best horses trained in Bahrain, but he beat him pretty emphatically and it was over a trip short of our best. We're stepping up to ten furlongs this week which should suit so even though we're worse off at the weights, the extra furlong should stand him in good stead."

On the booking of Moore, Bell said: "We've got a very experienced jockey and the horse is definitely training well over here. He looks great and he's eating well. With the locals, it's always the same when you go overseas. When you go to Ireland you take on Aidan O'Brien, and when you come to Bahrain

you take on Shaikh Isa and Fawzi Nass."

Moore is riding in Saudi Arabia on Thursday before making the trip over to Bahrain. He said: "I'm looking forward to riding in Bahrain again. I ride Ace Rothstein who won well over 1m 1f recently on this course in a small field proving he handles the conditions. This looks a competitive race, and we will need to improve again."
