6- What are the research facilities offered by the university in various disciplines?

We presently have a dual-floor library at the heart of the Campus. It can accommodate over 200 simultaneous users in both shared and private study spaces and meeting rooms. As well as being an e-resource center, it houses text and reference books, and periodicals in individual sections. Faculty, Students, and Staff can access over 170,000 of the latest international e-books,

research papers and more than 25,000 e-journals in different languages as part of AUBH's ProQuest offering. There are also several study areas with computers for downloading research papers, e-journals, e-books, and other reading material.

We have labs for chemistry, physics, and biology, plus a well-equipped IT lab to support research. In the planning stages are a media lab for AV and production work, a mechanical engineering lab, and a space built specifically for students of architecture. We also have several hundred square meters planned as an Innovation Hub that can be utilised for any business partner relationships that we may develop over the next several years. Our programs contain elements in which research will be key, and students will manage their own research projects independently

7- Looking forward, what are the university's future plans?

We plan to continue to support the Kingdom's 2030 vision by maintaining quality in our educational programs with a strong emphasis on soft skills and a replication of an American-style experience. This provides an option for students who finish secondary education and would normally look to continue learning in the United States or the UK or elsewhere. AUBH provides a viable and accessible alternative to moving to another country where students get the highest quality education and academic credits that are mobile, preparing them to work around the globe or in Bahrain, whatever their choice. This approach allows AUBH to graduate employment-ready students and positively impact local and regional economies. To further demonstrate our commitment to quality education and student experience, we are currently seeking U.S. regional accreditation. and are exploring affiliations with U.S.-based academic institutions.
