tle girl from Orlando, Florida, who got her start singing the National Anthem, I'm not sure I ever would have dreamed this big.

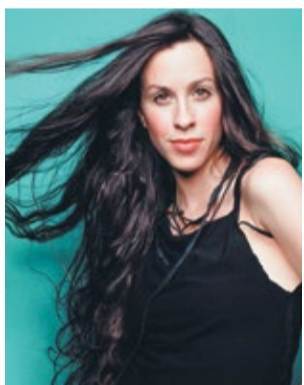
"I never thought anything like this would ever come to light and yet here we are and it's deeply humbling."
