## Can Uruguay create history?

fter a swift start to its qualification campaign, Uruguay collapsed losing three successive matches -3-1 in Chile, 4-1 at home to Brazil, 2-1 in Peru. Until then manager Oscar Tabarez's strategy was to drop deep and hit on the counter, relying on Edinson Cavani and Luiz Suarez upfront.

But as key components of his team - particularly the midfield started ageing and two teams which didn't even qualify for the World Cup - Italy and Ireland - thrashed Uruguay, Tabarez changed his tactics.
