Israel military brigade to protect West Bank wall

Ramallah

Israel has established a new special military brigade to protect its barrier in the West Bank and reconstruct several kilometres of wall in southern Jenin, with a shoot-to-kill policy against Palestinian infiltrators, senior Israeli military sources revealed this week.

The Wall Brigade started functioning two weeks ago and consists of six battalions numbering 2,100 personnel.

The budget for the new 60-kilometre-long, seven-metre-high cement wall, which will start from the south of Jenin and run along the border with the West Bank, is \$100 million.

The brigade command is located in the Maccabim area near the village of Ni'lin, close to Israel's borders west of Ramallah.

Major contracting company ordered to pay BD50,000 to sub-contractor

The Sixth High Civil Court ruled to obligate a renowned contracting company to pay BD50,000, the value of a contract with another company under which the latter supplied the necessary labour for a major

project.

As per the court documents, the contracting company had refused to pay the outstanding amount.

Lawyer Essam Al Tayeb, agent of the plaintiff company, said that the contracting company signed an agreement with the

defendant under which the plaintiff supplied labour to complete a major project.

However, the defendant refused to pay amounts that exceeded BD50,000. The attorney demanded payment of the outstanding amount in addition to 7% interest.

While hearing the case, the Court ordered the assignment of an expert, whose report concluded that the defendant was late in paying monthly bills despite the plaintiff's full commitment to supplying manpower, with cost of unpaid dues estimated at over BD50,000.

According to Article 1 of the Evidence Act, the creditor must prove obligation and the debtor must dispose of it. The contract is the law, and neither contracting party may revoke it or modify its provisions except within the limits of what is permitted by the agreement or dictated by law.

'No hopes at all' in life and death

Social workers in Kingdom in tough spot over illegal residents' deaths

Many social workers in the Kingdom are finding themselves at sea after the deaths of illegal residents, whose semi-identities aren't enough to fly the body home or inform the relatives or friends.

They say, over the past few years, funerals for a large number of illegal residents have been held in the Kingdom, owing to struggles to trace their permanent addresses back in their home countries or immediate survivors or relatives.

Speaking to The Daily Tribune, a social worker said an illegal resident's life in the Kingdom is nothing short of a mystery. "There are many illegal residents, who have been living in the Kingdom for many decades. And the toughest aspect of their lives is the fact that no-one knows their permanent address or close relatives in their home countries.

"They generally don't have passports with them nor do they have a permanent place to stay or long-time friends. We only get to know them once they are seriously ill or upon death. And our job would become really difficult in the absence of these basic identities that constitute a human being in the modern society."

The last such incident was the death of Indian national Suresh Rajamanickam, who has been an illegal resident in the Kingdom since 2014.

Sources said a group of acquaintances took Suresh to Salmaniya Medical Complex (SMC)

hospital sometime back after he seriously fell ill.

Upon his death at SMC, the social workers contacted his acquaintances to obtain the permanent address to fly back the body home.

"However, none of them knew it," sources said.

Suresh Kaladi, who is the Secretary of Rajini Fans Association (Association of fans of Indian film actor Rajinikanth) in the Kingdom, said they had to use their network across the South Indian state of Tamil Nadu, to discover the permanent address of the deceased as well as contact his mother and relatives.

"We are planning to perform the final rites of the deceased person in the Kingdom and have already received the consent of his mother Rasathi in this regard. The Indian Embassy has been actively supporting us to ensure that all legalities are met in both countries," he told The Daily Tribune.

"Our team members Mr Ramesh Mayavarathan and Mr Muruganantham is coordinat-

ing with the family in India and supporting them all financially," he added.

According to official estimates, there are around 55,000 illegal foreign workers residing in the Kingdom and the number has been declining sharply since the outbreak of the pandemic.

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority has always been exerting its best efforts to legalise the stay of all illegal residents in the Kingdom. And it was in this regard the authority introduced Flexi Permits.

Flexi Permits are permits that allow foreign workers to live freely in the Kingdom and work in any non-specialised occupation without a sponsor for a renewable period of one or two years.

World theatrical premiere for Bollywood movie shot in Bahrain

● **Khel Kood Aur Bhoot a 130-minute Hindi film with English and Arabic subtitles**

Moviegoers are in for a treat as the first Bollywood film that was considerably shot in Bahrain is set to release here next month with a world theatrical premiere in the Kingdom.

Khel Kood Aur Bhoot (Fun, Frolic, and Ghost) is the brainchild of Bahraini award-winning journalist turned film-maker and actor Adnan Malik.

The 130-minute Hindi film with English and Arabic subtitles will be premiering exclusively at the Cinépolis, Atrium Mall and will be mostly invite-only. However, it will subsequently be released in theatres across Bahrain following the red-carpet event.

"Cinépolis is an exotic global theater chain and this is really a great deal for me as an independent filmmaker and I'm extremely grateful to God for this," said an ecstatic Malik from Mumbai explaining that the cinema operator, which is one of the fourth largest cinema chains in the world, "immediately saw the merits of releasing this independently produced movie."

"We are making history here as the first Bollywood film to release in theatres after releasing online. This has never happened before in Hindi cinema." Normally, Bollywood movies release in theatres and then go to the OTT platform and subsequently to satellite channels, explained Malik.

The comedy-horror, which is inspired by true events, made an online debut on India's largest OTT platform on May 13 this year.

"Independent films often fall under the radar, are bypassed or overlooked in favor of popular movie titles with a well-

known star cast so this is truly a historic moment for the movie and our kingdom," said Malik, adding that he is also "extremely grateful" to the Ministry of Information for their support in censoring the movie and the

Dubai-based digital content distributors Scrabble, Qubewire for delivering the content and Phars Film Co. for the go-ahead for censor screening.

"This is the first Bollywood movie shot in Bahrain so I had

to somehow bring the movie here," said Malik adding that he was overwhelmed with requests from family, friends, and many acquaintances from Bahrain and the region after they watched his gripping teaser online and

the news broke about the film's release in our newspaper.

The movie already has rave reviews and scores on popular, reliable, and authoritative movie content sites like IMDB and a 100 per cent score on the extremely popular Indian movies' site Bollywood Hungama.

Speaking to The Daily Tribune, Alejandro Aguilera, CEO of Cinépolis Cinemas Gulf Region, said: "We are very excited to collaborate in the release and premiere of Khel Kood Aur Bhoot at Cinépolis Cinemas in Bahrain.

Egypt contracts to buy 180,000 tonnes of wheat from India

Egypt has contracted to buy 180,000 tonnes of wheat from India, Supply Minister Aly Moselhy said yesterday, less than previously agreed, a deal that is part of the country's efforts to diversify its wheat supplies. Russia and Ukraine have been Egypt's main wheat suppliers.

Moselhy had said in May that Egypt had agreed to buy 500,000 tonnes of wheat from India but that a contract had not been signed.

"We had agreed on 500,000 tonnes, turns out [the supplier] has 180,000 tonnes in the port," he said.

Moselhy added that Egypt was also in talks with Russian suppliers for a wheat purchase agreement.

Russia slides towards default as payment deadline expires

● **Russia says it has funds to pay, sanctions are to blame**

Russia edged closer to default yesterday amid little sign that investors holding its international bonds had received payment, heralding what would be the nation's first default in decades.

Russia has struggled to keep up payments on \$40 billion of outstanding bonds since its invasion of Ukraine on Feb. 24, which provoked sweeping

sanctions that have effectively cut the country out of the global financial system and rendered its assets untouchable to many investors.

The Kremlin has repeatedly said there are no grounds for Russia to default but is unable to send money to bondholders because of sanctions, accusing the West of trying to drive it into an artificial default.

The country's efforts to swerve what would be its first major default on international bonds since the Bolshevik revolution more than a century ago hit an insurmountable roadblock when the US Treasury Department's Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) effectively blocked Moscow from making payments in late May.

The payments in question are

\$100 million in interest on two bonds, one denominated in US dollars and another in euros, Russia was due to pay on May 27. The payments had a grace period of 30 days, which will expire on Sunday.

Russia's finance ministry said it made the payments to its onshore National Settlement Depository (NSD) in euros and dollars, adding it has fulfilled obligations.

However, it is unlikely that funds will find their way to many international holders. For many bondholders, not receiving the money owed in time into their accounts constitutes a default.

With no exact deadline specified in the prospectus, lawyers say Russia might have until the end of the following business day to pay the bondholders.

Collective investment

Most days, there are attractive ads calling potential investors for collective investments in certain investment funds. These ads are normally from investment banks or companies and the like. When seeing such ads certain queries arise. What is the meaning of this venture, what are investment funds? Is it safe to join and to give money for investment? Investment funds, pension funds, unit trusts, trust portfolio... are almost of the same legal nature, and they embody the main characteristics with some differences regarding details that are tailored for each fund. As de facto and de jure, stock markets and securities boards encourage investment in such funds because they represent acceptable collective investment.

Collective investment, in securities or commodities, is welcomed because it attracts potential investors and, also, tries to mitigate or counter the risks that could happen to certain participants. Collective investment opens new opportunities for small investors to invest in prime mega projects in which they cannot afford to invest by themselves because a lot of money is needed. This process achieves a profound effect through educating people to invest in securities and stocks even though they do not have big amounts of money, this is because the door is open for big and small amounts

from different investors. In collective investment, the interested investor is not involved directly in relation to investment decisions or policies because the fund director takes the decision on his behalf. The concerned director, in all cases, takes the necessary decision that suits the fund and such decision is not necessarily always to the satisfaction of all investors who have joined the fund. This should not be taken to mean that the director or the fund will act in jeopardy to the interests of investors simply because the investors' interest becomes part & parcel of their own interest.

Due to such relationship and other related factors, including the nature and concept of collective investment, the Regulatory Authorities set standards regarding licensing requirements and the regulation of those to operate collective investment schemes. This is a pivotal point because such funds are entrusted to manage third parties money and, they should be trustworthy and able to meet the fiduciary trust vested on them. The Regulatory Authorities should clearly issue and provide for clear-cut rules governing, inter alia, the legal form of the fund, accountability and legal structure of the collective investment schemes.... Rules should be strictly adopted and followed, with particular reference to the segregation and protection of the client assets from the assets of the fund. Each investor, shall be able to know how much he is holding in his name, and how much he can take in case of profits... etc. Laws should clearly provide for disclosure requirements to evaluate the suitability of each collective investment for each investor, and the value of the investor's interest in the scheme. Regulations to ensure that there is proper basis for asset valuation, pricing and redemption of units in each collective investment scheme.

Directors entrusted to manage collective investments shall maintain professional standard, experience and relevant know-how. Good reputation, conduct and close follow-up of the concerned codes of ethics should be of paramount importance. To safeguard the interests of investors and to give them the required shield of protection, Regulatory Authorities are advised not to allow such type of collective investment unless undertaken by able and capable institutions. Reference to able institutions should be taken to mean that such institutions are having sufficient paid-capital, reserves and required net worth. Authorities should make sure that, contracts signed between funds and potential investors are clear and free from ambiguities that could harm investors because the investors rely on the trust bond that links them with the fund. This trust bond constitutes a cornerstone in the relationship between the parties and should be maintained.

Collective investment concept, should be developed and encouraged because we believe that they are important for the market expansion and growth. They should be encouraged according to strong rules that cater for the protection of investors. It should be known that all applicable or specified information furnished to investors, and other parties, is accurate, true, and complete in every material respect. Collective investment funds shall issue a statement or an undertaking to specify that they will comply with all laws and orders. In some jurisdictions investment funds or unit trusts are required to specify that there is no pending legal suit or proceedings before any court, governmental body, or any arbitrator that is likely to affect the legality, validity or enforceability of any of their.

We believe that the competent authorities, should prepare up-to-date regulations to protect investors in all respects, there should be sufficient means to inspect licensed institutions and the products they offer. All, among other things, are required to give water-tight security to potential investors in collective investments.

US President Joe Biden will unveil the plans, flanked by other Group of Seven leaders, some of whom have already unveiled their own separate initiatives, at their annual gathering being held this year at Schloss Elmau in southern Germany.

Increasingly worried about China, G7 leaders first floated plans for the project last year, and are formally launching it now under a fresh title, "Partnership for Global Infrastruc-

ture and Investment" while dropping the moniker "Build Back Better World" first coined by Biden during his presidential campaign.

Biden will unveil several specific projects at a G7 side event, joined by leaders from Britain, Germany, Japan, the European Union and Canada, vowing to focus on projects that help tackle climate change as well as improve global health, gender equity and digital infrastructure. Notably absent will be French President Emmanuel Macron who had formally joined the Chinese infrastructure programme.

◆ **Russian Defence Minister**

Sergei Shoigu inspected Russian troop units involved in Ukraine, the defence ministry said yesterday. "At the command posts of Russian units, Army General Sergei Shoigu heard reports from the commanders on the current situation and actions of the Russian Armed Forces in the main operational areas," the ministry said in a statement. It was not immediately clear when the visit took place or if Shoigu had visited Ukraine itself.

◆ A well at a site operated by local Nigerian firm **Eroton Exploration and Production Limited** has been spilling oil and gas into the Niger Delta for more than a week, the company and an agency responsible for detecting oil spills said. Eroton produces and exports crude from its Oil Mining Lease 18 block through the Nembe Creek Trunkline. Last year, a nearby well run by Aiteo Eastern E&P spilled oil for more than a month, polluting the Delta creeks before it was successfully shut. Idris Musa, head of the National Oil Spills Detection and Response Agency said on Sunday Eroton had reported the spill to authorities, blaming it on a leak from a wellhead.

◆ **Egypt has strategic reserves of wheat sufficient**

for 5.7 months, Supply Minister **Aly Moselhy** said in a news conference on Sunday, adding that the country has procured 3.9 million tonnes of wheat in the local harvest so far. Egypt is often the world's biggest wheat importer. He added that the strategic reserves for sugar were sufficient for more than six months and those for vegetable oils are sufficient for 6.2 months, while the country is self-sufficient for rice for 3.3 months.

◆ **Charity donations accepted** by Britain's Prince Charles were handled correctly, his office said after a newspaper reported that he received 3 million euros (\$3.2 million) in cash from a former Qatari prime minister, some of it in shopping bags. The Sunday Times said that Charles accepted three lots of cash that were given to him personally by Sheikh Hamad bin Jassim bin Jaber Al Thani between 2011 and 2015. "Charitable donations received from Sheikh Hamad bin Jassim were passed immediately to one of the prince's charities who carried out the appropriate governance and have assured us that all the correct processes were followed," the prince's office said in a statement on Sunday. The Sunday Times said there was no suggestion the payments were illegal. In November Michael Fawcett, the right-hand man to Prince Charles for decades, stepped down from his role running one of the British royal's main charities weeks after the Sunday Times said he had offered honours in return for donations. Police and Britain's Charity Commission are investigating those claims. A spokesman for the prince has said that Charles had no knowledge of the alleged offer of honours or citizenship on the basis of donations.

Russian missiles hit an apartment block and kindergarten in the Ukrainian capital Kyiv yesterday, in strikes US President Joe Biden condemned as "barbarism" as world leaders gathered in Europe to discuss further sanctions against Moscow.

Up to four explosions shook central Kyiv in the early hours, in the first such attack on the city in weeks. Two more blasts were heard on the southern outskirts of the city later in the day, a Reuters reporter said.

"The Russians hit Kyiv again. Missiles damaged an apartment building and a kindergarten," said Andriy Yermak, head of the president's administration.

A Reuters photographer saw a large blast crater by a playground in a kindergarten that had smashed windows.

UK, US, Japan and Canada to ban Russia gold

Britain, the United States, Japan and Canada will ban new imports of Russian gold as part of efforts to tighten the sanctions squeeze on Moscow for its invasion of Ukraine, the British government said yesterday.

The ban will come into force shortly and apply to newly mined



or refined gold, the government statement said ahead of a meeting of Group of Seven leaders in Germany on Sunday.

The move will not affect previously exported Russian-origin gold, it added.

Russian gold exports were worth 12.6 billion pounds (\$15.45 billion) last year and wealthy Rus-

sians have recently been buying bullion to reduce the financial impact of Western sanctions, the government said.

"The measures we have announced today will directly hit Russian oligarchs and strike at the heart of Putin's war machine," Prime Minister Boris Johnson said in the statement.

Iran tests Zuljanah satellite launcher for second time

Iran has carried out a second test of its Zuljanah satellite launcher, Iranian state TV reported yesterday.

"The third development

phase of the Zuljanah satellite launcher will be based on a combination of information gained during today's launch," a defence ministry spokesperson told state TV, without clarifying whether the test was successful.

Last year, the United States voiced concern over the successful launch of the domestically-made satellite launcher for the first time, which Tehran said was aimed at helping achieve its "most powerful rocket engine".

Russia has stepped up air strikes on Ukraine this weekend, which has also seen the fall of a strategic eastern city to pro-Russian forces.

"It's more of their barbarism," said Biden, referring to the missile strikes on Kyiv, as leaders from the Group of Seven (G7) rich democracies gathered for a summit in Germany.

Ukraine's Foreign Minister Dmytro Kuleba said G7 countries should respond to the latest missile strikes by imposing further sanctions on Russia and providing more heavy weapons to Ukraine.

As Europe's biggest land conflict since World War Two entered its fifth month, the Western alliance supporting Kyiv was starting to show signs of strain as leaders fret about the growing economic cost.

British Prime Minister Boris Johnson said the West needed to build a united front against Russian President Vladimir Putin.

"The price of backing down, the price of allowing Putin to succeed, to hack off huge parts of Ukraine, to continue with his programme of conquest, that price will be far, far higher," he told reporters.

There had been no major strikes on Kyiv since early June.

The city's mayor, Vitali Klitschko, said on the Telegram messaging app that Sunday's strike had partially destroyed a nine-storey apartment building in the historic Shevchenkivskiy district of central Kyiv and caused a fire.

"There are people under the rubble," Klitschko said. "They have pulled out a seven-year-old girl. She is alive. Now they're trying to rescue her mother."

Iraqi PM in Iran for revival of Tehran-Riyadh talks

Iran and Iraq have agreed to seek stability in the Middle East, Iraqi Prime Minister Mustafa al-Kadhimi said in Tehran yesterday, a day after he visited Saudi Arabia in a bid to revive talks to ease years of hostility.

Iran and Saudi Arabia severed ties in 2016.

"We have agreed to work together to bring stability and calm to the region," Kadhimi said in a joint televised news conference with Iran's President Ebrahim Raisi.

An Iranian official told Reuters earlier on Sunday that "the resumption of talks between Tehran and Riyadh will be discussed during Kadhimi's trip to Iran".

"Dialogue with regional officials can resolve the regional issues," Raisi said, without elaborating.

The fifth round of talks between the regional rivals were held in April, after Iran suspended the negotiations in March without giving a reason.

On Saturday, Kadhimi held talks with Saudi ruler Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman in Jeddah that the state news agency SPA said included bilateral relations and "boosting security and stability in the region".

Kadhimi's visit comes as a months-long impasse in the indirect talks between Tehran and Washington is expected to break in the coming days to secure a 2015 nuclear pact which curbed Tehran's nuclear programme in exchange for sanctions relief.

US President Joe Biden is expected to visit Riyadh in mid-July and talks are expected to include Gulf security concerns over Iran's ballistic missiles programme and network of proxies across the Middle East.

US held secret meeting with Israeli, Arab military chiefs to counter Iran air threat, reports WSJ

Meeting in Sharm El Sheikh included military officials from Israel, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Jordan, Egypt, the UAE and Bahrain

The United States of America held a secret meeting of top military officials from Israel and Arab countries, including Bahrain, in March to explore how they could coordinate against Iran's growing missile and drone capabilities, a Wall Street Journal report said quoting officials from the US and the region

The report said the meeting, which had officers from Bahrain and the United Arab Emirates were held at Sharm El Sheikh, Egypt.

WSJ says it was also the first time that such a range of ranking Israeli and Arab officers have met under US military auspices to discuss how to defend against a common threat.

Top military officers from Israel, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Egypt and Jordan and Israel and its neighbours were part of the early stage of discussing potential military cooperation, the report quoting officials said.

The US was represented by Gen. Frank McKenzie, then the head of the US Central Command.

Discussions among the Middle East nations about cooperating on air defence, however, have a long way to go and are still diplomatically sensitive, WSJ adds.

In a statement, Col. Joe Buccino, a Central Command spokesman, said the command "maintains a firm commitment to increasing regional cooperation and developing integrated air and missile defence architecture to protect our force and our regional partners." Iran "is the primary destabilising factor across the Middle East," he added. "The UAE, is not party to any regional military alliance or cooperation targeting any specific country," the government there said in a statement. "Furthermore, the UAE, is not aware of any formal discussions relating to any such regional military alliance."

The Sharm El Sheikh

talks followed secret discussions in a lower-level working group among representatives from Middle East nations that discussed hypothetical scenarios about how they could cooperate to detect and defend against air threats. The working group included the Central Command's then-chief planning officer, Marine Maj. Gen. Scott Benedict.

WSJ report says at the high-level Sharm El Sheikh talks, the participants reached agreement in principle on procedures for rapid notification when aerial threats are detected, according to people familiar with the talks.

For now, such notifications would be carried out by phone or computer but not through high-speed digital US military-style sharing of data. Officials also discussed how decisions might be made on which nation's forces would intercept aerial threats.

Those understandings, however, weren't binding, people familiar with the meeting said. The next step is to secure the support of political leaders to codify the notification arrangements and determine the interest of Middle East leaders in broadening the cooperation.

Air Defence already in place?

Many of the building blocks for a potential regional air defence system are in place. Saudi Arabia has bought as many as 22 US Patriot antimissile batteries, according to a US official, and is in the process of acquiring Terminal High Altitude Area Defense batteries, another US antimissile system known as THAAD, says WSJ.

The UAE already has a THAAD system, which it says was used to shoot down a missile fired at Abu Dhabi from Yemen by Iran-backed Houthi rebels in January.

Israel has the Iron Dome system and other advanced aerial-defence systems for detecting and shooting down rockets, missiles and other threats, including short-range rockets fired by Palestinian militants from Gaza and drones launched from Iran and other countries.

"The task in the theater is really how do you knit those together so you create more than the simple sum of the component parts," Gen. McKenzie said at a Pentagon press conference in March. "So everybody sees the same thing, everybody gets early warning, everybody can be prepared to react very quickly to a potential Iranian attack."

Gen. McKenzie, who handed off command of US forces in the region to Gen. Erik Kurilla in April before retiring from the military, didn't mention the Egypt meeting at the press conference.

In a briefing last week for Israeli lawmakers, Israel's Defence Minister Benny Gantz described the emerging arrangement as the "Middle East Air Defence Alliance," though some people informed about the talks said they hadn't heard that term used previously and it appeared to overstate how far the effort has progressed.

Mr. Gantz also said the air defence initiative had already enabled "the successful interception of Iranian attempts to attack Israel and other countries" in the region." Israeli officials declined to provide details about such intercepts.

"It's still a work in progress. It's a mechanism that's being built," said a senior Israeli official, who declined to discuss the Sharm El Sheikh talks. "There are definitely partners who see it as too sensitive to talk about."

At least 22 young people die in South African tavern

South African authorities are investigating the deaths of at least 22 young people found inside a popular tavern in the coastal town of East London, provincial health officials and the presidency said yesterday.

State broadcaster SABC reported the deaths resulted from a possible stampede, but was scant on details as the exact cause of death remained unknown.

The bodies will be transported to state mortuaries where relatives are expected to help identify both male and female victims, said Siyanda Manana, a spokesperson for the Eastern Cape provincial health department. "We are going to immediately be embarking on autopsies so we can know the probable cause of death," he told Reuters as forensic personnel continued their work at the cordoned-off crime site at Enyobeni Tavern.

"We are talking 22 bodies right now," Manana said, adding that toxicology tests were part of the examination.

Expressing his condolences to affected families, President Cyril Ramaphosa said he was

worried about the circumstances under which young people, potentially under the age of 18 years, were allowed to gather at the tavern. Ramaphosa said in a statement the law must take its course once investigations conclude.

"The call is on the parents to see that their kids are kept well, the call is on the community to say we can't allow our kids to die," Bheki Cele, the nation-

al police minister, told a large crowd in Scenery Park during an impromptu visit broadcast live on television.

A 17-year-old girl, who only gave her name as "Lolly" and lived close to the tavern, told Reuters the venue was a popular hangout with teenagers, but the community wanted it shut down after the tragedy.

"Everyone wants it closed down because they sell alcohol

to under-age children. Everyone is angry, everyone is sad because of what happened," she said.

Earlier Brigadier Tembinkosi Kinana said police were alerted by members of the public to the incident in Scenery Park, about three kms (1.9 miles) from the city centre.

"What has happened can be equated to a massacre," East London mayor, Xola Pakati said in a statement.

Putin to make first foreign trip since launching Ukraine war

Vladimir Putin will visit two small former Soviet states in central Asia this week, Russian state television reported yesterday, in what would be the Russian leader's first known trip abroad since ordering the invasion of Ukraine.

Russia's Feb. 24 invasion has killed thousands of people, displaced millions more and led to severe financial sanctions from the West, which Putin says are a reason to build stronger trade ties with other powers such as China, India and Iran.

Pavel Zarubin, the Kremlin correspondent of the Rossiya 1 state television station, said Putin would visit Tajikistan and Turkmenistan and then meet Indonesian President Joko Widodo for talks in Moscow.

In Dushanbe, Putin will meet Tajik President Imomali Rakhmon, a close Russian ally and the longest-serving ruler of a former Soviet state.

In Ashgabat, he will attend a summit of Caspian nations including the leaders of Azer-

baijan, Kazakhstan, Iran and Turkmenistan, Zarubin said.

Putin's last known trip outside Russia was a visit to the Beijing in early February, where he and Chinese President Xi Jinping unveiled a "no limits" friendship treaty hours before both attended the opening ceremony of the Olympic Winter Games.

Russia says it sent troops into Ukraine on Feb. 24 to degrade its neighbour's military capabilities, keep it from being used by the West to threaten Russia, root out nationalists and defend Russian-speakers in eastern regions. Ukraine calls the invasion an imperial-style land grab.



"To have four cars like this with no issues: it is clearly the strongest and fastest car. The team did a fantastic job."

Hyundai's Thierry Neuville, fifth in the rally and second in the championship, won the final 'Hell's Gate' Power Stage for five bonus points.

Bagnaia wins Dutch MotoGP after Quartararo crashes out

Game on in the title fight as Francesco Bagnaia wins a wild Dutch GP

Italy's Francesco Bagnaia won the Dutch MotoGP yesterday to reignite his title challenge after championship leader Fabio Quartararo crashed out of an incident-packed race.

Frenchman Quartararo fell twice, flipping spectacularly over his handlebars in the second incident although he walked away afterwards, shaking his fists in anger at his error. Bagnaia, in contrast, stayed out of trouble on his Ducati to record his third victory of the season and a welcome full points score after failing to finish in the last two races.

"I am so happy after two difficult races," the Italian said.

In a great day for Italian riders, Marco Bezzecchi on a Ducati for Valentino Rossi's VR46 team was second while Spanish rider Maverick Vinales rounded out the podium in the 11th race of the 20-season.

Quartararo heads into the summer break with a 21-point lead over Aleix Espargaro, who was fourth yesterday.

The Frenchman fell on the fifth then on the 13th lap out of 26 in front of an enthusiastic crowd in the Netherlands.

Even if he quickly got back on his feet, he had to give up after this second accident.

The Frenchman got off to a bad start and was quickly overtaken by Aprilia rider Espargaro.

It was while he was trying to recover second place, in an attempt on the inside of a bend, that Quartararo lost control of

his Yamaha, ending up in the gravel although he was soon back in the saddle, albeit in last place.

But a few laps later, his race was over after an acrobatic tumble.

Wimbledon doesn't care what looks cool, says Kyrgios on strict dress code

Nick Kyrgios would rather wear all black when competing at Wimbledon instead of adhering to the all-white dress code, with the Australian saying yesterday that the Championships were out of tune with what looks 'cool' on court.

The grasscourt major is famous for its strict dress code and does not even allow players to wear off-white or cream, while the measuring tape comes out to ensure the trim of colour on necklines or sleeves are no wider than a centimetre.

"I always want to wear all black, ob-

viously," Kyrgios said with a smile at a news conference ahead of his first round match with British wildcard Paul Jubb.

"But I don't think it's something that's going to change, I don't know.

"I think it would be cool to allow, like, a black headband or black sweatband. I think it would look cool. Obviously Wimbledon doesn't really care what looks cool... I don't think it will ever change."

But the prestige associated with Wimbledon was still enough to lure Kyrgios to compete despite the lack of ranking points this year due to the ban on Russian and Belarusian players.

The decision essentially reduced Wimbledon to an exhibition event but the major's organisers are also dishing out record prize money to the tune of

40.3 million pounds (\$49.42 million).

Kyrgios, who said he did not agree with the ban as the sport's number one ranked Daniil Medvedev would not be playing, added that he did not pick tournaments based on the ranking points on offer.

"As a kid, when I watched Wimbledon, when I wanted to play it, I wasn't thinking about ranking points. I was thinking about playing in the most prestigious tournament in the world. That's all I'm here for," he said.

"There's people that are (saying) 'I'm not going to play Wimbledon because of ranking points. I'm going to go play a challenger that week'.

Fit-again Murray full of belief ahead of Wimbledon

Andy Murray has shaken off the abdominal injury which threatened his participation at Wimbledon, the former world number one said on Saturday before declaring that there was still a lot of "good tennis" left in him.

Murray, who won the grass-court Grand Slam in 2013 and 2016, sustained the injury during his Stuttgart Open final defeat by Italian Matteo Berrettini earlier this month, after impressive wins over Stefanos Tsitsipas and Nick Kyrgios.

The problem forced Murray, ranked 51st, to skip the Queen's Club event with doubts over his participation at Wimbledon but the Scot said things had improved since.

"It's gone well," Murray, 35, told reporters. "I've been able to gradually progress my training this week and got to play a few sets, a lot of points. The last few days have been good."

Murray secured his first victory over a top-five opponent in six years with a 7-6(4) 6-3 victory over Tsitsipas in Stuttgart, showing fans glimpses of the form that marked his rise to the top of the rankings before multiple hip surgeries.

Sydney.

"I think I showed a couple weeks ago that there was still good tennis left in me," Murray said. "I beat a guy in the top five, I was neck-and-neck with Berrettini, who is one of the best grasscourt players in the world before the injury."

Bale set to join MLS side Los Angeles FC

Wales forward Gareth Bale yesterday appeared to confirm his move to Major League Soccer (MLS) side Los Angeles FC (LAFC) following his departure from LaLiga champions Real Madrid.

The 32-year-old, who signed for Spanish giants Real from Premier League side Tottenham Hotspur in 2013 for a then-record transfer fee of 100 million euros (\$105.54 million), is set to join as a free agent with his contract due to end this summer.

"See you soon, Los Angeles," Bale wrote in a post on Twitter, following reports of the transfer on Saturday. The post, which was retweeted on LAFC's official Twitter account, was accompanied by a video of Bale wearing an LAFC jersey and cap.

Bale enjoyed a trophy-laden spell with Real, winning three LaLiga titles, five Champions League crowns, three Club World Cups and the Spanish Cup, although his time at the club was marred by injuries.

The Welshman will likely be best remembered for scoring twice, including a stunning overhead kick, in the 2018 Champions League final against Liverpool and also netting a superb winner against Barcelona in the 2014 Copa del Rey final.

But he was also often targeted by the Spanish media, who labelled him a "parasite" after he missed Real's 4-0 home loss to Barcelona in March immediately before appearing
