

Children aged 3 to 11 will be eligible to receive two doses of the Sinopharm vaccine, starting today.

The National Medical Task-

force for Combatting the Coronavirus (COVID-19) made the announcement yesterday following approval by the Vaccination Committee.

The taskforce noted that the decision was taken following a thorough review of all medical health and safety recommendations conducted by the Vaccination Committee, adding that the move aims to preserve public health.

Additionally, the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine will soon be approved for children aged 5 to 11 age who will be eligible to receive two doses.

Full details will be announced on the Ministry of Health's website.

The taskforce stressed that it is important that eligible children get vaccinated to protect themselves, their families, and

public health. To register children for the vaccination, please visit the Ministry of Health's website at: healthalert.gov.bh or register through the BeAware application.

The taskforce noted that registration requires the consent of a legal guardian. The children must also have an adult accompanying them when receiving their vaccination.

Speech by H.E. Xi Jinping President of the People's Republic of China at the Conference Marking the 50th Anniversary of the Restoration of the Lawful Seat of the People's Republic of China in the United Nations

Fifty years ago today, the 26th Session of the General Assembly of the United Nations adopted, with an overwhelming majority, Resolution 2758, and the decision was made to restore all rights of the People's Republic of China in the United Nations and to recognize the representatives of the Government of the People's Republic of China as the only legitimate representatives of China to the United Nations. It was a victory for the Chinese people and a victory for people of the world.


Today, on this special date, we are here to review the past history and look to the future, and that makes our gathering all the more significant.

The restoration of New China's lawful seat in the United Nations was a momentous event for the world and the United Nations. It came as the result of joint efforts of all peace-loving countries that stood up for justice in the world. It marked the return of the Chinese people, or one-fourth of the world's population, back to the UN stage. The importance was significant and far-reaching for both China and the wider world.

On this occasion, I wish to express, on behalf of the Chinese government and the Chinese people, heartfelt gratitude to all countries that co-sponsored and supported UN General Assembly Resolution 2758, and to pay high tribute to all countries and people that stand on the side of justice.

The past five decades since New China restored its lawful seat in the United Nations have witnessed China's peaceful development and its commitment and dedication to the welfare of all humanity.

- For these 50 years, the Chinese people have demonstrated an untiring spirit and kept to the right direction of China's development amidst changing circumstances, thus writing an epic chapter in the development of China and humanity. Building on achievements in national construction and development since the founding of New China, the Chinese people have started the new historical era of reform and opening-up, and successfully initiated and developed socialism with Chinese characteristics. We have continued to unleash and develop productivity and raise living standards, and achieved a historic breakthrough of leaping from a country with relatively low productivity to the second largest



economy in the world. Through much hard work, the Chinese people have attained the goal of fully building a moderately prosperous society on the vast land of China, and won the battle against poverty, thus securing a historic success in eradicating absolute poverty. We have now embarked on a new journey toward fully building a modern socialist country and opened up bright prospects for the great rejuvenation of the Chinese nation.

- For these 50 years, the Chinese people have stood in solidarity and cooperation with people around the world and upheld international equity and justice, contributing significantly to world peace and development. The Chinese people are peace-loving people and know well the value of peace and stability. We have unwaveringly followed an independent foreign policy of peace, and resolutely opposed hegemony and power politics. The Chinese people are a strong supporter of other developing countries in their just struggle to safeguard sovereignty, security and development interests. The Chinese people are committed to achieving common development. From the Tazara Railway to the Belt and Road Initiative, we have done what we could to help other developing countries, and have offered the world new opportunities through our own development. During the trying times of the COVID-19 pandemic, China has been active in sharing COVID response experience with the

world, and has sent large quantities of supplies, vaccines and medicines to other countries, and deeply engaged in science-based cooperation on COVID-19 origins tracing, all in a sincere and proactive effort to contribute to humanity's final victory over the pandemic.

- For these 50 years, the Chinese people have upheld the authority and sanctity of the United Nations and practiced multilateralism, and China's cooperation with the United Nations has deepened steadily. China has faithfully fulfilled its responsibility and mission as a permanent member of the UN Security Council, stayed true to the purposes and principles of the UN Charter, and upheld the central role of the United Nations in international affairs. China has stood actively for political settlement of disputes through peaceful means. It has sent over 50,000 peacekeepers to UN peacekeeping operations, and is now the second largest financial contributor to both the United Nations and UN peacekeeping operations. China has been among the first of countries to meet the UN Millennium Development Goals. It has taken the lead in implementing the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, accounting for over 70 percent of global poverty reduction. China has acted by the spirit of the UN Charter and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and earnestly applied the universality of human rights in the Chinese context. It has blazed a path of human rights development that is consistent

with the trend of the times and carries distinct Chinese features, thus making major contribution to human rights progress in China and the international human rights cause.

The trend of the world, vast and mighty, prospers those who follow it and perishes those who go against it. Over the last 50 years, for all the vicissitudes in the international landscape, the world has remained stable as a whole, thanks to the concerted efforts of people of all countries. The world economy has grown rapidly, and innovation in science and technology has kept breaking new ground. A large number of developing countries have grown stronger, over a billion people have walked out of poverty, and a population of several billion are moving toward modernization.

In the world today, changes unseen in a century are accelerating, and the force for peace, development and progress has continued to grow. It falls upon us to follow the prevailing trend of history, and choose cooperation over confrontation, openness over seclusion, and mutual benefit over zero-sum games. We shall be firm in opposing all forms of hegemony and power politics, as well as all forms of unilateralism and protectionism.

- We should vigorously advocate peace, development, equity, justice, democracy and freedom, which are the common values of humanity, and work together to provide the right guiding philosophy for building a better world. Peace and development

are our common cause, equity and justice our common aspiration, and democracy and freedom our common pursuit. The world we live in is diverse and colorful. Diversity makes human civilization what it is, and provides a constant source of vitality and driving force for world development. As a Chinese saying goes, "Without achieving the good of one hundred various schools, the uniqueness of one individual cannot be achieved." No civilization in the world is superior to others; every civilization is special and unique to its own region. Civilizations can achieve harmony only through communication, and can make progress only through harmonization. Whether a country's path of development works is judged, first and foremost, by whether it fits the country's conditions; whether it follows the development trend of the times; whether it brings about economic growth, social advancement, better livelihoods and social stability; whether it has the people's endorsement and support; and whether it contributes to the progressive cause of humanity.

- We should jointly promote the building of a community with a shared future for mankind, and work together to build an open, inclusive, clean and beautiful world that enjoys lasting peace, universal security and common prosperity. The human race is an integral community and Earth is our common homeland. No person or country can thrive in isolation. Humanity should overcome difficulties in solidarity and pursue common development in harmony. We should keep moving toward a community with a shared future for mankind, and jointly create a better future. To build a community with a shared future for mankind is not to replace one system or civilization with another. Instead, it is about countries with different social systems, ideologies, histories, cultures and levels of development coming together for shared interests, shared rights and shared responsibilities in global affairs, and creating the greatest synergy for building a better world.

- We should stay committed to mutual benefit and win-win results, and work together to promote economic and social development for the greater benefit of our people. As ancient Chinese observed, "The essence of governance is livelihood, and the essence of livelihood is adequacy." Development and happy lives are the common aspirations of people in all countries. Development is meaningful only when it is for the people's interest, and can sustain only when it is motivated by the people. Countries should put their people front and center, and strive to realize development with a higher level of quality, efficiency, equity, sustainability and security. It is important to resolve the problem of unbalanced and inadequate development, and make development more balanced, coordinated and inclusive. It is also important to strengthen the people's capacity for development, foster a development environment where everyone takes part and has a share, and create a development paradigm where its outcome benefits every person in every country more directly and fairly. Not long ago, at the 76th Session of the UN General Assembly, I proposed a Global Development Initiative, with the hope that countries

will work together to overcome impacts of COVID-19 on global development, accelerate implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, and build a global community of development with a shared future.

- We should step up cooperation, and work together to address the various challenges and global issues facing humanity. The international community is confronted by regional disputes as well as global issues such as terrorism, climate change, cybersecurity and biosecurity. Only with more inclusive global governance, more effective multilateral mechanisms and more active regional cooperation, can these issues be addressed effectively. Climate change is Nature's alarm bell to humanity. Countries need to take concrete actions to protect Mother Nature. We need to encourage green recovery, green production and green consumption, promote a civilized and healthy way of life, foster harmony between man and Nature, and let a sound ecology and environment be the inexhaustible source of sustainable development.

- We should resolutely uphold the authority and standing of the United Nations, and work together to practice true multilateralism. Building a community with a shared future for mankind requires a strong United Nations and reform and development of the global governance system. Countries should uphold the international system with the United Nations at its core, the international order underpinned by international law and the basic norms of international relations based on the purposes and principles of the UN Charter. International rules can only be made by the 193 UN Member States together, and not decided by individual countries or blocs of countries. International rules should be observed by the 193 UN Member States, and there is no and should be no exception. Countries should respect the United Nations, take good care of the UN family, refrain from exploiting the Organization, still less abandoning it at one's will, and make sure that the United Nations plays an even more positive role in advancing humanity's noble cause of peace and development. China will be happy to work with all countries under the principle of extensive consultation, joint contribution and shared benefits to explore new ideas and new models of cooperation and keep enriching the practice of multilateralism under new circumstances.

A review of the past can light the way forward. Standing at a new historical starting point, China will stay committed to the path of peaceful development and always be a builder of world peace. China will stay committed to the path of reform and opening-up and always be a contributor to global development. China will stay committed to the path of multilateralism and always be a defender of the international order.

As an ancient Chinese poem reads, "Green hills immerse in the same cloud and rain. The same moon lights up towns however far away." Let us join hands, stand on the right side of history and the side of human progress, and work tirelessly for the lasting and peaceful development of the world and for building a community with a shared future for mankind!

tion of its select committees, namely Parliamentary Standing Select Committee on Human Rights, Parliamentary Standing Select Committee on Women and Child, Parliamentary Standing Select Committee to Support the Palestinian People, and Parliamentary Standing Select Committee on Youth and Sport.

The meeting also discussed two proposals, introduced as a matter of urgency, regarding the suspension of the procedures to lay off a number of Bahraini staffers in Gulf Air, particularly pilots, and the disbursement of the frontline bonuses for volunteers, endorsed them and referred them to the government.

Restorative Justice Law guarantees exemplary treatment for children

Attorney-General, Dr Ali bin Fadl Al Buainain, has affirmed the Public Prosecution's intention to implement effectively the Restorative Justice Law for Children and their Protection from Ill-Treatment, which is an exemplary legislation with an enlightened humanitarian dimension in the criminal treatment and protection of children.

This is because it includes procedural and objective provisions that stipulate that no judgment or order shall be issued or actions be taken against children unless they are based on a thorough study of their social and psychological conditions, as well as ensuring that top priority shall always be given to the best interests of the child, he said.

The Attorney-General made the statements while addressing the international workshop

on the "Prospects and Challenges of Effective Application of the Restorative Justice Law for Children", held under his patronage, in cooperation with the Judicial and Legal Studies Institute and the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime, and with the participation of the British and French embassies in Bahrain.

The two-day event was launched yesterday with the participation of more than 200 specialists from different coun-

tries and in the presence of the Minister of Justice, Islamic Affairs and Endowments, Shaikh Khalid bin Ali Al Khalifa, ambassadors and diplomats.

Judges, members of the Public Prosecution and experts and international experts took part in the workshop.

In his opening speech, Dr Al Buainain stressed that the ultimate goal of the Law on Restorative Justice for Children is to give priority to preserving the best interests of the child.

In the QS World University

Rankings for 2022, ASU was ranked 591-600, in addition to being ranked among the top 150 universities under 50 years old

in the world for the year 2021.

It is the only university in Bahrain to have Four Stars in the QS Stars Ratings, and was also ranked among the top 550 universities in the world in the QS Graduate Employability Rankings for the year 2022, in addition to obtaining a 401+ ranking in the Times Higher Education Impact Ranking for Achieving the Sustainable Development Goals, and 37th in the Arab world in the Green Metric Ranking of Green and Environmentally Friendly Universities.

At the local level, the university succeeded in passing the Institutional Review by the Education and Training Quality Authority, where the official report of the authority showed that the university met all the required standards and indicators. Prior to that, the university has also achieved the Institutional Accreditation from the Higher Education Council.

The university also achieved the ISO 9001:2015 certification for its administrative support services and has achieved the ISO 21001:2018 certification for its educational delivery, making

it the first university in Bahrain and the Arab Gulf to achieve this double certification.

In addition, ASU collaborated with the British Higher Education Academy to qualify its faculty members to obtain a fellowship certificate from the Academy.

The latter chose the university to become an accredited training center, and as a result a large number of the university staff members obtained fellowship of the academy.

As for research, the university succeeded in publishing 181 scientific research papers in international refereed scientific journals during the past year.

On this occasion, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, Professor Waheeb Al Khaja, stated that the university's progress in the international rankings of universities confirms the prestigious position it has reached at the local, Arab and international levels, which constitutes an incentive to work even harder in the coming years to deliver excellence and enhance the quality of education it provides.

Bahrain witnesses significant progress in overall gender balance index

Bahrain's overall gender balance index for the years 2019-2020 increased to 69%, up from 65% during the period running from 2017 until 2018.

The gender balance also jumped from 70% to 73% in key national development areas and from 59% to 65% during the same period on the institutional index.

The positive shifts were featured in the National Gender Balance Report (2019-2020), which was compiled by the Supreme Council for Women (SCW).

The National Gender Balance Report relies on two basic dimensions that include several areas and indicators to measure the progress made to bridge the gaps between women and men in national development.

The first dimension takes into account six core areas - economic participation, decision-making, education, health, social stability and civil society.

As for the second dimension it covers indicators that measure

institutional performance in 12 areas - employment, leadership

positions, wages, education and training, the system of professional development and progression, institutional representation, integrating women's needs in the work environment, budgets responsive to women's needs, integrating women's needs in the products and services, studies related to women, participation in national, regional and international awards in the field of equal opportunities and compliance with the requirements of equal opportunities committees.

World stocks buoyant on upbeat earnings

● **Euro STOXX 600 up 0.3%**

Shares made slim gains around the world on Tuesday, with upbeat corporate earnings buoying European shares and outweighing recurring worries about China's property sector.

The broad Euro STOXX 600 (.STOXX) hit its highest in seven weeks, adding 0.5%, with German stocks (.GDAXI) gaining 0.9%.

After a stellar quarter for U.S. and British banks, Switzerland's UBS (UBSG.S) rose over 2% on its highest quarterly profit since 2015, helping the financial services sector (.SXFP) climb about 1%.

Wall Street futures were up 0.3%, with the earnings season reaching its peak and tech heavyweights including Apple Inc (AAPL.O) and Alphabet (GOOGL.O) due to report later.

Still, some analysts voiced caution over the impact of the

COVID-19 pandemic on supply chains.

"Even though this has been a good earnings season in aggregate we are starting to see more companies with supply backlogs, hiring difficulties, and rising input prices that are eating into profits," Deutsche Bank analysts wrote.

The MSCI world equity index (.MIWD000000PUS), which tracks shares in 50 countries, added 0.1%.

Asian stocks had earlier followed Wall Street's record highs overnight, before giving up their gains. Electric car maker Tesla Inc (TSLA.O) had boosted Wall Street after it joined the \$1 trillion market capitalisation club.

MSCI's gauge of Asia-Pacific stocks outside Japan (.MIAPJ000000PUS) was flat after briefly touching its highest in six weeks, following gains throughout October.

Weighing on the market were Chinese property stocks, which extended losses as another developer, Modern Land (1107.HK), defaulted on a payment, adding to worries about the effects of the debt crisis at China Evergrande Group (3333.HK). read more

Hong Kong-listed mainland property firms (.HSMPI) dropped 5% while the mainland CSI 300 Real Estate Index (.CSI000952) fell 2.8%.

China has said it will roll out a pilot real estate tax in some regions, adding to existing concerns about real estate.

The U.S. dollar index held at 93.932 - in between a one-year high of 94.563 hit earlier in the month and a one-month low of 93.483 on Monday.

Brent crude futures fell 0.4% to \$85.68 a barrel, while the U.S. West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude futures edged 0.01% higher to \$83.76 a barrel.

Biden to announce up to \$102 m in funding for US-ASEAN partnership

US President Joe Biden will announce plans to provide up to \$102 million to expand the US strategic partnership with the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) at a virtual summit with the 10-nation bloc on Tuesday, the White House said.

The US funding will go towards health, climate, economic and education programs, a White House factsheet said.

Of the total, \$40 m will go to an initiative to help address the current COVID-19 pandemic and strengthen ASEAN's ability to prevent, detect and respond to future outbreaks of infectious diseases, it said.

A further \$20.5 m will go to help tackle the climate crisis and up to \$20 m to support cooperation on trade and innovation. Another \$17.5 m is earmarked for education projects and \$4 m to promote gender equality and equity, it said.

Biden's participation in the virtual summit will mark the first time in four years that Washington will engage at the top level with a bloc that it sees as key to its strategy of pushing back against China.

ICD – CIBAFI webinar puts focus on cryptocurrencies and Islamic Finance

served individuals and small and medium-sized enterprises. "ICD will continue exploring practical shariah compliance opportunities to enhance its FinTech platform with smart sukuk issuance, asset tokenization, zakat and Sadaqah collection for development purposes" he added.

Dr Abdelilah Belatik, Secretary-General of CIBAFI, said: "We are pleased to collaborate for the second time with ICD to highlight how cryptocurrencies can be embraced and supported for the growth of Islamic finance".

"In the same context, CIBAFI, in support of these advancements, have recently established an Innovation and Technology Working Group (ITWG). This group will conduct various initiatives to strengthen the adop-

tion of financial technologies within the Islamic financial services industry. These initiatives include encouraging innovation and product development activities in line with the industry developments and Shariah objective, among many others".

Two panel sessions

The webinar included two-panel sessions. The first focused on the effects that the emergence of cryptocurrencies has on the financial system and the regulatory interventions by central banks.

The second session highlighted how to embrace cryptocurrencies for the growth of Islamic finance. Rachid Ettaai, a Senior Research Analyst at the General Council for Islamic Banks and Financial Institutions, moderated the sessions.

AIIB to fully align with Paris agreement by mid-2023

● **Currently projects USD50 billion investment for climate finance by 2030**

The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank announced that it will align its operations with the goals of the Paris Agreement by July 1, 2023.

The Bank currently estimates its cumulative climate finance

approvals to be USD50 billion by 2030. This amount would represent a fourfold increase in annual climate finance commitments since AIIB started publicly reporting the number in 2019.

Earlier this year, AIIB announced it would target at least a 50% share of climate finance in actual financing approvals by 2025. Today's announcement marks an important step towards achieving this goal.

"We are at a defining moment in history—one which calls for bold, fast and wide-ranging collective action if we are to limit

global warming and protect our fragile planet," said Jin Liqun, President and Chair of the Board of Directors at AIIB. "Today's announcement reinforces AIIB's long-standing pledge to support climate action in line with the Paris Agreement. We think the way forward needs greater participation by the private sector on all fronts, so that we can collectively deliver on the promise of building an inclusive, equitable and sustainable future."

Speaking at a press conference on the sidelines of the 2021 AIIB Annual Meeting hosted by the

United Arab Emirates, President Jin said enhancing investments in adaptation and resilience for low-income members and fostering emerging technologies to drive action on climate change are key focus areas.

The Paris Alignment commitment will apply to sovereign and nonsovereign projects, including investments made via financial intermediaries.

AIIB is currently testing a rigorous process to ensure projects meet low-carbon and climate-resilient standards consistent with the Paris accord.

The approach draws on the international standards and frameworks currently being developed in collaboration with other multilateral development banks.

An expanded focus on adaptation and resilience will complement the Bank's ambitious target of having climate finance represent 50% of AIIB's financing approvals by 2025. Climate finance accounted for 41% of the Bank's infrastructure portfolio in 2020.

"There is no one-size-fits-all solution. Properly funding adaptation recognizes that this

work may require fundamental shifts in infrastructure and our behavior. Flood walls, improved building standards, resilient infrastructure are all tools we have at our disposal. But access to funds to implement these measures is vital, especially in developing countries," President Jin said.

Annual resilience costs in developing countries alone are estimated to be USD140-300 billion in 2030. Today, resilience finance stands at a mere USD30 billion, according to the United Nations.

◆ Myanmar's ousted leader Aung San Suu Kyi has denied a charge of incitement to cause public alarm, media reported yesterday, in her first court testimony since a February coup plunged the country into chaos and ended a decade of democratic reform. Citing lawyers, BBC Burmese and Myanmar Now reported that Suu Kyi had denied incitement in connection with her party publishing a letter in February calling on international organisations not to cooperate with the junta. Suu Kyi is being held at an undisclosed location and attended Tuesday's hearings at a specially built court in the Southeast Asian country's capital, Naypyidaw.

◆ South Korean former president Roh Tae-woo, a decorated war veteran who played a pivotal but controversial role in the transition to democratic elections from rule by authoritarian leaders, has died, a Seoul hospital confirmed. The 88-year-old died on Tuesday, a Seoul National University Hospital official said, without citing the cause of death. Roh had been in poor health since 2002 when he received surgery for prostate cancer and he was repeatedly hospitalized in recent years.

◆ Egypt's state of emergency will be lifted for the first time in years, President Abdel Fattah el-Sisi said yesterday. Egypt imposed a state of emergency in April 2017 after deadly bombings of churches and has since routinely extended it at three-month intervals, despite an improved security situation. "Egypt has become ... an oasis of security and stability in the region," Sisi wrote in a Facebook post. "Hence it was decided, for the first time in years, to cancel the extension of the state of emergency in all areas of the country."

US to weigh authorizing Pfizer Covid vaccine for younger children

◆ A high-level medical panel of US government advisors will meet Tuesday to decide whether to authorize the Pfizer Covid-19 vaccine for children aged five to 11 years old. If, as is widely expected, the independent experts convened by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) vote in favor, an emergency authorization could follow within weeks.

US President Joe Biden yesterday signed an order imposing new vaccine requirements for most foreign national air travellers and lifting severe travel restrictions on China, India and

much of Europe effective Nov. 8, the White House said.

The extraordinary US travel restrictions were first imposed in early 2020 to address the spread

of COVID-19. The rules bar most non-US citizens who within the last 14 days have been in Britain, the 26 Schengen countries in Europe without border controls, Ire-

land, China, India, South Africa, Iran and Brazil.

Children under 18

The White House confirmed that children under 18 are exempt from the new vaccine requirements as are people with some medical issues. Non-tourist travellers from nearly 50 countries with nationwide vaccination rates of less than 10% will also be eligible for exemption from the rules. Those receiving an exemption will generally need to be vaccinated within 60 days after arriving in the United States.

The Biden administration also detailed requirements airlines must follow to confirm foreign travellers have been vaccinated before boarding US-bound flights.

US envoy says Iran nuclear deal effort is at 'critical phase'

Efforts to revive the 2015 Iran nuclear deal are at a "critical phase" and Tehran's reasons for avoiding talks are wearing thin, a US official said yesterday while raising the possibility of further diplomacy even if the deal cannot be resuscitated.

US Special Envoy for Iran Robert Malley told reporters Washington was increasingly worried Tehran would keep delaying a return to talks, but said it had other tools to keep Iran from developing a nuclear weapon and would use them if need be.

"We're in a critical phase of the efforts to see whether we can revive the JCPOA," Malley said, referring to the deal formally called the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action. "We've had a hiatus of many months and the official reasons given by Iran for why we're in this hiatus are wearing very thin."

While saying that the window for both the United States

and Iran to resume compliance with the agreement would eventually close, Malley said the United States would still be willing to engage in diplomacy with Iran even as it weighed other options to prevent Tehran from getting the bomb.

He also hinted at the economic benefits that might flow from Iran's return to the agreement, under which Tehran took steps to limit its nuclear program in return for relief from US, European Union and UN economic sanctions.

While saying the window for returning to the JCPOA will not be open forever because eventually Iran's nuclear advances will have overtaken it, Malley said Washington would continue to look for diplomatic arrangements with Tehran.

"You can't revive a dead corpse," he said, stressing that the United States had not reached that point yet. "We will continue to pursue diplomacy, even as we pursue other steps if we face a world in which we need to do that."

UK's Queen Elizabeth carries out first duty since hospital stay

Britain's Queen Elizabeth carried out her first official engagement yesterday since spending a night in hospital and being ordered to rest by her doctors.

The 95-year-old queen, the world's oldest and longest-reigning monarch, stayed overnight at London's King Edward VII private hospital last Wednesday after undergoing "preliminary investigations" for an unspecified but not COVID-19 related ailment.

It was Elizabeth's first overnight hospital stay for years, but royal officials said she was in good spirits and she returned to her Windsor Castle home the following day where she got back to carrying out light duties.

On Tuesday, she carried out two virtual audiences to welcome the new ambassadors to Britain from South Korea and Switzerland. Pictures showed the monarch, wearing a yellow dress, smiling and looking her usual self during the engagement.

Roads were blocked, shops were shut, phones were down and mosque loudspeakers blared calls for a general strike in Sudan yesterday, a day after the army seized power in a coup.

At least seven people were killed in unrest triggered by the military takeover, which brought a halt to Sudan's transition to democracy two years after a popular uprising ended decades of authoritarian rule.

Plumes of smoke rose over Khartoum from tyres set ablaze by protesters. Life came to a halt in the capital and in its twin city Omdurman across the Nile, with roads blocked either by soldiers or by protester barricades.

The night appeared to have passed comparatively quietly after Monday's unrest, when protesters took to the streets after soldiers arrested Prime Minister Abdalla Hamdok and other civilians in the cabinet. A health ministry official

Southeast Asian leaders sharply criticised Myanmar's junta as a regional summit opened yesterday without a representative from the country, following its top general's exclusion for ignoring a peace roadmap agreed six months ago. The Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) had said it would accept a non-political figure from Myanmar, but the junta on Monday rejected that, saying it would only agree to its leader or a minister attending.

In an unprecedented snub to the leader of a member state, ASEAN had decided to sideline junta chief Min Aung Hlaing, who led a Feb. 1 coup that spiralled into violence and nationwide

One concern among US officials and airlines is making sure foreign travellers are aware of the new vaccine rules that will take effect in just two weeks as well as unvaccinated Americans who will face stricter testing rules.

No to Sputnik

The US Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)

issued on Monday new contact tracing rules requiring airlines to collect information from international air passengers like phone numbers, email and US addresses and retain it for 30 days.

The CDC said this month it would accept any vaccine authorised for use by US regulators or the World Health Organisation and will accept mixed-dose coronavirus vaccines from travellers.

That list leaves off the Sputnik vaccine that has been used by Latin American countries extensively.

No religious exemptions

The CDC said there are no religious exemptions for international travellers seeking to avoid COVID-19 requirements.

Foreign air travellers will need to provide vaccination documentation from an "official source" and airlines must confirm the last dose was at least two weeks earlier than the travel date.

International air travellers will need to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within three days prior to departure. The White House said unvaccinated Americans and foreign nationals receiving exemptions will need to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test within one day of departing.

The Biden administration plans to issue details later this week of its parallel plans to lift restrictions to land border crossings on Nov. 8 for vaccinated foreign nationals.

"Today, ASEAN did not expel Myanmar from ASEAN's framework. Myanmar abandoned its right," said Cambodian Prime Minister Hun Sen, who will become the group's chairman next year.

"Now we are in the situation of ASEAN minus one. It is not because of ASEAN, but because of Myanmar." Indonesian Foreign Minister Retno

Marsudi said ASEAN had a slot ready for Myanmar, but it chose not to join.

Indonesian President Joko Widodo in his remarks to leaders lamented Myanmar's "unwelcome attitude" towards ASEAN's diplomatic efforts, Retno said. "ASEAN's decision to invite a Myanmar representative on a non-political level was a heavy one, but it had to be done," she said. "The president reminded that it's important for us to honour the principles of non-interference. But on the other hand, we're obligated to uphold other principles ... like democracy, good governance, respect for human rights, and a constitutional government."

Iran says cyberattack behind widespread disruption at gas stations

A cyberattack disrupted the sale of heavily subsidised gasoline in Iran yesterday, state media reported, causing long lines at gas stations across the country.

"The disruption at the refuelling system of gas stations... in the past few hours, was caused by a cyberattack," state broadcaster IRIB said. "Technical experts are fixing the problem and soon the refuelling process...will return

to normal."

The disruptions came ahead of the second anniversary of a November 19 increase in fuel prices which led to widespread street protests in which hundreds were reported to have been killed by security forces.

The oil ministry said only sales with smart cards used for cheaper rationed gasoline were disrupted and clients could still buy fuel at higher rates, the ministry's news agency SHANA reported.

Jerusalem mayor says he won't shun US consulate if it reopens

Jerusalem's mayor dismissed media speculation yesterday that a US consulate for Palestinians in the city would be denied municipal services if the Biden administration reopens it despite Israeli opposition.

The rightist mayor, Moshe Lion, also said Washington's plan to reverse the Trump administration's subsuming of the consulate into the U.S. Embassy that was moved to Jerusalem from Tel Aviv in 2018 did not appear to be close to implementation.

US Secretary of State Antony Blinken this month reiterated the plan to reopen the consulate as part of efforts to rebuild ties with the Palestinians but gave no timeline. read more

Asked on Israel's Army Radio whether the municipali-

ty might consider cutting off water or power to a future consulate, or refusing to collect its rubbish, Lion said: "No way ... There is no such intention."

"Wherever the municipality has to provide services, it will provide services," he said. "One has to provide this by law, and there is no reason not to do so."

The consulate had long been a base for diplomatic outreach to the Palestinians before it was closed by U.S. President Joe Biden's predecessor, Donald Trump.

"I very much hope that the diplomatic officials, the government of Israel, will prevent the establishment of this consulate," Lion said. "I think that is what is happening right now. I don't think we are on very high stand-by for this (consulate) getting built."

Russia puts onus on regional leaders to step up COVID fight

Russia ordered regional leaders yesterday to step up their fight against COVID-19 as the daily death toll hit a record for the sixth time in eight days.

Health Minister Mikhail Murashko said infections were up by more than 10% in the past week and 268,500 people were receiving treatment in hospitals across the country's 85 regions.

Doctors report packed wards and a heavy strain on resources and staff, including junior doctors and medical students who have been brought in to help.

"At the moment the hospital is completely full. It has 540 beds - 490 patients in the department and 50 patients in the intensive care unit," said Roman Mironov, deputy chief physician at a hospital in Volzhskiy, 900 km (550 miles) southeast of Moscow.





The terms of the agreement include developing a cooperative programme to help athletes in the two countries to participate successfully in the Olympic Games, cooperate in developing the organisational structure and administrative effectiveness of the two Olympic Committees, organising mutual visits between athletes and coaches

of the two brotherly countries, and discussing the possibility of cooperation with the Olympic Solidarity Committee in order to provide Olympic grants for the players of the two countries.

The agreement also includes exchanging information on the qualification and development of trainers through specialised programmes such as the International Coaching Training Enrichment Certificate Programme (ICECP), sports medicine programmes, technical and sports administrators programmes, benefiting from the best applications in the field of sports facilities, especially Olympic training centres, and benefiting

Major warm-up for Australian Open tennis cancelled again over virus

A major warm-up tournament for the Australian Open was cancelled on Tuesday, with organisers blaming uncertainty over Covid-19 rules players will face in Melbourne.

It is the second year the Kooyong Classic, normally played in the weeks leading up to the season-opening Grand Slam, has been scrapped because of the coronavirus pandemic.

Kooyong president Adam Cossar said he was disappointed the event could not take place in January 2022 but hopes it will return in 2023.

"With the great deal of uncertainty over recent months about the arrangements that would be in place in January, it has not been possible to make the best plans to deliver the best and safest sporting (event)," he said in a statement.

Toyota Gazoo Racing ready for desert double

Hypercar history will be written when the 2021 FIA World Endurance Championship (WEC) titles are decided in a Bahrain double-header, and four-time Le Mans winner Toyota Gazoo Racing are ready for a duel in the desert.

For the first time in WEC history, races will be held on consecutive weekends at the same venue; on Saturday 30 October the Bapco 6 Hours of Bahrain, followed by the Bapco 8 Hours of Bahrain a week later.

A 100 per cent win-record this season means Toyota Gazoo Racing travels to Bahrain in pole position to retain the World Championship. The team leads Alpine by 51 points, with a total of 65 on offer in the final races, meaning third place in the first Bahrain contest is enough to guarantee a third consecutive title.

There is a three-way fight for the drivers' crown and the identity of the first Hypercar drivers' World Champions will be decided only in the final race of 2021.

Following their emotional first Le Mans victory in August, the #7 GR010 HYBRID crew of Mike Conway, Kamui Kobayas-

hi and José María López head the standings as they attempt to defend the title they won in Bahrain last year.

Sébastien Buemi, Kazuki Nakajima and Brendon Hartley, in the #8 GR010 HYBRID, are only nine points behind having also won two of the four races so far this season. Another two victories would guarantee them the title while the third-placed Alpine drivers are also in the championship challenge, trailing by 30 points.

TOYOTA GAZOO Racing has a very strong record in Bahrain,

having won five times from eight visits to the 15-turn, 5.412km Bahrain International Circuit, including three wins for its legendary TS050 HYBRID LMP1 car.

The new GR010 HYBRID Hypercar will make its Bahrain debut in exactly the same specification as at Le Mans, when the team earned a one-two victory thanks to a strong team effort to overcome fuel pressure problems caused by contamination in the fuel cell. That issue has been addressed prior to Bahrain following extensive technical investigations.

improving the car balance so we are in good shape for both races."

Added Buemi: "I am looking forward to a long stay in Bahrain; it's going to be good. We have been preparing in the simulator for this and we expect a tight fight with the sister car and the Alpine.
