Mauricio Pochettino has "never asked to leave" Paris Saint-Germain despite speculation linking the coach with Manchester United, the French club's sporting director Leonardo said yesterday.

The Brazilian also denied reports that PSG had approached former Real Madrid boss Zinedine Zidane, saying he has had "no contact" with the Frenchman.

British media reports earlier this week suggested that former Tottenham boss Pochettino could be persuaded to leave Paris and join Man United mid-season.

But it has since emerged that German Ralf Rangnick is set to take over at Old Trafford until the end of the season, with his lawyer telling AFP subsidiary SID yesterday that the final points of a deal are being ironed out.
