Recommendations

Paediatric ICU at Salmaniya Medical Complex upgraded

Misconduct screening

New Registrar-General would review patient complaints before they reach police or prosecutors

MP proposal to probe breaches, issue penalties

A proposal to create a Registrar-General for physicians and other health professionals would place a new gatekeeper between patient complaints and the police or Public Prosecution, under a draft amendment to Decree-Law No 7 of 1989 on the practice of human medicine and dentistry.

The draft, submitted by MP Abdulla Al Rumaihi, would add five new articles to the existing law so that most complaints against doctors and health practitioners pass first through a single post – the Registrar-General rather than going straight to law-enforcement bodies.

The text has been put forward for referral to the competent committee for study before it is taken up by Parliament.

Recommendation

Under the proposal, a "Registrar-General for Physicians and Health Professions" would be appointed by Royal Decree on the recommendation of the competent minister.

The Registrar-General would receive complaints lodged against doctors and other health practitioners, arrange for them to be examined by specialised medical committees and decide, in light of those findings, what disciplinary action to take.

The Registrar-General would be able to issue a range of penalties: a caution, a warning, suspension from practice for up to one year or removal of a doctor's or practitioner's name from the professional register. If the facts of a case suggest a criminal offence, the Registrar-General would refer the file to the Public Prosecution.

Another article would limit direct recourse to police stations and the Public Prosecution in

cases linked to medical practice.

Criminal conduct

Except in matters that amount from the outset to purely criminal conduct, no complaint against a doctor or a person treated in the same way under the law would be handled by police or prosecutors unless it had first been submitted to the Registrar-General.



The draft law also provides for a disciplinary committee chaired by the Registrar-General, with a representative of the Health Ministry and a representative of the doctors' union or the health professions as members.

This committee would examine professional breaches and issue disciplinary decisions.

Regulation

The implementing regulation would lay down how complaints are submitted and investigated, and how disciplinary decisions can be challenged.

Safe seas, sustainable shipping

London

His Excellency Dr. Shaikh Abdulla bin Ahmed Al Khalifa, Minister of Transport and Communications, has emphasised that Bahrain views international conventions and treaties as fundamental for building a safe and sustainable maritime sector.

H.E. Dr. Shaikh Abdulla participated in the 34th session of the General Assembly of the International Maritime Organization (IMO) held in the United Kingdom.

In his address to the General Assembly, H.E. Dr. Shaikh Abdulla bin Ahmed affirmed that since Bahrain acceded to the IMO, the Kingdom has remained an active partner, fully committed to the organisation's goals and mission of enhancing global maritime safety and protection.

The Minister explained that the Kingdom implements its international commitments through an advanced legislative and regulatory framework, including the Maritime Law issued in 2022, which contains

provisions that reinforce full compliance with maritime conventions, provide a legal framework to protect lives and property, and ensure the safety of navigation.

Commitment

He also highlighted Bahrain's strong commitment to marine environmental protection, considering the safeguarding of the oceans and seas a humanitarian and ethical duty.

H.E. Dr. Shaikh Abdulla emphasised that the Kingdom

follows a modern legislative system primarily based on the MARPOL Convention and is working to accede to the remaining annexes to support plans for achieving net-zero emissions by 2060.

The minister emphasised that the IMO's theme for this year, "Our Ocean, Our Commitment, Our Opportunity", reflects the environmental and economic significance of the oceans, recognising them as a lifeline and vital resource for millions of people worldwide.

Bahrain steps up drive to protect workers

New York

Bahrain is advancing its efforts to enhance the work environment and combat human trafficking through a government-led, integrated institutional approach.

This was emphasised by His Excellency Nibras Taleb, Chief Executive Officer of the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA), as he participated in the high-level meeting of the General Assembly on the Appraisal of the United Nations Global Plan of Action to Combat Trafficking in Persons.

Also Chairperson of the National Committee to Combat Trafficking in Persons, Taleb highlighted the Kingdom's commitment to combating human trafficking and its support for the 2025 Political Declaration on the implementation of the UN Global Plan of Action to Combat Trafficking in Persons.

Institutional approach

He emphasised Bahrain's continued institutional approach to strengthening the protection of rights, establishing a comprehensive framework that contributes to crime prevention and addresses all forms of trafficking, while supporting global efforts to enhance labour systems in line with the specificities and obligations of each country.

The LMRA CEO noted that promoting human rights and combating trafficking are central to the Kingdom's long-standing approach, rooted in a civilisational and ethical legacy, and form part of its commitment to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

This approach positions Bahrain as a model for protecting rights, with a comprehen-

sive system based on prevention, protection, justice, and partnership, institutionalising measures and integrating them into national policies and plans to ensure sustainability.

Initiatives

Taleb highlighted several initiatives supporting the improvement of the work environment, including the establishment of the Migrant Workers Protection Centre, the first specialised comprehensive centre in the region providing preventive, advisory, and legal services, receiving complaints and grievances, investigating potential indicators of human trafficking, offering shelter to victims and potential victims, and operating a 24-hour call centre.

Business hours

Southern councillors approve fixed late-night trading times to protect neighbourhood peace

● Southern Council caps shop hours at 5am-midnight

Councillors in Southern Governorate have agreed fixed opening hours for shops and workshops across the area, after an extraordinary session that brought together municipal, labour, police, health and trade representatives.

Meeting yesterday, the Southern Municipal Council unanimously agreed to regulate trading times for commercial outlets within the governorate.

The decision covers commercial and service premises in, and near, residential neighbourhoods and is framed as a way to organise trading hours and protect residents' peace and quiet.

In its report, the technical committee said: "Our aim is to preserve calm in residential areas, ease traffic on local streets and raise standards of public cleanliness, while reducing security and social problems linked to late-night trading."

Under the move, restaurants, cafes, boutiques and other shops in or near housing areas will be allowed to open from 5am until midnight. Garages, workshops, scrap yards and all other service outlets in residential districts will be limited to working hours from 7am to 7pm.

Debate then shifted to enforcement and the way licences are granted.

Criticism

Second Constituency repre-

sentative Mubarak Faraj criticised the decision to licence a shop selling electronic cigarettes at a petrol station in the Southern Governorate after it applied to operate round the clock.

He said the technical committee, which he chaired at the time, had already studied and rejected the request on the grounds that there was no need for a 24-hour outlet.

"Licensing a 24-hour vape shop at a petrol station is unnecessary and carries serious risks," Faraj said.

Council chairman Abdullah AbdulLatif told the meeting that a number of outlets properly licensed to trade around the clock complain about the fees that come with those permits, while some non-compliant shops open 24 hours a day without paying anything.

Checks

He called for closer checks on such breaches and for clear display of permits at premises that are allowed to trade through the night, so that inspectors can more easily spot shops which are breaking the rules.

The Councillor said follow-up work on these cases was once handled by the municipality alone, then moved to the Interior Ministry and is now shared between both sides.

Council member Hamad Al Zaabi drew attention to a sharia-based legal opinion, written into the law, which states that decisions to close commercial outlets fall to the municipal council, while the municipality carries out those decisions.

"The law makes clear that closing commercial outlets is the council's responsibility,

while the municipality carries out enforcement," Al Zaabi said, adding that the municipality is able to tell whether a shop trading 24 hours a day is in breach or not.

Support

Al Zaabi urged colleagues to support the technical committee's proposal for small and medium-sized shops to trade for 18 hours a day, from 5am until midnight, and to convert that proposal into a formal decision to be sent to the relevant authorities for action.

He noted that the same system is already in force in the Northern Governorate and called for it to be applied in the Southern Governorate as well, in co-operation with the Interior Ministry and other concerned bodies.

The Councillor also said the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) should carry out inspections and check the validity of work permits, pointing to its link with the municipality on issues such as residency breaches, and he praised staff in the municipal inspection section and officers from the Interior Ministry.

Lawmaker seeks 'urgent' Malkiya land takeover for northern housing project

Expropriating land south of Malkiya Housing to build a new estate has been proposed in an effort to ease long-standing housing pressure on families in the Northern Governorate.

The move comes in a proposal tabled by MP Hanan Fardan, who is calling for the state to take over the plot and use it for a new, integrated housing scheme serving residents of Malkiya and nearby areas.

The project is intended to absorb the large backlog of housing applications that local families have been living with for many years.

Position

MP Fardan said the site's position gives the authorities a valuable chance to launch a project capable of bringing a clear change to the housing file in the Northern Governorate.

She added that the

estate is planned to support family and social stability by allowing households to stay within their usual surroundings instead of being moved away from their communities.

According to the MP, the proposal also aims to ensure fairness in how housing schemes are spread across districts, so that projects match the real needs of each area.

Urban growth

She said it would back national plans for balanced urban growth that aim to improve quality of life.

MP Fardan described the proposal as part of parliamentary responsibility towards housing matters and a continuation of efforts to support the sector with practical steps that respond to citizens' needs.

The lawmaker stressed that decent housing is a basic pillar of social stability and said a project of this type would represent a responsible response to residents' demands and hopes.

Reliance JV to invest \$11 billion in AI centre in Indian state

A joint venture between India's Reliance Industries and Canadian and US companies will invest \$11 billion to develop an artificial intelligence data centre in south-eastern India, the state government said yesterday.

The five-year investment is for a one-gigawatt AI data centre in Visakhapatnam in the state of Andhra Pradesh.

Google said last month it will spend \$15 billion over the same period on a giant data centre and AI base in the same city, its biggest outside the United States.

The Digital Connexion joint venture is between retail-to-refining giant Reliance, Canadian multinational Brookfield and US real estate investment firm Digital Realty.

The investment will drive "jobs, innovation and global tech investment", Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu said in a post on social media platform X.

"This landmark project underscores Andhra Pradesh's emergence as a leading destination for advanced digital infrastructure and next-gener-

ation computing capabilities," the state government said in a statement.

Demand for AI tools and solutions is surging in India, which is projected to have more than 900 million internet users by year's end.

Data centres are also an area of phenomenal global growth, fuelled by the need to store massive amounts of digital data and to train and run energy-intensive AI tools.

Leading US AI firms seeking to court users in the world's fifth-largest economy have made a flurry of announcements recently about expanding into India.

US startup Anthropic said in October it plans to open an office in India next year, with its chief executive Dario Amodei meeting Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

OpenAI has said it will open an Indian office this year, with its chief Sam Altman noting that ChatGPT usage in the country had grown fourfold over the past year.

AI firm Perplexity also announced a major partnership in July with Indian telecom giant Airtel, offering the company's 360 million customers a free one-year Perplexity Pro subscription.

UK unveils tax-raising budget as growth downgraded

The tax hikes will raise nearly \$40 bn in 2030-31 and £26 bn in previous fiscal year

Britain's centre-left Labour government unveiled a tax-raising budget yesterday to curb debt and fund public services -- and said the country would grow less than expected over the coming years.

Ahead of the budget, Prime Minister Keir Starmer vowed to reduce National Health Service waiting times and ease a prolonged cost-of-living crisis, hoping to strengthen Labour's appeal as hard-right Reform UK gains momentum in the polls. Finance minister Rachel

Reeves, who raised taxes on businesses in her inaugural budget last year, returned on

Wednesday with fresh hikes, this time hitting workers.

The budget measures will raise tens of billions of pounds, culminating in an extra £30 billion (\$40 billion) from taxes in 2030-2031, official figures showed.

Driving the hike will be a freeze to income-tax thresholds, which drags more workers into higher tax brackets and breaks pledges made in Labour's budget last year, shortly after winning a general election.

'My choices'

"These are my choices, not austerity, not borrowing, not turning a blind eye to unfair-

ness," Reeves, whose official title is chancellor of the exchequer, told parliament Wednesday.

"My choices are a budget for fair taxes, strong public services, and a stable economy," she said, as Britain faces a £20-billion gap in public finances.

Higher levies for online gambling, a tax on luxury properties, and a mileage-based charge on electric cars were unveiled, along with a cap on pension benefits. Most measures outlined in the budget, however, will not come into effect until 2028, near the end of the current parliament.

Reeves unveiled billions of pounds in spending measures including an end to the two-child benefit cap and above-inflation rises to the minimum wage and pensions.

Some sweeteners in her budget included freezes on rail fares and prescription charges, and cuts to energy bills.

Britain's economy is on target to beat growth forecasts this year, but its likely to slow more than previously expected between 2026 and 2029, the Office for Budget Responsibility (OBR) said in a report mistakenly released shortly ahead of Reeves's speech.

Britain already faces a deficit near five percent of gross domestic product (GDP), elevated inflation and climbing unemployment.

Richard Branson 'heartbroken' as his wife dies aged 80

London, United Kingdom

British entrepreneur Richard Branson paid tribute Wednesday to his wife Joan Templeman shortly after announcing her death, saying "life will never be the same without her".

The founder of the Virgin Group had revealed Templeman's death, aged 80, in an Instagram post late Tuesday, saying he was "heartbroken".

He did not say what had caused her passing, but noted in a subsequent blog post that she had recently been recovering from a back injury in hospital in England.

Eulogising their decades-long relationship, Branson said they had enjoyed "fifty incredible years of memories".

"Years filled with tears and laughter, kindness, and a love that shaped our family more than words could ever capture," he added in the message, shared on his Virgin Group's website.

"It was a relationship that worked. We just had lots of laughs. We were very lucky."

Branson said the family -- which includes their two adult children, Holly and Sam, and several grandchildren -- were "devastated" at the loss.

The couple first met in London in 1976, with the tycoon

previously saying he had fallen in love with Templeman at first sight.

They married 13 years later, on the private Necker Island in the Caribbean, which Branson had bought in the late 1970s for \$180,000 and where they have lived for decades.

Templeman avidly avoided the public spotlight, with Branson describing her as a "down-to-earth Scottish lady" and "very private person" who almost never gave interviews.

In his post Wednesday, he said she "lived so fully and joyfully, always thinking of others, always lifting everyone else up".



News in brief

◆ **Defence Minister Israel**

Katz yesterday warned there would be "no calm" in Lebanon if Israel's security was not guaranteed, as Israeli forces intensify operations despite a year-old ceasefire with Hezbollah. "We will not allow any threats against the inhabitants of the north, and maximum enforcement will continue and even intensify," Katz told the Israeli parliament. He cited as proof the "elimination" of a top Hezbollah military chief in an Israeli strike on southern Beirut days earlier. "There will be no calm in Beirut, nor order and stability in Lebanon, until the security of the State of Israel is guaranteed," he said, vowing to disarm Hezbollah. An Israeli strike on Beirut's southern suburbs on Sunday killed Haytham Ali Tabatabai -- the most senior Hezbollah commander to be killed by Israel since a November 2024 ceasefire sought to end over a year of hostilities between the two sides.

◆ **Iran bans access to most forests after fire in UNESCO-listed site**

Iranian authorities have imposed a temporary ban on public access to most forested areas, a local media outlet reported yesterday, as the country struggled to extinguish a fire in a UNESCO World Heritage-listed site. The fire in northern Iran's Hyrcanian forests, which started on November 1, was brought under control in a few days. However, it reignited on November 15, fuelled by strong winds and an unusually severe drought, according to Iranian media. "We have notified the provinces to ban entry into forest areas outside protected zones and parks before the autumn rains occur in order to prevent similar incidents from occurring," Majid Zakariaei, commander of the unit responsible for forest protection, told the Mehr news agency.

◆ **Lebanon and Cyprus** yesterday signed a new maritime border agreement to demarcate the countries' exclusive economic zones, the latest high-seas deal aiming to open up commerce in the eastern Mediterranean.

The agreement comes nearly two decades after the countries hammered out a deal to delineate their respective exclusive economic zones. The deal, however, was never ratified by the Lebanese parliament due to an unresolved dispute with Israel. In 2022, Lebanon signed a maritime boundary deal with Israel, allowing the country to move forward with maritime border talks with Cyprus. "We are here to celebrate the achievement of demarcating the exclusive economic zones between our two countries," Lebanese President Joseph Aoun said after the signing of the agreement alongside his Cypriot counterpart Nikos Christodoulides.

Humanoid robots to trial guiding crowds at Chinese border crossings

Humanoid robots could guide travellers and manage crowds at some Chinese border crossings after Shenzhen-based UBTECH Robotics said it had won a multimillion-dollar contract to supply its latest models for a trial project.

The company said Tuesday it had struck the \$37-million deal with a humanoid robotics testing centre based near China's border with Vietnam.

The project will use mainly the latest version of UBTECH's "Walker" robots to test practical humanoid applications such as helping border management, handling logistics or patrolling factories.

UBTECH said it would start delivering the robots, which can swap their own batteries, to the centre in December.

It did not say whether they would be powered by artificial intelligence or operated remotely.

China's government has encouraged domestic firms to develop humanoid robots in the hopes of leading the global robotics industry.

An April report published by Leaderobot, a specialist consulting firm, predicted that China's humanoid robotics industry would reach 82 billion yuan (\$11.6 billion) in 2025 -- accounting for half of global sales.

This month, a robot made by Shanghai's AgiBot set a Guinness World Record for the longest reported distance ever walked by a humanoid machine, having completed a three-day, 100-kilometre trek.

Beijing hosted the world's first-ever humanoid robot games in August, where more than 500 "athletes" vied in disciplines ranging from basketball to competitive cleaning.

Large-scale real-life use cases remain elusive though.

Goldman Sachs warned recently that the sector risks overcapacity as production scales up rapidly without actual orders.

UBTECH said Tuesday its Walker series has generated 1.1 billion yuan in sales so far this year.

"The orders we have received far exceed the announced number," UBTECH executive Tan Min told local media this month, addressing the overcapacity concerns.

Russia welcomes 'aspects' of new US plan to end Ukraine war

Russia has seen the latest copy of a draft US plan to end the Ukraine war and views some of it positively, but wants a discussion about the other parts, the Kremlin said yesterday.

In comments to a Russian state TV reporter, Kremlin aide Yuri Ushakov said the new draft required "truly serious analysis" and that Russia had not yet discussed it with anyone.

The plan has not yet been published. US President Donald Trump said Tuesday that it was a "fine-tuned" version of an earlier 28-point plan that Kyiv and Europe had rejected, and that he was sending officials to meet with both sides in the hopes of finalising it.

Ushakov said of the plan on Wednesday: "Some aspects can be viewed positively, but many require special discussions among experts."

The original plan, widely criticised in Europe as heeding Moscow's demands, would have seen Ukraine withdraw from its eastern Donetsk region and the US de facto recognise the Donetsk, Crimea and Lugansk regions as Russian.

Ukraine said later it had reached an "understanding" with the US and that the two sides had pared back some of the points Kyiv disagreed with following talks in

Geneva.

It is not clear which points were removed and which remain, and deep differences remain in Russia and Ukraine's negotiating positions.

Kyiv and its European allies say the war, the largest and deadliest on European soil since World War II, is an unprovoked and illegal land grab that has resulted in a tidal wave of violence and destruction.

Tens of thousands of civilians and military personnel have been killed since the war began, while millions of Ukrainians have been forced to leave their homes.

Key sticking points

US special envoy Steve Witkoff will meet Russian President Vladimir Putin in Moscow next week in a bid to finalise the US administration's plan, while US army secretary Dan Driscoll will meet the Ukrainian side, Trump said.

Ushakov, a senior Russian diplomat and aide to Putin, said

Wednesday that Russia needed "serious discussions" on the document.

"The peace plan hasn't been discussed in detail with anyone yet," he told a state TV reporter.

US officials were upbeat Tuesday about the drive to end the war, even as they acknowledged key sticking points remained over the plan.

But Ukraine's European allies, which regarded the original 28-point plan as a Kremlin wish list, have cautioned against conceding too much to Moscow.

They drafted their own counter-proposal to the original plan, which Russia immediately smacked down.

EU Commission Chief Ursula von der Leyen said Wednesday that days of negotiations to refine the US plan had begun to lay the groundwork for a possible settlement.

But she warned Russia showed no sign of really wanting to stop the fighting.

"I want to be clear from the

very outset: Europe will stand with Ukraine and support Ukraine every step of the way," she told EU lawmakers.

As diplomatic efforts to end the war rumbled on, Ukraine reported another night of air attacks. A Russian drone attack on the southern Ukrainian region of Zaporizhzhia overnight left more than a dozen wounded and damaged tens of homes, governor Ivan Fedorov said.

Trump rages at report that he is increasingly frail

US President Donald Trump raged yesterday at a New York Times report that focused on his age and growing signs of fatigue, insisting that he is full of energy and calling the woman author of the article "ugly."

"I have never worked so hard in my life. Yet despite all of this the Radical Left Lunatics in the soon to fold New York Times did a hit piece on me that I am perhaps losing my Energy, despite facts that show the exact opposite," the 79-year-old Republican posted on his Truth Social platform.

Trump is the oldest person ever to have assumed the US presidency and the job has clearly weighed on him since starting a second term in January.

But in the lengthy post, sprinkled with words in all-caps and a misspelling, Trump said the Times article published Tuesday was ignoring his output.

He listed what he said were his many accomplishments, ranging from the election victory last year to a strong US stock market and the settling of wars abroad.

He also boasted that he recently underwent a "PERFECT PHYSICAL EXAM AND A COMPREHENSIVE COGNITIVE TEST ('That was aced') JUST RECENTLY TAKEN."

Trump does remain an omnipresent figure in the media, frequently fielding questions from journalists for marathon sessions -- in sharp contrast to his predecessor Joe Biden, who left office at 81.

But while the White House public relations machine continues to portray Trump as improbably virile -- creating AI-generated pictures of him as muscle-bound superheroes and warriors -- the Republican is visibly slowing down.

The report in the influential Times noted that Trump has sharply reduced his public events and domestic travel, compared to his first term, and generally runs a public schedule between the hours of noon and 5:00 pm.

During one televised event in the Oval Office earlier this month, Trump appeared to fall asleep briefly.

There are unanswered questions about Trump's health, notably why he had an MRI scan in October and what it showed.

Photographs of his swollen ankles and a large bruise on his right hand have also triggered speculation.

Trump called the Times "truly an 'ENEMY OF THE PEOPLE.'"

And he branded the female reporter who wrote the Times report "ugly, both inside and out." Earlier this month, he called another woman journalist "piggy" and yet another "a terrible person."

The Times responded to Trump's post with a statement saying its "reporting is accurate and built on first hand reporting of the facts."

"Name-calling and personal insults don't change that, nor will our journalists hesitate to cover this administration in the face of intimidation tactics like this."

Bangladesh seize 10kgs gold from Hasina's lockers

Lockers were seized in September

● The haul included gold coins, bars and jewellery

● Hasina failed to deposit some of the gifts at the state treasury

Anti-corruption authorities in Bangladesh have seized about 10 kilograms (22 pounds) of gold worth about \$1.3 million from bank lockers belonging to ousted prime minister Sheikh Hasina, officials said yesterday.

Officials from the Central Intelligence Cell (CIC) of the National Board of Revenue said the discovery was made after opening lockers that had been seized in September.

"Following a court order, we opened the lockers and found about 9.7 kilograms of gold belonging to the former prime minister," a senior CIC official

told AFP, requesting anonymity. The haul included gold coins, bars and jewellery.

Investigators said Hasina had failed to deposit some of the gifts she received while in office at the state treasury, known as "Toshakhana", as required by law.

The National Board of Revenue is also probing alleged tax evasion and examining whether Hasina declared the recovered gold in her tax filings.

Bangladesh has been in political turmoil since the end of Hasina's rule, and violence has marred campaigning for elections expected in February 2026.

Earlier this month, the International Crimes Tribunal sentenced Hasina to death

over a deadly crackdown against a student-led uprising.

The United Nations says up to 1,400 people were killed in the crackdown as Hasina tried to cling to power.

Israel returns 15 bodies to Gaza after hostage remains identified

The health ministry in Hamas-run Gaza said Israel returned the bodies of 15 Palestinian prisoners yesterday as part of the exchange deal under the US-brokered ceasefire.

It came after Israel announced that a body handed over by Gaza militants on Tuesday was that of Dror Or, one of the last three deceased hostages held in the Palestinian territory.

Under the ceasefire deal, which came into effect on October 10, Israel is required to hand over the bodies of 15 Palestinians for every deceased Israeli returned.

"The Ministry of Health announces the receipt of 15 bodies of martyrs released today by the Israeli occupation via the International Committee of the Red Cross, bringing the total number of bodies received to 345," the Gaza ministry said in a statement.

The ICRC facilitates the transfers in its role as a neutral intermediary.

Hamas spokesman Hazem Qassem said in a statement that the handover "reflects Hamas's

steadfast commitment to fully complete the exchange process and its ongoing efforts to finalise it despite significant difficulties".

AFP witnessed the 15 bodies, in white body bags, being carried inside the morgue at Gaza's Nasser Hospital in the southern city of Khan Yunis.

Mahmud Ashour, spokesman for the forensic evidence department in Hamas-run Gaza, told AFP that of the 345 bodies

received via the ICRC, 99 have now been identified.

"We always receive these bodies in a state of decomposition and with facial features missing," he said.

"We also see signs of injuries on the bodies, and we do not know the true circumstances" that led to their deaths, he added.

"The families face extreme difficulty in identifying the bodies."

US to slap big surcharge on foreign visitors to national parks

Foreign tourists visiting US national parks including the Grand Canyon and Yellowstone will now pay a hefty surcharge, the Trump administration announced Tuesday.

The Department of the Interior, which operates the renowned US national parks, said that starting in 2026 visitors from abroad will have to pay \$100 on top of the individual park fee to enter 11 of the most popular destinations in the system.

The cost of an annual pass to all the parks will meanwhile more than triple to \$250 for non-residents.

"President Trump's leadership always puts American families first," said Secretary of the Interior Doug Burgum in a statement.

Safran hopes annual India revenue to triple by 2030

French aerospace group Safran said yesterday it will triple its annual revenue in India to \$3.5 billion by 2030 as it invests in one of the world's fastest-growing aviation markets.

Half of that revenue will be generated by facilities in India, Safran CEO Olivier Andries said, with the group building what it bills as the world's largest maintenance centre for LEAP engines, used in most single-aisle planes.

"The opening of this site illustrates the importance of India for our group," Andries said.

"We are proud to support the rapid growth of the civil and military aviation markets in the country as well as the strategic autonomy of the country," he added.

India's Civil Aviation Minister Kinjarapu Rammohan Naidu said the prospects in the world's fifth-largest economy were immense for foreign players.

"Over the past 11 years, India's aviation ecosystem has

made a decisive leap, doubling the number of airports, aircraft, and passengers," Naidu said.

LEAP engines are used in all Boeing 737 MAX and about 60 percent of Airbus A320neo -- the best-selling models of the two aircraft manufacturers -- as well as Chin's COMAC C919 aircraft.

The Hyderabad centre, due to begin operations early next year, cost \$234 million to build and will have the capacity to maintain and repair 300 LEAP engines a year.

Spanning 45,000 square metres (484,000 square feet), it will initially employ more than 250 people and up to 1,100 in the long term.

Until now, Indian airlines have serviced their single-aisle aircraft engines abroad.

"By 2030, up to 90 percent of the maintenance of LEAP engines for Indian airlines will be carried out in this workshop," said Naidu, referring to the Hyderabad centre.

"This will significantly reduce dependence on foreign centres, costs, and turnaround times," he said.

Brazil's Bolsonaro begins 27-year jail term for coup bid

Brazil's Supreme Court on Tuesday ordered far-right former president Jair Bolsonaro to begin serving a 27-year sentence for plotting a failed coup, after he exhausted all appeals.

The brash former army captain who fired up Brazil's right and reshaped the country's politics is ending a divisive career jailed in a small room at police headquarters equipped with a TV, mini-fridge, and air-conditioning.

Bolsonaro, 70, was convicted in September over a scheme to stop Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva from taking office as president after the 2022 elections that included a plot to kill the veteran leftist.

Prosecutors said the scheme failed only due to a lack of support from military top brass.

The Supreme

Court rejected an appeal to his sentence earlier this month, and on Tuesday ruled the judgment was now final.

The court also ordered a military tribunal to decide whether Bolsonaro should be stripped of his captain's rank.

Bolsonaro had been under house arrest until Saturday, when he was detained at police headquarters in the capital Brasilia for tampering with his ankle monitor using a soldering iron.

Supreme Court Justice Alexandre de Moraes said there were signs Bolsonaro was planning to flee during a planned vigil organized by his son outside his home.

The justice pointed to the location of the nearby US embassy, and Bolsonaro's close relationship with US President Donald Trump, suggesting he may have tried to escape to seek political asylum.

The terms of the purchase were not disclosed due to confidentiality agreements with the previous owner, US-based Sport 10, but Brazilian media reports said the deal was worth

Hong Kong housing estate fire kills at least 13, still burning

A huge fire engulfed a Hong Kong residential estate and killed at least 13 people on Wednesday, with firefighters saying they were blocked from reaching some of the people seeking help.

The fire, which started in the afternoon and was still burning late into the night, was the deadliest in decades in Hong Kong, which has some of the world's most densely populated and tallest apartment blocks.

Massive flames first took hold on bamboo scaffolding on several apartment blocks of Wang Fuk Court, which contains nearly 2,000 flats in eight towers and was reportedly undergoing estate-wide maintenance.

An AFP reporter heard loud cracking sounds, possibly from the burning bamboo, and saw thick plumes of smoke billowing from the buildings as flames and ash reached high into the sky.

A 65-year-old resident surnamed Yuen said he had lived in the estate for more than four decades and that many of his neighbours were elderly and might not be mobile.

"The windows were closed because of the maintenance, (some people) didn't know

there was a fire and had to be told to evacuate via phone calls by neighbours," Yuen told AFP.

"I'm devastated, there is loss of property and loss of life, and even a firefighter has died."

Nine people died at the scene and four more, including a 37-year-old firefighter, were certified dead at hospital, the government said late on Wednesday.

A police officer at a temporary shelter told AFP it was unclear how many people were unaccounted for because residents were still trickling in late into the night to report missing family members.

Sections of charred scaffolding fell from the burning blocks and flames could be seen inside apartments, sometimes belching out through windows into the night sky, casting an eerie orange glow on surrounding buildings.

"The temperature at the scene is very high and there are some floors where we have been unable to reach people who requested help, but we will keep trying," said Derek Armstrong Chan, the deputy director of fire service operations.

He said the fire likely spread from one building to another due to the wind and drifting debris, although he added authorities are investigating the cause of the blaze.

China likely to bid on building new Panama Canal ports

China is among parties interested in bidding to build two new ports on the Panama Canal, its administrator said Tuesday, despite US talk of retaking control of the vital trade route.

US President Donald Trump made the threat earlier this year, alleging that China controls the strategic waterway because Hong Kong-based CK Hutchison Holdings operates existing ports at either end -- Cristobal on the Atlantic, and Balboa on the Pacific.

The firm agreed in March to transfer control of both ports

to a conglomerate led by US-based BlackRock, but the deal -- viewed with suspicion by China -- has not been finalized.

The Central American country is hoping to attract \$8.5 billion in investment over the next decade to expand port capacity,

and to build a gas pipeline and a new reservoir, among other projects.

In addition to new ports, the project envisions the construction of a gas pipeline and a new reservoir.

"We have to be open to participation of all interested parties," and solicit "the broadest possible competition," canal administrator Ricaurte Vasquez told journalists. He said all parties would bid on an equal footing.

He declined to speculate about a possible increase in tensions with the United States if the projects were awarded to Chinese firms in the future.

The Panama Canal Authority, which has begun meeting with interested parties ahead of the bidding process, plans to award contracts for the two terminals in late 2026 and begin operations in 2029.

Hong Kong's Cosco Shipping Ports and Orient Overseas Container Line (OOCL) are among international players that have

expressed interest -- along with Singapore's PSA International, Taiwan's Evergreen, German Hapag-Lloyd, Denmark's Maersk and France's CMA Terminals.

Panama's five main ports are all located near the canal and are operated by concessionaires from the United States, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Singapore.



The 80-kilometer canal is used mainly by the United States and China and carries five percent of the world's maritime trade. The United States built and operated the Panama Canal for a century before handing control to Panama on the last day of 1999.



South Africa condemn India to biggest Test loss for series sweep

408-run victory gives South Africa their first series win in India in 25 years

- Simon Harmer takes six wickets
- India's biggest Test defeat by runs
- First series win in India since 2000

Spinner Simon Harmer took six wickets as South Africa thrashed India by 408 runs in the second Test on Wednesday to condemn the hosts to a record loss and sweep the series.

It was South Africa's first series win in India in 25 years, after bowling the home team out for a dismal 140 in an unlikely chase of 549 on day five in Guwahati.

India suffered their biggest Test defeat by runs and a fifth loss in seven home matches, having been whitewashed 3-0 by New Zealand little more than a year ago.

Off-spinner Harmer, 36, returned figures of 6-37 as world champions South Africa clinched a Test series in India for only the second time, the first in 2000 under Hansie Cronje.

"Winning a Test match and series in India is very special," said left-arm quick Marco Jansen, who took 6-48 in India's first-innings 201 after smashing a quickfire 93 with the bat as the visitors piled up 489.

India lost the opening Test in Kolkata inside three days on a pitch with uneven bounce and South Africa once again beat the hosts at their own game of spin on a batting-friendly track.

India coach Gautam Gambhir, under fierce pressure following the latest home whitewash, refused to point the finger of

blame squarely at his players.

"It lies with everyone in that dressing room and starts with me," he told journalists.

"I have said it before as well -- that we win together, we lose together."

Asked if he was the right man to lead India, he referred reporters to the Indian cricket board.

"I've said it during my first press conference when I took over as the head coach," said the former batsman.

"Indian cricket is important, I'm not important."

India fold

A confident South Africa led by Temba Bavuma were always in control.

All-rounder Senuran Muthusamy scored 109, his maiden Test century, before Jansen's blast after electing to bat.

The hosts were bundled out for 201 in reply to concede a first-innings lead of 288 but

threatened to get close.

"Whether you're playing at home or away, cricket demands that determination and the extra effort," said India captain Rishabh Pant.

"As a batting unit you need to capitalise on certain moments. As a team we didn't do that."

Starting day five at 27-2 as they attempted to avoid defeat, India rode their luck early when Jansen had Sai Sudharsan caught behind for four, but the delivery was declared a no-ball after the bowler overstepped.

In the next over Kuldeep Yadav survived a reprieve on four when Aiden Markram dropped him at first slip off Harmer.

The relief was short-lived for India as a relentless Harmer bowled Kuldeep for five for the first wicket of the day.

Three balls later the spinner dismissed Dhruv Jurel for two and soon sent back Pant for 13 as India slumped to 58-5.

Gulf Kings on course for Arab supremacy

Bahrain Punch Ticket to Arab Cup with Win Over Djibouti

The Bahrainis secured their place in the FIFA Arab Cup 2025 with a 1-0 win over Djibouti in yesterday's one-off qualifier at Doha's Jassim Bin Hamad Stadium. The Gulf champions took the lead in the 36th minute through Mohammed AlRomaihi, and a first-half red card for Djibouti's Ahmed Zakaria left the visitors with ten men, making Bahrain's path to victory clearer.

The result ensures Bahrain will compete in the group stage of the Arab Cup, which will also be held in Doha, Qatar, from December 1 to 18. Fans had turned out in force, urging their team to secure qualification after a year of mixed fortunes. The Bahrainis have twice finished as runners-up in the Arab Cup,

in 1985 in Ta'if, Saudi Arabia, and in 2002 in Kuwait, and will now aim to improve on those achievements.

The match began slowly, with few clear chances in the first half. AlRomaihi opened the scoring in the 36th minute after Djibouti goalkeeper Mouktae Youssouf spilled a dangerous delivery from Mohammed Marhoon. And on the stroke of half-time, Djibouti's Ahmed Zakaria was shown a second yellow card following a VAR review. The booking came after he pushed Bahrain's Mehdi Abduljabbar while pressing the goalkeeper, who had already collected the ball. The referee deemed it a reckless challenge, reducing Djibouti to ten men, stripping them of their main attacking threat and severely denting their hopes of a comeback.

Bahrain arrive in the Arab

Cup as Gulf champions, having lifted the 26th Gulf Cup in January, but also carrying the disappointment of missing out on FIFA World Cup 2026 qualification and a run of poor results in friendlies. Head coach Dragan Talajic was confident heading into the tournament, saying, "We have come here to show that we were winners of the last Gulf Cup - we are the best in the Gulf, and now we want to show we are the best in the Arab world."

After exiting at the group stage in 2021, Bahrain will be looking to make amends and push further in this year's competition. Placed in Group D, they will face defending champions Algeria, Iraq, and the winner of Lebanon versus Sudan, carrying both the pride of their Gulf Cup success and the weight of a nation's expectations.

IOC chief Coventry in tears as 2026 Winter Games torch relay sets off

New International Olympic Committee chief Kirsty Coventry fought back tears on Wednesday as she urged nations to come together in the 2026 Winter Games, as the torch relay set off from ancient Olympia in Greece.

Addressing guests during the torch ceremony at the Olympia archaeological museum, as the first woman to head the Olympic movement, a tearful Coventry stressed the power of sport to unite.

"I wasn't supposed to get emotional, but this place is very special," she added to applause.

"In a divided world that we live in today, the Games hold a truly symbolic place. It is our duty, our responsibility, to ensure that the athletes from around the world can come together peacefully," she said. Coventry repeatedly veered from her prepared speech to stress her emotional connection to the Games.

The torch was carried initially by Greek rower Petros Gaidatzis and then jointly with Italian cross-country skiing champion Stefania Belmondo

as the relay began the countdown to the Milan-Cortina Winter Games, which will open on February 6.

The pair ran from the museum to the grove in Olympia, the birthplace of the ancient Games, where the heart of modern Olympics founder Baron Pierre de Coubertin is kept, and handed over the torch to Italian luge great Armin Zoeggeler.

The flame ceremony was flanked by sculptures from the Temple of Zeus, the patron god of the ancient Olympics.

The ceremony to light the Olympic flame is usually held among the ruins of the 2,600-year-old Temple of Hera, near the stadium where the Olympics were born in 776 BC.

But a rainy weather forecast -- which proved mistaken -- raised concerns that the sun's rays would not be able to sufficiently heat up the parabolic mirror used by actresses dressed as ancient priestesses to light the flame.

That forced organisers to head indoors for Wednesday's ceremony where they used a flame lit on Monday, during an outdoor rehearsal under the sun.

India has its eyes on a bigger prize, having submitted a formal letter of intent last year to the International Olympic Committee to host the 2036 Summer Olympics.
