

# BIC and CBX launch ticket sales for 2026 Bahrain Darts Masters

Bahrain International Circuit (BIC) and sports promoter CBX, today launched ticket sales for the 2026 Bahrain Darts Masters. In

its three-year history, The Bahrain Darts Masters has become a landmark event for international sport in the Bahrain calendar and is supported by Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority (BTEA).

Tickets are now on sale for the two-day event on 15 and 16 January, which will be the first event after the 2025/26 World Darts Championship and will include eight leading stars in world darts, a sport which has become a global phenomenon in recent years.

Tickets have now been launched for the event with a special, limited time, 20% Early Bird discount. Prices for next year's competition start from 20BD (after Early Bird discount) for a two-day pass in the new Bahrain Darts Masters Grand-

stand. Premium seating – including stage-side tables – are from just BD 40 for two days after discount.

All ticket options are available online at bahraingp.com or by calling the BIC Hotline on +973-17450 000. Fans are urged to act quickly, as the Early Bird discount is for a limited time only and the event is expected to be hugely popular, based on the demand in previous years.

## New venue

As the event has grown in the last three years, the venue has been moved for 2026 to Exhibition World Bahrain, which will be transformed into Bahrain's answer to the iconic Alexandra Palace. Fans can expect an incredible atmosphere, with fancy

dress, themed activations and a wide range of food and beverage options as "Sports Biggest Party" brings its unique flavour to Bahrain.

The Bahrain Darts Masters will be the first event of the 2026 World Series of Darts, organised by The Professional Darts Corporation (PDC) and features eight of the biggest stars of global darts, as well as regional and local talent.

Tomorrow, BIC will be offering the public the chance to enjoy an early morning workout within the unique setting of a Formula 1 host venue in Batelco Fitness on Track.

Then, on Saturday, speed enthusiasts can get into the fast lane with BIC's Track Experiences, featuring three ultra-quick race cars.

Tomorrow's Batelco Fitness on Track can be done both on foot or on a bicycle – either individually or with a group of friends and family. The activity will be taking place from 6am to 10am, making for a bright and early start to the weekend.



Runners and walkers will be utilising BIC's 2.550-kilometre Inner Circuit, while cyclists will get to ride their bikes along the 3.543-kilometre Outer Circuit, with another dedicated area for children's cycling.

The cost to take part is BD2 for cyclists and BD1 for runners. Payment must be made upon booking. Children under the age of 12 can participate for free if accompanied by a paying adult.

BIC's Batelco Fitness on Track Season Pass is also still available. This is ideal for regular participants as it grants access to all Batelco Fitness on Track events throughout the season, at the affordable price of just BD15. Meanwhile, Saturday's Track Experiences gives racing fanatics the chance to get into the hot seat either as a driver or a passenger. They can choose between a Renault Clio Cup or either a Radical SR1 or SR3 race car. The event will be held from 8am to 3pm.

Those opting for the Clio Cup Experiences will get an awesome introduction into the

high-octane world of motorsports. The Clio Cup sports car boasts a 1.6-litre, Turbocharged engine.

The Driving Experience takes the participant onto the track behind a professional instructor in a lead-follow manner, while the Passenger Experience requires those taking part to simply buckle up and enjoy the ride.

Fans won't go wrong if choosing from the SR1 and SR3 Expe-

periences. The Radical SR1 Driving Experience is ideal for amateurs and expert racers alike, as the car's 185bhp engine roars like no other. Interested participants must complete a Clio Cup Drive in order to take part in this activity. The Radical SR3 Passenger Experience takes fans from zero to 100kph in about 3.4 seconds, making for a memorable number of laps around BIC alongside the circuit's expert instructors.

The cost to get behind the wheel for the Clio Cup Driver Experience is BD121, while the Clio Cup Passenger Experience is BD27,500. For the Radical SR1 Driver Experience, the cost is BD132, while the Radical SR3 Passenger Experience is BD38,500.
