Qatari claims baseless: Al Ruwaie to UN

Bahrain's yesterday strongly refuted Qatari claims of airspace violations as "baseless" before a UN body.

The allegations that four Bahraini fighter jets violated Qatari airspace, Bahrain UN envoy said, are "baseless, unfortunate and unrelated to facts."

Bahrain explained its position in a letter sent to Jerry Matthews Matjila, Security Council President for the month, and South Africa's Permanent Representative to the United Nations and the United Nations Secretary-General António Guterres.

The statement by Bahrain's Permanent Representative to the United Nations in New York Jamal Faris Al Ruwaie affirmed

Qatari practices lack credibility and are contradictory and inconsistent with the principle of good neighbourliness stipulated in international conventions to which Qatar claims that it adheres.

that the allegations are part of "continuous and escalating distortion" practised by Qatar to increase regional tensions.

Al Ruwaie added that such

practices lack credibility and are contradictory and inconsistent with the principle of good neighbourliness.

Hopes high for GCC Summit

Bahrain hosts GCC foreign ministers virtual summit today

- **GCC Summit to be held in Riyadh on January 5**
- **Meeting expected to focus on COVID-19 outbreak, Qatar dispute**
- **Saudi King directs to start sending summit invitations to GCC leaders**

Preparations are on track for the 41st Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) Summit during which Bahrain will assume the presidency of the summit's next session.

In preparation, Bahrain is also hosting an online meeting of the foreign ministers of the GCC, today. The crucial January 5 summit will be in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.

The GCC was founded in 1981 by Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia and the United

Ahead of the summit, Bahrain's Supreme Defence Council, led by King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, stressed the importance of ending regional conflicts and disputes by peaceful means and in accordance with international covenants and the principles of good neighbourliness.

Arab Emirates.

Meanwhile, Saudi Arabian King Salman bin Abdulaziz Al Saud yesterday requested the GCC Secretary-General to formally invite Gulf leaders to the 41st GCC Summit in Riyadh.

GCC leaders have held the annual meeting to "discuss coordination, integration, and interconnection between the member States and their citizens in economic development, commerce, education, and culture."

This time around, discussions

are expected to focus on overcoming the economic challenges posed by the COVID-19 outbreak and Qatari dispute.

Ahead of the summit, Bahrain's Supreme Defence Council chaired by His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, the Supreme Commander and President of the Supreme Defence Council, had called for "to end regional conflicts and disputes by peaceful means" in an apparent suggestion of the ongoing dispute with Qatar.

His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince, Deputy Supreme Commander and Prime Minister was present at the meeting.

In another statement, the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Dr Abdullatif bin Rashid Al Zayani, has said that Bahrain "is looking forward to a Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) summit that will lead to strengthening Gulf dialogue to achieve the goals for the future."

Earlier this month, Saudi foreign minister, Prince Faisal bin Farhan Al Saud, has said: "significant progress" had been

reached in the last few days, and he was optimistic all countries were close to finalising a resolution.

He said that the four governments behind the Qatar blockade are "on board" for discussion and a final agreement is expected soon.

Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, Bahrain, and Egypt cut ties with Qatar in June 2017 for funding militant movements.

Sheikh Zayed Road project 62pc complete

Construction works of the BD23.4 million Sheikh Zayed Road Development project is on track, with the project achieving a 62 per cent completion, said the Minister of Works.

The project expands Sheikh Zayed Road into three lanes in each direction, starting from 16th December Street to Sheikh Khalifa bin Salman Street and from the Western roundabout of Ali village to Sheikh Isa bin Salman Street.

The project also replaces four roundabouts on the road into intersections managed by signals.

The road development project, which began in August 2019 and funded by Abu Dhabi Fund for Development, is scheduled for completion in June next year.

Essam Khalaf, the Minister of Works, Municipalities Affairs and Urban Planning, took a tour of the project site to review work progress.

The first part of the project, which included the expansion

of 16th December street, was completed in November 2020.

The second phase deals with expanding the 3.2 km two-lane Sheikh Zayed Road into three lanes. Expansion works of the

Sheikh Khalifa Benseelman Street in the west to the Driving Training School in the east are also ongoing and slated for completion in the first quarter of 2021.

In the third phase, the project focuses on the Salmabad Street. Here a 3.2 km, two-lane, street no.12 will be expanded to three lanes and is scheduled for completion in the second half

of 2021.

“The project is one of the important strategic projects of the main road network in the Kingdom,” the minister said adding, “it connects people from the villages of Aali and Salmabad and Madinat Zayed with Sheikh Khalifa bin Salman Street and Manama.”

Easy access to educational zone in Isa Town and elimination of traffic jams in front of the Driving School and Bahrain National Stadium are other benefits. “The ministry is also working to establish a 1.2 km long sewage line from Ramli housing project to Sheikh Isa bin Salman Street and a sewage lift station with a depth of about 10 metres,” said Khalaf. Other works include lighting works, setting up barriers, traffic signs, renewing asphalt layers, landscaping and rainwater drainage works.

Capital municipality to improve aesthetic appearance

The Capital municipality announced plans to implement eight projects worth 120 thousand Bahraini dinars this month to boost the aesthetic appearance of the Kingdom's capital.

The Director-General of the Capital Municipality, Muhammad Saad Al-Sahli, confirmed the new development. He said the move falls in line with the decision of the municipality's and Minister of Works, Municipalities Affairs and Urban Planning to increase the green cover in the governorate. Al Sahli said the municipality will plant more than 300 shade-trees on King Faisal Street and Sheikh Khalifa bin Salman Street.

Roundabouts are to be enhanced by planting palms and trees of more than 70 varieties.

The Capital municipality, Al Sahli said, will install artificial grass and stones, and new games for children at the Sitra bridge walkway, Zinj Park and Seef Park. Plans are also progressing to install rubber floor at Abu Ghazal Park play area and renovating public facilities and service buildings in Salmaniya Park, Mahooz Park, Adliya Park and Al Wahda Park.

The municipality is also pursuing approval for three more projects. One of them is for establishing an arboretum in Salmaniya Park to cultivate trees and plants. Other projects are for installing solar-powered lighting at East Coast Corniche and main streets.

Britain yesterday published the text of its narrow trade agreement with the European Union just five days before it exits one of the world's biggest trading blocs in its most significant global shift since the loss of empire.

The text includes a 1,246-page trade document, as well as agreements on nuclear energy, exchanging classified information, civil nuclear energy and a series of joint declarations.

The "Draft EU-UK Trade and Cooperation Agreement" means that from 2300 GMT on Dec. 31, when Britain finally leaves the EU's single market and customs union, there will be no tariffs or quotas on the movement of goods originating in either place between the UK and the EU.

The treaty explicitly recognises that trade and invest-

ment require conditions for "a level playing field for open and fair competition."

On financial services, which drive the British economy, the two sides simply commit "to establish a favourable climate for the development of trade and investment between them".

The text includes many detailed annexes including on rules of origin, fish, the wine trade, medicines, chemicals and security data cooperation.

Erdogan says Turkey will break economic 'triangle of evil'

Turkey will bring in structural reforms to break the "triangle of evil" of interest rates, inflation and exchange rates, President Tayyip Erdogan said yesterday, adding Ankara was determined to form a system based on production and employment.

Erdogan promised a slate of judicial and economic reforms last month, leading to expectations of the possible release of politicians, including Kurdish ones, and human rights advocates from jail. But Erdogan's recent comments on court rulings and criticism aimed at his government have fuelled scepticism about his pledge.

Speaking via videolink at a ceremony in Ankara, Erdogan said 2021 would be "the year of democratic and economic reforms" and that efforts to present the reforms to parlia-

ment would move "as soon as possible".

"We hope to overcome troubles from economic attacks and the pandemic measures as soon as possible. By speeding up structural reforms, we are determined to form a system based on production and employment and breaking the interest rates, inflation and exchange rates triangle of evil," Erdogan said.

European businesses hopeful of China-EU investment deal

European businesses in China are hopeful of an EU-China investment deal by end of the year, the head of the European Chamber of Commerce in China said yesterday, although Beijing has declined to commit to a deadline.

The China-EU Comprehensive Agreement on Investment has been in the works for seven years, and is expected to pave the way for European businesses to invest in financial services, telecommunications, electric vehicles and other sectors that are gradually being opened up for foreign investment in China.

But the deal is facing opposition from some European members of parliament and the incoming US administration of

President-elect Joe Biden, who say it does not address concerns about the use of forced labour by Chinese manufacturers, especially in the restive northwestern region of Xinjiang.

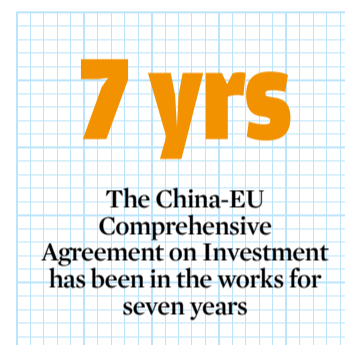
"The next few days will be interesting. My sense is that there is a serious push to get this past the finishing line," Joerg Wuttke, head of the European Chamber of Commerce in China, said.

"It's not a perfect deal, far from it, but it's a big step forward."

China's commerce ministry has refrained from committing to a year-end deadline and appears prepared for an extension

of discussions.

"In order to preserve its security and development interests, China will conduct the negotiations at its own pace and strive to reach a comprehensive, balanced and ambitious investment



agreement with the EU," it said in a statement late Thursday.

"The China-EU investment agreement is aimed at providing more investment opportunities and sound institutional guarantees for the two sides, but to reach it requires joint efforts and to meet each other halfway," it added.

In an interview with Le Monde on Wednesday, France's junior trade minister Franck Riester said Beijing needed to address the issue of forced labour if Paris was to agree to the deal.

Jake Sullivan, who has been tipped as National Security Advisor, tweeted on Tuesday that: "The Biden-Harris administration would welcome early consultations with our European partners on our common concerns about China's economic practices."

The investment deal aims to create an equal playing field for European businesses in China that have long complained about preferential terms enjoyed by domestic firms.

The treaty will also strengthen intellectual property protections for European companies and ban forced technology transfers.

Millions of Americans lose jobless benefits

Millions of Americans saw their jobless benefits expire yesterday after US President Donald Trump refused to sign into law a \$2.3 trillion pandemic aid and spending package, protesting that it did not do enough to help everyday people.

Trump stunned Republicans and Democrats alike when he said this week he was unhappy with the massive bill, which

provides \$892 billion in badly needed coronavirus relief, including extending special unemployment benefits expiring

on Dec. 26, and \$1.4 trillion for normal government spending.

Without Trump's signature, about 14 million people could lose those extra benefits, according to Labor Department data. A partial government shutdown will begin on Tuesday unless Congress can agree a stop-gap government funding bill before then.

After months of wrangling, Republicans and Democrats agreed to the package last weekend, with the support of

the White House. Trump, who hands over power to Democratic President-elect Joe Biden on Jan. 20, did not object to terms of the deal before Congress voted it through on Monday night.

But since then he has complained that the bill gives too much money to special interests, cultural projects and foreign aid, while its one-time \$600 stimulus checks to millions of struggling Americans were too small. He has demanded that be raised to \$2,000.

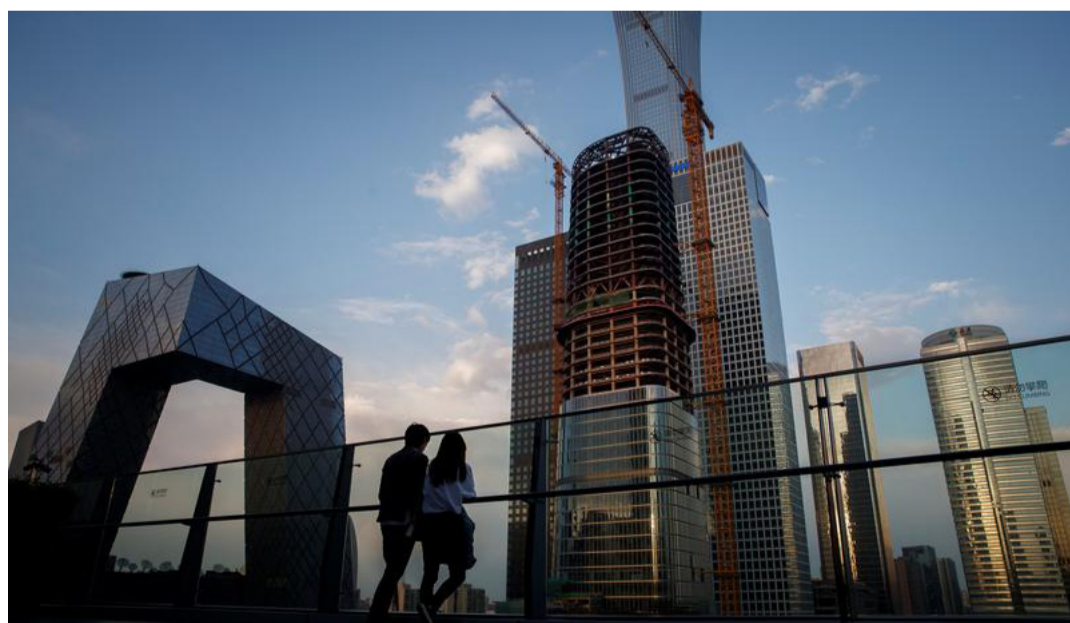

China will overtake the United States to become the world's biggest economy in 2028, five years earlier than previously estimated due to the contrasting recoveries of the two countries from the COVID-19 pandemic, a think tank said.

"For some time, an overar-

ching theme of global economics has been the economic and soft power struggle between the United States and China," the Centre for Economics and Business Research said in an annual report published on Saturday.

"The COVID-19 pandemic and

corresponding economic fallout have certainly tipped this rivalry in China's favour."

The CEBR said China's "skilful management of the pandemic", with its strict early lockdown, and hits to long-term growth in the West meant China's relative

economic performance had improved.

China looked set for average economic growth of 5.7 per cent a year from 2021-25 before slowing to 4.5pc a year from 2026-30.

While the United States was likely to have a strong post-pandemic rebound in 2021, its growth would slow to 1.9pc a year between 2022 and 2024, and then to 1.6pc after that.

Japan would remain the world's third-biggest economy, in dollar terms, until the early 2030s when it would be overtaken by India, pushing Germany down from fourth to fifth.

The United Kingdom, currently the fifth-biggest economy by the CEBR's measure, would slip to sixth place from 2024.

However, despite a hit in 2021 from its exit from the European Union's single market, British GDP in dollars was forecast to be 23pc higher than France's by 2035, helped by Britain's lead in the increasingly important digital economy.

It also said the pandemic's impact on the global economy was likely to show up in higher inflation, not slower growth.

"We see an economic cycle with rising interest rates in the mid-2020s," it said, posing a challenge for governments which have borrowed massively to fund their response to the COVID-19 crisis.

Four injured in Berlin shooting, police say



◆ Four people were injured in a shooting in the German capital Berlin in the early hours of yesterday, police said. A police spokeswoman said four people were taken to hospital in the altercation involving several people in the Kreuzberg district, adding there was no indication of a political motive. The Berlin fire service said earlier on Twitter that three people were seriously injured in the shooting.

◆ Three UN peacekeepers have been killed by unidentified combatants in the Central African Republic, the United Nations said, as the country prepares for a general election and fighting continues between rebels and government forces. The news came after a rebel coalition called off a ceasefire and said it would resume its march on the capital, as well as the arrival of troops from Russia and Rwanda to shore up the government of the resource-rich country.

Europe launches a cross-border vaccination programme of unprecedented scale today as part of efforts to end a COVID-19 pandemic that has crippled economies and claimed more than 1.7 million lives around the world.

The region of 450 million people has secured contracts with a range of suppliers for over two billion vaccine doses and has set a goal for all adults to be inoculated during 2021.

While Europe has some of the best-resourced healthcare systems in the world, the sheer scale of the effort means that some

countries are calling on retired medics to help out while others have loosened rules for who is allowed to give the injections.

With surveys pointing to high levels of hesitancy towards the vaccine in countries from France to Poland, leaders of the 27-country European Union are promoting it as the best chance of getting back to something like normal life next year.

"We are starting to turn the page on a difficult year," Ursula von der Leyen, president of the Brussels-based European Com-

mission coordinating the programme, said in a tweet. "Vaccination is the lasting way out of the pandemic."

After European governments were criticised for failing to work together to counter the spread of the virus in early 2020, the goal this time is to ensure that there is equal access to the vaccines across the entire region.

But even then, Hungary yesterday jumped the gun on the official roll-out by starting to administer shots of the vaccine developed by Pfizer and BioNTech to frontline

workers at hospitals in the capital Budapest.

Countries including France, Germany, Italy, Austria, Portugal and Spain are planning to begin mass vaccinations, starting with health workers on Sunday. Outside the EU, Britain, Switzerland and Serbia have already started in recent weeks.

The distribution of the Pfizer-BioNTech shot presents tough challenges. The vaccine uses new mRNA technology and must be stored at ultra-low temperatures of around -80 degrees Celsius (-112°F). France, which received its first shipment of the two-dose vaccine yesterday, will start administering it in the greater Paris area and in the Burgundy-Franche-Comte region.

US President-elect Joe Biden warned yesterday of "devastating consequences" if President Donald Trump continues to delay signing a Covid-19 economic relief bill passed by Congress.

Trump threw a long-awaited pandemic aid package into doubt last week as millions of Americans prepared to lose benefits

and face eviction -- demanding lawmakers more than triple the \$600 direct payments to US taxpayers.

"This abdication of responsibility has devastating consequences. Today, about 10 million Americans will lose unemployment insurance benefits," Biden said in a statement. The stimulus measure is wrapped up with a \$1.4 trillion funding bill, without which the

government will be forced to shut down at midnight Monday.

"In just a few days, government funding will expire, putting vital services and paychecks for military personnel at risk," Biden added.

"In less than a week, a moratorium on evictions expires, putting millions at risk of being forced from their homes over the holidays."

Turkish opposition TV station shuts after 26 days

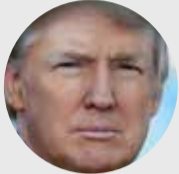

Police search for clues at Nashville blast site

The explosion on Christmas day in downtown Nashville damaged dozens of businesses

Tennessee governor seeks emergency declaration

Authorities in Nashville yesterday probed an explosion that ripped through part of the US city on Christmas morning after a chilling bomb warning while the governor requested an emergency declaration from the White House.

The fiery blast, heard from miles away, destroyed several vehicles, damaged more than 40 businesses and left a trail of glass shards around the area.

The motor home, parked on a downtown street of Tennessee's largest city, exploded at dawn on Friday moments after police responding to reports of gunfire noticed the recreational vehicle and heard an automated message emanating from it warning of a bomb.

The means of detonation and whether anyone was inside the RV when it blew up were not immediately known, but investigators were examining what they believed might be human remains found in the vicinity of the blast, police said.

Police offered no possible motive, and there was no claim of responsibility, though Nashville Metropolitan Police Department officials called the blast an "intentional act" and vowed to determine its origin.

Dozens of agents from the FBI and the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives were surveying the ashy disaster area yesterday. Inside the area, which was blocked off to traffic, parked cars and trees were blackened and an exploded water pipe that had been spraying overnight had covered trees in a layer of ice.

A total of 41 businesses were damaged, Mayor John Cooper said.

"All the windows came in from the living room into the bedroom. The front door became unhinged," Buck McCoy, who lives on the block where the blast occurred, told local TV station WKRN. "I had blood coming from my face and on my side and on my legs and a little bit on my feet."

McCoy told CNN that he and some neighbors were returning to the area yesterday in search of pets they had been forced to

leave behind.

Tennessee Governor Bill Lee said he toured the disaster zone yesterday, saying in a Twitter message it was a "miracle" that no one was killed. In a letter to President Donald Trump, Lee requested a federal emergency declaration for his state to aid in relief efforts.

Police scrambled to evacuate nearby homes and buildings and called for a bomb squad, which was still en route to the scene when the RV blew up just outside an AT&T Inc office building where it had been parked.

Police later posted a photo of the motor home, which they said had arrived in the area about four hours prior to the explosion.

Fire officials said three people were hospitalized with relatively minor injuries and were in stable condition. Authorities said police likely prevented more casualties by acting quickly to clear the area of bystanders.

The explosion occurred about two blocks from Lower Broadway, where some of Nashville's famous live music venues are located. The Ryman Auditorium, former home of the Grand Ole Opry and just three blocks from the blast scene, was undamaged. The Gaylord Opryland and current Grand Ole Opry complexes, which sit outside the downtown area, were not impacted.

British Cold War double agent George Blake dies in Moscow

George Blake, a famous "mole" in British intelligence who spied for the Soviet KGB during the 1950s before fleeing across the Iron Curtain, has died aged 98, Russian news agencies reported yesterday.

"The legendary intelligence officer George Blake has passed away today," the spokesman for Russia's SVR foreign intelligence service Sergei Ivanov told the TASS state news agency.

"He sincerely loved our country and admired our people's achievements during World War II," Ivanov added.

Russian President Vladimir Putin, himself an ex-KGB agent, yesterday expressed his "deep condolences" to Blake's family and friends.

In a message published on the Kremlin website, the Russian leader noted Blake's "invaluable contribution to ensuring strategic parity and maintaining peace on the planet".

A former member of the Dutch resistance during World War II then an agent of the British foreign intelligence service MI6, Blake offered his services to the Soviets in the 1950s after witnessing US bombings against the civilian population during the Korean War.

He provided the names of hundreds of MI6 agents to the KGB and revealed the existence of a secret tunnel in East Berlin that was used to spy on the Soviets.

Archaeologists uncover ancient street food shop in Pompeii

Archaeologists in Pompeii, the city buried in a volcanic eruption in 79 AD, have made the extraordinary find of a frescoed hot food and drinks shop that served up the ancient equivalent of street food to Roman passersby.

Known as a termopolium, Latin for hot drinks counter, the shop was discovered in the archaeological park's Regio V site, which is not yet open to the public, and unveiled yesterday.

Traces of nearly 2,000-year-old food were found in some of the deep terra cotta jars containing hot food which the shop keeper lowered into a counter with circular holes.

The front of the counter was decorated with brightly coloured frescoes, some depicting ani-

mals that were part of the ingredients in the food sold, such as a chicken and two ducks hanging upside down.

"This is an extraordinary find. It's the first time we are excavating an entire termopolium," said Massimo Ossana, director of the

Pompeii archaeological park.

Archaeologists also found a decorated bronze drinking bowl known as a patera, ceramic jars used for cooking stews and soups, wine flasks and amphora.

Pompeii, 23 km (14 miles) southeast of Naples, was home to about 13,000 people when it was buried under ash, pumice pebbles and dust as it endured the force of an eruption equivalent to many atomic bombs.

lent to many atomic bombs.

"Our preliminary analyses shows that the figures drawn on the front of the counter, represent, at least in part, the food and drink that were sold there," said Valeria Amoretti, a site anthropologist.

Amoretti said traces of pork, fish, snails and beef had been found in the containers, a discovery she called a "testimony to the great variety of animal products used to prepare dishes".

About two-thirds of the 66-hectare (165-acre) ancient town has been uncovered. The ruins were not discovered until the 16th century and organised excavations began about 1750.

A rare documentation of Greco-Roman life, Pompeii is one of Italy's most popular attractions and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Philippine-American Bobby Ray Parks Jr. has captured his second statistical race title in the recent Philippine Basketball Association (PBA) Philippine Cup, the second time he achieved the feat after the 2019 Commissioner's Cup as a rookie.

It was yet another individual accolade for the 6-foot-4 swingman, son of the late Bobby Parks Sr., who is largely regarded as one of the greatest imports in the PBA.

But what would satisfy him more is not just an individual award. Rather, a championship for TNT Tropang Giga.

"At the end of the day, winning a championship is what matters the most," said the 27-year-old Parks, who stressed a trophy for the team, and not individual awards, will fulfill his PBA mission.

"That's the primary goal of every team, to win a championship and gets better," added the former National Basketball Association D-League, which is now known as NBA G League.

Parks emerged as the best individual performer in shorted, one-conference 45th PBA season.

Since entering the pro league last year, winning his first title has been his ultimate goal.

In his pro debut with Blackwater, Parks made a strong impact averaging 22.1 points, 7.1 rebounds, 3.4 assists and 1.4 steals for 37.2 statistical points despite the Elite managing only to reach the quarterfinals.

In the Philippine Cup, Parks

registered 38.2 SPs on 22.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.3 steals in 16 games in the Clark bubble.

He only played in Game One of the Finals because of a left calf injury with Barangay Ginebra San Miguel winning the title in five games.

Parks said he is undergoing rehabilitation and hopes the injury heals soon enough as he declared his availability for the national team to the third window of the International Basketball Federation Asia Cup qualifiers in Clark in February.

"For as long as I am healthy, I am okay to play for the national team. I just keep my options open," he said.

Parks admitted that he misses rolling with the Philippine national players and is gunning his engines to do so again.

"It would be my honour and privilege to join and represent the national team if they would have me. A lot has been going on, and I feel that we all should come together as one now more than ever," said Parks.

Parks will fly to the US later this month.

Arsenal eased fears of being dragged into a relegation battle with a stunning 3-1 win over Chelsea yesterday, as Manchester United's Premier League title challenge stumbled after they conceded a late equaliser to draw 2-2 at Leicester.

Mikel Arteta led Arsenal to win the FA Cup the last time they faced Chelsea in August, but less than five months on the Spaniard was under intense pressure after a run of one win in 10 league games.

Arteta had bemoaned his side's fortune in recent weeks, but the Gunners' luck turned on a night when he gave youngsters Gabriel Martinelli and Emile Smith Rowe the chance to shine in the absence of more experienced figures such as David Luiz, Willian and Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang.

Kieran Tierney won a soft penalty for a push by Reece James and Alexandre Lacazette slotted home the spot-kick to open the scoring on 34 minutes.

Granit Xhaka then answered his critics after being stupidly sent off in a 1-0 defeat to Burnley earlier this month with a brilliant free-kick to double Arsenal's lead just before half-time. A third consecutive away defeat for Chelsea further damages their chances of competing for the title and there was no way back for Frank Lampard's men once Bukayo Saka chipped in off the inside of the post 11 minutes after the break.
