Pete Davidson and Elsie Hewitt are “settling into a rhythm” of parenting.

The 32-year-old comedian and Elsie, 29, recently announced the birth of their daughter Scottie Rose - but Elsie’s early experience of parenthood was complicated by having to have her wisdom tooth extracted just one day after giving birth.

A source told People: “Elsie is doing really well now and feeling so much better since having the tooth taken care of.

The comedy star explained: “I don’t want to victimise myself in any way because I’m cool, but the sexualisation of me — if that was a girl, people would be like, there would be a march for it ... Seriously. You’re just talking about my d*** all day.”

The 50-year-old actress has made her directorial debut with Goodbye June, which follows a family coming together as their mother passes away, and Kate hopes the new movie can help to change some attitudes in the UK.

The British actress - whose son Joe wrote the script for the film - explained: “In this country, we’re not necessarily so good at processing, especially when it comes to talking about grief.

Taylor Swift was always opposed to dating athletes - until she met Travis Kelce.

The 36-year-old pop singer began dating Travis in 2023, and the loved-up couple announced their engagement earlier this year - but Taylor was previously opposed to the idea of dating a sportsman, as she didn’t think they’d have much in common.

She said: “I’m looking at the headlines and perusing around on the Internet and I see that

this guy came to your show and he brought a friendship bracelet and wants to meet you. So I call up my resident expert on the Kansas City Chiefs, my cousin Robin, and I go, ‘Tell me about this guy named Travis Kelce.’”

Meanwhile, Patrick Mahomes - Travis’ teammate at the Kansas City Chiefs - previously claimed that the singer has helped to make the NFL franchise a “worldwide team”.

Paul Rudd says he lied about being directed by Sir Ben Kingsley on his CV

Paul Rudd lied about playing Hamlet “in a production directed by Sir Ben Kingsley” at the beginning of his career.

The 56-year-old actor has been one of the most in-demand actors for the past two decades with roles in hits like Anchorman: The Legend of Ron Burgundy, Friends, Ant-Man and Ghostbusters: Afterlife.

But when he was starting out, Rudd’s manager got creative with his CV and put that he had done

Shakespeare with Oscar winner Kingsley, even though he had in fact only attended a class run by the Gandhi star.

Appearing on The Graham Norton Show, Rudd revealed: “When I first got a manager, I had no credits to put on my CV, but I’d once done an afternoon masterclass with Sir Ben Kingsley when I was in school. My manager put this down as, ‘Paul played Hamlet in a production directed by Sir Ben Kingsley.’ I lived in fear that he would one

day see my CV!”

Rudd got his big screen break in 1995 with roles in comedy Clueless and horror sequel Halloween: The Curse of Michael Myers and he is combining horror and comedy for his latest project Anaconda, a meta-reboot of the 1997 movie of the same name.

Rudd stars with Jack Black in Tom Gormican’s film about two friends who travel to the Amazon to shoot an amateur remake of the Jennifer Lopez-led Anacon-

da, only to encounter a real and giant man-eating snake.

Asked how the film came about, Paul said: “Jack and I are both huge fans of Tom Gormican’s The Unbearable Weight of Massive Talent and when this script showed up it seemed to have similar DNA in that it was a clever meta comedy take on a reboot. I was very excited to work on it particularly when I found out Jack was involved.”

Jack, 56, joined Paul on the UK TV chat show and admitted

he agreed to sign up to play wedding videographer Doug McCallister when he was told Rudd would be playing background Ronald “Griff” Griffen Jr.

The School of Rock star said: “It is really very funny and crazy. I had never read anything like it. I was mainly excited to work with Paul because he makes me laugh so much. I made sure he was definitely attached to the film before I signed anything.
