Act now, WHO says

Monkeypox can be contained with right measures: WHO director

The World Health Organisation yesterday urged countries around the world to take quick steps to contain the spread of monkeypox and share data about their vaccine stockpiles.

A senior World Health Organization official said yesterday that with the right measures we could contain the threat easily.

"We think that if we put in place the right measures now we probably can contain this easily," Sylvie Briand, WHO director for Global Infectious Hazard Preparedness, told the UN agency's annual assembly.

So far, there are about 300 confirmed or suspected cases in around 20 countries where the virus was not previously circulating.

"For us, we think that the key priority currently is trying to contain this transmission in non-endemic countries," Bri-

and told a technical briefing for member states.

Needed measures included the early detection and isolation of cases and contact tracing, she added. Member states should also share information about first generation stockpiles of smallpox vaccines which can also be effective against monkeypox, Briand said.

the world and so that's why we encourage countries to come to WHO and tell us what are their stockpiles," she said. A slide of her presentation described global supplies as "very constrained".

Currently, WHO officials are advising against mass vaccination, instead suggesting targeted vaccination where available for close contacts of people infected.

"Case investigation, contact tracing, isolation at home will be your best bets," said Rosamund Lewis, WHO head of the smallpox secretariat which is part of the WHO Emergencies Programme.

"We don't know exactly the number of doses available in



Monkeypox is a usually mild viral infection that is endemic in parts of west and central Africa. It spreads chiefly through close contact and until the recent outbreak, was rarely seen in other parts of the world, which is why the recent emergence of cases in Europe, the United States and other areas has raised alarms.

Iran says forces seize two Greek tankers

Iranian forces seized two Greek tankers in the Gulf yesterday, Iranian state media reported, shortly after Tehran warned it would take "punitive action" against Athens over the confiscation of Iranian oil by the United States from a tanker held off the Greek coast. "The Revolutionary Guards Navy today seized two Greek tankers for violations in Gulf waters," said a Guards statement, quoted by the state news agency IRNA.

Greek authorities last month impounded the Iranian-flagged Pegas, with 19 Russian crew members on board, near the coast of the southern island of Evia due to EU sanctions. The United States later confiscated the Iranian oil cargo held onboard and plans to send it to the United States on another vessel, Reuters reported on Thursday. The Pegas was later released because of confusion about the sanctions over its owners.




Family loses sole breadwinner, BD37,000 payout in accident case

A family that suffered a double blow in a tragic accident, as they also lost their sole breadwinner with the death of a Bahraini man, will now receive a BD37,000 compensation following a court order.

The High Civil Court ordered the insurance company and the driver who caused the accident to jointly make the payment to the wife and two daughters of

the man killed in the accident.

An earlier verdict by another court had found the driver of the insured car guilty of causing the accident. Reports said the accident occurred when his car rammmed into the victim's car.

The findings also prompted

the victim's family to file a case seeking hefty compensation.

However, the insurance company denied the claims.

The company appealed the ruling arguing that the compensation was excessive.

The insurance company also argued before the court that it failed to consider the deceased's actions in the accident. The car that caused the accident and its driver have insurance coverage from the said company.

Failure to pay rent: Court orders tenants to pay BD40,000 to coffee shop owners

The High Civil Court ordered the lessees of a coffee house to pay BD40,000, plus 3% annual interest, in a case filed by the cafe owners citing non-payment of rents and contract terms violations.

The decision came in a case filed by the cafe owners against two partners who took the cafe on rent.

Court files say the agreement

signed in 2020 allowed the partners to run the coffee shop in return for an undisclosed amount.

The lessees were also required to pay a three-month rent in advance. The contract terms further call for the duo to pay the monthly rent of the shop, salaries of employees, and their accommodation on top of other expenses associated with

running the business.

The cafe owners told the court that the defendants failed to honour any commitments, resulting in them expelling the duo from the building.

"The two partners owe BD41,000 to my clients, while they also failed to pay the electric and water bills for so many months," the plaintiffs' lawyer told the court.

Court orders to destroy more than 300 counterfeit women's accessories, bags

A Bahrain court has ordered to destroy more than 300 pieces of imported women's bags and other accessories, which the Court said are counterfeit products.

The High Administrative Court said the bags are pure imitation of one of the famous brands registered in Bahrain.

The products bore a trademark similar to a registered trademark, confusing the public.

The Court's order is to destroy the products at the expense of its importer or to dispose of them outside if the products are to cause unacceptable harm to public health and the environment.

The company that owns the trademark requested the Department of Ports and Maritime Affairs to stop the release of the products and oblige the

first defendant to pay for the material damage suffered by

the plaintiff.

The lawsuit filed claims that the defendant imported 300 pieces of accessories and bags that carry a trademark similar to theirs, purposefully misleading and harming public confidence in their brand.

The plaintiff also submitted a copy of their trademark registration certificate in the Kingdom before the Court.

Eleven companies are in the fray for a pre-qualification tender for Bahrain Metro phase one issued by the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications.

Bahrain Metro Phase One Project comprises two lines with a total length of 29 kilometres and 20 stations, which will operate on two lines.

The first line will connect Airport to Seef District, while the other line will connect Juffair to the educational area in Isa Town.

The proposal is to develop a state-of-the-art Metro system which is fully automated, driverless and with modern technology following international standards. MTT plans to develop a 109km long Metro System in 4 phases.

China Harbour Engineering Co Ltd - Foreign Branch, China Railway Group Limited, Orascom Construction, Alstom Transport SA, Taqi Mohammed Albahrana Trading Est., Hyundai Engineering & Construction, Aradous Energy Generations Co., Larsen & Tubro limited, Virtue Global Holding Limited, Plenary Asia

The move follows an Economic Recovery Plan launched following royal directives of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and as announced by the

Cabinet chaired by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

The ministry is also working on studying phase two of the project by linking the King Hamad International Passenger Station in the Ramli area with the Sports City and Bahrain International Exhibition and Convention Centre in the Sakhr area with a total length of 18 km, including five stops.

Earlier, Kamal Ahmed, the Minister of Transportation and Telecommunication, said, "The Bahrain Metro Project is one of the most important land transport projects providing a new sustainable model of transportation in the Kingdom, aiming to achieve Bahrain Economic Vision 2030. The project is part of the strategic projects plan and comes as a part of the government's priority projects that are worth more than US\$30 billion. The plan to develop an integrated public transport network will raise the efficiency of transport services in the Kingdom."

Brent could push past \$150 if Russian exports shrink, Bank of America says

Global oil benchmark Brent crude could rise past \$150 a barrel if there is a sharp contraction in Russian oil exports, Bank of America (BoFA) Global Research said yesterday.

Oil prices surged after Russian's Ukraine invasion, which Moscow calls a "special operation", and are currently just below the \$120 a barrel level.

"With our \$120/bbl Brent target now in sight, we believe that a sharp contraction in Russian

oil exports could ... push Brent well past \$150/bbl," the bank said in a research note.

The European Commission has proposed an oil embargo on

Russia, though talks have failed to produce a breakthrough so far, with Hungary vetoing the move.

BoFA forecasts Brent prices

averaging \$104.48/bbl in 2022, \$100/bbl in 2023.

The analysts do not forecast a recovery in oil demand to pre-COVID levels in 2022 because supply issues persist.

"A supply-led \$30/bbl increase in oil prices this year shaved 1.5mn b/d off demand, preventing a recovery to pre-COVID levels," the bank's analysts said.

They also said that oil demand could approach pre-COVID levels next year if Russian liquids (oil) production holds near 10 million barrels per day and OPEC+ supplies increase.

US OKs potential sale of Chinook helicopters to Egypt, Pentagon says

of \$2.6 billion. Egypt had requested to buy 23 CH-47F Chinook helicopters, the Pentagon said, adding that the principal contractor will be Boeing Helicopter Co.

Abu Dhabi rebounds ahead of Borouge IPO, Dubai flat

Stocks in Abu Dhabi rebounded yesterday, ahead of its biggest ever initial public offering (IPO) of petrochemicals firm Borouge, although the Dubai index ended flat.

The Abu Dhabi National Oil Company (ADNOC) is selling 10% of its petrochemicals joint venture with Austria's Borealis, known as Borouge.

Borouge said on Monday it has set the offer price for its IPO, which shows it could raise about \$2 billion in the deal, and secured seven cornerstone investors.

According to Daniel Takkiedine, CEO MENA BDSwiss, investors are increasingly looking toward Borouge's IPO as a catalyst and the listing could attract liquidity as well as help the main index near its previous peak.

In Abu Dhabi, the index (.FT-FADGI) advanced 1.6%, with First Abu Dhabi Bank (FAB) (FAB.AD) jumping 6%, its biggest intraday gain in nearly three months.

Logistics firm Aramex leapt 4.8% after the company increased its foreign ownership limit to 100% from 49% earlier.

Monsoon rains likely to hit India in two to three days, weather office says

Monsoon rains are likely to hit India's southern Kerala coast in the next two to three days, the weather office said yesterday, marking the start of the four-month rainy season that is forecast to be average this year, helping the farm sector.

"Conditions are becoming favourable for the onset of Southwest Monsoon over Kerala during the next 2-3 days," the state-run India Meteorological Department said in an update yesterday.

It had already said on May 13 that monsoon rains were likely to reach Kerala on May 27, five days earlier than usual. That would provide some relief after Kerala like other parts of India has been hit by a heat-wave recently. India, one of the world's biggest producers and consumers of farm goods, relies on monsoon rains for watering nearly 50% of its farmland that lacks irrigation.

Last month, the India Meteorological Department said India would receive average monsoon rains in 2022, raising prospects of higher farm and overall economic growth in Asia's third-biggest economy.



The India Meteorological Department defines average, or normal, rainfall as ranging between 96% and 104% of a 50-year average of 87 cm (35 inches) for the season beginning in June.

New Zealand leader plans to discuss contested Indo-Pacific with Biden on Tuesday



Minister Jacinda Ardern said she will meet with US President Joe Biden at the White House next Tuesday, when she expects to discuss increasing competition in the Indo-Pacific, trade and the US economic role in the region. The two countries are close allies but the meeting with Biden had been uncertain after Ardern tested positive for COVID-19 earlier this month, given strict White House pandemic protocols. Ardern, who spoke with reporters on Thursday after delivering the commencement address at Harvard University during a visit to the United States, said she would also meet with US Vice President Kamala Harris the same day.

China and Russia on Thursday vetoed a US-led bid at the United Nations to toughen sanctions on North Korea over its missile launches, laying bare divisions that Western envoys fear would be exploited by Pyongyang.

China, Russia veto US bid at UN to punish North Korea



The Security Council resolution put forward by the United States would have reduced the amount of oil North Korea could legally import as punishment for a test Wednesday of an intercontinental ballistic missile. The resolution enjoyed the support of the 13 other members of the Security Council, although some US allies quietly wondered whether Washington should have gone ahead with the vote knowing the unflinching opposition from Beijing and Moscow.

Bollywood superstar Shah Rukh Khan's son cleared in high-profile drugs case



India's main drug law enforcement agency, the Narcotics Control Board (NCB), said yesterday it was dropping the case against Aryan Khan, 24, and five others due to a lack of "sufficient evidence", while pressing charges against 14 others.

Seven dead as bus carrying Indian soldiers falls into remote gorge

A bus carrying soldiers fell into a gorge in India's remote Ladakh region yesterday, killing at least seven and injuring 19 others, officials said.

The bus plunged off a mountainous road and rolled down the 25-meter (80-foot)-deep gorge in the frigid region's Nubra Valley, police said.

The injured soldiers were flown to a military hospital in

the northern city of Chandigarh, the military said.

Authorities were investigating whether the accident was caused by a mechanical failure or driver negligence. The privately owned bus was hired by the military to transport soldiers in the high-altitude region.

The accident occurred near an area where the borders of India, Pakistan and China meet, in what strategic experts call the world's only three-way nuclear-armed junction.

Turkey's talks with Sweden, Finland made little progress on NATO concerns, sources close to talks say

Talks between Turkish officials and delegations from Sweden and Finland this week in Turkey made little headway overcoming Ankara's objections to the Nordic countries joining NATO, and it is not yet clear when further discussions will take place, according to two sources.

"It is not an easy process," a senior Turkish official said yesterday. "They need to take concrete steps that will be difficult. Further negotiations will continue. But a date doesn't seem very close."

Finland and Sweden formally applied to join NATO last week to boost their security in the face of Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

All 30 NATO members must approve enlargement plans. But Turkey challenged the move saying the Nordic countries harbour people linked to what it calls terrorist groups, and because they have halted arms exports to Ankara. Turkish Foreign Minister Mevlut Cavusoglu said yesterday that his country expects Sweden and Finland to take concrete action and halt such support before it lifts its objections.

Russian forces in eastern Ukraine captured the centre of the railway hub town of Lyman and encircled most of Sievierodonetsk, Ukrainian officials acknowledged yesterday, as Kyiv's forces fell back in the face of Moscow's biggest advance for weeks.

Ukraine insisted its forces were still holding firm at new defensive lines in the eastern Donbas region, despite the apparent Russian advances on two of the major fronts there, battles that showed how momentum has shifted in recent days.

Moscow's separatist proxies said they were fully in control of Lyman, a railway hub that Russia has been attacking from the north in one of the main axes of its advance.

Ukrainian officials acknowledged that Russia had captured most of the town. But the defence ministry said forces were still holding out in northeastern and southwestern districts, blocking the Russians from launching an advance towards Sloviansk, a major city a half-hour drive further southwest.

Further east, Russian forces had encircled two-thirds of the city of Sievierodonetsk, Luhansk regional governor Serhiy Gaidai said. The city is the easternmost major population centre still held by Ukraine in the Donbas, and Russia has been trying to trap Ukraine's main fighting force inside it and its twin city Lysychansk across the Siverskiy Donets river. Ninety percent of buildings in Sievierodonetsk were destroyed, Gaidai said.

Kids called 911 from classroom during Texas massacre as police waited outside - official

Nearly 20 police officers waited for nearly an hour in a hallway outside the classrooms where a gunman killed 19 children and two teachers in a Texas elementary school, even as panicked 911 calls were placed from inside the rooms pleading for police to intervene, authorities said yesterday.

At least one child and one teacher made multiple calls to the 911 emergency number from the two connecting classrooms after 18-year-old Salvador Ramos had entered with an AR-15 semi-automatic rifle, according to Colonel Steven McCraw, director of the Texas Department of Public Safety.

In hindsight, McCraw told reporters at a news briefing, "it was the wrong decision" for the onsite commander to wait for a specially trained tactical team before trying to enter the classroom at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas.

Someone whom McCraw did not identify called the 911 line

multiple times starting at 12:03 p.m., telling police in a whisper that there were multiple dead and that there were still "eight to nine" students alive, the colonel said. A student called at 12:47 p.m. and asked the operator to "please send the police now."

Officers did not go into the classroom until 12:50 p.m., according to McCraw, when the US Border Patrol tactical team used keys from a janitor to open

the locked door and kill Ramos. Several officers had an initial exchange of gunfire with Ramos shortly after he entered the school at 11:33 a.m., when two officers were grazed by bullets. There were as many as 19 officers in the hallway by 12:03 p.m., McCraw said - the same time that the first 911 call from inside the classroom was received.

Police recovered 142 spent rounds inside the school from

Ramos' rifle, as well as nearly two dozen more on school property outside the building, McCraw said.

Videos that emerged on Thursday showed frantic parents urging police to storm the school during the attack, with some having to be restrained by police.

The Ukrainian military's southern command said Russia was shipping in military equipment from Crimea, building a third line of defence to prepare for a potential Ukrainian counter-attack, and mining the banks of a huge reservoir behind a dam on the Dnipro River that separates the forces.

Brazil invites election observers on record scale as Bolsonaro stirs doubts

Brazil is preparing to receive a record number of international observers for its October election, according to electoral authorities and participating organizations, amid a polarized presidential race in which President Jair Bolsonaro has ques-

tioned the reliability of electronic voting machines.

Bolsonaro's government objected to an invitation last month extended by Brazilian electoral authorities to the European Union to send observers for the first time, sinking that proposal.

But the parliament of South American trade bloc Mercosur, known as Parlasur, will send a formal observer mission for the first time, as will the US-based Carter Center and the International Foundation for Electoral

Systems (IFES).

The 34-nation Organization of American States also will send more observers than it did in 2018, when Bolsonaro was elected.

"We don't know the size of the mission yet, that will depend on the money available, but we intend to make it bigger," said a source at the hemispheric forum in Washington, requesting anonymity to comment on preliminary discussions. "In 2018, there were 40 observers and we want to exceed that number."

Another Mass Shooting: Will US Gun Laws Change?

Is it just another day in the USA, with yet another shooting at school?

From long before this Robb Elementary School shooting in Uvalde, Texas, there have been scores of incidents of gunmen going berserk in the USA. But, there is hardly anything done to prevent gun sales.

In fact, a study found that 7.5 million US adults - almost 3% of the population - became new gun owners between January 2019 and April 2021 (Firearm Purchasing during the COVID-19 Pandemic: Results From the 2021 National Firearms Survey, Annals of Internal Medicine, February 2022).

According to a BBC report, "the US ratio of 120.5 firearms per 100 residents, up from 88 per 100 in 2011, far surpasses that of other countries around the world" (America's gun culture - in seven charts, bbc.com, April 2022).

The United States, Yemen, Switzerland, Finland and Cyprus are the top five countries in the world with gun ownership. But, here's something more shocking. US gun ownership is nearly double that of Yemen's, its closest contender.

But, why should ordinary citizens have access to deadly firearms? Common-sense tells us that, even if we ignore pistols or revolvers, civilians should never own lethal automatic or semi-automatic assault guns.

But the powerful gun-lobby will cite the Second Amendment of the US Constitution, from the Bill of Rights, which gives its citizens the right 'to keep and bear arms'.

However, many fail to note that the US Constitution became effective in 1789, and its first 10 amendments, called the Bill of Rights, were ratified in 1791. It was in an era completely different from that of the 2020s.

The US founding fathers probably never imagined the shape of things to come. They may not have visualized automatic and semi-automatic assault weapons, or these extremely violent video games to which the youth are being exposed now.

The USA's National Rifle Association (NRA) argues that more guns make a country safer. They had even argued- in the 2012 Sandy Hook Elementary School shooting case of Connecticut, which killed 26 people - that an armed guard would have lessened the deaths. Their logic is that if everyone is armed, as self-defence, it will reduce deaths. Citizens can even protect themselves from the government if it becomes evil.

Let's take the case of an Australian mass-shooting in 1996. In Port Arthur, Tasmania, 35 people were brutally killed by a gunman Martin Bryant. Intellectually disabled, with a history of erratic behaviour, he had later pleaded guilty, but never gave reason for his gruesome killing.

The then Australian Prime Minister John Howard soon banned almost all fully-automatic or semiautomatic firearms. And the government even instituted a gun-buyback program which made people surrender some 700,000 firearms. They were later destroyed.

The Australian shooter said he had taken inspiration from another case in Scotland, a few months earlier. A gunman had invaded a primary school in the town of Dunblane and shot to death 16 young children and their teacher.

The UK Parliament immediately passed a law banning private ownership of handguns above .22 calibre; and in a few months, the ban got extended to "all handguns".

Following mass shootings, both Australia and the UK had responded swiftly with tighter gun-laws. But the US is just not going that way.

In 2022 so far, there have already been more than 200 mass shootings in the USA - of which 27 are school shootings - according to the Gun Violence Archive, an independent data collection organization.

But, seemingly, the maximum number of mass shootings, which should invoke gun law reforms, has not been reached, yet.


Jennifer Connelly is facing her flying fears.



Collision course: Djokovic, Nadal roll into last 16 at French Open

Novak Djokovic into Roland Garros fourth round for 13th straight year after beating Aljaz Bedene

● **Rafael Nadal powers past Botic van de Zandschulp**

Novak Djokovic and Rafael Nadal closed in Friday on a blockbuster clash at the French Open as both reached the last 16, while Carlos Alcaraz prepared to face the only man to beat him on clay this year.

Reigning champion Djokovic and 13-time winner Nadal are on course to meet in the quarter-finals, with the Spaniard seeded outside the top four at Roland Garros for just the second time.

World number one Djokovic strolled to a 6-3, 6-3, 6-2 win over Slovenia's Aljaz Bedene and Nadal eased past Dutch 26th seed Botic van de Zandschulp 6-3, 6-2, 6-4.

"I'm always very motivated when I get on the court, with the desire to produce my best level each time. It's not always

possible to do it, but today it was very good," said Djokovic.

The 35-year-old Serb is aiming to become the oldest men's singles champion in Paris in the Open era as he chases a record-equalling 21st Grand Slam title.

Next up for Djokovic, who was also French Open champion in 2016, is a match-up with Argentina's Diego Schwartzman, the 15th seed.

Nadal, the 21-time major champion, improved his record at Roland Garros to 108-3 after seeing off 2021 US Open quarter-finalist Van de Zandschulp.

He has now reached at least the fourth round in 17 of 18 visits to Roland Garros, with the exception of 2016 when he withdrew in the third round with a wrist injury.

"I think I played a good match against a good player. I'm very

happy to win," said Nadal.

The Spaniard had a break point for 5-0 in the third set, but Van de Zandschulp refused to roll over, winning four of the next five games before Nadal put away his second match point, having saved a break point in between the two.

"You always feel a little bit the nerves to finish the match, so I'm happy to be through in straight sets," said Nadal, who plays Canadian ninth seed Felix Auger-Aliassime for a place in the last eight.

"I think it was my best match of the tournament so far for two-

and-a-half sets, so I'm very happy with that."

Anisimova, Gauff move on

Amanda Anisimova, the 27th seed and a 2019 semi-finalist, advanced to the last 16 as injury-plagued Karolina Muchova retired down 6-7 (7/9), 6-2, 3-0 after falling and twisting her ankle midway through the second set.

Last year's US Open runner-up Leylah Fernandez beat Olympic champion Belinda Bencic of Switzerland 7-5, 3-6, 7-5, while Aliaksandra Sasnovich defeated three-time Grand Slam winner Angelique Kerber 6-4, 7-6 (7/5).

Coco Gauff, the youngest player left in the French Open, made the last 16 with a straight-sets win over Kaia Kanepi, the oldest woman in the tournament at 36.

After saving a match point in a thrilling five-setter against countryman Albert Ramos-Vinolas, Spanish teenage star Alcaraz goes up against Sebastian Koroda, the US 27th seed who won their meeting in Monte Carlo last month.

"I believe in myself, and of course I work hard every day," said the 19-year-old Alcaraz.

"You have to have a good goal, good dreams. Of course trying to follow your dream. Work hard every day. I think that's the secret.

"I'm still young, but I would say pretty experienced player now. I feel comfortable playing on the big stadium, big matches, playing in a Grand Slam. As I said, physically I'm strong. Mentally I'm strong, as well."

Alexander Zverev, the third seed and 2021 semi-finalist, was also staring at defeat in the second round against Sebastian Baez, saving a match point on serve at 4-5 in the final set after fighting back from two sets down.

The German Olympic champion meets Brandon Nakashima of the US who is enjoying his best Grand Slam run on his Roland Garros main-draw debut.

It is the first time since Wimbledon in 2011 that all top 12 men's seeds have reached the third round at a major.

Asitha rips through Bangladesh as Sri Lanka win Test series

Asitha Fernando finished with a career-best 6-51 as Sri Lanka thrashed hosts Bangladesh by 10 wickets in the second Test on Friday to win the series 1-0.

The visitors bowled out Bangladesh for 169 runs in their second innings with the 24-year-old playing a starring role at Dhaka's Sher-e-Bangla National Cricket Stadium.

"We knew we needed a couple of wickets to go our way," said Sri Lanka skipper Dimuth Karunaratne.

"The fast bowlers did the job for us, both in the first innings as well as the second."

Sri Lanka made 506 runs in the first innings after bowling out Bangladesh for 365.

Oshada Fernando sealed the devastating win with an unbeaten 21 in three overs.

Play had resumed on the fifth and final day with the hosts at a

precarious 34-4 and Sri Lanka upped the pressure when Kasun Rajitha bowled Mushfiqur Rahim for 23 in the eighth over.

Shakib Al Hasan and Liton Das both hit fifties in a 110-run stand and held on through the first session with a mix of caution and aggression.

Shakib's counter-attack saw

him hit Rajitha for three fours in one over, forcing Sri Lanka to widen their field set-up, while Liton played an anchor role after resuming on one overnight.

Liton was given out caught behind off Rajitha on nine as he attempted to flick a ball going down the leg, but survived on review.

Ukraine can make nation proud in World Cup playoff, says Zinchenko

Ukraine full back Oleksandr Zinchenko said his team hope to make their country proud when they take on Scotland in a World Cup playoff semi-final next week.

Ukraine play Scotland at Hampden Park on June 1 in a match that was postponed from March due to the Russia's invasion, which Moscow calls a "special military operation."

"The first period when it just started, it was so complicated to be focused on football," Zinchenko told the BBC.

Bahrain spikers win GCC Games silver

Kingdom's national volleyball team defeat Kuwait in five-set thriller to finish as overall runners-up in men's volleyball tournament at third GCC Games in Kuwait

Bahrain captured the silver medals in men's volleyball last night at the third GCC Games in Kuwait.

The Bahrainis finished as overall runners-up following a hard-earned 3-2 (25-20, 27-25, 22-25, 15-25, 15-13) victory against the host Kuwaitis in their final match of the competition, which was held in league format.

It was the fifth fixture for the nationals at the Games and they finished with four wins and just one loss, which earned them their silver medals. Qatar clinched gold while Oman won bronze.

The Bahrainis were the two-time defending champions heading into the GCC Games, but lost out their chance on an unprecedented "three-peat" after losing to the Qataris in their penultimate assignment.

The men's volleyball team's silver was Bahrain's lone medal from the Games yesterday.

They improved their overall tally to 56, which includes 20 gold medals, 21 silver and 15 bronze.

The Bahrainis maintained their position in second place on the six-nation medal table.

Hosts Kuwait continue to lead, while behind Bahrain ranked third through sixth are the UAE, Qatar, Saudi Arabia and Oman.

In last night's concluding match of the men's volleyball tournament, the Bahrainis got off to a hot start and took a commanding two-set lead following a double-block between Mohamed Aldwairi and Mohamed Yaqoob.

The nationals appeared to be cruising to an easy win, but the home team had some fight left in them and convincingly took the next two sets, sending the game

into the tie-break.

There, Bahrain took a 7-4 lead but the Kuwaitis scored the next three points to tie the proceedings and regain the momentum.

But the Bahrainis managed to pull away for an 11-9 advantage on a service ace by Ali Marhoon, and then later a Naser Anan spike put them on the verge of the win at 14-12.

After Kuwait scored the next point, the home team eventually gifted the win to Bahrain with a service error to end the match, which lasted over two hours.

Yaqoob and Anan top scored for the Bahrainis with 15 points apiece, all of which came on

offence. Ali E b r a h i m added 12 for the nationals.

Abbas Al Khabbaz and Aldwairi were impressive defensively at the net, finishing with four and two blocks, respectively.

Following the match, the medal-winning teams were awarded their respective accolades.

Meanwhile, in the GCC Games' tennis tournament, Bahrain bowed to hosts Kuwait 0-3 in their group

clash last night in the men's team event.

In the first match, Hasan Abdulreda lost to Kuwait's Abdulhamid Mubarak 2-6, 0-6; and then Yusuf Qaed fell to Essa Qabazard 4-6, 2-6.

The pairing of Youssef Ashraf and Jaber Abdula'al then suffered a 1-6, 2-6 defeat to Qabazard and Bader Antar to close out the affair.

The Bahrainis will look to bounce back today when they play Saudi Arabia in their next match, scheduled for a 4.30pm start, Bahrain time.

In yesterday's action in padel, both Bahrain's men's and women's teams suffered losses in their respective competitions.

In the men's team event, the Bahrainis lost to Saudi Arabia 1-2.

Rashed Alobaidli and Khaled Althawadi went down fighting to Fahaad Al Saad and Omar Al Thagib 3-6, 6-0, 3-6 in the first match.

Bahrainis Ali Dawani and Husain Dawani then posted a 6-3, 6-0 win over Sattam Alshahrani and Abdulrahman Alazzam. But then Abdulla Mohamed and Ali

Alasfoor lost the decisive match to Musaeed Alazzam and Omar Abdo 6-7, 4-6.

On the distaff, Bahrain lost 1-2 to Oman in the women's team competition.

Maryam Alammadi and Maryam Isa opened the head-to-head with a 1-6, 3-6 loss to Fatma Al Nabhani and Maryam Al Balushi.

Bahrainis Safa Safar and Esra Nuruddin then fell to Azza Al Hinai and Sarah Al Balushi 1-6, 2-6; before Sara Khonj and Fatima Jassim closed the contest with a 6-0, 6-0 win over Eathar Al Bulooshi and Quote Al Nabhani.

Leclerc tops both practice sessions for Monaco Grand Prix

Charles Leclerc topped both of Friday's practice sessions at the Monaco Grand Prix, where the Ferrari driver could use a victory on his home track to return to the top of the Formula One standings.

Ferrari had a solid close to the day as Carlos Sainz Jr. was second-fastest behind teammate Leclerc.

Red Bull was right behind the Ferrari drivers as Sergio Perez and Max Verstappen were third and fourth fastest but lacked

Leclerc lost the F1 points lead last week in Spain. F1's reigning champion Verstappen has won three consecutive races to knock Leclerc from the top of the standings. Leclerc won two of the first three races to build a 46-point lead in the standings, but Verstappen has four wins and now leads Leclerc by six points.

But Leclerc is motivated at Monaco; he's never finished an F1 race on his hometown streets. He's so comfortable with the circuit that he cycles to the track from his apartment, and although he won the pole

last year, he never even started the race because of damage to his Ferrari.

Mercedes, meanwhile, had a disappointing pair of practice sessions with George Russell and seven-time F1 champion Lewis Hamilton. The duo both trail Ferrari and Red Bull in speed and the new Mercedes has struggled with what's called "porpoising" - an aerodynamic issue where cars hop and bounce on the track.

Hamilton struggled in Friday's second practice and was 12th on the speed chart, a whopping 1.61-seconds behind Leclerc.

The national team is conducting their Bangkok camp in preparation for their AFC Asian Cup 2023 qualifiers, which will be held in Kuala Lumpur next month.

Bahrain are in Group E of qualification, which includes hosts Malaysia, in addition to Bangladesh and Turkmenistan.
